### Dvojni zasluzkarji ne škodijo brezposelnim

Raziskovalni oddelek Federal Reserve Bank v Clevelandu je dognal, da bi brezposelnih lahko prevzeli le mal del zaposlitev, ki jih vrše ljudje z dvemi posli.

CLEVELAND, O. — Po podatkih, ki jih je zbral raziskovalni oddelek Federal Reserve Bank v Clevelandu, je v vsej deželi povprečno okoli 5 odstotkov ljudi, ki imajo po dve službi. Dvojni zasluzkarji ali kot jima pravijo v naši deželi "moonlighters", ne vrše dveh polnih zaposlitev, ampak eno redno, polno zaposlitev, drugo pa le delno.

Po uradnih podatkih je bilo leta 1956 takih ljudi v vsej deželi 3.6 milijonov ali 5.5 odstotkov celotne delovne sile v deželi. V naslednjih treh letih je njihovo število zdrknilo na 3 milijone ali 4.5 odstotkov celotne delovne sile, pa se lani povzelo na novo višino 3.9 milijonov oseb ali 5.7 odstotkov celotne delovne sile.

Po dve službi imajo največ ljudje, ki so osnovno zaposleni v kmetijstvu, veliko je takih, ki imajo glavno zaposlitev v javni administraciji, v šolstvu, zlasti učitelji, pa tudi taki, ki so redno zaposleni v transportu in javnih napravah kot so telefon, elektrarne, plinarne, vodovodi in razni javni servisi. Posebno znanci so avtomehaniki, lastniki lastnih farm. Ti opravljajo svoj posel na farmi, pa tudi povpravljajo motorna vozila in jih oskrbujejo z gorivom, kot jim to gre najbolj v račun. Te vrste dvojnih zasluzkarjev je izredno veliko.

Povprečni dvojni zasluzkar je star od 25 do 44 let, ki ima posebne obveznosti za rastočo družino in to ne more vzdrževati na ravni, kot bi rad, z enim samim zasluzkom. Ženske imajo le redko dve službi, prav tako mladi ljudje izpod 20 let ali stari nad 65 let.

Po sedanjih računih so druge službe pretežno le "delne", povprečno okoli 15 ur na teden.

Raziskava trdi, da dvojni zasluzkarji opravljajo največ posele, ki bi jih redni brezposelni težko opravljali, ker jim manjka za to strokovnega znanja, ali pa bi se jih branili, ker bi jim prinašali sorazmerno mal zasluzek v sorazmerno neugodnih okoliščinah.

Vodniki študentov so napovedali za jutri nove demonstracije v Sajgonu, če vlada ne bo reorganizirana po njihovih željah.

SAJGON, J. Viet. — Vlada Tran Van Huong je komaj dobro prevzela svoje posle, pa je že v nevarnosti pred javnimi protesti. Vodniki študentov so zagrozili, da bodo jutri izvedli velike demonstracije v glavnem mestu, če vlada ne bo spremena tako, da bodo v njej primerno zastopani tudi budisti in katoličani. Huong je sestavil strokovno vlado na stališču ločitve cerkve in države. S tem stališčem niso zadovoljni ne budisti ne katoličani.

Tran Van Huong je sprejel v svojo vlado 15 ministrov tudi nekaj strokovnjakov, ki so bili nekaj uradnikov v vladi umorjenega predsednika Ngo Dinh Diema. Predsednik republike Phan Khac Suu je sprejel zastopnike nezadovoljnih skupin, da bi preprečil nove izgredne in demonstracije, ki bi utegnile pognati deželo v novo vladno krizo. Po razgovoru s predstavniki nezadovoljne je predsednik republike imel daljši posvet z ameriškim poslanikom M. Taylorjem.

Ko se glavno mesto posveča notranje-politični borbi, je srednji del dežele zadelu buda naravna nesreča, ko je zaradi monzunskega deževja naraslo vodovje poplavilo dober del nižje ležečega ozemlja. Ameriški vojaški helikopterji odvajajo že več dni one, ki so odtrganici od sveta po naraslih vodah in so v nevarnosti, drugimi pa prinašajo nujne živiljenjske potrebuščine in zdravila.

Več vladnih čet je začelo po bombardiranju preteklo nedeljo prodirati na ozemlje "železne trikota" v bližini letališča Bien Hoa, od koder so rdeči gverilci 1. novembra obstrelevali to letališče in uničili vrsto ameriških letal ter ubili šest ameriških vojakov. Uspeh tega pohoda je doslej brez uspeha.

Glasovi črnih volivcev odločili prenekateri volivni boj

CLEVELAND, O. — Prvi pregledi volivnih rezultatov po volivnih okrajih in voliščih potrjujejo vsi do zadnjega, da so glasovi črnih volivcev pomagali do zmage prenekateremu politiku, ki podporuje črnih volivcev. Niti zaslužil ni.

Razpoloženje med črnimi volivci je bilo namreč sledče:

Do sedaj je volilo nekako dva milijona črnih volivcev, letos je treba dodati še kakih 700,000 do 800,000 na novo registriranih. Vsi ti so se najbrže kar po občutku držali sledče taktike: Vsi so volili solidarno, kogar so volili. Pregledi rezultatov ugotavljajo, da so črni volili 95-100% kandidat, ki so se zanje odločili. To je bila rasna zavednost, kot je ameriška politična zgodovina ne pozna. Z njem bodo morali v prihodnosti računati vsi politiki obeh strank.

Dalje je bilo značilno, da so črni glasovi bili usmerjeni v glavnem ne samo proti Goldwa-

terju, ampak tudi proti tistim, ki so ga podpirali, naj pripadajo eni ali drugi stranki. Črni volivci so trenutno pozabili na stranke, imeli so pred očmi samo Goldwaterja. Tako razpoloženje je pomagalo do poraza mnogim republikanskim kandidatom, ki bi bili drugače s pomočjo belih konservativnih demokratov gotovo zmagali.

V državi Georgia je na primer kandidiral demokratski kandidat in kongresnik Weltner. Ker je v Kongresu glasoval za Johnsonove zakone, so ga zapustili konservativni demokrati in podprt kandidaturo republikanca Callaghana. 
