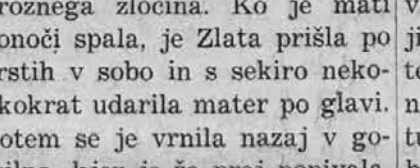

SSPZ National Indoor Baseball, Horseshoe Pitching and Lawn Bowling Tournament September 2, 3, 1934, Strabane, Pa.

(a) Indoor baseball teams shall be limited to fifteen (15) players.

(b) The ball tournament shall be determined by a process of elimination. Any team that is defeated two (2) times in the preliminaries shall be eliminated.

(c) The preliminary ball games shall consist of seven (7) innings. The final and championship games shall consist of nine (9) innings.

(d) The 14" inseam ball shall be used throughout the tournament.

(e) The horseshoe tournament shall be contested in singles and doubles.

(f) There shall be no limit as to the number of contestants representing any one lodge in the horseshoe pitching tournament.

(g) The process of elimination shall be used to determine the horseshoe pitching tournament. The loss of one (1) game shall eliminate the contestants.

(h) In the horseshoe pitching preliminaries the player or players first scoring twenty-one (21) points shall constitute a game. The final and championship games shall be determined by a first score of fifty (50) points.

(i) Lawn Bowling (balina) teams shall consist of four (4) players. Each lodge shall be limited to one (1) team.

(j) Any lawn bowling (balina) team that is defeated once in the preliminaries shall be eliminated.

(k) A lawn bowling (balina) game shall be won by the team first scoring 21 points.

(l) Distant lodges desiring to save traveling expenses, may enter members of the ball team as contestants in the horseshoe pitching and lawn bowling tournaments.

(m) All contestants must be recognized members of the Slovene Progressive Benefit Society. New members, whose applications are received by the main office on or before the 25th day of August, and who shall be admitted to the Society on September 1, 1934, are eligible to compete in this tournament.

(n) For all rules governing this tournament refer to Spaulding's Athletic Library. See book No. 12R for indoor baseball. Book No. 86R covers the rules on horseshoe pitching and lawn bowling.

(o) Entries close on August 15, 1934, with the secretary of the National Athletic Board at 255 West 103rd Street, Chicago, Illinois.
