Pittsburgh, Pa., 26. januarja. Država Pennsylvanija je prva država v Uniji, ki je začela s točnim izplačevanjem brezposelne zavarovalnine. 345,000 delavcev, ki so bili brez dela, je deležnih te podpore.

2,000 delavcev se vrne na delo pri Willys-Overland

Toledo, Ohio, 26. januarja. Tekom prihodnjih dveh tednov se bo vrnilo najmanj 2,000 delavcev na delo pri Willys-Overland tovarni, kot naznanja vodstvo tovarne. Kompanija naznanja, da se je zadnje čase nabralo precej naročil in ljudje zahtevajo zlasti lahke in cenene avtomobile. V tovarni je dosedaj delalo le kakih 500 ljudi. Kot naznanja predsednik družbe je zaenkrat dovolj dela za 6 mesecev in bo mogoče še nadaljnih tisoč ljudi poklicanih na delo.

21 zarotnikov

Zvezna velika porota v Clevelandu je včeraj obtožila 21 oseb, katerim se očita, da so se zarotili proti zvezni vladi, da sledijo osleparijo na davkih za zganje. Dotične osebe so kuhale zganje, ne da bi plačale zganjarski davke in so tako vlado osleparile za \$150,000 v davkih. Imeli so letnega prometa v znesku \$1,000,000. Vsi obtoženi so Italijani, pri katerih so dobili deset kotlov, vsak po 500 galon obsega.

Vsi pametni so nas poslušali. Uspeh našega delovanja na državljanskem polju je, da imamo v Clevelandu in v predmestjih najmanj 35,000 naših ljudi, ki imajo ameriško državljanstvo pravico. In hvaležni so nam, ker so nas poslušali.
Pisali smo ves čas resnico, ko smo trdili, da bodo državljanske postave postajale od leta do leta bolj stroge, kajti nativistični element, ki je danes v ospredju, črno gleda na tujezemce v Ameriki.

Najprvo so šli in zaprli vrata novim naseljencom. Potem so naredili skrajno krute postave glede deportacije, in končno združili pridobitev ameriškega papirja s toliko sitnostmi in paragrafi, da mora biti človek trdne volje in odločnosti ter imeti dobre nasvete, da se prebije skozi labirint postavnih zank in prepadov.

Toda še hujše stvari prihajajo na dan. Na primer, državna postavodaja v Columbusu je odredila \$12,000,000 za relief brezposelnih, toda k tej postavi je dodala točko, da oni, ki nimajo državljanstva papirja, ne morejo dobiti reliefa.

Taki postavodajalci zaslužijo palico. Ali naj siromak, ki je brez papirja, brez denarja, brez dela, brez reliefa, gre živ v zemljo? Seveda, je tak siromak večji del sam kriv svoje nesreče, ker ni storil tistih par korakov za pridobitev državljanstva pravčasno, toda računati moramo z dejstvom, da je takih ljudi v Ohio na stotisoče, in kaj bo država naredila z njimi?
Na governerja države Ohio se je iz tega vzroka naredil silen pritisk, da tako postavo prepove. Od Martina Daveya, ohijskega governerja, je odvisno, če bo prodanih lakoti in morebitni smrti stotisoče brezposelnih. To bi bilo naravnost barbarsko za Zedinjene države. Saj smo vendar ljudje, kristijani, ki kaj takega ne bi smeli nikdar dovoliti. Zato je tudi naše uredništvo poslalo protest na governerja s prošnjo, da prepove omenjeno postavo.

To se bo skoro gotovo tudi zgodilo, toda s tem še ni odstranjena nevarnost, ki grozi onim, ki so brez papirjev. Da, nevarnost postaja še večja. Ze je prišlo iz Washingtona povelje, da nihče ne more dobiti WPA del, kdor nima vsaj prvega papirja.
Vsakdo ve, da je tisoče naših ljudi brez dela. Ko se je zvedelo, da bo v Clevelandu dobilo nadaljnih 15,000 ljudi WPA dela, toda morajo imeti vsaj prvi papir, so začeli prihajati v naš urad stoteri rojaki, ki so prosili, da jim spišemo prošnjo za dotični papir. In še prihajajo dnevno številni rojaki.

To izjavo sta podala oba ministra pred japonskim parlamentom, toda s tem predpogojem, da dobi Kitajska vlado, ki je prijateljska napram Japonski in da Kitajska sodeluje z Japonsko proti širjenju ruskega komunizma.

Ta točka je bila sprejeta, ker se je dognalo, da je tisoče čizlerjev na reliefu, ki tako škodujejo v resnici potrebnim ljudem. Ako bi bila imena vseh reliefarjev priobčena v javnosti, bi ljudje kmalu dognali, kdo je potreben reliefa in kdo ne. 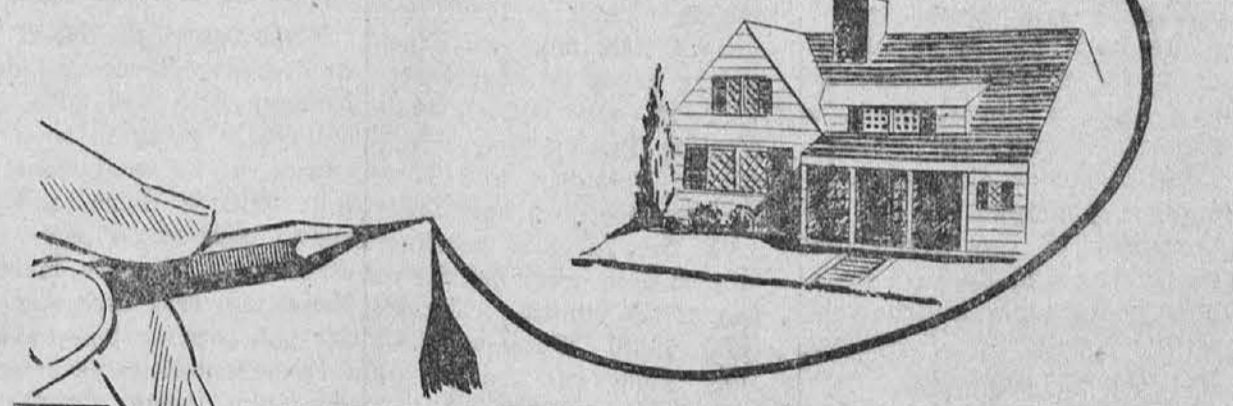
