klicne delavce. Delavci so v tej industriji organizirani 98%. Unija ima okrog 35,000 članov in je izvojevala razmeroma dobre delovne pogoje.

Potrebna je posebna duječnost, da se v šole ne zanesne "nevarne propagande". Učitelji naj imajo svobodo govorja, toda ne v šolah, ker otrok in študentov ne smejo indoctrinirati. Verski vpliv v šolah je treba protektirati. To je bilo jedro konflikta, ko pride preizkušnja delitve lojalnosti in ti tvorijo podlago lepim prizorom v povesti, ki je polna zpletanj."

## Norveška odklonila sovjetsko zahtevo

### Trockij ne bo izgnan iz države

Oslo, Norveška, 1. sept.—Člani norveškega kabinka so na včerajnji seji odločili, da ne bo dolegnili Trockija, bivšega boljševiškega voditelja, katerega je sovjetska vlada obtožila kot voditelja zarotnikov, ki so namevali umorit Stalina in druge visoke sovjetske uradnike. Zahteva sovjetske vlade, naj Norveška izdene Trockija, je kabinet ne odloknil.

Člani kabinka so po dajali razpravi naznali, da bo vlada poslala Trockija v samoten kraj, kjer bo pod stalnim policijskim nadzorstvom. Prejana poročila so podarjala, da bo norveška vlada internirala Trockija na nekem svojem otoku v bližini "norveške Sibirije".

Trockij se sedaj nahaja v Hoenfossu in njegovo stanovanje je močno zastraženo. Avtoritete so uveljavile posebne ukrepe, ki regulirajo vsa njegova gibanja. Trockij ne sme sprejeti nobene osebe brez vladnega dovoljenja.

Cleveland.—The Cleveland Slovene young people offer their contribution to the parade of the cultures of the world displayed this year at the Cleveland Great Lakes Exposition with a stage program to be presented under auspices of the Inter-Lodge League on Thursday evening, September 3. The program will be given on International Circle, Streets of the World, at 8 p. m.

Many SNPJ lodges and members are vitally interested in the Inter-Lodge league. The SNPJ Federation team, which has appeared at Idora park and Detroit tournament and will travel to the SNPJ Day in Library over the holidays, is in the Inter-Lodge softball league battling for second place. The SNPJ Comrades were runners-up for the championship last year. The League has also seen the teams of the SNPJ Loyalties and the SNPJ Commodores and SNPJ Strugglers flash by its eight year history of baseball, basketball, and bowling.

The program to be presented by the Inter-Lodge at the Great Lakes Exposition will be the only one of any nationality which will be arranged and conducted by the younger people. It promises to be one of the outstanding programs presented at the Exposition this summer, as may be judged by the fact that the management of the Exposition thought the program good enough to offer the League the use of its gigantic band shell or its gorgeous Marine Theatre.
