### Detroitski prosekutor se pritožuje

Detroit, Mich. — Pomanjkanje kooperacije s strani federalnega justičnega departamenta in državnih avtoritet ovira preiskavo aktivnosti članov Črne legije in prosekucijo, pravi okrajni prosekutor Duncan McCrea. Prosekutor je tudi dejal, da bodo obravnave proti članom teroristične organizacije odkrile zveze med njimi in ljudmi, "ki imajo visoke javne urade."

### Gozdni požari v zapadnih državah

Spokane, Wash., 1. sept. — Armada tisoč mož je bila mobilizirana za gašenje gozdnih požarov v severnem delu države Idaho in zapadnem delu Montane. Več tisoč akrov gozda je v plamenih. Gozdni požari divjajo tudi v Severni Dakoti, dostavlja poročilo. V bližini Deadwooda, N. D., je ogenj uničil gozd v obsegu tisoč akrov.

### Kaos šolstva v Landonovi državi

#### Landon se je vsa leta upiral reformam

Washington. — Kansaski gubernor in republikanski predsedniški kandidat Landon se je zadnjič v svojem govoru v Chautauqui, N. Y., predstavil kot velik zagovornik in prijatelj "konstruktivnega", "adzevega" šolskega sistema. V uvodu je sam priznal, da njegov govor ne bo briljanten kakor kakega profesorja, kar je bila največja vrлина tega govora.

V njem je Landon orisal svoje namere o šolstvu, ki so tipično burbonski. On je proti centralizaciji šolske izobrazbe, ker je decentralizacija najboljša garancija za "ohranitev demokracije". Potrebna je posebna čuječnost, da se v šole ne zaneša "nevarne propagande". Učitelji naj imajo svobodo govora, toda ne v šolah, ker otrok in študentov ne smejo indoktrinirati. Veraki vpliv v šolah je treba protektirati. To je bilo jedro njegovega govora.

Vse to je popolnoma v skladu z arhaičnim šolskim sistemom v Kansasu, katerega je Landon vsa štiri leta svoje administracije skrbno protektiral pred reformami. Kansaski šolski sistem je proučila Delavska neustrankarska liga, ki pravi, da je šolstvo zadnja briga v Kansasu.

V podeželskih krajih ni niti enega šolskega busa. Država tudi nima nobenega zakona o minimalni plači za učitelje in učiteljice. Posledica tega je, da je povprečna plača podeželskih učiteljev \$37.79 na mesec. Dobe se tudi učiteljice, ki prejema jo le po \$25 na mesec.

Slična temu je tudi upravna stran. Med tem ko napredne države grade moderna šolska poslopja tudi po deželi, o tem v Kansasu nič ne vedo. Kansas ima 8687 šolskih distriktov, ki so na aplošno brez vsake realne podlage. 7267 teh distriktov imajo po eno učiteljico. V enem teh distriktov ni bilo lani nobenega učenca, učiteljica pa je bila nastavljena skozi šest mesecev s plačo \$35. 22 distriktov je imelo po enega šolarja, 61 po dva šolarja, 163 po tri in 2228 distriktov je imelo le po 10 otrok. Mnogo teh distriktov je imelo šole le dva do tri mesece v letu.

Liga pravi, da je za ta kaotični sistem v prvi vrsti odgovoren gubernor Landon, ker je skrbel, da je legislatura pokopala vse predloge za reformiranje, s katerimi je prišel pred vsako zasedanje državni šolski načelnik. Vsa pa Landon ni ganil niti z mezinem za izboljšanje šolskega sistema.

### Slamnatno glasovanje za industrijske unije

New York. — Slamnatno glasovanje, katerega je vodila po vsej deželi ustanova Institute of Public Opinion, je izpadlo v prilog industrijskemu unionizmu. Za to unijsko formo se je izreklo 59% volilcev in 41% proti. Glasovanje je bilo omejeno večinoma na delavce in je rezultat prilično dober barometer njih sentimenta o tem vprašanju. To glasovanje je dognalo še druge zanimave stvari. Ljudje, ki so za "tretjo" stranko, so skoraj stoodstotno za industrijski unionizem, republikanci so na splošno proti, demokrate pa so razdeljeni na približno enaki skupini. Za unionizem na splošno se je izreklo 76% volilcev, proti pa 24%.

### Norveška odklonila sovjetsko zahtevo

#### Trockij ne bo izgnan iz dežele

Oslo, Norveška, 1. sept. — Člani norveškega kabineta so na večerajnji seji odločili, da ne bodo isgnali Trockija, bivšega boljševiškega voditelja, katerega je sovjetska vlada obtožila kot voditelja zarotnikov, ki so name-ravali umoriti Stalina in druge visoke sovjetske uradnike. Zahtevo sovjetske vlade, naj Norveška izšene Trockija, je kabinnet odklonil.

Člani kabineta so po daljši razpravi naznanili, da bo vlada poslala Trockija v samotni kraj, kjer bo pod stalnim policijskim nadzorvom. Prejājna poročila so poudarjala, da bo norveška vlada internirala Trockija na nekem svojem otoku v bližini "norveške Sibirije".

Trockij se sedaj nahaja v Hoenfossu in njegovo stanovanje je močno zadržano. Avtoritete so uveljavile posebne ukrepe, ki regulirajo vsa njegova gibanja. Trockij ne sme sprejeti nobene osebe brez vladnega dovoljenja.

### Odmevi eksekucije ruskih zarotnikov

#### Tajnik socialistične stranke hvali Trockija

Chicago. — (FP) — Obravnava pred sovjetskim vojnim sodiščem in eksekucija šestnajstih zarotnikov, ki so bili spoznani za krive, da so nameravali umoriti Stalina in druge prominentne voditelje, sta izzvali odmev tudi v Ameriki.

Clarence Senior, tajnik socialistične stranke, je poslal telegram norveški delavski stranki, v katerem kritizira akcijo sovjetske vlade, "ker je vodila obravnavo v času, ko se španski levičarji borijo proti fašističnim rebelom, ki hočejo uničiti demokracijo v Španiji." Senior dalje oboja sovjetske avtoritete, ker niso dovolile reprezentantom Delavske in socialistične internacionale in zastopnikom Mednarodne zveze strokovnih unij vstopa na obravnavo. Senior hvali Trockijeve zasluge v delavskem gibanju in priporoča imenovanje mednarodne delavske komisije, ki naj bi zaslišala Trockija in štela njegovo pravico do zavetja v zunanji državi.

Istočasno je Roger N. Baldwin, predsednik Mednarodnega odbora za politične jetnike, objavil poročilo dveh angleških in enega ameriškega odvetnika, ki so prisostvovali obravnavi proti ruskim zarotnikom. Poročilo pravi, da je bil telegram, v katerem je rečeno, da reprezentantje Delavske in socialistične internacionale niso dobili vstopa na obravnavo, "fantastičen".

"Izjavljamo, da so imeli obtoženci pravično obravnavo", pravijo odvetniki v svoji izjavi. "Obravnava je dokazala zvezo med zarotniki in nacijsko tajno policijo in zarotniki so zaslužili smrtno kazen."

To izjavo so podpisali odvetniki Joseph Edelman, Dudley Col-lard in Robert Lazarus.

### Amerika bo umaknila bojno brodoge iz vojne cone

#### Državni department še ni prejel odgovora na protest glede napada na bojno ladjo. Španska ljudska armada porazila rebele na severni fronti. Fašistični letalci obnovili bombardiranje Madrida. Levičarska vlada naznanila razpust civilne garde

Washington, D. C., 1. sept. — Državni tajnik Cordell Hull je večeraj izjavil, da bodo vse ameriške bojne ladje, ki se nahajajo v španskih vodah, odpoklicane, da se Amerika tako izogne komplikacijam v zvezi s civilno vojno, ki divja v Španiji. Bojne ladje so bile poslane v španske vode, da pomagajo pri evakuaciji ameriških državljanov iz Španije.

Dalje je Hull dejal, da še ni prejel odgovora na protest, ki ga je naslovil madridski vladni po-veljnikštvu fašističnih rebelov po bombardiranju ameriške bojne ladje iz zraka. Doslej še ni bilo ugotovljeno, ali je bombe vrglo rebelno ali vladno letalo.

Druga vest se glasi, da bo washingtonska vlada zaprla svoje poslanstvo v Madridu. Poslanik Claude G. Bowers se je kmalu po izbruhu civilne vojne umaknil iz Madrida v Francijo in osmaniške pošte vodi sedaj Eric C. Wendell.

Irun, Španija, 1. sept. — Uradno poročilo javlja, da je ljudska armada s pomočjo bojnih letal razpršila koloni fašističnih legionarjev in da so rebeli utrpeli velike izgube. Legionarji so se morali umakniti z utrjenih pozicij, katere so nekaj dni prej zasedli na južni strani gorovja Er-lais.

Lizbona, Portugalska, 1. sept. — Poročilo z rebelne radiopostaje v Sevilji je naznanilo, da je bilo 70 rudarjev v Rio Tintu, kjer so veliki bakreni rudniki, ustreljenih, ker so sodelovali pri transportaciji municije in orožja španski ljudski armadi.

Berlin, 1. sept. — Nacijska vlada je odredila premostitev svojega poslanstva iz Madrida v Alicante vled nezadostne protekcije, znano pa je posvarila madridsko vlado, da bo ona odgovorna za varnost uradnikov nemškega poslanstva. Alicante je utrjeno pristanišče in je oddaljeno od Madrida okrog 250 milj.

Madrid, 1. sept. — Levičarska vlada je naznanila razpust civilne garde, ki šteje 30,000 mož. To bo nadomestila z republikansko gardo, katero bodo tvorili elementje, na katere se bo vlada lahko zanesla.

Socialisti so takoj po strmo-glavljenju monarhije zahtevali razpust civilne garde, toda liberalni republikanci so v bojani pred socialno revolucijo odklonili zahtevo. V sedanjih civilni vojni so se člani civilne garde pridružili rebelom v vseh krajih, kjer so bili fašisti v premoči.

Civilna garda je bila ustanovljena v devetnajstem stoletju in je bila vedno poslušna dekla španske monarhije, fevdalnih baronov in katoliške cerkve. V vseh uporih in revolucijah, ko so španski kmetje in delavci šli v boj za svoje pravice, je bila civilna garda glavna opora reakcije.

Seville, Španija, 1. sept. — Tukajšnja fašistična radiopostaja je naznanila obnovitev bombardiranja Madrida iz zraka. Rebelna letala so vrgla večje število bomb na urada vojnega in notranjega ministarstva in na glavno železniško postajo. Poročilo dostavlja, da so eksplozije bomb ubile in ranile okrog tristo oseb.

Burgos, Španija, 1. sept. —

Večje število civilistov je bilo ubitih, ko so vladna letala vrgla litiri bombe na azil St. Jean in bolnišnico, s katere je vihrala zastava Rdečega križa. V bolnišnici so bile štiri osebe ubite in 16 ranjenih.

Irun, Španija, 1. sept. — Rebeli so obnovili bombardiranje tega mesta. Topovi, ki so jih rebeli postavili na hribu v bližini mesta, bruhajo granate, katero so razdejale še večje število poslopj. Šest fašističnih letal, ki so se nenadoma pojavila nad mestom, je vrglo nekaj bomb, nakar so odletela nazaj.

Krueger, profesor na čikaški univerzi in aktiven v delavskem gibanju, Joško Oven, Maximilian Olaj od Odbora za obrambo avobode v Španiji in en češki govornik. Pričetek ob 8. zvečer, vstop prost.

### Eksplozija v nemškem premogovniku

#### Dvajset rudarjev izgubilo življenje

Hochum, Westfalija, Nemčija, 1. sept. — Eksplozija, ki se je večeraj pripetila v nemškem tukajšnjem premogovniku, je ubila dvajset rudarjev, dvajset drugih pa je dobilo težke poškodbe. Eksplozija je zajela 325 rudarjev, ki so bili na delu v premogovniku. Tri se pogrešajo, ostale pa je rešilno moštvo že spravilo na površje. Vrak eksplozije še ni bil ugotovljen.

### Belgija ne da azila antinaciji

New York. — Otto Richter, mladi antinacijski ubežnik, ki mora iti iz Amerike radi nepostavnega prihoda, ni dobil azila v Belgiji, ker se je belgijska vlada premislila in preklicala prvotno dovoljenje. Odbor za protekiranje tužencev sedaj išče drugo državo, kamor bi Richter lahko šel.

# Na kaj je treba paziti pri uživanju sadja

Sadje je zdrava in dobra hrana. Ima mnogo vitaminov, hranljivih soli, osvežujočega eteričnega olja in sladkorja.

Pri uživanju sadja moramo paziti na sledeče:

1. Jesti smemo samo zrelo sadje. Nezrelo sadje je težko prebavljivo in lahko izzove težke posledice v želodcu in črevesju. Nezrelo in prezrelo sadje uporabite za komplete in marmelade.
2. Pred jedjo je treba sadje dobro oprati. Na sadju se zbira prah in bacili raznih nalezljivih bolezni. Jagode češnje, višnje in sploh sadje, ki ga kupujete na trgu, je treba izprati celo po večkrat.
3. Ljudje z občutljivim želodcem naj sadje olupijo. Zdravi ljudje pa naj jedo sadje neolupljeno, kajti v lupini je največ vitaminov.
4. Samo po sebi je umevno, da je treba črvi vo in nagnito sadje obrezati.
5. Tudi sadje moramo dobro prežvečati, da želodec in čreva ne bi imeli preveč posla. Tudi sadja ne smemo jesti preveč hkratu, ker prevelika količina rada povzroča težave v želodcu.
6. Večjih sadnih koštic in zrn nikar ne požirajte. Ena ali dve koščici vam morda res še ne povzročijo posebnih težav, ker jih želodec pusti neprebavljene dalje, toda v večji množini zaužite koščice privedejo do težkih posledic. (Trditev, da povzročajo pogojitvene koščice vnetje slepiča, sicer res ne drži.—Vnetje slepiča povzročajo bacili.) Povzročajo pa druge težke prebavnim organom.
7. Nikoli ne smemo neposredno po zaužitem sadju piti vode, ker se sadno meso napihne, kar povzroča tudi hude bolečine.

## Da si ohranite obleko čim dalje lepo

Kadar pridete domov s trga, z obiska itd., se takoj preoblecite in obleko osušite.

Mnoge ženske imajo navado, da obleke takoj po uporabi obesijo v omaro, ali pa jo enostavno vržejo preko stola ali postelje. Takšna obleka bo kaj kmalu izgubila svojo prvotno obliko. UNIVERSAL, PA.—Sept. 5-6-7 activities will attract thousands of SNPJers and friends. Extensive program planned by the three Western Penna Federations—Speakers, Athletics, Entertainment.

The two Slovene speaking and one English speaking SNPJ Federations of Western Penna, comprising approximately forty five lodges, take this last opportunity to extend a hearty welcome to all SNPJers, to attend the Second Annual SNPJ Celebration in Western Penna, on Sept. 5-6-7. The happy occasion is SNPJ Day not for Western Penna only, but for all the localities where the SNPJ is known and where an SNPJ Lodge might exist. #### SEPT. 5

The celebration will commence with a dance at Slovene Hall, Butler st., Pittsburgh, featuring Benny Burton's broadcasting orchestra from 8.30 to 12 e. s. t. Benny Burton's orchestra is commendably well known in SNPJ circles and has won the reputation as one of the best in Pittsburgh vicinity.

#### SEPT. 6

This will be the "Big Day" of the celebration, this will be celebrated as National SNPJ Day. The program will open at 10 a. m. (e. s. t.) with an SNPJ MUSHBALL Tournament, under the supervision of the Nat'l Athletic Board. The SNPJ Day affair will take place at Jones' Pleasure Grounds, near UNIVERSAL, on the Hulton road. The teams competing are the Mid-West All-Stars (Chicago, Detroit, Milwaukee, etc.), Northeastern All-Stars (Cleveland, Gowanda, Buffalo, etc.), and the Pennsy All-Stars (Veronians). Racing and field events will take place between mushball games under the supervision of the Western Penna E. S. Federation Athletic Board. The final mushball game is scheduled for 2.30 o'clock. This is the championship game to determine the SNPJ Champions for 1936. Individual medals will be awarded the winners of the tournament. Truly, we hold no sectional bias, but this Veronian aggregation looks good to us. But out of staters can feel assured that the officials and umpires will be fair and impartial.

Good prizes will also be awarded to the winners of the field events and races.

The speakers' program will commence at 4 p. m. Supreme President Vincent Cainkar will deliver the principal address. Bro. John Tercej of the Western Penna Slovene Speaking Federation, Bro. John Fradel of the Westmoreland County Federation, and Bro. Henry Lamuth of the Western Penna E. S. Federation are among others scheduled to speak. Early in the evening, Slovene music will be furnished by the Moonlight Serenaders, followed later in the evening with popular tunes by the same orchestra.

#### SEPT. 7

The last day of the celebration will be concluded with a conference of E. S. members, convening at Pittsburgh Slovene Hall, Butler st., at 10 a. m. The conference will particularly dwell upon the subject of SNPJ Athletics. However, it is hoped that the assemblage will find time to discuss other questions that confront the SNPJ youth.

And then the parting of the ways, the handshakes, the farewells, until the next SNPJ Day Celebration. Where will it be?

### Inter-Lodge Program at Exposition

Cleveland.—The Cleveland Slovene young people offer their contribution to the parade of the cultures of the world displayed this year at the Cleveland Great Lakes Exposition with a stage program to be presented under auspices of the Inter-Lodge League on Thursday evening, September 3. The program will be given on International Circle, Streets of the World, at 8 p. m.

Many SNPJ lodges and members are vitally interested in the Inter-Lodge League. The SNPJ Federation team, which has appeared at Idora Park and Detroit tournament and will travel to the SNPJ Day in Library over the holidays, is in the Inter-Lodge softball league battling for second place. The SNPJ Comrades were runners-up for the championship last year. The League has also seen the teams of the SNPJ Loyalties and the SNPJ Commodores and SNPJ Strugglers flash by its eight year history of baseball, basketball, basketball and bowling.

The program to be presented by the Inter-Lodge at the Great Lakes Exposition will be the only one of any nationality which will be arranged and conducted by the younger people. It promises to be one of the outstanding programs presented at the Exposition this summer, as may be judged by the fact that the management of the Exposition thought the program good enough to offer the League the use of its gigantic band Shell or its gorgeous Marine Theatre. The League feels itself a nationally group, even if composed of American-born English speaking members, and it chose the International Circle where all the foreign groups present their program.

Shadowed and enclosed by the spires, walls and grottos of a score of nations, the Inter-Lodge program will give to these foreign settings, a program exemplifying the spirit of youth, that youth which is mixing its American traditions with those of European customs brought over from across by its parents.

The program will have among its attractions the accordion bands of Frankie Yankovich, Johnny Pecon, Vedral Quartet, Zarja male chorus in a group of Slovene folk songs, the Slovene dancers appearing twice a week at the International Revue, Beanie Modic in a comic wrestling act, and as a grand finale a large pillow dance around the International Circle in which all the spectators will be asked to join.

Possibilities for the program are Miss Anne Govednik, Slovene mermaid now with the American Olympic team in Berlin, who has returned to this country on Aug. 29, Banjo Buddy, famed banjost of the NBC, who is better known among Slovene circles as Joe Sodja, brother of Rev. Max Sodja, once a famed pitcher with the SNPJ Loyalties, a boxing exhibition between the Simms brothers, a Croatian tamburica orchestra and a Serbian act.

Special reduced tickets are offered by the League for that night. A 75 cents value admitting one to the Exposition and the Streets of the World, they are selling for 50 cents. They may be procured at Slovene merchants. It is advised that they be bought early, as the supply is limited and the League cannot guarantee additional supply.

The League regularly draws upwards to 2000 people to its affairs and the fact that the September 3 program is at the Exposition should double this number.

# 10th Anniversary of Slovene Home

Sharon, Pa.—Our Slovene Workmen's Educational Home will celebrate its 10th anniversary with a fitting program, Saturday, Sept. 5, at its main hall. The program will include a one-act comedy and speeches. A large attendance from the Shenango valley is expected; in fact, the officials look forward to accommodating the largest gathering of the Slovene people in the valley in recent years.

Our Slovene Home today is recognized as one of the most modern clubs in this vicinity. In 1905, Lodge 31 of the SNPJ was organized. The Slovene National Benefit Society, the largest of its kind among our people in America, is nationally known for its fraternal and educational work based on progressive labor and free-thought principles. The Dom is a real center to our many activities, for the old and young alike; it's a social and educational center.

The first Slovenes settled in the Shenango valley in 1902 (J. Gornick, M. Vrenik and F. Cimperman), in Farrell, known at that time as South Sharon. The oldest local Slovene is John Perkin, 78, for the past 25 years a resident of Farrell. When the SNPJ Lodge 31 was organized it had 93 members. Other lodges were organized later. The other SNPJ Lodge, No. 262, located in Farrell, was organized 25 years ago and today numbers 150 members. The SSCU Lodge numbers 90 members. A Slovena Glee Club was organized in 1930 with the purpose of acquainting the younger generation with the songs of their parents. Its annual concerts rank as one of the outstanding social events of the year. As a soloist this club has Rose Mlakar, soprano, prominent in valley musical circles; she represented the Mercer county in the Pittsburgh Musical Jubilee two years ago.

Also affiliated with the Dom are the Young Slovene Social Club, a newly-organized group of young members of SNPJ Lodge 262, and the Ladies' Aid. # Steel Workers Organizing

(Notes on speech of Philip Murray, chairman of Steel Workers' Organizing Committee at a conference of Fraternal Organizations and foreign language groups in the William Penn hotel, Saturday, Aug. 8, 1936.)  
Pittsburgh, Pa.—The Steel Workers' Organizing Committee is interested in having the cooperation of any group which has any interest in the industrial form of organization. For a period of 50 years steel industry has been without any kind of independent organization. At times there has been small membership affiliated with the Amalgamated Association of Iron, Steel and Tin Workers, but it was so small that the membership did not represent the steel workers. The battle we are waging is age-old; we are seeking to set up the type of union that will give an organization which in strength is equal to that of the employers. Men employed in the mills have been subjected to complete rule and domina-

tion of their employer. The men have never had a voice in setting hours, wages or working conditions. So that this drive is aimed to give the workmen the right to sit in conference with the employers and settle those questions.

Those rights to organize are definitely recognized by law—in the Norris-La Guardia Act and in the Wagner Act.

But unfortunately this five billion dollar enterprise has decided the workers shall not enjoy those rights and they have resorted to coercion and intimidation to prevent the workers from exercising that right.

# "Cankar's Herald"

## CANKARJEV GLASNIK

Cleveland, O.—During the last several weeks all Slovenes have been given a challenge: To unite and to take an active part in preserving and perpetuating, as well as adding to their rich cultural heritage. More specifically this challenge has been given to Cleveland Slovenes. But there are many Slovenes and those of Slovene extraction scattered over this country who, when they are fully informed about the subject, will take an interest in this non-partisan, non-sectarian cultural movement to establish a monument to the best known of Slovene writers and to the Slovenes as a nationality group.

Briefly, it has been proposed and the movement started on its way to establish an "Ivan Cankar Foundation" which will support and sponsor the publication of a literary magazine called "Cankarjev Glasnik" (Cankar's Voice or Herald). This magazine will serve the purpose of acquainting a larger public with the work of the foremost literary man we have and will offer all Slovenes a chance to express themselves in their native tongue or in English in an organ that will be exclusively their own. It is obvious that the amount of expression depends upon those who have a desire to do so. There are many young American Slovenes who are endeavoring to have their writings, in original Slovene or English or translations, published in one organ or another. It is proposed to concentrate these efforts of our literarily inclined into one organ where the authors may be given encouragement and where they may be able to add to the prestige not only of themselves but also to that of their nationality group.

There are several obstacles to be overcome, however, before this publication is established. The first of these is that of financing. A fund

of approximately \$2,000 must be set up and at least 100 subscribers secured before publication begins. All lodges of Slovene organizations have been appealed to to become members of the foundation by taking membership at a cost of ten dollars. A similar appeal has been made to Slovenes as individuals to become subscribers at cost of \$3.00 per year, \$1.75 per half year. Secondly, a competent editor has to be engaged. At this writing we understand that Mr. Etbis Kristan, a personal friend of Ivan Cankar and an experienced literary man will most probably be editor. And last and most annoying obstacle to one who is interested in seeing a purely cultural movement get under way with the maximum encouragement and auspiciousness of that of interested, yet jealous and prejudiced individual subversive propaganda.

Anyone who has lived in a community where many people of foreign extraction have settled and where differences of religious opinion in their native lands need not be reminded that invariably there arise two hostile groups; one concentrated around the established Church and the other expressing dissenting views. These groups also tend to set up their own organ of expression in order to propagate their beliefs and to foster their prejudices. Naturally there is constant and acrimonious discussion on any topic which is controversial. It is dictated largely, we suspect, by the desire to hold and to gain new subscribers for the respective papers. This rivalry is healthy, a sign that there are checks on what might otherwise be a purely monopolized molding of public opinion. The danger of this, however, is not minimized, because there are few people who can afford to subscribe for both publications or who take the trouble to inform themselves about both sides of a current controversy. Obviously then, readers get one side of the picture in the only paper they can afford. And what one organ prints is very likely to be taken for gospel truth and what the other prints as a distortion or entire falsehood. The editor may, by a few subtle and ambiguous phrases of interpretation, (even though he says he is reserving judgment) play upon the emotions and prejudice most of his readers against anything that he himself may have a prejudice against or that he thinks is not expedient for his own interests. This has happened in so many instances and been the cause of only half hearted success of really worthwhile endeavors sponsored by practical idealists among the Slovenes that it is a pity. One wonders whether there will ever be enough reason exercised and enough charity shown by the vested interests of these foreign language newspapers to wholeheartedly unite behind an undertaking of cultural value to the nationality group as a whole. It hardly seems likely so long as the older generation is alive. Just this kind of opposition has been experienced to date by the promoters of the Cankar Foundation.

My appeal is to the younger generation to rise above petty self interest to recognize that the forthcoming publication is something that they can, if they will, make their own and that it is their opportunity to gain an outlet for their talents. Let us all take an active part in making the magazine the kind of magazine WE should like to see it become.
