I am satisfied that the report submitted by the Secretary of the Finance Committee discloses the activities of this Branch of the Supreme Board in such a detailed and concise manner that there is nothing I can add except that I heartily agree with it.

I am very fortunate to have had the privilege of serving on this Committee during the past seven years, and shall exert all my efforts towards a continuance of its success.

The co-operation of each member of this Committee, plus the invaluable assistance given us by our Supreme Secretary Mr. Zalar, has made our task lighter. To this I wish to add my thanks to our Supreme Treasurer, Mr. Železnikar, Assistant Supreme Secretary Mr. Vertin, the Board of Trustees as well as the efficient corps of workers in the Supreme Office.

In the very recent past, we have adopted the 3½% American Experience Table. There has been some criticism, due to this action, but I hope that the answer to these critics as published in the Glasilo a few days ago, will satisfactorily explain our reasons for taking this step. However, I might add that in view of the almost unlimited money supply in the hands of bankers and some individuals who are able to buy up gilt-edge securities for investment, not only our Society, but many other fraternals, with their limited funds, have found it very difficult to make investments to meet the required income on the previous 4% Table. Our adoption of the 3½% Table will enable not only the present Finance Committee, but also those who may be honored with this duty in the future, to carry on without the danger of any additional burden to our members.

During the past year, I have been called upon to appear at many functions held by our various subordinate lodges, as well as investigating numerous loan applications. Were I to attempt to mention them individually, I fear I might unwittingly omit one or more and thus subject myself to criticism. Therefore, I wish to take this means of thanking all who aided in making by visits so pleasant, and I hope that whether I be a member of the Supreme Board in the future or not, that I be given an opportunity of continuing my friendly relations so established.

I would, however, like to refer to one particular event. At the convention of the Pennsylvania State Fraternal Congress which was held in the William Penn Hotel in Pittsburgh last Fall, and which was attended by Messrs. Decman, Lokar and myself, representing the KSKJ, we were fortunate in electing to the Executive Board of the Congress Mr. Frank Lokar, who has the distinction of being the first member of our organization to serve on the Executive Board of this Congress.

In closing, I wish to extend my heartiest congratulations to Mr. Zalar on his long service as Supreme Secretary, and pray that he may continue to serve the KSKJ in his present capacity for many years to come.

I also wish to extend my belated wishes to the members of the Supreme Board, and also all members of the KSKJ a Blessed and Prosperous Year of 1938.

Msgr. Fulton Sheen has said that the world does not think any more.

Moreover, very few people know what it means to think.

It does not mean to have mental pictures.

That's imagination.

Thinking or reasoning means to draw a conclusion from one or two truths for which we have evidence.

And the conclusion must be conclusive, not a guess.

For example, John was born in 1917. But the Civil War was over in 1864. Therefore, John was not in the Civil War.

We can not claim to be reasoning unless our conclusions are as watertight as this example. Nor can we say we have "proved" a truth unless we can show a mental process like that in the example given.

On the contrary, many argue from circumstantial evidence. Many, too, form their philosophy of beliefs and actions by mere catchwords.

"Soak the rich" is one phrase which many follow whether it is true or not, whether applicable or not. Other phrases which form the mental reasoning and motives of moderns are: "Everybody's doing it; why shouldn't I?" "You can't take it"; whether it is wrong or right to take it, people rarely question. This last expression has taken the place of: "Oh, you're yellow."

Two boys rooming at a secular college were debating the obligation of going to Mass one Sunday. One insisted on going. The other said: "Oh, you're yellow; you're afraid the chaplain will report you or something."

As a matter of fact, it was the lazy lad who was "yellow."

How much reason is there in Sunday excuse: "I don't feel like going to Mass; I'll pray at home."

We can multiply the examples of trite axioms which guide the lives of too many people who never stop to reason.

What is the consequence? It means we have not discovered the REASONS for our faith and for our Catholic morals.

We are helpless to give our non-Catholic brethren a REASON for being Catholic. Yet, the world outside the Church is hungry for a solid philosophy.

Hilaire Belloc says: "The rapid breakdown of all philosophies except the Catholic may make for a big movement toward Catholicism."

But we Catholics must know and spread the reasons for our faith.
