Cleveland's Fifth Annual Folk Festival

Cleveland's most colorful annual event, the Folk Festival, will be staged again for the 5th successive year in the Music Hall on February 14, Sunday afternoon and evening.

A Cleveland audience of nearly 6000 will see a rich spectacle of folk dances, choral groups, and folk customs presented by more than 25 nationality groups, sponsored jointly by the Cleveland Folk Arts Association and The Cleveland Press.

Approximately 1000 performers, dressed in the costumes of the various countries which they represent, will stage two lively performances, on Sunday afternoon at 2 p. m., and again in the evening, at 8 p. m.

Thus far the following nationality groups have announced their participation and are already rehearsing for this traditional event: Bavarian, Czech, William D. Raatt is the program chairman.

ADULT CLASSES START FEBRUARY 1

The Cleveland Board of Education will open many schools for a new term permitting adults to attend classes in the evening.

Some of the activities in which adults may enroll are of a vocational nature giving pre-employment training in fields such as television repair, auto mechanics; other courses, such as sheet metal drawing, electrical maintenance, blue print reading, are designed to help those already employed.

The demand for typists and stenographers continues to be heavy. Fifty-eight commercial classes have been set up in the various schools to take care of enrollments in that field.

There will be all kinds of leisure-time activities, such as ceramics, hooked rug making, drawing and painting, candy making, art metal and jewelry, photography.

Courses relating to the home include interior decoration, home repairs, slip cover making, meal preparation.

There are courses in mathematics and science and social studies, all of which can be applied to a high school diploma for anyone interested. These courses are taught only at John Hay and West Technical high schools.

There are also pre-high-school courses in arithmetic, spelling, reading, and writing. These are held at East Technical, Glenville, and West Technical. For the new Americans, there are classes in beginner's and advanced English at twenty centers about the city. These classes are taught both day and evening and are free. In most other courses, there is a charge of \$7.50 for residents of the Cleveland school district and \$12.00 for non-residents.
