## IZ PRIMORJA

—Požar v Barkovljah.— V Barkovljah je meseca novembra nenaden požar skoro uničil znano tvornico voskov Zibel. Da niso prišli ognjegasci hitro po izbruhu požara, bi gotovo cela tovarna postala plen plamenov. Vest se je takoj raznesla po mestu, tako da so ljudje oblegali tramvaje, ki peljejo v Barkovlje. Goreti je pričelo v oddelku za kuhanje voska. Zaradi zelo vnetljivih tekočin in masti je bila cela stavba takoj v ognju. Z veliko muko so ognjegasci rešili ostale objekte, kjer so bila skladišča polna že izgotovljenega blaga, ki je bilo namenjeno v Ameriko. Vzroka požara niso mogli ugotoviti. Posebno je čudno, da se je ogenj razširil iz kotlov, ki so grajeni izven stavbe, tako da ni bil omenjeni oddelk v nevarnosti zaradi ognja. Škodo cenijo na 250,000 lir.

## DNEVNE VESTI

### Trgovska pogodba med Nemci in Romunci

Bukarest, 14. dec. Med Nemčijo in Romunsko je prišlo do delno ugodne trgovske pogodbe, o kateri se je razpravljalo dolge mesece. Romunska bo zanj plačevala 40.5 lejev za nemško marko, dočim je doslej 38. Nemčija je zahtevala 55 lejev. Nemčija bo začela prodajati več blaga kot doslej na Romunsko.

### Poljska bo zavrgla avtonomijo Ukrajincev

Varšava, 14. decembra. Predlog ukrajinskih poslancev v poljskem parlamentu za avtonomijo ali samovlado ukrajinskega naroda, ni bil sprejet. Kot znano obsega Ukrajina eno četrtino poljske republike. Ukrajincem se je povedalo, da če želijo, da bo njihov predlog sprejet v parlamentu, da morajo dobiti na svojo stran predsednika poljske republike in njegov kabinet, kar je pa izključeno. Poljska vlada trdi, da ukrajinski narod kot masa se ne zmenja za avtonomijo, pač pa je slednja le posledica neprestanega hujskanja od strani gotovih ukrajinskih voditeljev.

## Nemški poslanik je prezrl premierja Chamberlaina

London, 14. decembra. Včeraj se je vršil tu sijajen banket, prirejen od Foreign Press Association. Glavni govor bi imel biti ministerski predsednik Chamberlain. Ker so pa v nemškem poslanstvu v Londonu zvedeli, da bo Chamberlain kritiziral nemško časopisje na banketu, je nemški poslanik z vsem svojim štabom pravočasno odvedal svojo udeležbo. Na banketu so bili navzoči zastopniki vseh narodov, ki imajo svoja poslanstva v Londonu. Le ameriški poslanik Kennedy, ki se nahaja na potu proti Zed. državam, ni mogel biti navzoč. Zastopal ga je tajnik poslanstva.
