## Vstali Kristus nas odrešuje

Velikonočni praznik je najpomembnejši v bogoslužnem letu, je praznik luči: vstali Gospod nas razsvetljuje, v naša srca polaga neizmerno veselje, neizmerno upanje in jih napolnjuje z ljubeznijo.

Evangelij nam poroča o dogodkih vstajenjskega jutra. Dan po soboti je Marija Magdalena zgodaj zjutraj, ko je bila še tema, šla h grobu. Zaradi zelo strogega judovskega predpisa je bilo gibanje v soboto nemogoče. Vendar se je za jude dan končal z večerom. Zato gre Marija, ko je še tema, h grobu. Marija je polna ljubezni, pa tudi bolečine. Ko pride h grobu, je presenečena: opazi, da je kamen odvaljen od groba.

Celoten odlomek nam hoče dati razumeiti, da je vstajenje za učence nepričakovan dogodek. Misili so, da je bilo z Jezusovo smrтjo vsega konec. Niso razumeli njegovih napovedi o vstajenju. Priznati moramo, da napovedi, kakor jih beremo v evangeliju, niti niso tako jasne. Jezus pravi, da bo »vstal«, kar ne pomeni nujno »vstati od mrtvih«; govori o tem, da se bo »zbudil« in apostoli ne razumejo, na kaj se nanašajo te besede. Zato so popolnoma nepripravljeni na Gospodovo vstajenje.

Iz odvaljenega kamna Marija Magdalena ne sklepa, da je Gospod vstal, ampak, da so »Gospoda vzeli iz groba«. Vstajenje je tudi zanjo tuja in nepredstavljiva stvar. Jezus je mrtev. Iz groba ne more priti sam; zato so ga odnesli »in ne vemo, kam so ga položili.«



## EASTER SUNDAY

Gre za oskrunitve groba. Marija Magdalena pride to te ugotovitve zato hiti, da bi o stvari poročala učencem; Simon Peter in učenec, ki ga je Jezus ljubil se takoj odpravita h grobu, da bi preverila njeno pripoved. Peter vstopi prvi, za njim pa Janez. Stvari, ki jih vidi Peter, pričajo o zares nenavadnem dogodku; kaj pomenijo? Če bi Jezusovo truplo odnesli hudodelci, bi ga odnesli skupaj z vsemi povoji in s prtičem z glave. Povojev ne bi pustili na tleh in prtiča ne bi zvili na drugem mestu.

Ko v grob vstopi drugi učenec, tudi on vidi povoje in prtič, vendar doživi nekaj kot razsvetljenje in razume: Jezusovega telesa niso ukradli; Jezus je oživel. Živi drugačno življenje, kot je zemeljsko; življenje, v katerem povoji in prtič niso več uporabni. »Drugi učenec je videl in veroval.«

Evangelist nato pripomni: »Nista še namreč umevala Pisma, da mora vstati od mrtvih.« Janez nam hoče dopovedati, da dogodka Jezusovega vstajanja niso prepoznali izhajajoč iz Pisem, ampak je nasprotno vstajenje osvetlilo Pisma. Šele po tem dogodku so učenci razumeli, kaj so hotela povedati Pisma in kaj so hotele povedati Jezusove napovedi. Prej jih niso znali razlagati. Jezusovo vstajenje je bilo dogodek, ki je razsvetlil razum in srca učencev.

Vstali Jezus je vir luči, ki je zelo tolažilna in pozitivna. Vstajenje razkriva pomen njegovega trpljenja. Brez vstajenja bi bilo namreč trpljenje dramatičen, negativen dogodek, strahoten poraz, konec brez upanja. Tako pa Jezusovo vstajenje kaže vso vrednost trpljenja, dokazuje, da ni bilo poraz, ampak zmaga, zmaga ljubezni. Dobri pastir je dal življenje za ovce. Trpljenje je živel z ljubeznijo, zato je dosegel vstajenje, novo življenje, ki ni zemeljsko.

Sprejmimo torej sporočilo Jezusovega vstajenja. Vemo, da ga lahko spoznamo samo po veri. Človeško govorjeno je dogodek, ki ga ni mogoče pojasniti. V veri pa se zavedamo božjega posega in sprejemamo to močno luč, ki ne osvetljuje samo Jezusove skrivnosti, ampak tudi vse naše življenje.

Vstali Jezus je poln oblasti, ki pa se ne kaže v sodbi, ampak v odpuščanju grehov. In »ko se bo prikazal Kristus, vaše življenje, tedaj se boste tudi vi prikazali z njim v slavi.« Kristusovo vstajenje ni samo studenec vere, ampak tudi čudovitega upanja.

## Illustration

Most of us will have experienced some kind of disappointment, pain or failure – it is part of life and cannot be avoided. For some this will be the loss of a loved one, or the break-up of a marriage. For others it might be persistent ill health, a job they don't enjoy or financial hardship. Some may perhaps feel that life has been a disappointment, a series of small, exhausting setbacks and broken dreams. We all have our own crosses to bear. For the disciples, the crucifixion and death of Jesus on Good Friday must have signalled the ultimate dashing of all their hopes and dreams. They had seen him as the Messiah, the anointed one, the one who was to save them... and now he was gone.



## Gospel Teaching

But everything changed when Christ rose from the dead on that first Easter Day – nothing would ever be the same again. Without the resurrection the Jesus story would have been an interesting footnote in history – a miracle worker, a holy man, remembered with fondness and a little disappointment by his friends. As each of the apostles passed away, the memories would have dimmed and the “Jesus Movement” would probably have withered away, a few stories passed on to grandchildren perhaps and then nothing left but folklore – and then nothing.

The resurrection means that we can say “Jesus is alive!” in the present tense. He has conquered death, not just for himself, but for all peoples and all times. It enables us to say “He lives among us”, not a figure from history, but as a living presence – in the present. The risen Christ transcends time and space – he is available everywhere to everybody.

For the disciples, the resurrection meant that Jesus had fulfilled the promise he had made to them. He truly was the Son of God. He appeared to them in various places in the days that followed, enabling Thomas the “doubting disciple” to proclaim, “My Lord and my God!” More than just an ordinary man, the Word made flesh, the risen Lord, was ready to fill his followers with his Holy Spirit so

that the Christian Church could begin and then spread to every corner of the globe.

## Application

However, the cross and resurrection of Jesus are not historical events to be pondered from afar -- they reflect our own lived experience, our own falling and rising. Here we find hope, that the personal darkness we often experience will eventually be followed by the morning light. Here is proof that God's grace can lift us out of every situation, no matter how desperate and hopeless it might appear: hence the phrase “We are an Easter people”. Despite all our failings and flaws, we live with the hope of something better, knowing that good will always triumph over evil. St Paul puts it like this: “you have died, and now the life you have is hidden with Christ in God.” When we die to our own ego and selfishness then we can share in this life of Christ, we become part of him, and he lives in us.

For many Christians the resurrection is significant because it signals that there is life for us too, after our own physical death. But this is to only grasp the half of it. The resurrection is something for us to experience in every moment whilst we still live! We share in the resurrection whenever we share the love and joy of God with each other. Look carefully in the days and weeks ahead and you will see the risen Christ in those you meet. God comes to us disguised as our lives. How could it be otherwise? We love God by taking care of and loving each other and the world in which we live. And God looks through our eyes when we love each other, transforming every human act of love into a divine act of love.

Jesus is raised from the dead whenever we choose to act with kindness and compassion. We bring Jesus to life by our daily attempts to faithfully live out the gospel, by what we do, and how we treat one another. We can mend a broken world: we can become Christ for each other. Our stone has been rolled away, our hopes for the future have been rekindled, our winter has become our spring, Christ’s rising is our rising. Happy Easter!
