



## Ameriški odvetniki se zavzeli pri Titu za Srdjo Popovića

**Poziv predsedniku Titu je podpisalo 106 znanih ameriških odvetnikov.**

NEW YORK, N.Y. — Na predsednika SFR Jugoslavije Josipa Broza Tita se je obrnilo 106 ameriških odvetnikov s posebno spomenico, ki jo je Titu posredoval načelnik Mednarodne lige za človekove pravice Jerome J. Shestack. Odvetnik Srdja Popović je bil obtožen in obsojen "širjenja neresničnih trditvev" o Jugoslaviji, ko je branil Dragoljuba Ignjatovića pred sodiščem aprila 1974.

Dragoljub Ignjatović je bil obsojen, pa na pritisk javnega mnenja v tujini predčasno puščen iz zapora. Odvetnik Srdja Popović, ki je pravni zastopnik večine ameriških družb v Jugoslaviji, pa tudi holandskega in japonskega poslanstva, je bil obsojen 10. marca na eno leto zapora.

Pri razpravi so bili navzoči zastopniki mednarodne odvetniške zveze in drugih mednarodnih skupin, ki so vsi izrazili hudo kritiko nad to obsodbo. Popović je napovedal priziv in ostal na svobodi.

Med podpisniki spomenice na Tita so med drugimi Morris B. Abram, bivši zastopnik ZDA pri OZN v komisiji za človekove pravice, Jose A. Cabranes, pravni svetovalec univerze Yale, bivši kongresnik Emanuel Celler, bivši pravosodni tajnik ZDA Ramsey Clark, Samuel Dash, pravni svetovalec Senatskega odbora za preiskovanje Watergate zadev, ter Albert E. Jenner, glavni svetovalec odbora Predstavnika doma, ki je vodil postopek za odstavek predsednika R. Nixona.

## Na svetu 4 milijone ljudi

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Po podatkih urada za prebivalstvo bo prihodnje nedeljo, 28. marca 1976, doseglo število prebivalstva na vsem svetu 4 milijone.

Leta 1930 je bilo na vsem svetu 2 milijona ljudi, leta 1961 3 milijone in sedaj nas bo 4 milijone. Prebivalstvo sveta se je torej podvojilo v 46 letih.

## "Čudovita" zmaga pri volitvah na Poljskem

VARŠAVA, Polj. — Po uradnih podatkih je pri zadnjih volitvah v sejem, kot se imenuje poljska narodna skupščina, dobil glavni tajnik Komunistične partije Edward Gierek 99,99% vseh glasov.

Poročilo pravi, da je to najvišji odstotek oddanih glasov za glavnega tajnika Komunistične partije na Poljskem, odkar ima ta komunistični režim.

PARIZ, Fr. — Viktor Nekrasov, sovjetski pisatelj, ki je dobil svoj čas Stalinovo nagrado za svoja dela, se je leta 1974 preselil v Francijo in ostal v Parizu. Po več kot dveh letih je dobila za izselitev dovoljenje tudi njegova družina.

## SOVJETSKA ZVEZA IN KOMUNISTIČNA EVROPA V "ORGANSKI ZVEZI"

Ko je opisal Sonnenfeld detento kot sredstvo, ki naj vpliva na rabo sovjetske moči, je svaril: "Sedanji nena-ravni odnos Sovjetske zveze z Vzhodno Evropo utegne preje ali kasneje eksplodirati in povzročiti tretjo svetovno vojno. To neorgansko, nena-ravno razmerje je veliko večja nevarnost za svetovni mir kot je spor med Vzhodom in Zahodom."

Nato je Kissingerjev glavni sodelavec in zaupnik opozarjal, da "vsaka prevelika vne-ma z naše strani" lahko pre-okrene 'zaželjeni proces' (organske povezave Sovjetske zveze z Vzhodno Evropo). Doslédno s tem je postavil "politiko v soglasju do jasno vidnih želja v Vzhodni Evropi po bolj avtonomnem življenju v okviru močnega sovjetskega geopolitičnega vpliva. To je delovalo na Poljskem. Poljaki so bili sposobni premagati svoje romantične politične nagibe, ki so jih vodili v preteklosti v nesreče".

## Štirje črni afriški voditelji se v Lusaki pogovarjali o Rodeziji

LUSAKA, Zamb. — Voditelji štirih afriških držav so se zbrali tu v sredo na posvetovanja o položaju v Rodeziji, odkar so tam razgovori med predstavniki črne večine in belo vlado propadli.

Predsednik Zambije Kaunda, predsednik Tanzanije Nyerere, predsednik Botsvane Khama in predsednik Mozambika Machel so razpravljali o položaju v Rodeziji najprej sami, nato pa so se pogovarjali tudi z zastopniki rodezijskih črnih domačinov. Ti vidijo rešitev v povečani gverilski vojni.

Zambijski predsednik Kaunda, ki je znan kot zmeren politik in državnik, se zavzema za to, da Velika Britanija, ki je pravno še vedno odgovorna za Rodezijo, odločno začne reševati vprašanje njene vlade, ki bo brez dvoma povzročilo večjo gverilsko vojskovanje, če ne bo naglo rešeno mirnim potom.

## Reagan bi rad dobil vodstvo v usmerjanju svoje tekme s Fordom

Ronald Reagan hoče dati veljavni kampanji republikanske stranke novo smer z nagovorom preko televizije vsej deželi.

LOS ANGELES, Calif. — Še predno je Ronald Reagan zmagal pri primarnih volitvah v Severni Karolini, je sklenil svojo volivno kampanjo preusmeriti z obsežnim govorom na televiziji, ki naj bi na enkrat dosegel republikance in v kolikor le mogoče tudi vse ostale volivce v vsej deželi ne le v eni izmed naših držav.

Ta govor, ki je napovedan za prihodnji teden, naj bi na novo določil smernice celotnega volivnega boja, označil stališča Reagana v posameznih važnih vprašanjih, pred katerimi stoji naša dežela, in nakazal rešitve ki jih Reagan predlaga.

Govor naj bi prevzel pobudo in vodstvo v volivni kampanji, predstavil kandidata Reagana kot nasprotnika sedanje skupine v Washingtonu in posebej izrazil nasprotovanje mednarodni politiki predsednika Geralda R. Forda. Novi prijem naj bi okrepili Reaganovo kampanjo in iznesli pred volivce jasnejše razliko med obeh republikanskih kandidatom.

## Prisluškovanje tudi za "narodno varnost" odvisno od sodišč

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Vlada je po razgovoru s člani Kongresa predložila nov načrt o elektronskem nadziranju oseb zaradi "narodne varnosti". Načrt predvideva predhodno odobritev sodišča za vsako prisluškovanje, ki doslej v tem ni bilo potrebno.

Doslej so redno iskali dovoljenje za elektronsko nadziranje le za preiskave proti osumljencem zločinov znotraj dežele in za splošno nadziranje nezakonitih, podzemnih revolucionarnih skupin.

## KRŠČANSKI DEMOKRATI V ITALIJI SO RAZKLANI

Strankin kongres se je končal s ponovno izvolitvijo sedanjega glavnega tajnika Zaccagninija s komaj nekaj nad polovico glasov.

RIM, It. — Kongres krščansko-demokratske stranke se je po sedmih dneh končal z očitno razklanostjo stranke, ki bi prav v teh košljivih in težavnih časih potrebovala polno slogo in edinost. Stranka, ki vodi vsa leta po drugi svetovni vojni Italijo, je začela v zadnjih letih očitno slabeti zaradi notranjih sporov in trenj.

Večji del krščanskih demokratov je proti sodelovanju s komunistično stranko, ki tako sodelovanje vztrajno in vneto ponuja kot "zgodovinski kompromis". Levo krilo krščanskih demokratov je pripravljeno "zgodovinski kompromis" sprejeti ali ga vsaj preskusiti, ko je Italija v hudih gospodarskih krčih. Zagovorniki zgodovinskega kompromisa vidijo v njem edino uspešno pot iz sedanjih gospodarskih stisk Italije. Upajo namreč, da bi se delavstvo, ki je uporno in slabe volje, ne upiralo trdim gospodarskim ukrepom, če bi odgovornost za to prevzela tudi komunistična partija.

Zmerni prevladali

Na sedemdnevem kongresu krščanskih demokratov so v vseh teh predlogih in zamislih vztrajno, pa tudi zagrizeno razpravljali. Nasprotniki vsakega sodelovanja s komunisti so predložili za glavnega strankinoga kandidata obrambnega ministra v sedanji Morovi vladi Arnalda Forlanija. Dobil je močno podporo, pa je z zelo pičlo večino le prevladal sedanji glavni tajnik Zaccagnini, ki je sicer tudi proti vključitvi komunistov v vlado, pa se je pripravljen z njimi "razgovarjati" in "posvetovati".

Splošni štrajk

Včeraj je po vsej Italiji štrajkalo kakih 15 milijonov delavcev v znak protesta proti zadnjim gospodarskim ukrepom, ki

naj bi pomagali deželi iz sedanje hude gospodarske stiske. Proti ukrepom so se izjavile delavske unije, kritizirala pa jih je tudi komunistična partija, četudi se je predsednik vlade Aldo Moro z njenim vodnikom Enricom Belinguerjem posvetoval, predno je te ukrepe proglasil.

Italija živi preko svojih dohodkov, toda nihče se noče ničesar odreči, ljudje hočejo živeti po starem, ko jim vlada pripoveduje, da je potrebno za-tegniti pasove. Meso je postalo dražje, prav tako tudi ostala hrana, gasolin je dosegel \$2.50 za galon, ko je lira v kratki dobi dveh mesecev izgubila skoraj 20% svoje vrednosti.

Cene so na splošno v februarju porastle za 2,2%, še enkrat več kot v januarju, in za marec ne pričakujejo nič boljšega. Tako se Italija vrača na raven inflacije preko 20% letno, ko je bila ta lani na letni ravni 17%.

Položaj je težaven, pa se zdi, da se odgovorni, pa tudi splošna javnost tega nočejo ali ne morejo zavesti in se podati na resilno pot.

## Zadnje vesti

BEIRUT, Lib. — Bojevanje med kristjani in muslimani se nadaljuje, ko je del mesta zajel požar in je nevarnost, da ta uniči zaloge žita v pristaniškem predelu. Umik predsednika republike Franjeha iz predsedniške palače v krščansko naselje Jounieh je kristjane prizadel, toda Franjeh je izjavil, da ne odstopa. Kristjani naseljujejo vse za boj sobne, naj se vključijo v vojaške enote. Posredovanje Sirije je obtičalo, ko so muslimani mnenja, da bodo uveljavili svoje stališče s silo orožja. Sirija temu nasprotuje in išče politično rešitev.

DETROIT, Mich. — Prodaja novih avtov je bila sredi marca za povprečno 42% večja od one lani v istem času.

ZDRUŽENI NARODI, N.Y. — ZDA so včeraj vetirale v Var-nostnem svetu ZN resolucijo, ki obsoja Izrael zaradi njegovega poskusa vključitve starega Jeruzalema v Izrael in zaradi postopanja v zasedenem arabskem delu Palestine. Zastopnik ZDA W. Scranton je dejal, da je proti resoluciji, ker bi ta škodovala novemu naporu za iskanje mirne rešitve spora med Izraelci in Arabci.

CAPETOWN, J. Af. — Vlada Južne Afrike je izjavila, da bo umaknila vse svoje vojaške sile iz Angole, ko je dobila preko Londona in preko Združenih narodov zagotovilo, da bo vlada Angole čuvala naprave ob reki Cunene in dobavo vode ter elektrike od tam v Jugozahodno Afriko (Namibijo), ki je pod upravo Južne Afrike.

LONDON, Vel. Brit. — Sovjetski zunanji minister A. Gromiko je dejal tu, da Sovjetska zveza ne posega v notranje razmere Rodezije in Namibije, ker je mnenja, da je tamkajšnje spore mogoče "rešiti

LONDON, Vel. Brit. — Pri več-ranjši volitvi naslednika Haroldu Wilsonu je dobil največ glasov vodnik levega krila delavske stranke Michael Foot, nekaj manj glasov pa je bilo oddanih za zunanjega ministra Jamesa Callaghana. Pričakujejo, da bo Callaghan končno izvoljen verjetno pri drugem glasovanju prihodnji terek ali pri tretjem 5. aprila.

BUENOS AIRES, Arg. — Voja-ki, ki so v sredo prevzeli oblast v Argentini, so prepovedali pet levčarskih strank, nastopili odločno proti vsemu gverilskemu bojevanju in pripravilo vrsto trdih gospodar-skih ukrepov. Sodijo, da je bilo prijetih do 3.000 raznih politikov in unijskih vodnikov.

## Jeleni se bodo pasli poleg govedi

Kmetijska zbornica v Porenju v Zvezni republiki Nemčiji preskuša možnosti udomačenja divjadi in njeno gojitev poleg domačih živali.

V prihodnje se bodo damjaki mirno pasli zraven ovce in govedi, napoveduje Vitas Droscher, ki poroča o poskusih porenške kmetijske zbornice, da bi veliko divjad, zlasti jelene, spremenila v neke vrste domače živali. Zivinorejec, ki si od tega obeta korist — pravi Droscher — bo lahko redil jelene prav tako kakor govedo, zlasti tam, kjer zemlja ni več dovolj dobra za donosno staro zivinorejo.

Pašniških površin, ki spričlovečnosti tal niso več primerne za govedo, je v ZRN zdaj 300 tisoč hektarov, do leta 1990 pa naj bi bilo takih pašnikov že petkrat več. Tu naj bi damjaki pripomogli k rentabilnosti. V nekem obratu kmetijskega inštituta se je obnesel poskus s 113 živalmi.

Damjaki žo tudi trdo travo bornih tal, ki je krave ne marajo, razen tega so poleti in pozimi na prostem, torej ne potrebujejo staj in so zadovoljni v manj krme, razen tega samice kotijo mladiče brez veterinarske pomoči. In kar je najpomembnejše: damjaki dajejo meso, ki je boljše od govejega, razen tega pa vsebuje zelo malo maščob.

Seveda se moti, kdor misli, da je damjaka lahko udomačiti. Zlasti mladiči se zelo boje človeka, nasprotno pa se kmalu sprijaznjijo z govedom in ovcami, tako da jih je mogoče rediti na istem prostoru. Prav tako ni utemeljen strah, da bi pes, ki ga gospodar pelje na sprehod, lahko splašali čredo damjakov. Nasprotno pa je res, da so damjaki preganili že marsikaterega kupa. Prav tako ni razloga za domnevo, da 'oo puška poslej poglavito orodje zivinorejcev ograj.

v vlogi jelenarjev, kajti damjaki bodo prav tako kakor goved in prašiči potovali v klanice. S sanjami o imenitnem rogovju ne bo nič, ker bodo šteje črede na pašniku s površino 2,5 hektara v 34 samic in enega samega samca. Tem "haremskim pašem" bodo vsako leto požagali rogovje, zakaj rukači so tako napadalni, da vidijo tekmeča celo v človeku in so mu lahko bolj nevarni kot andaluzijski bik v areni. Siccer pa samice v svojem času sprejemajo tudi samce brez rogov.

Ali bodo damjaki na pašnikih s poldrugi meter visoko ograjo pogrešali gozd? Odgovor zoolog je za lajka presenetljiv: jeleni po naravi niso prebivalci gozdov, marveč živali stepskih pokrajin, gozd jim je le zatočišče pred človekom.

Gozd je za veliko rogovje precejšnja ovira. Nekdanji evropski orjaški jelen, čigar rogovje je imelo razpon do 3,5 metra, je po vsej verjetnosti izumrl zato, ker so se v Evropi po zadnji ledeni dobi velike tundre brez drevja spremenile v goste gozdove.

Zdaj naj bi že dokaj redki damjaki doživeli nov razcvet kot neke vrste domače živali, kot dobavitelji dragocenega mesa, govedo pa naj bi se omejilo na področja, ki so res primerna zanje. V Afriki že petnajst let poskušajo nadomestiti z gnuji in gazelami, na Skotskem delajo pet let podobne, a za zdaj manj uspešne poskuse z jeleni in srnjadjo, zamisel o taki gojitvi kenspa. Prav tako ni razloga za domnevo, da 'oo puška poslej zaradi visokih in zato predragih poglavito orodje zivinorejcev ograj.

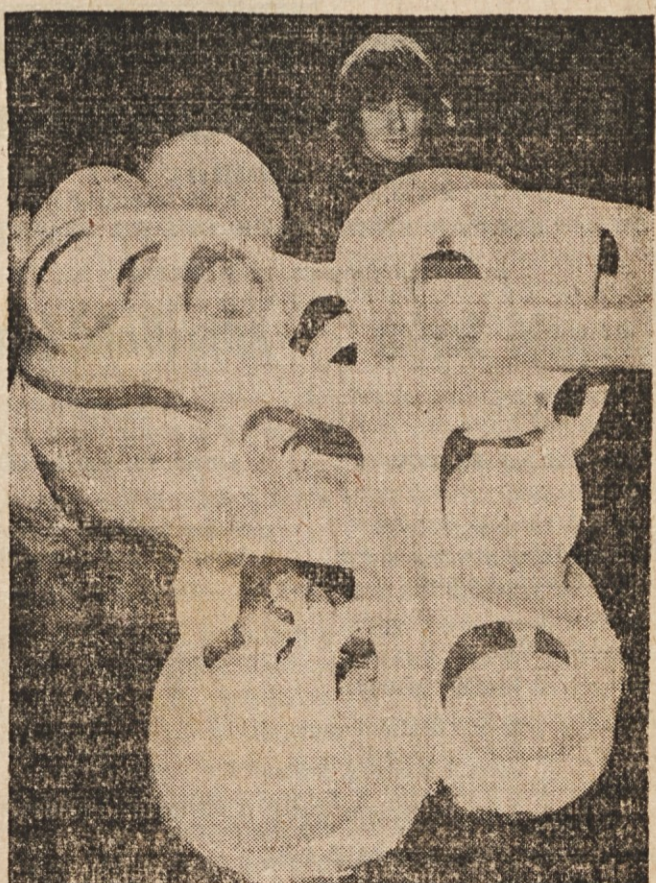

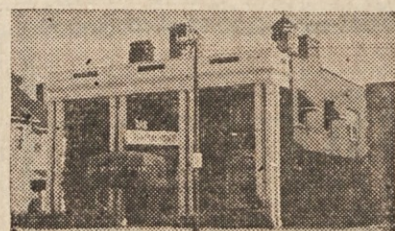

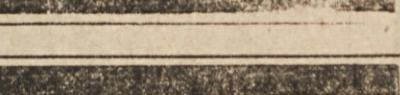

## Flaming Fire of Faith

### Slomšek biography

By Sister MARY LAVOSLAVA (Continuation)

#### 21. "YOU ARE MY JOY"

Students of Theology for the Diocese of Lavant had to study in Klagenfurt Seminary. As often as possible their Bishop visited them. He let them know how much he loved them. "You are my joy," Slomsek habitually greeted them. He regretted the fact that he could not lodge them closer to his See.

In 1850 he at last succeeded in getting permission from State authorities for transfer of the fourth year of Theology to St. Andraz. Since there was no proper building ready for their occupation. Slomsek offered his palace and his garden at their disposal. How happy they felt! Students in lower classes could hardly wait, for their transfer to St. Andraz — to be a member of Bishop's family. There they enjoyed greater freedom for Slomsek wished them to get in contact with the world. Thus it would be easier for them when they would leave the Seminary to get adjusted. Slomsek, kind as he was, nevertheless, demanded strict observance of the horarium. Any transgressor was severely reprovded.

The faculty was comprised of the Cathedral Canons. They received no salary. The Bishop himself gave lectures in Pastoral. He was indirectly interested in each Seminarian. His door and heart were always open to all... He provided help for the poor men. No wonder he was idolized by them.

#### 22. Bishop's Dream Realized

For 60 years the Bishops of Lavant Diocese wished to transfer their See from Korosko to Stajersko. All of them encountered defeat of their plans. It was to become Slomsek's privilege — or rather his heavy burden — to accomplish this almost impossible historical feat. Naturally, he had to surmount all kinds of obstacles but with God's help and his indomitable will, he succeeded where others, less persistent, had failed.

Slomsek encountered a lot of "red tape". Patiently, persistently he wrote to government and ecclesiastical authorities for permission of transfer of his See, prayed, and waited. In 1853, the Archbishop of Salzburg sent a petition to the government in Wien. In 1856 the Emperor Franz Joseph I signed the so long yearned for document which caused Slomsek's heart to leap for sheer joy. And in 1857 the story that had started sixty years previously, had reached the climax: Pope Pius XI authorized the Bishop to go on with his project.

Then the real difficulties began: Where to move? To Celje, Slomsek's pet city? To Ptuj, Slovenska Bistrica, or Maribor? All these cities were clamoring for the privilege. At last the decision was reached: Maribor is the largest city of Stajersko; its location is suitable on account of its accessibility. Slomsek appointed his best friend Marko Glazer, his manager. Nobody envied him his position... There were no buildings in Maribor that could have served as Bishop's residence, theological seminary, etc. Poor Father Glazer had to create something almost out of nothing. His trust in God's Providence was his support.

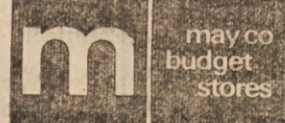

## Slovenian National Art Guild Promotes Culture

On July 25, 1973, the first meeting of the Slovenian National Art Guild was held by Slovenian artist John J. Stuchal to organize a group of Slovenian artists and craftsmen, and others interested in the Slovenian arts, and to promote the richness of the Slovenian culture.

John J. Stuchal - with the assistance of co-founder Slovenian artists Fran Bezdek, and Avery S. Friedman (legal counsel); knowing that a need existed for ethnic heritages, formed the Slovenian National Art Guild.

It is one of the nation's first national ethnic art guilds. Organized as a nonprofit corporation, the Slovenian National Art Guild will be a model for other ethnic organizations to follow.

Membership is not limited to just Slovenian artists and craftsmen; but both patrons and observers of the arts, irrespective of their origin and ancestry, to support the perpetuation of the works of artists of Slovenian ancestry as an important dimension to art.

Meetings of the Slovenian National Art Guild are held the last week of each month, and are open to all members. Membership is \$8.00 per year, and allows the member to participate in all of the Slovenian National Art Guild's activities, and to receive a monthly newsletter.

## South American Adventure

For two hundred years, from its founding until establishment of the Vice-Royalty, Buenos Aires remained a small, dirty, unattractive colonial town. A census taken in 1744 showed that it had a population of 10,223. Of this number, 441 were Spanish property owners who formed the colonial nobility of office holders. All the others were "the common people", offspring of Spanish men and Indian women. In the country districts around Buenos Aires there were 6083 inhabitants, and of these, 186 were Spanish landlords, to whom the crown had awarded grants of land, the rest were mestizos. The Spanish government prohibited immigration into the colonies all during the colonial period, but it encouraged marriage between Spaniards and Indian women. Buenos Aires means good air. The city population in 1940 was 2,364,263 and metro 3,486,430.

Buenos Aires is the capital of Argentina, a major seaport, large raising of cattle, and industry. Moving at a fast pace, congestion of traffic, dotted with many apartments, 12 stories high. Today it is a beautiful cosmopolitan, city with its broad boulevards, the widest street in the world; Avenida de Julio. Sophisticated area along Del Libertador, and Alvear Avenues, have palatial homes.

One of the tallest buildings stands 44 stories high. The present population of the city is about 4 million and metropolitan area has approximately 9 million.

In all the parks are statues of national heroes.

**Slovenians in Buenos Aires**  
A large Spanish population, followed by the Italians, French, German, Swiss, Irish, American, and Yugoslaves are in Buenos Aires. Slovenians, who first emigrated here from Austria sometime in 1878, were welcomed by the Argentinian government.

After W.W. I approximately 22,000 more Slovenians came. Shortly after W.W. 2, from

1947 to 1950 around six thousand Slovenians (political refugees) entered Argentina.

Residing today in Buenos Aires are approximately 31,000 Slovenians. Published here is a weekly Slovenian newspaper "Svobodna Slovenija" plus a bulletin "Oznanilo".

The center of Slovenian activity in Buenos Aires is (Slovenska Hiša) Ramon Falcon 4158. They assist Slovenians who come to Argentina to live.

Located in this home is the church of Mary of Perpetual Help dedicated May 26, 1974.

The following Slovenian Homes are located in Metro Buenos Aires (Slomskov Dom) in Ramos, (Nas Dom) in San Justo, Slovenski Dom in San Martin, Hladnikov Dom in Slovenian Village, Carapachay, Pristava Gastelarju, Beragateguiju.

In other sections of Argentina Slovenian Homes are in Mendoza, Bariloce and Miramar. Msgr. Anton Orehar is the Spiritual Director for Slovenians in Argentina. Teaching in the center, courses are conducted by Mark Bajuk (1961 Director P. Rant) who resides in the center teacher 14 professors, and has 260 students from 1st to 6th grades.

All the above mentioned Slovenian Homes have singing choirs, put on plays, school is taught, in addition to other cultural activities.

When we arrived in Buenos Aires, the exchange at the banks was 220 Peso for one dollar, the monetary system here. Black marketing, legal here we received 300 pesos. No one refused the American dollar, it was welcome anywhere we traveled. Our best deals were made in Buenos Aires. Especially leather goods, food, steaks broiled, almost 2 inches thick. Naptha gas, for automobiles 8 pesos a liter, a telephone call cost you 1 peso. If you could find one. The bus fare, zone system, from 5 peso to 14 to the city limits. The wine served here tasted better than the water, safer too. A family of four can live on 40

American dollars a month conservatively.

The shoppers had a field day in Buenos Aires.

In the company of Mr. Paul Malovrh who resides here, we toured the Standmetal S.A. and Oblak Brothers and Associates Factory, manufacturers of wood shutters, wood doors, and steel windows, enclosures for entrances, porch enclosures, balconies of various designs, and plastic venetian blinds.

Employed here in the wood shop are 135 men, 60 in the metal plant, and 30 in the plastic department. The wood is shipped from a lumber mill in Bolivia, which employs 130 men. The manufactured products are delivered anywhere in Argentina.

Owners of the combined plants are Cyril Oblak, Felix Oblak, Anton Oblak, Paul Malovrh, and Tone Rovar.

The system here is, the man works, and the wife takes care of the house and the children. Travel to learn - learn to travel.

**JOHN AMBROSIC COACHES GIRL BASKETBALL PLAYERS**

In making his college coaching debut, John Ambrosic has given only one rule to his highly-successful John Carroll basketball team.

It is, "Our policy is everybody stays dressed in the locker room until I leave."

You see, Ambrosic is coaching girls not guys and wants to keep the rules simple. No sweat about curfews and of course he doesn't have to worry whether his players wear ties on the road.

Ambrosic is the first man to ever head a women's basketball team at John Carroll and he may be pioneer among all college coaches in this regard.

Ambrosic, who coached the JCU men's JV basketball team two years ago, was asked by Blue Streaks women's physical education director Kathy Manning to take the job. Miss Manning believed she needed a break between coaching volleyball and tennis.

Under their new coach, the Blue Streaks have been a "turn-around gang."

It is no wonder Miss Manning wanted to throw in the chamois after last year's disastrous 1-10 season. But, under Ambrosic, the most valuable player in the Presidents' Athletic Conference when he was a senior in 1973 for JCU, the girls are 9-3 and doing great.

"We have practiced almost every day in this late rush of games and the big turnaround in our program I attribute to the time, work and dedication the girls are putting in," said Ambrosic.

JCU has a small squad both in numbers and in height so it relies on quickness. Tallest of the nine players is 5-10 center Terry Schaefer from Independence, who is averaging 22 points per game.

Ambrosic follows Plain Dea-

ler sports editor Hal Lebovitz's famous philosophy on sports. He never cut a player. But then, he needed all he had.

"We only had response from nine girls and everybody who tried out made the team," said Ambrosic.

To balance the numbers situation, Ambrosic practices with the girls so they can have full-court; five-on-five drills.

"I don't get that upset with losses," admits Ambrosic, who says he would like to make coaching his life's work. "I am not displeased when we get beat. We played the best we are capable. Other people have been able to spend more and have more. We are doing exceptionally well for the numbers and for the limited budget we have."

The coach doesn't have any fancy playbook as you might find such dynamite women's teams such as Immaculate College and Delta University using. John Carroll bases its attack off one or two basic patterns and works options off them.

"We don't go into great detail," said the Benedictine High grad. "We stress fundamentals — passing and shooting — and team play."

The major difference in the rules is the girls use a 30-second shooting clock.

"It is good but it takes a lot of coaching out of the game," Ambrosic declared. "The teams can't stall the ball. It makes it difficult when there is a broad range of talent."

Of the girls' mental outlook to basketball, Ambrosic declared, "they are better disciplined than the boys. They take basketball very seriously."

Other key players are 519 guard Ramona Francesconi who is averaging 17 points per game, 518 forward Sue Leopold of Toledo, 518 forward Coleen Farrell of Cleveland and 5-5 guard

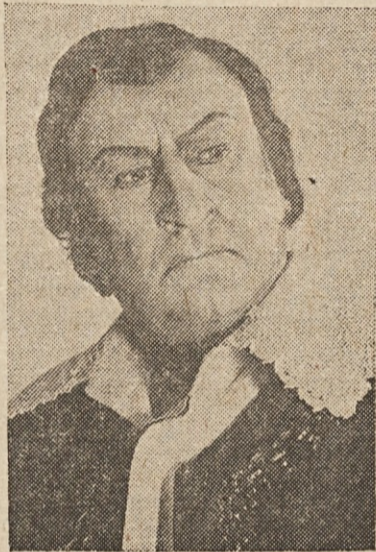
