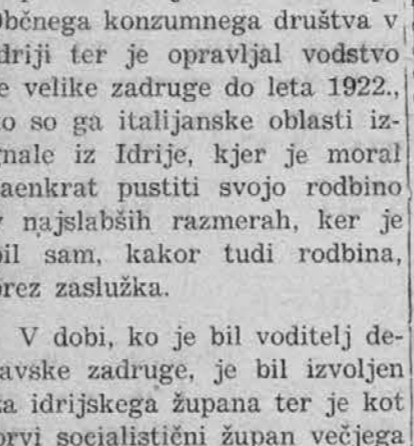

Congratulations to all new officers of SSPZ lodges and to all re-elected officers. Also to the lucky winner of Strabane.

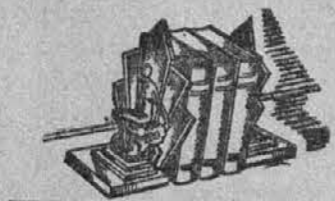

Our organizer, Mr. Anton Zaitz, is Vrtec No. 1's newly elected Administrator. Congratulations, Mr. Zaitz!

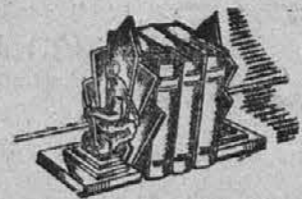

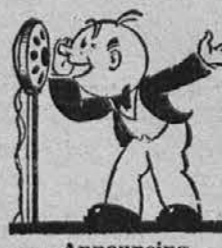

PENNSYLVANIA led all other states in the amount of business written-up during the MILLION DOLLAR CAMPAIGN.

OHIO came in second. 20 lodges and their Vrtecs contributed a total of \$77,500, or a little over 10 per cent of the grand total.

ILLINOIS took third honors among the states. Here 31 lodges and their Vrtecs contributed a total of \$63,500, or approximately 11 1/2 per cent of the grand total.

COLORADO made the fourth best showing by contributing \$36,000 to the campaign total, or slightly more than 6 1/2 per cent.

MONTANA is fifth in line. 5 lodges and their Vrtecs contributed \$30,000 for an average of \$6,000 (ranking next to Colorado in this respect).

WEST VIRGINIA, we find in sixth place by virtue of its \$20,000 new insurance. 6 active lodges and 3 inactive for an average of \$3,333.00.
