30.000 ITALIJANOV JE ŽE ZAJETIH

Kaira, 13. dec. — Angleški avijatičarji so poleteli globoko v Libijo in bombardirali italijanske postojanke, zrakoplovne pristane, zlasti pa obe glavni pristanišči Bardia in Tobruk. Angleška armada pa brez postanka pritiska za Italijani in jih podi iz egiptovskega ozemlja. Zajeli so nadaljne tisoče italijanskih vojakov včeraj, med njimi dva generala. Vsega skupaj so Angleži zajeli že nad 30.000 Italijanov.

Italijanske čete beže na vrat na nos iz Egipta proti Libiji. Angleži jih ne puste niti za trenutek pri miru. Noč in dan jih napadajo po suhem, iz zraka in z morja ter jih pode naravnost proti ozkemu prehodu, ki vodi iz Egipta v Libijo, ki je podoben vratu od steklenice. Ta kraj je ozka zaseka med Sollum, na egiptovski strani in Bardia, na libijski strani. Tukaj nameravajo Angleži zgnesti Italijane in jih potem vse skupaj zajeti.

Atene, 13. dec. — Grki so danes zasedli albansko pristanišče Palermo in nek ujeti italijanski poveljnik je povedal, da italijansko poveljstvo v Tirani premišlja, če ne bi vprašalo Grke za premirje.

V gorovju Mokra so Grki prvič naleteli na italijanske alpine na smučkah. Na smučkah in v svojih belih plaščih so se vsuli na Grke, ki so jih sprejeli s križnim ognjem iz strojnic. Nekaj alpinov je prodrlo prvo grško linijo, toda skozi drugo ni prišel noben. Vsi so padli.

Belgrad, 13. dec. — V Dubrovniku na Jadranskem morju so danes slišali močno kanonado. Sodijo, da se je vršila nekeje v bližini bitka med angleškimi in italijanskimi ladjami. Dubrovnik leži 80 milj severno od albanske meje.

A Letter from Girard

It is with a feeling of joy that we are happy to announce to our many Slovenian readers that the cornerstone for the new St. Rose Church at Girard, Ohio, was laid on Sunday afternoon, Nov 10, at 3 o'clock by the Very Rev. James A. McFadden, Auxiliary Bishop of Cleveland. The ceremony, witnessed by scores of clergy, Ursuline Sisters, many of them former teachers, and hundreds of parishioners and friends, was the first important step realized by the parish in its great undertaking—the building of a new church. The church is rapidly nearing completion and is expected to be dedicated during the early part of 1941. The new \$90,000 edifice located on the site of the old church is of the Tudor-Gothic type and will have a steeple. It will seat 600 people in the church proper and 100 in the choir. The frame building which the new church replaces was more than 50 years old. During the early years of 1870 and 1880, mass was celebrated in private homes, the history of the parish reveals. As the population of the Village of Girard gradually increased, it was found necessary to build a church which was begun around 1891, under the leadership of a committee of men, the pioneer organizers. The late Rev. James J. Stewart came from Cleveland, Ohio, to serve as first pastor, remaining for 18 years. He was succeeded by the Right Rev. Monsignor Edward A. Kirby who was pastor for 15 years and under whom the school building was completed. Msgr Kirby is at St. Cecilia's Church in Cleveland, Ohio. Rev. Michael J. Coan who came to serve as pastor in 1923 succeeded Msgr Kirby. Our assistant pastor is Rev. George P. Murphy. It is gratifying to note that a large portion of the congregation of St. Rose Parish is made up of the Slovenian colony of Girard which is working zealously with their fellow church members in order that they may attain their goal and witness the completion of a new dwelling place for Almighty God.

Recently, the Slovenian people sponsored a concert which was a decided success, proceeds being turned over entirely to the Church Building Fund. This is only one of many forms of activity which they have undertaken for the benefit of the parish. In conjunction with the dedication of the church, the members of the parish, under the chairmanship of Miss Sophie Cekuta, are working on a "Golden Jubilee Memorial Book" which they plan to issue in commemoration of this event. The book will contain a history of the development of the parish and will feature illustrated articles on various church groups. Advertising effort will also be solicited and every effort will be made to insure the success of the book. The proceeds will aid the Building Fund.

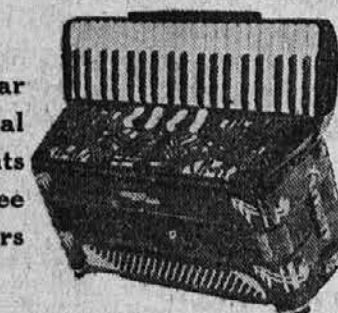

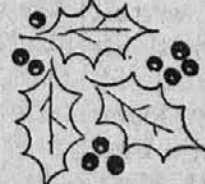
