SANC Holds Fourth Regular Convention in SWH

This coming Saturday and Sunday, May 27 and 28, the Slovene American National Council is holding its fourth convention at the Slovenian Workmen's Home on Waterloo Road, under the direction of the three SANC branches located in Cleveland.

SANC is a product of the last war and was organized for the purpose of co-ordinating the efforts of the Slovenes in the U. S. A. in their endeavor to aid in bringing the war to a successful conclusion through the purchase and sale of War Bonds and in reply to the appeals of the Red Cross with the knowledge in mind that the termination of the war would bring a cry for help from their brethren in Yugoslavia who had suffered horribly under the heel of the fascist and nazi hordes with their concentration camps and policies of racial extermination. Funds were solicited by SANC not for bombs and bullets, but for food, clothing, medicines, medical equipment, and the monumental achievement of constructing a hospital for children in Ljubljana. What could be more morally right!

The question before SANS this week-end will be the policy the organization is to pursue in the future. Now that the United States has recognized the sincerity of purpose of the Yugoslav government in its attempt to construct a social order beneficial to all its peoples, and the stand of the Yugoslav government in refusing to become a satellite of any power group, and its willingness to deal with all groups on friendly terms, and the USA put out a helping hand, the tension has been eased.

MW'S RAINBOW DANCE

The Martha Washingtons, the ever popular English-Speaking lodge of SDZ will annex another novel dance to their long list of annual socials before they are ready to celebrate their Silver Anniversary in 1951. It is the "Merry Martha's Rainbow Dance" featuring the up and coming accordionist, Ray Champa. This will be Ray's debut at the Slovenian Auditorium, 6419 St. Clair Avenue, Saturday, May 27, 1950.

The Martha Washingtons take great pride in being one of the first groups to feature bands led by Frank Yankovich, Lou Trebar and Johnny Pecon. Hundreds attended these dances which were the beginning of their increasing popularity, until it brought them the crown of Polka King of today. When Yankovich, Trebar and Pecon were young boys, they played polkas, waltzes and fox trots because they loved it, but as time went on, they improved themselves because their public, the dancers, fell in love with it.

Ray Champa was practically born with an accordion in his hands, and lullabied to sleep with old Slovene Ballads sung by his grandmother. His father began to play the accordion while still a boy. He learned the tunes and melodies as they were sung by his mother. Later, Frank Champa wrote the old favorites into composition which Ray is now using weekly on the air, and very often at the Glen Park Cafe, owned and operated by his parents. He had been engaged for dances at various Slovenian Dance Halls and the Bowl where he and the orchestra were well received. His great ambition is to play at the Slovenian Auditorium on St. Clair Avenue, which is rated amongst the best dance floors of the city.

It is with great pleasure that the Martha Washingtons take the opportunity of introducing their member, Ray Champa and his Champs tomorrow, Saturday, May 27, 1950 at the Slovenian Auditorium, 6419 St. Clair Avenue. The MWS plead that you and your friends give Ray a warm reception by packing the house just as it was done for the top-notch players of today, back in the days when they were making a fresh start.
