Jadranska proga Beograd-Bar

POGLED V ZGODOVINO

BEOGRAD,—Lani so v Jugoslaviji pričeli graditi tako imenovano jadransko progo. Potreba po progji, ki bi povežala severovzhodni predel Jugoslavije (Srbijo) z morjem, je bila pereča že v času carsinske vojne med Srbijo in Avstro-Ogrsko.

Leta 1920 je skupina ameriških izvedencev predlagala jugoslovanski vladi traso nove jadranske proge, ki naj bi potekala po dolinah Drine, Pive in Komarnice, skozi Nikšić, po dolini Zete v Kotorski zaliv. To je bila za takrat najidealnejša tehnična rešitev.

1. Jadranska proga je najkrajša in najprikladnejša kopna zveza Srbije in Beograda z morjem in Črne gore z drugimi kraji Jugoslavije. Sedanji načrt je tako imenovana limska proga. To je zelo posrečena varianta drinske proge, ki ima številne gospodarske in tehnične prednosti pred prejšnjo traso.

2. Jadranska proga poteka skozi zapadno Srbijo in Crno goro, ki sta bili do sedaj prometno odsekani od ostale Jugoslavije.

arandjelovskim bazenom (rjavi premog in nekatere rude, industrijska šamota, elektropercelean in azbesta) in podrinskih rudniških območjem (antimon).

Proga bo omogočila najkrajšo pot na svetovno tržišče jugoslovanskemu svinu in cinku iz Trepče. Tudi veliki gozdni predeli Sandžaka in Črne gore, ki so bili do sedaj neizkoriščeni, bodo pristopni eksploataciji, s čimer bodo povečane možnosti za razvoj lesne industrije.

Z zgraditvijo proge bo nastalo široko gospodarsko območje, ki bo gravitiral k južnemu Jadraniu. Proti morju bodo prevladali žitarice, živilske in razne industrijske izdelke, v nasprotno smer pa živino, južno sadje, industrijske rastline, sol, olje, nafto in prodobno.

3. Jadranska proga bo postala prava žila jugoslovanskega prometa. Zaradi njenega položaja v centralnem delu države utegne v doglednem času postati osrednja proga, v katero se bo stekal večji del jugoslovanskega železniškega omrežja.

Zgraditev jadranske proge bo pomenila tudi precejšnjo razbremenitev zahodnih železnic in pristanišč na Severnem Jadraniu.

S pripravljalnimi deli na progi Beograd-Bar, ki bo dolga 518 km, so pričeli lansko pomlad. Sedaj gradijo progo v dveh delih, na odsekih Beograd-Valjevo in Bar-Titograd. Na teh odsekih bodo letos opravili dela v skupni vrednosti treh milijard 300 milijonov din.

Na odseku Beograd-Valjevo bo do konca leta dokončan spodnji ustroj proge. Na odseku Titograd-Bar so že pričeli vrtati predor skozi Sazino, ki bo dolg 6250 m. Treba bo tudi zgraditi most čez Skadrsko jezero.

Ker pa graditev proge zahteva velike tehnične napore—saj se šestkrat dvigne na višino 1200 m in zopet spusti v dolino in je potrebna gradnja predorov

in skupni dolžini 96 km, predvidevajo, da bo celotna gradnja trajala deset let.

ŽIVLJENJE V GLOBINAH 10,000 M

Danska raziskovalna odprava ki se je nedavno vrnila iz raziskovalnega potovanja okrog Filipinskega otočja, je našla celo v globini 10,000 m živa bitja. To so bile posebne vrste morske anemone nedoločene barve, velike kot mandeljni. Odprava je pod vodstvom dr. Antona S. Brunnna raziskovala tudi morske globine ob afriški obali, prekržarila Indijski ocean in nadeljevala pot prek Tihega oceana.

Alien Registration and Address Reports

1955 will mark the fifth year that aliens have been required to file an address report with the Immigration and Naturalization Service during the month of January.

How does an alien report his address? He goes to any United States Post Office or any immigration office and asks for an Alien Address Report Card. This is a simple form which he fills in and signs. He then hands the completed form to any Post Office clerk or an immigration employee. The card should not be sent through the mails.

Is this report necessary for an alien who is just a visitor or a student in this country? Yes, as long as he was in the United States on January 1st he must submit this address report during the month of January. This applies to non-immigrants, such as visitors for business or pleasure, seamen, students, and treaty traders, to name a few.

What if an alien has been here for many, many years and has not been naturalized? If he has not been naturalized, he is still an alien. It would not matter if he came here as a baby and has been in this country for more than fifty years. As long as he has not been naturalized, he must file this address report.

Are there any penalties for failure to report? If an alien willfully or inexcusably fails to report his address during January, he may be taken into custody and deported from the United States. He may also be fined and imprisoned before deportation.
