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Slovenia Declines to Exempt US Citizens from UN Court

LJUBLJANA – Defending the jurisdiction of a new international war crimes court, Slovenia Monday resisted pressure from the U.S. to sign a treaty protecting Americans from prosecution by the tribunal.

The U.S. strongly opposes the International Criminal Court, fearing that its troops could be subjected to politically motivated trials, and has asked its allies to sign a non-surrender agreement.

Such an accord would shield U.S. soldiers from being extradited to the International Criminal Court based in The Hague, Netherlands.

The court is empowered to prosecute individuals for war crimes committed anywhere in the world.

Slovenia, which is set to join the European Union next year, welcomed the establishment of the court and is bent on "defending the integrity," a statement from Foreign Minister Dimitrij Rupel's office said.

In a meeting in Ljubljana on Monday, June 2, U.S. negotiators apparently failed to make Slovenians change their minds.

Patricia McNerney, a senior adviser to the State Department said the U.S. would continue lobbying Slovenian authorities and hinted that the former Yugoslav republic could lose \$8 million in military assistance if it fails to yield to U.S. premises.

Record Mihevc Grants Disbursed

St. Vitus Parish in Cleveland is pleased to announce that the Joseph and Antonia Mihevc Scholarship Endowment Fund will provide a record \$237,000 in grand funding for registered parishioners who attend tuition-paying schools from grades Kindergarten to senior year college for school year 2003-2004.

The Mihevc Grant Program was established in April 1989 by the late Mr. Edward L. Mihevc Sr., a former parishioner, to assist families attending tuition paying schools. Since 1990 the Mihevc Grant Program has provided nearly \$677,400 to approximately 510 qualified and approved

applicants.

The Mihevc Grant Program initially allowed grants for registered parishioners who attended tuition paying schools from grades 9 to 13. In March 2003 the Mihevc Grant Program was expanded to include grades kindergarten to senior year in college.

In two separate but related activities, the Mihevc Grant Program will provide funding for the next five years in the form of grants to John Carroll University.

St. Vitus Parish will rename and re-dedicate the parish auditorium / gymnasium after the late Edward L. Mihevc Sr.

Bob Dolgan Writes New Sports Book

Bob Dolgan, longtime Plain Dealer sportswriter, is the author of a new book, "Heroes, Scamps and Good Guys."

The book, published by Gray and Company, contains 101 profiles of Cleveland sports figures that were written by Dolgan in The Plain Dealer over the last four decades.

The stories cover the entire spectrum of Cleveland sports, from the earliest days to the present.

In baseball, there are stories on people such as Ray Chapman, the only major league player ever to be killed in a game, the star-crossed Shoeless Joe Jackson, Lou Boudreau, Cleveland's greatest sports hero, Earl Averill, Bob Feller, Hal Trosky, Kenny Keltner, Bob Feller, Jim Thome, Carlos Baerga, Albert Belle and many others.

Dolgan, a Slovenian-American who grew up in the E. 65th-St. Clair neighborhood, has stories on two fellow Slovenians, Indians pitcher Al Milnar and boxer Eddie Simms.

The football articles include studies of Otto Graham, Big Bill Willis, Mac Speedie, Brian Sipe, Lou Groza, Earnest Byner, Sam Rutigliano, Marion Motley and many others.

There are also Cavaliers basketball stories

on people like Lenny Wilkens, Mark Price and Larry Nance, boxing pieces on promoter Larry Atkins and champions Joey Maxim and Michael Dokes, and horse racing pieces on jockey Danny Weiler, trainer John Rutherford, who died of a broken heart, and Barbara Turcotte, the queen of Northfield racetrack.

The stories are told with the usual style of warmth and humor characteristic of Dolgan's nostalgia series. They would make a fine Father's Day gift.

The word "Scamps" in the title refers to athletes who got into trouble with the law, or were mischievous and broke rules, while remaining likable people.

Dolgan will be signing books at several area bookstores, including Saturday, June 7 from 1 - 2 p.m. at Borders Books in Cuyahoga Falls; and Saturday, June 14 from 1 - 2 p.m. at Borders in Strongsville.

Goes without saying that in the next few days I did not have much to eat, but then I was missing teeth that I generally chewed on and they left enough holes in my mouth to set mine traps.

Thank God the weekend was coming up and they said they would finish me on Monday morning with only one more extraction to go. Lord I hope you are listening to me; you owe me big time, for I felt I was really going up the hill of Calvary.

Well, the weekend was coming up and I had two days of freedom; no doctors to deal with for 48 hours. Since the weekend was to commence, I had planned long before now that I would go out and buy Mom something to remember me and Fort Dix by. You won't believe it. The fun is about to begin. Sorry; you have to tune in next week to hear about the gift.

Time to sign off, the Doc says I gotta keep my feet elevated and chew diuretic tablets like they are going out of style. How do you like that; they want me potty trained.

In closing May the Good Lord bless and watch over all of you and keep you all in good health and his loving care. Thanks again to all my faithful readers for your concern and prayers.

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Life in the Refugee Camps

-- 1947 --

Wednesday, Jan. 1, 1947

From 3 - 4 a.m. this morning, it was our barracks' turn to pray in the camp chapel. We all went - except Mire. At dawn I wished everyone a Happy New Year, even Breznikar. He never says anything, even today, he barely replied.

This evening, my sister Mici cooked a special New Year's dinner in our room - meat and eggs. After dinner, everyone went to bed.

We've been refugees for a year-and-a-half now, and our situation looks more hopeless than it did a year ago: many people think we will have to languish here for many more years. For most of us, there is no hope for a safe return home. There may be a little hope that we could move to America. Some people hope that we will be saved by a revolution in Yugoslavia.

This spring, it will be two years since we left Slovenia. At one time, I had hoped that we could return home in two years. Now I can see that won't be possible. Maybe after 20 years?

Friday, Jan. 3, 1947

Janko Demšar returned from Feldkirchen after 14

days. My brother Joze, who has been living there, came with him bringing potica, flour, klobase, clothes, 180 cigarettes, 15 little boxes of Swiss sugar and other good things. He also brought me 500 dinars from my brother Ciril in Slovenia.

Saturday, Jan. 4, 1947

Our friend Silva had sent us some ration cards from the Karinthian region of Austria. Today, I took those to a number of stores in Judenburg, but at first I couldn't find a store that would accept them. Finally, I found one that agreed to sell me some bread and meat for them.

Sunday, Jan. 5, 1947

As we always did at home on the evening before Epiphany, we did a procession around our barracks this evening and prayed all three decades of the rosary. It was very cold outside. After dinner, we played "spank the judge."

Monday, Jan. 6, 1947

Today is Epiphany, the holy day of the three kings who came to adore the baby Jesus. It is very cold outside -31°C below zero (-24°F)!

Wednesday, Jan. 8, 1947

Craftspeople from our refugee camp met at Vrtačnik's barracks from 2 - 4 p.m. this afternoon. We decided to form a union, but we couldn't decide who should be president. Some-

body nominated Sepin, but he refused and instead nominated me. However, a number of people wanted "opposition" candidates; they thought I was too aligned with the leadership.

We met again at 8 p.m., and this time Vrtačnik the tailor was voted as president. My sister Mici was elected to the board. People are hoping this union will help us gain autonomy for our camp. The Ukrainian camp has only 9 craftspeople, the Croatian camp has 30, while our Slovenian camp has 70. That means the Slovenians contribute most of the work, but UNRRA (the United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration) requires all proceeds from the sale of craft items to be divided into 3 equal parts, one to each camp. Vrtačnik and Zupan will be our leaders in our fight for a fair share.

Saturday, Jan. 11, 1947

My brother Joze returned to Feldkirchen today after staying here with us for a week. There is a train which runs from here to Feldkirchen twice a day. Joze had planned to take the 2:30 train, but it was 3 hours late.

Sunday, Jan. 12, 1947

I went to the pastry shop with Cilka and Mici this afternoon. We each got two cups of tea and some potica.

For Sale The Album of the Ljubljana Noble Society of St. Dismas 1688-1801

The album, produced over 113 years, is one of the masterpieces of the Baroque period in Central Europe.

The society was formed by Sir Wolf Sigmund von Kunpach and Sir Franz Jakob von Erberg to preserve Christian faith and to encourage noble and honest virtues. The 500 page album contains 186 full-page illustrations of the coats-of-arms of the society's members which were commissioned whenever a noble joined the society. Its members included prominent members of the elite of Slovenian regions of Austro-Hungarian empire, which also encompassed several areas of present day Austria, Italy and Croatia.

The album contains the work of several painters of the period, including Anton Trost, Bartholomeus Ramschissl, Matthias Greyscher and Simon Thaddeus Grahovar, as well as some unknown illustrators.

The reproduction of the volume, which was published in a six-color printing process, took eight years to accomplish. Accompanying the volume is a literal transcription of the many texts contained in the album as well as translations and an interpretive narration in German and English.


The album was reprinted in 200 numbered and verified copies of which 134 copies have been sold.

Books of Slovenia is the exclusive representative for North America and Asia for the publisher, the Janez Vajkard Valvasor Foundation, which is affiliated with the Slovenian Academy of Sciences and Arts.

The price is \$7,500 plus shipping costs.

Ravioli Salad

This sounds weird, but please hold your judgment until you taste. This recipe came from Robin Benzle, the morning DJ on WDOK. It is one of my favorite summer salads.

Ingredients:

- 1 lb. frozen ravioli, cooked and cooled
- Steamed asparagus, cooled and cut into 2"
- English cucumber, sliced thin
- Cherry or yellow grape tomatoes, cut in half
- Bell pepper, julienned
- 6 slices of bacon, cooked until crisp & chopped
- Toasted pine nuts
- Fresh basil, chopped

Dressing:

- ½ C olive oil
- ¼ C balsamic vinegar

Directions:

Cook the ravioli and cool by running under cold water. Drain and put on a large platter. Arrange all the chopped vegetables over the top of the ravioli. Feel free to substitute whatever you have that is fresh (steamed zucchini, plum tomatoes, etc.). Sprinkle with toasted pine nuts and chopped basil, and drizzle the dressing over the top.

To toast the pine nuts, put them in a dry pan over medium high heat, and stir until they get slightly browned. Cool before using. (They are also great on other pasta dishes.)

It was not "Will you marry me?" It was "What are you doing for the next 20 years?" This on the occasion of our first formal meeting. I admired his timing, his humor and forthrightness and accepted (after a time) his unique proposal.

It was the right choice as our family was in good hands over the years with Frank at the head.

I came across a Christmas card I had given him along with a pair of gloves some 10 years ago. On it I had written: "To keep warm the capable hands of my beloved, the hands that can maintain a furnace, household appliances, clocks, automobiles, electrical systems, plumbing, basement landscaping, redecorating, painting, antiquating, papering, spraying, pruning, laying linoleum, making a grape vine grow out of a stick-like cutting. The hands that gave confidence and comfort to our kids when they needed to be "stitched up" or given the "booster" shots. The hands that have soiled these many years to make our Christmases possible. The hands that can make any little animal comfortable. May we all long know the comforts of those capable hands. Love, Jennie."

Our children had complete trust in Frank. If he said a thing had to be done they did not question it. I remember the day we took them to get their booster shots. They were all apprehensive but knew it was unavoidable. As we drove home after it was over, our daughter Vicki turned to her brother Steve and asked, "Why did we have to get booster shots? He shot back, "So we don't get the booster, silly." The implication being that dad knows best, not to question.

Little things mean a lot and our children are now harkening back to their childhood and reminiscing about the way things were.

Steve always wanted to be with Frank when he was a little tike, and wanted to do whatever he was doing. When Frank was painting the house, Steve wanted to help so Frank gave him a bucket of water and a paint brush and let him "paint" the front bricks. The patience paid off because today Steve is the same capable person his dad was, and knows how to get things done.

Vicki remembers her dad

taking her horseback riding and how they conspired on one occasion to bring me a kitten on Mother's Day. Now they both knew I was not as much of an animal lover as they were, so when they came across a new litter of kittens, Frank knew I would not be thrilled and didn't want to take the responsibility of bringing one home so he urged Vicki to pick one out and take it home so that I would think it was her idea alone, but you can't fool mom. Vicki has never lost her love for animals and still chuckles about that incident.

Our daughter Kate is most like Frank in that she is methodical, efficient and meticulous. Frank didn't realize how much like him she is until he went to Michigan to visit her some years back. He was helping her to cut green beans for freezing and when he came home he said, "Kate wanted them to be cut so that they would all be the very same size - kind of fussy." I responded, who do you think she takes after? He seemed surprised but then smiled at the realization that they were as one in so many ways.

We are trying to forget the last grief-filled days of Frank's long illness by remembering him as he was during our life together. All three of our children lent me strength and support when I needed it most. One or the other was with me every day during his last months. Steve in particular was a pillar of strength encouraging me to be positive while he hid his own grief. I shall never forget their devotion and concern.

I enjoy listening to their scattered recollections of their dad such as the many times he took them fishing in a rowboat on Lake Erie. They all still love fishing.

Frank was a very serious person with a dedication to duty from the time he was eight years old when his father, Frank Mramor Sr., died. He felt early on the responsibility to his mother and sisters, being the only son. Until he became ill he maintained his mother's house over all the years so that she could continue to live independently. She died at age 90 from congestive heart failure while Frank was also lying mortally ill. They were in the same hospital and

couldn't see one another and it devastated Frank because he felt he had let her down.

One night when we went to visit him, he related that he imagined his mother was sitting by his bedside looking at him. I have no doubt she was communicating with him because her heart was broken when she learned of his illness. I believe she just didn't care to live any longer without her son.

While Frank was ultra serious most of the time, he had a comedic sense of humor and could rivet the attention of a roomful of people with his expressive antics while telling jokes. His son has the same talent.

Frank had the soul of a musician and was happiest when he was playing his accordion while people danced and sang. He was in his own world when he strapped on his accordion and didn't hear a word anyone said.

Frank and I were different in many ways. He was the practical one; I was the dreamer. He kept my feet on the ground when I was ready to shuck it all and just have a good time. He was not a social being when he wasn't playing the accordion and was most comfortable when he was at home. But in the things that mattered most, we thought as one.

Altogether, Frank was a good husband, good provider, father and son which is all anyone can ask of a man. He fulfilled his mission admirably.

Wait for me, Frank we'll meet again around the next bend. (Maybe I'll bring your accordion.) Life without you is empty. We love you.

A Dream and 57 Cents

A sobbing little girl stood near a small church from which she had been turned away because it was too crowded. "I can't go to Sunday School," she sobbed to the pastor as he walked by.

Seeing her shabby, unkempt appearance, the pastor guessed the reason and, taking her by the hand, took her inside and found a place for her in the Sunday school class. The child was so happy that she went to bed that night thinking of the children who have no place to worship Jesus.

Some two years later this child lay dead in one of the poor tenement buildings and the parents called for the kindhearted pastor who had befriended their daughter, to handle the final arrangements.

As her body was being moved, a worn and crumpled purse was found which seemed to have been rummaged from some trash dump. Inside was found 57 cents and a note scribbled in childish handwriting which read, "This is to help build the little church bigger so more children can go to Sunday School." For two years she had saved for this offering of love.

When the pastor tearfully read that note, he knew instantly what he would do. Carrying this note and the cracked, red pocketbook to the pulpit, he told the story

of her unselfish love and devotion. He challenged his deacons to get busy and raise enough money for a larger building.

A newspaper learned of the story and published it. It was ready by a realtor who offered them a parcel of land worth many thousands. When told that the church could not pay so much, he offered it for 57 cents.

Church members made large donations. Checks came from far and wide. Within five years the little girl's gift had increased to \$250,000 - a huge sum for that time (near the turn of the century).

When visiting the city of Philadelphia, look up Temple Baptist Church, with a seating capacity of 3,300 and Temple University, where hundreds of students are trained.

Have a look, too, at the Good Samaritan Hospital and at a Sunday School building which houses hundreds of Sunday schoolers so that no child in the area will ever need be left outside.

In one of the rooms may be seen the picture of the little girl whose 57 cents made such remarkable history. Alongside of it is a portrait of her pastor, Dr. Russel H. Conwell.

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
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Vineyards in Slovenia: 'There's always room for improvement in quality'

Slovenia is Small But Perfectly Cultivated

Hopes to bring cottage wine into Europe's fore

Speaking to Bojan Protner at the winery he runs in Slovenia can be a tricky business. The winery, based in Pernica, near Maribor, is so small that Mr. Protner is constantly called away to shift crates of bottles or work the bottling machine.

Yet in terms of size, Mr. Protner is in the top 300 of Slovenia's 22,000 registered wine and grape producers. He has seven hectares of vines on the rolling hills around the winery. More than 16,000 producers each have just half a hectare or less.

According to Spela Terpin, under-secretary of state for wine at Slovenia's agriculture ministry, 8,500 of the country's 25,000 hectares of vines belong to part-time producers so small they have not even registered for agriculture ministry subsidies.

As a result, Slovenia exports only between 6 and 15 percent of its production. Under communism, when drinking was heavier, Slovenian wine producers could not even supply the home market's demand.

Mr. Protner still sells domestically nearly all the 50,000 to 60,000 liters of white wine he produces.

Yet the industry partly makes up in quality for what it lacks in size. Just down the hill from Bojan Protner, Joannes Protner - not a relative - produces very high quality wines from a vineyard of 6.5 hectares. His customers include an exclusive restaurant in New York. His production is almost entirely for export and he is considered one of several high quality producers in Slovenia.

For such producers, small size can be an advantage, says Ms Terpin. They would be unable to sell larger quantities of their wines without heavy marketing spending. On their present scale, they can dispose of most of their production through contacts with a few

knowledgeable sommeliers abroad.

Joannes Protner says it is important not just to produce high quality wines but also to have marketing skills.

"You must know how to sell the wine," he says.

The generally high standards of Slovenian wine - which are unusual in a post-communist country - reflect both Slovenia's geography and its unusual history during communism.

Many of Slovenia's vineyards remained under private control during the Yugoslav socialist era. The vines are consequently in better condition than in neighboring Hungary, where state and cooperative farms often replanted vineyards to obtain higher yields but lower quality.

Slovenia also never lost touch with western wine-making techniques. Slovenians from the two main wine-growing areas - in the northeast and west - continued during the communist era to have contacts with colleagues just over the border in Austria and Italy.

Slovenia's hills also produce good insulation for vines, protecting them from frosts. "There's always room for improvement in quality," says Ms Terpin. "But, compared with our neighbors and other producers, we could say that the quality on average is quite high."

The challenge is to improve marketing to boost sales abroad. Such exports will be needed upon EU accession, to overcome falls in Slovenian wine's domestic market share. Tariff barriers which will disappear on EU entry are keeping imported wines market share at negligible levels.

Judging by the experience of neighboring Austria's EU accession in 1995, imports are likely to take 10 to 15 percent of the market after EU entry, following an initial phase when their market share will be even higher.

"We can compare on quality," says Ms Terpin.

"[But] what the Italians are able to do in marketing we are not able to do."

There have been efforts to address the problem. The agriculture ministry has hired a public relations company to organize publicity for Slovenian wine among wine specialists in the UK.

Meanwhile, the Slovenian Commercial Union of Wine and Viticulture, a group of 18, mainly larger scale producers, is seeking to introduce a brand name wine to some UK wine retailers.

If it is a success, says Dusan Brejc, assistant director of the organization, wines from single grape varieties and from individual wineries may follow.

He concedes that Slovenia is only a small fish in a pond of much larger, more aggressive producers. In most markets, such large fish would swallow the smaller ones.

But the wine market offers the small fish other opportunities: "What the small fish can do is to create a niche market," he says.

Study Links Smoking to Shoddy Memory

WASHINGTON - Another study suggests smoking is bad for your brain: Researchers tracking the health of almost 2,000 British adults found heavy smokers had poorer memories in middle age.

People in the British study are in their 50s, far too young to know if the memory decline will translate into dementia when they are elderly.

But testing so far suggests that heavy smokers who survive smoking's biggest

threats - lung cancer and heart disease - into old age, may be at risk of serious cognitive decline, the researchers report Thursday in the *American Journal of Public Health*.

Other research already has labeled smoking a risk factor for dementia. One cause of dementia is restricted blood flow in the brain, smoking is linked to narrowed arteries and silent mini-strokes that choke that blood supply.

Good Health: 9 Fruits & Veggies

If you thought eating five servings of fruits and vegetables a day was pretty much impossible, here is some bad news: The National Cancer Institute wants men to increase their consumption to *nine* servings a day.

Although past campaigns have touted the need for five servings a day, health experts now say five is just the bare minimum. They say U.S. dietary guidelines have always called for men to eat nine servings - but many haven't gotten the message.

Indeed, most men are shocked to learn they are supposed to eat anything near nine servings. A recent NCI survey found that 97% of men didn't have a clue nine was the magic number. The vast majority of men think four servings is enough to insure good health, although the average man eats only three.

While men are the focus of the new campaign, health officials note that women should increase their consumption to seven servings a day, while kids should eat at least five.

The goals are particularly daunting when you consider only 23% of adults eat at

least five daily servings of fruit and vegetables. Only 4% of men consume nine. More than one-third of the population eats only one or two servings and 4% eat less than that.

It is worth noting that the most dramatic health benefit comes when people jump to at least five vegetables a day.

The primary goal with children is to get them to eat a variety of foods and learn to enjoy eating fruits and vegetables.

Kids today are getting fat from eating fried foods, soda and junk food.

A Harvard School of Public Health study of 120,000 nurses or health workers found that those who had very high intake of fruits and vegetables had the lowest risk for heart disease. For every additional serving of fruits and vegetables eaten regularly, a person lowers their risk for heart disease by 4%. Another study found that women who ate 7 to 10 daily servings of fruits and vegetables lowered their heart-attack risk by 40%.

In other studies, fruit and vegetable consumption has been shown to lower blood pressure.

Ohio likely to be very crucial battlefield in presidential race

Bush visited Canton, Ohio and Lima Army Tank Plant on Thursday, April 24, he was joined by a prominent Republican senator, Mike DeWine. - George Voinovich, Ohio's other senator and a moderate Republican - whose opposition to the president's tax cuts prompted Mr. Bush's visit in the first place - restricted his role to a perfunctory greeting at the Dayton, Ohio airport.

While Mr. Bush and a coterie of other state Republicans preached the tax-cut gospel, Mr. Voinovich was holding previously scheduled events, including a meeting with editors of the Dayton Daily News. The White House invited Mr. Voinovich to accompany and said he was already booked.

Too busy to escort a popular president of his own party in his home state? It was not the first time Mr. Voinovich, who has opposed tax cuts many times over a 30-year political career, has resisted a Republican president. In the early 1980's Mr. Voinovich, then mayor of Cleveland, opposed Ronald Reagan's big tax cuts. Mr. Reagan pointedly did not invite Mr. Voinovich to his second inauguration in 1985.

Mr. Voinovich, who supported Mr. Bush's \$1.350 billion tax cut in 2001 as a senator, has balked at any tax cuts over the next decade

larger than \$350 billion. He argues that they will add to the already growing budget deficit, which is expected to top \$400 billion this year. In a Senate controlled by Republicans 51-49, Mr. Voinovich's vote is critical to the fate of Mr. Bush's proposed \$726 billion plan.

With characteristic simplicity, Mr. Voinovich says: "I consider myself a deficit hawk and I'm concerned about deficit spending."

The Cleveland Plain Dealer, a leading Ohio newspaper, has praised Mr. Voinovich for his stance calling him a "Republican who understands the dangers of runaway deficits."

The Bush visits underscores the high stakes for both men. Republicans are the dominant party in the Buckeye state. Today they control every statewide office and enjoy solid majorities in the congressional delegation and state legislature.

However, in the past, Democrats fared well, too. It remains to be seen whether Ohio is experiencing a lasting political realignment in favor of Republicans or a more temporary partisan swing. In 2000 Mr. Bush eked out a bare 50 percent victory in the state, to Democrat Al Gore's 46 percent. Bill Clinton carried the state in 1996 and 1992, edging out Republicans Bob Dole and the senior George Bush respectively.

With 20 electoral votes, Ohio is likely to be a crucial

battleground for both parties in the 2004 presidential race.

The risk for Mr. Voinovich is clear: bucking a popular postwar president who comes bearing tax-cut goodies may not be the wisest course. But Mr. Bush is also taking a chance, applying brass-knuckles pressure on a popular lawmaker whose reputation for fiscal responsibility was forged during two successful terms as Ohio governor.

"He's had budgets to manage, and he did it with the hand that was dealt him. And people in Ohio remember he turned around a big city (Cleveland) says Jennifer Duffy, a Senate expert at the Cook Political Report.

Mr. Voinovich faces a potential challenge next year from Jerry Springer, the millionaire talk-show host, who may seek the Democratic nod for his Senate seat. But Republican state officials predict Mr. Voinovich will prevail. He has nearly \$3 million in his re-election coffers and a strong first-term record in the Senate, where he sits on the foreign relations committee and supported the Iraq war.

The latest opinion polls show that only 2 percent of US citizens think high taxes are an important economic problem facing the nation today. Eleven percent cited high unemployment as a top concern.

In the end, that may be more Mr. Bush's problem than Mr. Voinovich's.



ZDA si prizadevajo, da bi Slovenija podpisala dvostranski sporazum v zvezi z mednarodnim kazenskim sodiščem

V ponedeljek je v Slovenijo prispela petčlanska delegacija ameriške vlade in se na pogovorih o Mednarodnem kazenskem sodišču in se srečala s predstavniki zunanjega, notranjega, obrambnega in pravosodnega ministrstva. Delegacijo je vodila Patricia McNerney iz pisarne podsekretarja za nadzor orožja in mednarodno varnost. Povedala je, da je bil to prvi obisk te vrste in da je bil namen izmenjavo mnenj. Dejala je, da upa na nadaljevanje dialoga glede omenjenega sodišča, ki ga ZDA odklanjajo in je Slovenija bila ena od pobudnic zanj.

ZDA želijo podpisati dvostranske sporazume z drugimi državami (velik je npr. ameriški pristisk s tem vzvezi na Hrvaško), v vsakem sporazumu bi bila ključna točka ta, da kljub pravilom sodišča, omenjena država podpisnica zavezuje se, da ne bo izročila ameriških državljanov temu sodišču. Slovenija se upira podpisu sporazuma in meni, da čaka na odločilno stališče Evropske unije, tu je pa jasno, da bo EU sodišče (znano s kraticami ICC) podprla.

Dvostranski sporazum o neizročanju ameriških državljanov so ZDA doslej podpisale oz. sklenile z 38 državami, v naslednjih tednih, je menila McNerneyjeva, naj bi se to število povečalo na 45 do 50 držav. Dodala je, da upa, da bo Slovenija ena teh, a po vsej verjetnosti do tega ne bo prišlo. Ameriška stran je poudarila, da se za to zadevo zelo zanima ameriški kongres in namignila vsaj posredno, da bi nedopis lahko imel posledice, predvsem v finančnem oziru. Kongres je že odobril zakon, ki bi to omogočil, je pa za izjeme določil države, ki so članice mdr. NATA, kar Slovenija v manj kot letu dni tudi bo.

V Bruslju mesta za 134 Slovencev

Iz dvomilijonske Slovenije (2,7 odstotka prebivalstva EU, 4 glasovi, 7 poslancev) bo

v Bruslju lahko zaposlitev dobilo 134 uslužbencev, je zagotovilo podpredsednika Evropske komisije Neila Kinnocka. Veliko bo potrebnih tudi prevajalcev, saj se bo v EU število jezikov (s slovenščino vred) povečalo s sedanjih 11 na 20, to pa omogoča kar 380 kombinacij.

Ukinitvev glasila Naš tednik kot znak dobre volje – Obdržale se bodo le Novice

Današnji Delo poroča, da je Zbor narodnih predstavnikov, najvišji organ Narodnega sveta koroških Slovencev, po dolgi in dokaj kontroverzni razpravi sklenil dokončno ustaviti svoje glasilo Naš tednik, ki je v zadnjih dveh mesecih izhajal vzporedno z novim slovenskim tednikom Novice.

Zadnja številka glasila NSKS bo izšla 13. junija. Podpredsednik NSKS Rudi Vouk je dejal, da je ukinitvev Našega tednika "gesta dobre volje" do Zveze slovenskih organizacij. Novo vodstvo NSKS pa od nje pričakuje urejanje probleme v zvezi z novim skupnim tednikom in bolj usklajeno nastopanje pri reševanju aktualnih vprašanj slovenske manjšine na Koroškem.

Preleti ameriških letal čez Slovenijo v Irak bodo odslej dovoljeni

Po pobudi Sveta za nacionalno varnost in na podlagi prošnje ameriškega veleposlanništva je slovenska vlada podprla sporazum med vladama Slovenije in ZDA (v skladu z resolucijo ZN 1483 od 22. maja) o dovoljenju za prelete in tranzite prek Slovenije (letal in osebja, ki sodelujejo v obnovitvenih operacijah v Iraku, vojakov in policistov). Po poročilu v Delu ni bilo jasno, ali "podpora varnosti v Iraku" dovoljuje in pomeni tudi transport orožja.



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Gorenjskim domobrancem v spomin

EUCLID, O. – Ker se o gorenjskih domobrancih bolj malo piše, sem se namenila, da tudi jaz izpovem, kar mi je še ostalo v spominu na leta groze med drugo svetovno vojno. Mnogi ljudje umirajo in nosijo svoje dragocene spomine s seboj v grob.

Nastanek gorenjskega domobranstva se je začel šele v decembru 1943. Prve postojanke so bile v Lučinah in v Poljanski dolini. Postojanka v Kranju pa je nastala zgodaj spomladi 1944.

Od takrat naprej so rastle postojanke kot gobe po dežju po vsej Gorenjski. Do konca vojne jih je bilo 45. Vseh gorenjskih domobrancev je bilo okoli 3800 mož, večinoma dezertarji, ki so bili prisilno mobilizirani v nemško vojsko.

Med njimi je bil tudi moj brat Ivan Cvajnar. Dolgo časa se je skrival doma na podstrešju, kjer je imel skrit prostor, da ga je bilo težko opaziti. Ni namreč maral služiti v nemški vojski in tudi k partizanom ni hotel. Oče mu je dejal: Ivan, k takim že ne boš hodil. Nimajo nič vere in ne usmiljenja, kradejo in ubijajo dobre ljudi in še mučijo na vse načine.

Tako je bil Ivan med dvema ognjema: pred Nemci in pred partizani. Težko je bilo njegovo življenje v skrivališču za 18 mesecev. Bil je že vsega naveličan.

Med tem časom je že bila ustanovljena postojanka domobrancev v Škofji Loki. Nekega dne so prišli domobranci od tam in se ustavili tudi na našem dvorišču. Ivan jih je opazoval skozi podstrešno okno. Tedaj se je odločil. Zaklical jim je: Fantje, počakajte! Jaz grem z vami.

Tako je postal domobranec, najprvo v Škofji Loki. Ko se je ustanovila postojanka v Goričanah je odšel tja, kjer je bil do našega umika na Koroško.

Na postojanki so bili samo dobri fantje iz vseh krajev. Poveljnik je bil Rudi Habjan, dober in zelo mehkega značaja. Vsi fantje so ga imeli radi.

Tako lepo so nas varovali pred komunisti, da smo lahko vsaj mirno spali, to vse do tistega nesrečnega maja 1945, ko so začele prodirati močne komunistične sile drugih narodnosti proti Sloveniji.

Prišel je ukaz: umakniti se moramo samo za štirinajst dni k Angležem na Koroško. Umaknili pa smo se za vedno. Ivan je na hitro prišel domov, ves v skrbeh za starše in sestre, kaj bo zdaj.

Očeta je prosil: ata, pojdimo vsi skupaj, saj ne bo za dolgo. Če ne, nas bodo vse pobili, samo da se bodo lahko polastili našega imetja in kmetije. Skoraj vsa Preška je bila na komunistični strani.

Očka se je teško odločil zapustiti lepo urejeno posestvo. Mama je bila obupana in ni vedela, kaj bi naredila. Končno nas je le Ivan pregovoril, da smo se vdali v svojo usodo.

Ata je napregel voz, na katerega smo znosili najnujnejše naše stvari; vzeli bi več, pa so nam dejali, da gremo samo za dva tedna. Vsi smo jokali, ko smo zapuščali svoj dom in odšli v negotovost.

Z nami so se umikale vse domobranske postojanke iz Gorenjske. Zadnja se je ustanovila na Jezerskem v aprilu 1945. Med potjo proti Koroški smo srečavali vse polno

ru. Starši in nečaki so nesli hostije in vino.

V pridigi je opozoril na povojne grozote pobojev, ki jim ni najti primerjave v slovenski zgodovini in ki so spremenile narodovo zavest. Rešitev je sprava, je opozoril Rode, ta pa je možna le s pravico do imena in groba pobitih, torej s postavitvijo spomenika, ki bo pobite priznal v slovenskem občestvu, ter "s priznanjem te nezasižane hudobije in jasno obsodbo ideologije, ki je narekovala takšna dejanja".

Podobno je menil Justin Stanovnik z Nove zaveze, ki je sicer govoril tudi o Kučanovem pričanju pred haaškim sodiščem, po njegovem enem najpomembnejših dogodkov po letu 1990, saj je tujina pred sodišče postavila komunistično ideologijo in jo obsodila, kar v Sloveniji še ni bilo narejeno. Tunel je bil natrpan z ljudmi vseh slojev in tudi umikajočih nemških vozil. Po dolgem času smo le prišli na koroško stran. Pred dravskim mostom smo zagledali prve angleške vojake na tanku. Bili so molčeči in nič kaj prijazni.

Na drugi strani mostu so morali vsi oddati orožje. Bilo je velikanske kupe vseh vrst orožja. Ko je moj ata to videl, je dejal: to ne bi nič dobrega, če vojak položi orožje, posebno ker smo videli za cesto partizane, ki so se svobodno sprehajali med Angleži.

Napotili so nas na Vetrinjsko polje, ki je bilo vse v bujni rasti – sedaj pa vse pohojeno in potlačeno od ogromne množice ljudi in vojaštva.

Tu smo ostali nekaj tednov, prepuščeni sami sebi. Ivan je bil vedno v naši družbi vesel, ker je verjel Angležem, da jih bodo prepeljali v Italijo in tam dobili novo orožje za napad proti partizanom.

Proti koncu maja so Angleži začeli z vračanjem domobrancev, pa ne v Italijo, ampak so jih z lažjo in prevaro vrnili v Jugoslavijo krvnikom v roke.

Med prvim transportom je odšel polk vseh gorenjskih domobrancev. Tudi Ivan, ki je bil z nami, je šel z njimi, čeprav bi rad šel skupaj z nami. Pa ga je Vencelj Dolenc pregovoril, da je šel z njimi.

Kakšno razočaranje je nastalo, ko so domobranci videli, da jih peljejo nazaj komunistom v roke. Ker je bil ta odred domobrancev kot prvi, je gotovo dobil več udarcev in pretepanja od partizanov, kot pozneje drugi transporti.

V Sloveniji so jih sprejeli partizani in jih med pretepanjem napotili v Škofjeloški grad, ker so jih natrpali po sobah brez hrane in vode.

Komisija DZ za peticije in teharsko grobišče

Teharsko grobišče za žično ograjo

Vlada naj zagotovi denar za spominski park na Teharjah in določi upravljavca, občina pa naj poskrbi za označitev grobišč

Ljubljana – Komisija DZ za peticije poziva vlado, naj določi rok za ureditev spominskega parka na Teharjah, zagotovi potreben denar in določi njegovega upravljavca, občina Celje pa naj poskrbi za označitev grobišč in prepriča uporabo zemljišča za druge namene. Komisija se je namreč po ogledu prepričala, da je območje ograjeno z žično ograjo, dostop do spomenika je onemogočen, v neposredni bližini pa je golf igrišče.

Zagrajeni del spominskega parka leži tik ob zagrajenem delu odlagalnišča industrijskih odpadkov Cinkarne Celje. Park še vedno ni dograjen in prred njim ni informativnih tabel, ki bi obiskovalce obveščala o času odprtja. Smeti komisija sicer ni opazila, opazili pa so neurejeno začasno parkirišče brez oznak.

Državna podsekretarka za področje investicij na ministrstvu za delo in članica gradbenega odbora za teharsko grobišče Dunja Bubanj je komisiji pojasnila, da je bila ograja okrog spominskega parka postavljena zaradi zaščite zgrajenih spominskih znamenj, ki so bile že večkrat poškodovane. Večkrat so bile poškodovane tudi opozorilne table, tako jih ministrstva za delo vedno znova nadomešča z novimi.

Največji problem spominskega parka je njegovo vzdrževanje in to, da ni določen upravljavec parka (tega bo določil novi zakon o vojnih grobiščih), ki bi skrbel za varnost, urejanje in informiranje.

Odlok o zavarovanju in začasni ureditvi spominskega parka Teharje je bil sprejet leta 1993, v začetku leta 1995 sta bila končana idejni projekt in ureditveni načrt. Zgrajen je bil osrednji spomenik.

Gradnja spominskega parka je leta 1999 zastala, dela pa so se nadaljevala leta 2002 in potekajo tudi letos.

Vladna komisija za reševanje vprašanj prikritih grobišč je prvotni program parka skrčila tako, da bo po programu do letošnjega oktobra zgrajena vhodna kapelica.

Težave pa so s parkirišči. Po prvotnih načrtih naj bi bila parkirišča na zasebnih zemljiščih, ki pa bi jih morala država odkupiti, kar pa bi bila zelo drago. Zato je vladna komisija zaprosila celjsko mestno občino za pojasnilo, ali bi bilo mogoče urediti parkirišča na zdajšnji lokaciji, vendar je dobila odgovor, da to ni možno, je pojasnila državna podsekretarka.

Stare neumnosti začnejo enkrat presedati

Ta pogovor je bil ponatisnjen v argentinskem tedniku Svobodna Slovenija 23. maja, pogovor je pa vodila in pripravila za prvoto objavo v mariborskem Večeru Vanessa Čokl. Ur. AD

Gospod Sirc, v zloglasnem Nagodetovem procesu ste bili obsojeni na smrt, v zaporu ste nato preživeli sedem let in pol. Odšli ste v tujino in se prvič vrnili šele konec osemdesetih. Vmes ste morali zelo zaposlovati tajno politično policijo. Ste videli svoj dosje?

Moj dosje! Me niti posebno ne zanima, ker natančno vem, kaj se mi je zgodilo, in v glavnem tudi, kdo vse je bil v to vmešan.

Najbolj grozno je najbrž to, da so se komunisti na vse načine trudili, da bi vse, ki jih niso pobili, duševno zlomili. To se je najjasneje pokazalo pri tako imenovani "prevzgoji" v zaporih in na družbenokoristnem delu.

Prevzgoja je bila v treh stopnjah: najprej so zahtevali priznanje, da je človek kriv; nato priznanje, da je marksizem najvišja znanost; in končno, kot zadnji znak popolnosti, da je obdelani začel ovajati svoje sozapornike.

V kongregacijo Šolskih sester sv. Frančiška Kristusa Kralja je bila sprejeta 12. avgusta 1926 z imenom sr. M. Agnes. Večne zaobljube je položila 16. avgusta 1932 v samostanski kapeli Mt. Assisi v Lemontu.

TORONTO, Ont. – V vasi Božjakove v belokranjski župniji Metlika se je 6. novembra 1913 kot prvi otrok rodil materi Mariji in očetu Janezu Anton Vukšinič. Oče je kmalu po Antonovem rojstvu umrl. Otroška leta je preživel v materini novi kmečki družini desetih otrok.

Po osnovni šoli v domačem kraju je odšel v Ljubljano in obiskoval drugo realno gimnazijo na Poljanah.

V visoki starosti devetdesetih let se živo spominja svojega vstopa v ljubljansko semenišče oktobra 1934 ob času atentata na jugoslovanskega kralja Aleksandra v francoskem Marseillesu.

Leta 1938 mu je ljubljanski škof dr. Gregorij Rožman podelil mašniško posvečenje. V letu 1939 je dopolnil svoje teološko znanje z univerzitetno diplomom.

Njegovo duhovniško poslanstvo se je začelo v župniji Devica Marija v Polju pri Ljubljani. Poučeval je verouk v Zalogu in postal vodja farnih verskih skupin. Njegovo življenjsko geslo je bilo služiti samo Bogu, izpolnjevati Njegovo voljo, ostati miren in svoboden nad posvetnim hrupom in zmešnjave časov.

Prišla je druga svetovna vojna in tretja internacionala je začela dvigati rdečo zastavo nad slovensko zemljo. Mlademu, za božjo slavo zvestemu duhovniku je grozila smrt:

"Tone, Ti boš prvi visel", ga je opominjal duhovni sobrat in poznejši mučenec Franc Cvar.

V maju 1945 je s svojimi verniki zapustil domovino in kot begunec odšel na Koroško, na Vetrinje, Št. Vid ob Glini, Kellerberg, Spittal ob Dravi so bile njegove in tisočev Slovencev postaje od leta 1945 naprej.

G. Anton je zvedel, da v begunskem taborišču Treffling ni duhovnika. Prostovoljno je odšel tja in vršil duhovniško službo do odhoda v Kanado, v Toronto, k stricu Lojzetu Klemenčiču.

Kot škofijski duhovnik v Torontu je našel svoje življenjsko poslanstvo v župniji sv. Tomaža Akvinskega. Da bi uspešno deloval v župniji, je privatno študiral angleščino. Kmalu je postal župnik v Smithvillu, v hamiltonski škofiji. Njegova zadnja duhovniška postaja je bila župnija sv. Andreja v Wellandu, blizu Niagarskih slapov.

Zdaj g. Anton živi že nekaj let v Domu Lipa, kjer z molitvijo in sv. mašo posvečuje kraj miru in počitka. Nad dolino ob potoku preživlja dneve v prijetnem stanovanju polnem knjig in umetnin prijateljev.

službe se preverja, ali je prosilec kdaj kaj imel z obveščevalnimi službami, raste število nezadovoljnih z eldeesovske "privatizacijo" Slovenije. Boste rekli, da so to zgolj naključja?

Vtisu, da bodo komunistični veljaki skušali dobiti dobro plačana mesta v NATU in EU, se ni mogoče izogniti. Tako na Poljskem kot na Madžarskem in pri nas nenedoma začenjati kazati veliko navdušenje za zahodne, v bistvu protikomunistične zveze. Če bomo imeli srečo, bo šlo za to, da si naberejo nezaslužen zaslužek, utegne se pa zgoditi, da bodo ob neprimernem zaslužku tudi izpodkopavali organizacije, v katere se bodo vrinili.

Naj našim bralcem predstavimo novega misijonarja. Rodil se je leta 1946 v begunskem taborišču Peggez pri Lienzu na vzhodnem Tirolskem. V Argentino je prišel z ladjo General Surgis leta 1948, ko je bil star dve leti. Štirnovi so se po prihodu v Argentino naselili v Mendozii.


Sedemnajstleten je vstopil v kongregacijo Farnih sodelavcev Kristusa Kralja kot redovni brat. Od 38 let redovnega življenja je delal 25 let na severu Argentine, posebno v Reconquisti, Santiago del Estero, Chaco, Corrientes, Entre Rios in po celi provinci Santa Fe, tudi v Buenos Airesu, Mendozii in v San Juanu. Njegovo delo je bilo na prvem mestu v zvezi z duhovniškimi vajami in tedni duhovnosti, zlasti za moške. Po farah je vodil tečaje iz Stare in Nove zaveze. Red ga je poslal v Rim, da se je pri jezuitih specializiral v sredstvih javnega obveščanja. Nato se je izpopolnjeval tri mesece še v Kolumbiji. Sam je delal programe za radio in televizijo, nato pa na tečajih druge učil, kako je treba delati take programe. Afrika je kontinent, na katerem se je začela evangelizacija šele pred 80 leti in potrebuje še veliko apostolskega dela. Cerkev je tukaj živa in kristjani veliko žrtvujejo. Cerkve so ob nedeljah natrpene vernikov, da je po farah 1500 udeležencev pri vsaki sv. maši, to imajo za nekaj normalnega. In so sv. maše po tri ali štiri ure! Znan je rek, da v Švici delajo ure, tukaj pa čas.

Naša kongregacija se je ustanovila tu 1. decembra 2002. Poklicev imamo veliko. Tu bomo začeli 2. februarja z devetimi fanti enoletni postulat, kateremu bosta sledeli dve leti noviciata. Imamo še 20 fantov, ki so zaprosili za vstop, a nimamo več prostora. Pač pa bomo z njimi naredili misijonsko ekipo, ki bo delovala po farah. Zato se Vam toplo priporočam za molitve, da bi ti fantje postali sveti duhovniki odnosno bratje. Vaš misijonar, Matevž Štirn, CPCRC."



Ta novi misijonar je bil pred nekaj leti tu med nami. Stanoval je pri sestri Mari Miklavčič. Hodil je dvakrat na leto med Indijance na mejo med Argentino in Bolivijo, kar je tri do štiri tisoč metrov nadmorske višine. Pomagal je tem revnim ljudem, da je naprosil zdravnike in zobozdravnike, da so šli z njim in reševali življenja. Bog mu daj obilo milosti, da bo začeto delo imelo veliko sadov.

Na Brezjah začetek celoletnega katoliškega shoda

Vse države bodo v tem okviru pripravile različne pobude in prireditve ter mednarodne simpozije z vsebinami, ki so najbolj pereče zanje.

Slovenska škofovska konferenca bo letos poskušala pospešiti ureditev vprašanja verouka v šolah, medtem ko bo na primer na Poljskem potekal simpozij o razvijanju kmetijstva, na Madžarskem pa o krščanskih vrednotah v EU.
