PROTEST AGAINST AGGRESSION IN CROATIA

Slovenes experts, who are in charge of care and preservation of our cultural and natural heritage horrified and speechless witness the irrational raging of the Yugoslav army, which has been together with Serbian terroristic groups brutally destroying cultural monuments on the whole territory of Croatia.
