MUSSOLINIJEVA ABESINSKA AVANTURA

John W. Love, ki piše gospodarske članke za dnevnik "Press," je napisal članek, v katerem trezno razmotriva dučevo afriško avanturo z vidika ekonomskih možnosti in čijega osnovne misli navajamo spodaj.

Zagovorniki Mussolinijeve afriške avanture menijo, da je bila tudi Evropa l. 1914 prepričana, da ni bila ekonomsko zmožna šestmesečne vojne, toda vojna je vseeno trajala cela štiri leta. Pri tem pa pozablajo, da je vojna v Afriki nekaj drugega kot vojna na domačih mejah, kajti dočim se obrambno vojno na domačih mejah lahko financira iz požrtvovalnosti ljudstva, pa je treba za vojno v oddaljenih pokrajinah kot je Afrika inozemskega kredita ali zlata ali izvoza, kajti brez tega ni mogoče nakupovati v inozemstvu raznih potrebščin, ki so v takem slučaju neobhodna potreba.

In če neka država ne more dobiti inozemskih posojil, nima dovolj zlata in njena izvozna bilanca ni aktivna, so tako vojaška podvzeta v oddaljenih pokrajinah izredno tvegana. Razlika je tudi v transportaciji; če bi Italija vodila obrambno vojno na domačih mejah, bi lahko porabila svojo hidroelektrično silo, ki ji je ne manjka, za obratovanje vojaških transportnih vlakov, dočim za transportacijo čet v Afriko potrebuje premog iz rudnikov v Welshu ali vsaj ogrski premog. Toda Italija je že zaostala s plačili Angliji in slabim plačnikom nihče rad ne prodaja ničesar; poleg tega pa tudi že obstoji pomanjkanje welshega premoga.

Način, ki se ga je poslužil Mussolini, da je prišel do denarnih sredstev, ki jih potrebuje za nakupe v inozemstvu tudi ni razveseljav za Italijo; odredil je namreč, da mu morajo Italijani izročiti vse inozemske denarne terjatve, potem pa je šel ter odvezal Italijansko banko dolžnosti imeti na razpolago za papirnati denar določeno zlato kritje. Del italijanske zlate zaloge bo šel nedvomno za nakup vojnih potrebščin v inozemstvu, kajti Mussolini se očitno ne zanaša na posojila iz inozemstva. To so koraki, ki bi jih utegnili podvzeti kaka vojujoča se država v skrajni stiski, ko so vsa druga sredstva izčrpana, ne pa v začetku vojnih priprav. Italija, ki vojne niti še začela ni, tako že kaže simptome, ki so značilni za vsako vojujočo se državo, ki se nahaja že pred porazom.

Da bi se Mussoliniju zasedba Abesinije izplačala, bi mu morala ta dežela takoj začeti prinašati znatne dohodke. Toda petrolej je menda edino blago, ki bi ga Italija lahko začela takoj pridobivati v Abesiniji, če se namreč nahajajo v deželi velika oljna ležišča, kar je zaenkrat še zgolj domneva. Drugače pa Abesinici nimajo ničesar, kar bi imelo kako vrednost zunaj njihovih meja. In za eksploatacijo abesinskih petrolejskih polj bi zopet Mussolini potreboval tuja posojila, ki bodo po drugi strani požrla ves profit (če ga bo kaj). itd.

V luči te analize izgleda Mussolinijeve afriške avanture vse prej kot pametno. (Dalje v 6. koloni.)

Moč materine ljubezni

Romunsko vojaško sodišče v Kišinevu je sodilo staro ženo. Obtoženka je bila Feodozija Kaklanova. Njena zgodba je tale:

Feodozija je imela dva sinova, ki sta leta 1918 med rusko revolucijo iz Rusije pobegnili v Romunijo. Odkar sta sinova zbežala čez mejo, stara Kaklanova ni več dobila glasu o njih. Minila so leta, stara žena je še vedno upala, da bo nekoč zopet videla svoja sinova, vendar se je je vedno bolj lotevala žalostna misel, da sinova morda nista več živa. Nepričakovano pa je lansko poletje zgolj slučajno slišala pripovedovati, da je iz Romunije prišel neki Rus, ki trdi, da sta oba Kaklanova v Rcmuniji živa in zdrava ter celo premožna človeka. Tisti romunski Rus je celo trdil, da sta oba sinova že večkrat poskušala svoji materi pisati, vendar sta končno uvidela, da se njuna pisma v Rusiji izgublajo in da jih mati ne dobi. V Rusijo se pa seveda nista upala več vrniti, ker bi v tem slučaju tudi ne bila videla svoje matere.

Ko je stara Feodozija Kaklanova to izvedela, jo je prišlo tako strašno hrepenenje po sinovih, da je sklenila iti ju obiskat. Pomisliti pa je treba, da je uboga starica l. 1934 bila stara že 80 let. Kljub temu se je odločila in 11. avgusta 1934 šla na pot. Denarja seveda ni imela, da bi se bila mogla voziti z železnico. Zato je morala vso ogromno pot prehoditi peš in ta pot ni bila kratka, ampak je med njo in njenimi sinovi zivala razdalja 1500 km. Po neskončnih ruskih podeželskih cestah je starica tavalala proti jugu, vedno naprej, vedno naprej, vedno proti jugu. Včasih je že omahovala, toda njena ljubezen do sinov ji je dala novega poguma in zopet je šla in šla. Prehranjevala se je med potjo z beračenjem. Prenočevala je pri kmetih, katerim se je junaška starica in mati smilila, in so jo s spoštovanjem sprejemali.

Tako je romala več mesecev. Po napornem in strašnem maršu je starica končno prišla do

bregov reke Dnjestra, ki meji rusko zemljo od Romunije. Tu je bila največja težava in tudi največja nevarnost za njeno življenje. Na ruski strani Dnjestra pazljivo stražijo rdeči vojaki, na romunski strani pa romunski. Gorje mu, kogar zalotijo eni ali drugi. Zapisan je smrti!

Medtem je napočila zima. Reka je zamrznila in obmejne straže so svojo čuječnost še podvojile. Ruske straže so dale bolj povelje, da morajo brezpogojno ustreliti vsakogar, kdor bi hotel prestopiti mejo v Romunijo brez posebnega vladnega dovoljenja. Vsako zimo neštivilna trupla takih beguncev pokrivajo Dnjestrov led. Uboga starica, kaj te čaka!

In vendar se je stari Kaklanovi posrečilo, da se je izmuznila skozi vrste budnih sovjetskih stražnikov, stopila je na Dnjestrov led in po njem srečno prišla na romunsko stran. Toda tukaj so jo pograbil romunski orožniki. To je bilo koncem februarja.

In od februarja dalje je 80 letna Feodozija Kaklanova, vsa polna hrepenenja po svojih sinovih, pretrpela tedne in mesece v romunskih ječah. Končno je prišla pred vojaško sodišče v Kišinevu, katero jo je sodilo. In 9 mesecev potem, ko je nastopila svojo težavno pot do svojih sinov, jo je romunsko sodišče oprostilo. In njena sinova sta svojo plemenito in ljubečo mater vsa srečna objela.

60-letnica smrti

Velter, ostale važne vloge pa igralci velikega gledališča Dona Jose B. Jevlahov in Ecamilla P. Burlak. Na oder so svetili velikanski žarometi. Prireditvi je prisostvovalo 20,000 gledalcev.

palačo. Willereal je tudi zanikal, da bi bila država pod obsednim stanjem, rekel pa je, da je do bil poročila, da je bilo več občinskih svetov prisiljenih k resignaciji. "Gotov sem si, da bom lahko obvladal situacijo", je dejal Villareal spričo naraščajočega nezadovoljstva med agrarnim prebivalstvom proti njegovemu režimu.

Vzlic njegovim izjavam pa se smatra, da se Villareal ne bo mogel dolgo vzdržati. Če ga ne bo moglo pomesti iz urada uporno gibanje agrarcev, ga bo bržkone vrgla ven kongresna komisija, kar je verjetno zlasti spričo vesti, da podpira gibanje za njegovo odstranitev iz urada tudi Emilio Portes Gil, predsednik Narodne revolucionarne stranke in bivši guvernator države Tamaulipas.

Poročila iz glavnega mesta države Tabasco (Ciudad Victoria) vedo povedati, da je število upornih agrarcev naraslo na 20,000 in da je bilo 24 občinskih odborov v raznih krajih države prisiljenih k resignaciji. V Matamarosu je 2000 kmetov za-

Kmalu nato, ko so bile poslana v inozemstvo prve vesti o nemirih v državah Tabasco in Tamaulipas, je bila vzpostavljena cenzura, ki pa je trajala samo eno uro, nakar je bila odpravljena.

Zlata dežela Ofir

Pred časom smo poročali o ekskurziji, ki jo je vodil znani francoski potopisec grof Byron de Prorok v Egipt, iz katere so egiptski faraoni Salomon dobivali svoje neizmerne bogastve. Ze od vsega početka je bil grof proroški, da je to deželo iskati v tem koncu sveta pa bo izlivu Indu, kakor so menili raziskovalci. O uspehih njegove potovanja sedaj podrobneje vesti v javnosti.

Potem, ko si je Prorok s predizjavami od abesinske vlade izposlovoljuje, se je odpravil s svojimi 60 mulami in spremstvom 20 črnih želo sultana Gogolija, enega izmed skilih vazalov, ki se ga boje kot hrvražnika Italijanov in Angležev. Krvavana stopala po robu silovite so zagledali na dnu na stotine ljudi, ki li po izsušeni strugi "Zlate reke" zlatu, najmanj kakšnih 300 mož, trok. Raziskovalci so se pripravljali te ljudi pri njihovem opravlju fotografirati med tem so jih skušali pazniki mečih, marcialnih postav, obkrožiti, never pa je bil brezuspešen, ker so roženi s starimi kresalniki, pa so imeli nabojev, ekspedicijska pa je bila opremljena z najmodernejšim streljem. Tako ni paznikom preostalo ničga, nego da pošljejo sle k črnemu pomoč, raziskovalci pa so med tem tro preiskali sotesko od izvira reke.

Tu so v resnici odkrili jame, sile sledove staroegiptskih napisov, lo vdolbenih risb. Ponoči so nadalje proti Valegi, kjer jih je čakala straža določil abesinski cesar karavani to. Tu so odkrili tudi visoke kamele v podobi piramid, grobove staroegiptskih oblastnikov, ki so nekoč gospodovali sužnje, ki so zanje kopali zlato. Kamačini v praznovornem strahu izogrobišče, je bilo Proroku ponoči bližati se jim in jih preiskati. V neke takšne grobnice je odkril človeški, zlate predmete in dragulje. Ostro dišala po tisti neznanim snovi, so Egipteni balzamirali trupla, in odkrili tudi popohoma ohranjeno. Te najdbe so najboljši dokaz, da so ni nekoč tod gospodovali in so jim nja in pokolenja sužnje pridobivali prav tako kakor delajo to danes abesinske mogočnike. Prorokove najkakov potrjujejo njegovo teorijo, ljična dežela Ofir ni mogla biti nikogje nego tukaj.

Official Softball Rules Governing SSPZ National Athletic Meet

Rule 13 Called Games If the umpire calls a game at any time after four innings have been completed, the score shall be that of the last equal innings played, except that if the side second at bat shall have scored in an unequal number of innings, or before the completion of the unfinished inning, at least one run more than the side at bat, the score of the game shall be the total number of runs each team has made.

No exception to this rule. If the score at the end of the first half of the fourth inning, or any subsequent first half of an inning is 1 to 0 in favor of the team second at bat, the latter wins.

Rule 14 Ball Not in Play In case of an illegally batted ball, foul hit ball not legally caught, dead ball, interference with the fielder or batsman, or a fair hit striking a base-runner or umpire before touching a fielder, the ball shall not be considered in play until it be held by the pitcher standing in his position, and the umpire shall have called "Play."

Note each of these specifications. On umpire had ruled that a base-runner could advance when another runner had been retired for interference. The first runner should have been held at the base which he occupied until the ball had been thrown to the pitcher and the umpire had given the word to resume play. The ball goes out of play when the interference takes the place and annuls all that had taken place since the

play began. The umpire should announce "Play" as if he were announcing it at the beginning of a game.

Rule 15 Strikes A Strike is recorded against a batter when:

Section 1. A pitched ball is struck at by him without it touching his bat.

Sec. 2. He hits a foul not caught on the fly, unless two strikes have been previously called.

Sec. 3. A legally delivered ball passes over the plate, between the batter's shoulders and knees, and is not struck at.

Sec. 4. A pitched ball at which the batsman strikes but misses, and which touches any part of his person. Baserunner cannot advance.

Sec. 5. A foul tip is a strike except on the third strike. A third foul tip is also to be considered a strike if caught.

Note — A foul tip on the third strike that is caught by the catcher is a strike.

Rule 16 Illegally Batted Ball An Illegally Batted Ball is a ball batted by the batsman when either or both of his feet are upon the ground outside of the lines of the batsman's position. Penalty—The batter is out.

Note—No base-runner can advance when batsman is called out on an illegally batted ball, and no base-runner can be doubled out on this play. Base-runners must be sent back to the base originally held by them.

PHYSICAL CONDITION

In a study covering an analysis of the physical examinations on one hundred thousand adult males in this country it was found that physically the average business man is superior to the average professional man, the agricultural worker and the skilled worker.

All physical impairments were found to increase with age. This was especially true of heart disease, which causes more deaths than any other disease in the United States. In the group of men aged twenty there was an incidence of three per cent having disease. At the age of fifty-five and over the percentage was increased to eight per cent.

Twenty per cent of the men had defective vision. In men over fifty, fifty per cent had defective vision. Colds were frequent in the twenty year group; twenty per cent reported frequent colds, while only twelve per cent reported colds

who were in the fifty year group.

The most common defects among the men of the professional class are defective vision, chronic skin troubles and mastoiditis. In the agricultural group the common defects are carious teeth, retarded pulse rate, gastric disturbances, hernia and kidney diseases. Defects were most numerous among the men of skilled trades. They include defective eyes and teeth, frequent colds, heart disease, constipation, insomnia and varicose veins. No specific defect was observed as outstanding in the group of business men.

The examinations showed a close relation between the habitual use of laxatives and con-

stipation. Twenty per cent of the twenty year group used cathartics constantly and thirty per cent had chronic constipation.

This study proves without doubt that there is a constant change in our physical makeup. Just as the common causes of death have changed in the past; thirty years ago the first three causes of death were tuberculosis, pneumonia and heart disease, the present leading causes of death being heart disease, cancer and kidney disease; so has the physical condition of individuals changed.

Good physical condition and the prevention of disease can be helped most by annual complete physical examinations properly done by competent physicians, who will, if given the opportunity, find early signs of beginning disease. This will be the greatest help to keeping us physically fit thereby prolonging life.
