TRAHOTE PO ODNJI V NEW ORKU RASTEJO

izadete pokrajine v borbi proti preteči bolezenski epidemiji. Nalivi se nadaljujejo. Število mrtvih narastlo že na 49 oseb.

ITHACA, N. Y., 10. julija.— Vi deževni nalivi preko južne New Yorka in severne Pensylvanije so danes pokrili vsemi toki vode v od povodnijadet kraje, kjer je od leta zvečer že 49 ljudi izgubili življenje. Povodenje je priseljeno pokrajine s površino 20 kvadratnih milj. Vremenski uradi nepovedujo za danes konec nezaslišata deževja, kar pa bo morda pozno, da bi se rešilo več vodat vasi in veliko pokrajo, kjer se je 50,000 mož bo proti času, da spravijo nam ogrožano prebivalstvo in rešijo jezove in nasipe. Vsi od povodnje udarjeni so ogroženi od pojava epizode, ki utegnejo biti grozovise kot povodenje sama. Naše ljudi v mestih in vaseh, terih vodovodni sistemi so ozeni s kanalskimi dotoki in pljeno živilo, mora piti to ali pa nič.

Med tem ko so vode začele lati ter se je smer povodnji nala proti Pennsylvaniji, zatoči promet in povzročajočo škodo, pa reki Cochoton Canisteo še vedno narašča in istotako jezeri Cayuga in Luka. Delavci so mrzljeno delu, da ojačajo oslabljene n Natta nasip, južno od Ithaca, ki drži nazaj na milijone vode. Utrganje oblaka blizu Arkporta je poslalo praveni stebri po dolini proti nem, kjer je škoda narastla preko \$1,000,000.

Družbeni zdravstveni komisar Parran je danes potomu nujno pozival prebivalce begunce pred poplavou, da skuhajo sleherno kapljivo pitve, da se zavarujejo pred činsko boleznjijo. Danes bo oblasti začele s cepljenjem očnih oseb proti tej nevarni iznini.

Povodenje v severni Pensylvaniji je danes začela padati, je povzročila štiri smrti, leg 45 žrtv v državi New York. Povodenje je dosegla tudi Maryland, kjer stoji ponad cestami pet čevljev voda.

28 davčnih načrtov pred kongresom

WASHINGTON, 9. julija. — Pred kongresnim odsekom, ki ima sestaviti zakonski načrt za "večjo razdelitev bogastva," kakor se je izrazil predsednik, se nahaja 28 različnih načrtov za povisjanje davkov na dohode. Medtem ko je Roosevelt pravtvo izjavil, da naj bi se načilo višji davki le na letne milijon-dolarske dohodke in le na izredno visoke zapuščine in pa na darila, katera dajejo bogatini svojcem v življenju, da se izognejo davkom na njihove zapuščine, pa je sedaj jasno, da bo kongres posegel precej nižje. Davek se bo najbrže zvišalo že na letne odhoke v znesku \$100,000, dočim se utegne podvreti višjim davkom že zapuščine pri \$10,000.

Številni načrti, ki jih ima kongresni odsek pred seboj, imajo služiti le za statistično pomoč. Sestavili so jih odsekovi izvedenci, nakar so bili predloženi zakladnici za preračunjanje glede dohodkov, ki jih bi dobila vlada na podlagi posameznih načrtov, ter nato vrnjeni odsek s potrebnimi podatki. Sicer ni mogoče reči, kakšen davčni načrt se bo končno ustavilo, še manj pa, kakšne nove davke na dohodke, darila in zapuščine bo kongres končno potrdil, vendar pa je iz vseh priprav razvidno, da kar se tiči normalnih ali nizkih dohodkov, bodo ostali to pot nedotaknjeni do sekire davčnega eksekutorja.



Roosevelt v borbi s kongresom

Je povedal kongresnim voditeljem, da morajo sprejeti nove davke na bogatstvo ter druge nove zakone, predno bo dovolil ododenje.

WASHINGTON, 10. julija. — Predsednik Roosevelt je sinoči povedal kongresnim voditeljem, da ne bo pustil, da bi šel kongres na počitnice, dokler ne sprejme zakona za obdavčenje bogastva in drugih new-dealerskih predlogov, med katerimi je tudi zakonski načrt, da se one-mogoči tožbe za izplačilo vladnih obligacij v ziatu.

Med tem pa revolta v poslanski zbornicici proti administracijski raste. Kako se bo končala borba radi predloga za odpravo nepotrebnih super-korporacij na polju javnih učilitet, je v dnu. Na tej točki je senat podprt Roosevelta z enim glasom večine, dočim je nižja zbornica z veliko večino revoltirala. Sedaj se predloga nahaja pred konferenčnim odsekom običajnega zbornika. Obe strani sta enako odločeni, da ne bosta odnehalni.

Predsednik poslanske zbornice Byrns je po odhodu iz Belihihi rekel: "Predsednik nam je povedal, da želi, da zakonodajno delo zaključimo do 15. avgusta, ako mogoče, gotovo pa ne kasneje kot do Delavskega praznika. Upam, da bomo z delom končali do 20. avgusta."

Drugi zakonski načrti, ki spadajo na Rooseveltovo listo "obvezne zakonodajne," so: amendenje zakona za razvoj električnih central v Tennessee Valley (TVA); zakon za zvezno kontrolo nad trgovino z žganjem, ki je propadla z odpravo NRA; Guffey predlog za reguliranje industrije mehkega premoga; regulacija transporta in novi zakonik za reguliranje bank.

Dolgo zasedanje in vročina, ki je v Washingtonu zelo huda, je utrudila člane kongrese, ki bi radi šli čim prej domov. Toda vztrajali bodo, dokler ne bo delo izvršeni, je rekel Byrns.

"KOLUMBOVI VITEZI" PRI ROOSEVELTU

WASHINGTON, 9. julija. — Predsednik Roosevelt je danes sprejel in uljudno poslušal delegacijo "Kolumbovih vitezov," ki so urgirali, da Zed. države vložijo protest pri mehikanski vladni, ker baje zavira katoliško bogoslužje. Urgirala je tudi sprejem Borahove resolucije za preiskavo verskih razmer v Mehiki, toda je molčala glede poslanika Danielsa, ki je pod ostro kritiko ameriških katolikov, češ, da daje potuho mehikanskim brezvercem. Roosevelt ni delegaciji dal nobene definitivne obljube.

Vojaška alianca s Francijo utrdila laško pozicijo za vojno v Abesiniji. Se ne boji, da bo Hitler poskusil aneksijo Avstrije.

MUSSOLINI PRIPRAVLJEN "DATI" KOROŠKO JUGOSLAVI?

LONDON, 9. julija. — Premier Mussolini se ne boji, da bi katera sila ali skupina velesil mogla preprečiti njegov načrt, za podprtanjem Abesinije. Ko se je angleški diplomat Anthony Eden mudil v Rimu, ga je skušal pregoriti, da naj bo oprezen v Afriki, češ, da ako Italija poslje veliko armado v Abesinijo, utegne Hitler porabititi to priliko za prikljopitev Avstrije. Mussolini mu je na to ponosno odgovoril, da italijanska armada vsled pošiljatve ekspedicjske sile v Afriko ni oslabljena, temveč pa je veliko armado v Abesinijo, utegne Hitler porabititi to priliko za prikljopitev Avstrije.

Ker je Jugoslavija prenehala biti sovražnica Italije, bi bila očvidno deležna gotovega deleža, kadar bi se delilo Avstrijo.

Ce bi Jugoslavija dobila Koroško, bi to pomenilo, da bi ločila Italijo od Nemčije ter da bi ostal le primerljivo majhen kos italijansko - nemške meje, čigar protekcijo bi bila odvisna od italijanske armade.

Poleg tega ima Mussolini proti Hitlerju še eno karto. Lahko bi podprt akcijo za povratek Habsburžanov na avstrijski prestol, kar bi začaščal usoden udarec Hitlerjevih ambicij za aneksijo Avstrije.

Kar se tiče britske akcije, niso bili Italijani v resnicu nikoli v skrbih. Posebno se niso nikoli bili, da bi Anglija zaprla Sueski prekop, kajti uporaba takega noža, ki reže na obe strani, bi bila usodna za britske morske zvezze z Indijo in Vzhodom.

Preko vsega tega pa je Mussolini tudi trdno overjen, da bi velenile nikoli ne bile v stanu učinkovito nastopiti proti Italiji, še manj pa da bi bile sposobne priti do kakega soglasnega zaključka na posvetovanjih v Ženevi.
