Roosevelt bo našel novo pot za ameriške ladje v Sredozemlje

DELA TUDI NAČRTE, DA SE POŠLJE POMOČ JUGOSLAVIJI

Washington, 4. apr. — Predsednik Roosevelt je danes govoril o načrtu, po katerem bodo Zed. države prevzele nalogo prepejati vojni material in druge potrebščine v Sredozemlje in na Balkan. Roosevelt ima v mislih pristanišče Aden ob Rdečem morju, do kamor bi ameriške ladje vozile blago. Toda to se ne more izvršiti poprej, dokler angleška armada ne stre italijanskega imperija v vzhodni Afriki. Dokler tam traja vojna, je kraj smatran kot nevarno zono in v takoj ameriške ladje ne smejo. Kakor hitro bo pa vojna tukaj končana, bodo smele ameriške ladje voziti tje, ne da bi s tem kršile nevtralnost Zed. drž.

Henry Ford je ustavil delo v vseh svojih 34 tovarnah po Zedinjenih državah

Detroit, Mich., 4. apr.—Praktično nobeno kolo se ne vrti v ogromnem Fordovem avtomehanizmu po Ameriki. Vodstvo je ukazalo nocoj zapreti vse tovarne. Vzrok je, ker je unija CIO začela s stavko v največji Fordovi tovarni, kjer je zaposlenih 86.000 delavcev. Stavka traja že tri dni. Ker je to nekaka glavna tovarna, ki zalaga druge Fordove podružnice z raznimi deli, so bile vsled stavke tudi druge prizadete, nakar je Ford ukazal zapreti vseh svojih 34 tovarnen. Nocoj ni bilo še nobenega izgleda, da bo prišlo do poravnave.

WPA delavec je podedoval eno tretjino \$110,000

George Hartman, star 60 let, ki je bil zaposlen zadnja tri leta kot paznik pri WPA, je podedoval po svojem sorodniku v Oakland, Cal. eno tretjino od \$110,000, to je kakih \$35,000. Hartman pravi, da nista s ženo napravila še nobenih načrtov, kaj bosta s tem denarjem.

USODNA URA SE NAGLO PRIBLIŽUJE.

Belgrad, 5. aprila. — Jugoslovanska vlada je ukazala železniškim družbam, da dajo vse železniške proge na razpolago armadi. Dalje je izdala ukaz, da se morajo zgledati pod orožje vsi moški, ki morejo nositi puško, ne glede na to, če so imeli prej kako vojaško treningo. Potniki, ki prihajajo iz Madžarske pripovedujejo, da hite nemške motorizirane divizije preko Madžarske na jugoslovansko mejo. Tanki, truki, lahko topništvo in stotine motornih koles z strojnici so paradiralo skozi Budimpešto in hitelo proti Sigetu na jugoslovansko mejo.

Splošno se govori, da je ura odločitve blizu. Seja vladnega kabineta je trajala štiri ure in pol, do 2:30 danes zjutraj (v soboto). Nekateri ministri niti po seji niso hoteli zapustiti uradov, ampak so ostali tam in čakali pri telefonu novic. Kralj je bil odredil splošno mobilizacijo že 1. aprila, toda uradno je bila razglášena šele danes. Sod se, da je pod orožjem že 1,500,000 mož. Po cestah ni videti zdaj drugih civilistov kot pohabljene, otroke in starčke, ali pa ženski spol, drugo je vse v uniformi.

Balkanski blok v delu

Atene, 4. apr.—Iz najboljših zanesljivih virov se poroča, da bodo Anglija, Jugoslavija, Turčija in Grčija postavile skupno fronto proti osišču, ako bo napadena Jugoslavija. V diplomatskih krogih se z vso gotovostjo zadržuje, da bo Hitler udaril na Jugoslavijo v prihodnjih 48 urah in sicer iz Avstrije, Madžarske, Romunske in Bolgarije obenem. Generalni štabi Grške, Anglije, Jugoslavije in Turčije so v neprestanih dogovorih. Vse podrobnosti glede tega skupnega nastopa so bile že izgotovljene.

NATIONAL DEFENSE

We stumble along, weak and weary. Our legs are bowed and our eyes are bleary. Our tongues are thick, they drag on the floor.

By Private Will Gilha D Co. 7th Bat. Medical Dept., Replacement Center, Petersburg, Camp Lee, Va.

"At the present time we have finished one week of drilling. Looking over the results I would say we made fair progress. It is interesting. Drill formation is a matter of keeping time in step with a little bit of concentration.

"No matter who it is they all have to take 13 weeks basic military training. After these 13 weeks, some will be transferred to different branches of service, while some will be stationed here permanently.

"Last night being Saturday, Joe Bober, Joe Garvas, and I decided to go to Petersburg. While walking around town, we saw St. Joseph's Catholic Church, a red structure that has been here before the Civil War; also saw St. Paul's Episcopal Church, where General Lee worshipped every Sunday.

"We are through at 11:15 every morning. One day the sergeant asked us who had the time. One of the boys yelled out it was 11:07. The sergeant then looked around asking: 'Has anybody got 11:15?'"

"We have to get up a quarter to six every morning but Sunday when we get up at seven. In the evening the limit is 9:30 every day but Saturday which is eleven p.m."
