Begunci pravijo, da je v mestu pet bataljonov Asturcev, toda ni jih videti ne slišati. Nohenih znakov ni videti, da bi bilo mesto poškodovano, nenenih razvalin in nohenih pogorišč. He faithfully trekked from his E. 61 street home to the St. Clair Bath House where he quietly worked out in the gymnasium. He was known as Joey Speigal's brother who was quite a boxer in the professional welterweight ranks. Nobody seemed to bother to even ask the newcomer for his first name. This kid was like hundreds of others — just a dream fighter inspired mostly through his brother Joe's good showing. He fought a couple amateur bouts and then in the early winter his brother Joe said "Tom, we're going to have a change of scenery." And accordingly they were on their way to Miami, Florida.

Tom Merits Recognition
When they arrived in Florida they made the rounds with various fight promoters. Followed a few matches and before long Tom began to click with the

crowd—in fact he over-shadowed his brother in popularity. Then began his meteoric rise to fistic prominence which brought him into the same arena with Baby Miller Indian boxer of high repute whom he surprisingly repulsed.

Rated 7th Best in World
