

Predsednika Argentine bo volil volivni zbor

Pri splošnih predsedniških volitvah ni noben kandidat dobil absolutne večine, končna odločitev bo padla v zboru volivnih mož 31. julija.

BUENOS AIRES, Arg. — Volivni v Argentini niso prinesle predsednika, pa so vendarle pomembne, prvič zato, da so se sploh v redu izvedle, kar je bilo vedno zelo dvomljivo, in drugič zato, ker je bivši diktator Peron izgubil na moči in vplivu na volivce.

Peroniste poslušalo le 16% volivcev

Peronisti, ki so oddajali prazne glasovnice iz protesta, so nabrali samo 16% glasov, dočim so jih napovedovali preko 35%. Zadnjič so jih imeli 33%. Izkazalo se je zopet, da je Peron zapustil v Argentini solidno politično organizacijo kot dediščino.

Radikalni imajo večino, pa so razklani v dve skupini

Radikalni, ki so izšli kot najmočnejša skupina in jim manjka le 70 glasov, da bi izvolili predsednika, bi bili gospodujoča stranka bodočnosti, če bi ne bili razklani v dve krili, ki se bijeta med seboj.

Indija dobi radio oddajnik

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Informacijska agencija Združenih držav bo poklonila Indiji radijsko oddajno postajo vredno dva milijona dolarjev, potem ko bo ta oddajala pet let prosto "Glas Amerike" v južni in jugovzhodno Azijo.

Izredno močna radio postaja bo zgrajena v Kalkuti, v vzhodnem delu Indije.

Papež Janez XXIII. bil v skrbeh za Južno Ameriko na smrtni postelji

VATIKAN. — V govoru pred pontificijsko komisijo za Južno Ameriko je papež Pavel VI. povedal, da je pokojni papež Janez XXIII. še na smrtni postelji in še potem, ko je prejel sv. zakramente za umirajoče, ponovno govoril o nujnosti misijonskega in obnovitvenega dela v Južni Ameriki.

Politični boj v Alžiriji se začenja znova

ALŽIR, Alž. — Predsednik države Ben Bella je razpisal volitve v parlament za konec septembra. Volilne priprave so se začele tako, da obetajo malo dobrega in solidnega.

Prvi, ki je nastopil proti temu početju, je bivši Ben Bellov tovariš in sobojevnik za neodvisnost Hocine Ait Ahmed. Ta je izjavil, da bo organiziral opozicijo in vodil borbo proti Ben Belli, če ta ne bo spoštoval demokratskih metod in zaslug svojih tovarišev.

Peru ubira novo pot

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Novoizvoljeni predsednik republike Peru Fernando Belaunde bo sicer prevzel položaj 28. julija, pa se tu pri sejah Vseameriške zveze že čuti vpliv njegove nove zunanje politike.

Peru se je torej pridružil Braziliji, ki je doslej sama nastopala za to politiko in s tem koristila Castru na Kubi, oziroma ovirala nastopanje zveze proti njegovemu režimu.

V ponedeljek se začno v Moskvi razgovori o končanju preskusov

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Pomemben državni tajnik za politične zadeve, znana "stara sablja" v naši diplomaciji, bivši guverner A. Harriman, je odpotoval v Moskvo k pogajanju o pogodbi, ki naj bi določila, v kakih okoliščinah naj bi se končalo preskušanje atomskega orožja, kaj bi se moglo napraviti skupnega, da bi proizvajanje atomskega orožja ne bilo nevarno za življenje ljudi in vsa druga varnostna vprašanja, ki so s tem v zvezi.

Misija A. Harrimana je napovedal sam predsednik Kennedy že 19. junija v govoru na American University v Washingtonu, ko je govoril o neposrednih zunanje-političnih akcijah svoje vlade.

Tedaj je predsednik rekel, da je treba, da vse vlade v dobrem namenu pregledajo stanje napetosti in mrzle vojne in skušajo spremeniti svoje dose-danje ravnanje v duhu večje mednarodne obzirnosti in iskrenega truda za splošno varnost. To naj bi napravile vlade na obeh straneh.

POSKUS PORAVNAVE V MOSKVI ŽE PRI KRAJU?

Danes so stopili razgovori med Rusi in Kitajci v Moskvi v drugi teden, ne da bi se pokazali kakršni znaki, da je poravnava med obema velikoma komunističnega sveta sploh še možna.

MOSKVA, ZSSR. — Ruski in kitajski delegaciji sta včeraj počivali in verjetno iskali nova "navodila", ki naj razgovore rešijo pred popolnim neuspehom vsaj v obeh javnosti, če že dejansko ne bi bilo mogoče doseči nobene poravnave med Komunističnima partijama Sovjetije in Kitajske.

V Moskvi je bilo objavljeno, da bo s 1. septembrom gotova neposredna zveza med Kriemljem in Belo hišo, ki naj onemogoči sprožitve atomske vojne po naključju.

Indonezijska KP naj posreduje

Ko se razgovori v Moskvi med Kitajci in Rusi bližajo naglo proti neuspešnemu koncu in je nevarnost javnega preloma med Moskvo in Peipingom postala resnična in pereča, prinaša kitajsko časopisje na vidnih mestih poročilo o odhodu delegacije Komunistične partije Indonezije, poleg kitajske največje v Aziji, v Sovjetijo in na Kitajsko.

Morda ima indonezijska Komunistična partija res tak namen, morda je to le tiha želja Peipinga, vsekakor je ona za tako nalogo najbolj primerna. Čeprav se precej močno nagiba na kitajsko stran v sporu med Moskvo in Peipingom, se vendar javno še ni odločno izrazila za nobeno stran.

Oškodnine ni dobil, dokument - ponarejen

Zvezno okrožno sodišče je zavrnilo zahtevo po pol milijona oškodnine za v Jugoslaviji zaplenjeno premoženje tam rojenemu A. Philipsu, priseljencu v Združene države.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Sodišče je zavrnilo zahtevo po izplačilu pol milijona dolarjev oškodnine otrokom nekega v Jugoslaviji rojenega Adolfa Philipsa za v Jugoslaviji zaplenjeno imovino, ker je prišel sodnik do prepričanja, da je sodno potrdilo o zaplembi imovine iz l. 1948 ponarejeno.

A. Philips, oziroma njegovi otroci bi imeli pravico do oškodnine za imovino v Jugoslaviji, če bi bila ta zaplenjena, ko je bil on že ameriški državljan. Omenjeno sodno potrdilo naj bi to dokazovalo. Zvezna blagajna, ki bi morala oškodnino izplačati iz vsote 17 milijonov dolarjev, ki jo je Jugoslavija dala vladi Združenih držav za izplačilo oškodnine za zaplenjeno premoženje ameriških državljanov v Jugoslaviji, je zahtevo po izplačilu zavrnila, da Philips še ni bil ameriški državljan, ko je bila njegova imovina v Jugoslaviji zaplenjena. Ameriški državljan je postal leta 1948, njegovo premoženje naj bi bilo zaplenjeno že preje, verjetno l. 1945 ali 1946.

Kot posebno pričjo so povabile v Združene države pred sodnika Williama B. Jonesa vrhovnega sodnika Hrvaške ljudske republike Josefa Brncića. Ta je trdil, da je sodno potrdilo ponarejeno, ker naj bi bilo izdano od sodišča v Zagrebu, pa je pisano v srščini. Po njegovem so vsi sodni odloki in rozsodbe v Zagrebu pisani le v hrvaščini.

LONDON, Vel. Brit. — Britanske oblasti zaslišujejo sovjetskega obveščevalnega oficirja, ki je prebegnil na Zahod. Menda so ga zasliševali že preje v Ameriki, pa ga nato poslali sem na nadaljnja zasliševanja. Možno je bil menda na visokem položaju v sovjetski vojniski mreži in je baje izdal vrsto sovjetskih vohunov. V zvezi z njegovimi izpovedmi, naj bi bil prijatelj švedski polkovnik, ki je vohunil dolga leta za Sovjetijo, pa tudi ruska vohunska para, ki sta bila prijeta nedavno v New Yorku in Washingtonu.

QUITO, Ekv. — Vojaštvo je odstavilo včeraj predsednika republike Carlosa Arosemena radi njegovega očitnega pijanstva. V boju okoli predsedniške palače je bilo pet oseb mrtvih in tri ranjene. Arosemena so v letalu poslali v Panamo v izgnanstvo.

RIM, It. — Demokratska manjšinska vlada Leonitija je v parlamentu dobila zaupnico, da bo tako mogla izdelati državni proračun. Obvezala se je, da bo 31. oktobra, ko konča ta in druge nujne posle, odstopila in dala deželi možnost sestave nove, večinske vlade.

### Kennedy je zagotovil podporo Ngo Dinh Diemu

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Predsednik Kennedy je poslal osebno pismo predsedniku vlade v Južni Vietnamu Ngo Dinh Diemu. V pismu ga zagotavlja, da bodo Združene države vztrajno podpirale vietnamsko vlado v njenih naporih za zmagoto nad komunističnimi gverilci in napadi iz Severnega Vietnama. Ambasador Nolting, ki je odnesel to pismo, je poudaril, da ima po našem prepričanju sedanja vlada program in sredstva, ki obetajo uspešen zaključek bojevanja s komunisti in da je v interesu miru v tem delu Azije, da naša vlada podpira ta program do konca.

Ameriška zagotovitev je bila potrebna radi govoric, da smo prišli v spor radi naše kritike postopanja vietnamske vlade proti budistom in nemirom, ki so jih ti vprizorili, da bi vlado zrušili. Pismo naj zagotovi javnost, da te reči splošnega sodelovanja med nami in vlado predsednika Diema, ki se bori proti komunistom v Južni Vietnamu, niso nič pokvarile.

Naši zastopniki dodajajo, da je treba Južni Vietnam podpreti prav sedaj, ko je tudi Hruščevu treba dokazovati njegovim rdečim tovarišem na Kitajskem, da se take vojne, kot so jo začeli in jo vzdržujejo v J. Vietnamu, ne izplačajo in komunističnem gibanju niso koristne.

From toddler to four score and ten, people have more fun with water than almost anything else. Summer is upon us and as hot weather settles on the land millions of Americans will be rediscovering the pleasures of water. It is the time for swimming, boating, water skiing, and all the rest. But tragedy can strike with appalling swiftness when basic safety rules which should be observed on or around the water are forgotten in the excitement and confusion that often accompanies having a good time.

If you are a swimmer, for example, don't swim at unfamiliar or untended beaches where tides and currents may cause dangerous undertow, don't swim alone, don't try spur-of-the-moment swimming stunts and endurance trials that are beyond your skills. If You're a water skier don't forget to wear some approved flotation equipment. Every member of a group of people around the water will not be a swimmer, but every swimmer should know the basic techniques of rescue and artificial respiration.

With millions of pleasure boats now on the nation's waterways, and more coming every year, there are essential requirements which their "captains" must meet. Unless every operator of a pleasure boat assumes the responsibility that is his for the safety of his passengers and proper handling of his boat, it is inevitable that there will be severe restrictions and regulations which will take much of the fun and relaxation out of a most rewarding sport. Proper equipment, including fire extinguishers, life preserver for each passenger, lights, horn or whistle, anchor and line, bilge pump and so forth, are the beginning of safety afloat.

Just a reminder — water safety boils down to common sense. Let's use it and be around for another summer of fun in and on the water.

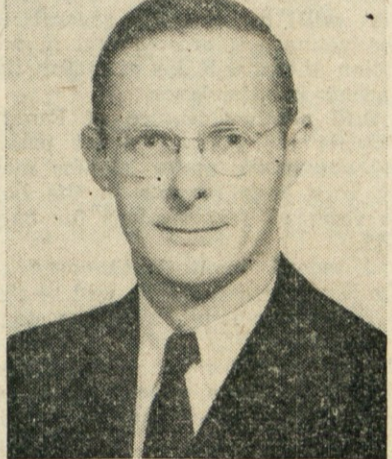

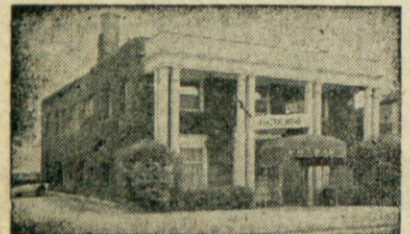

**A MALE BONGO FOR THE CLEVELAND ZOO!**

 The Cleveland Zoo will officially  
welcome its new male Bongo antelope  
today July 12, 1963.

 Ever since 1958 when "Karen,"  
the Cleveland Zoo's female Bongo  
was acquired, an endless search  
had been made to find a mate for  
her. Karen is the only captive female  
Bongo in the world, and in the  
interests of international conservation  
and propagation of the species,  
it is of vital importance that  
a breeding population be established.

 In January of this year, Dr.  
Leonard J. Goss, Director of the  
Cleveland Zoo, received word from  
Mr. George Mottershead, Director-  
Secretary of the North of England  
Zoological Society, Chester, Eng-  
land, that a young male Bongo  
was available in Ghana, Africa.  
Mr. Mottershead had been offered  
the animal, but generously passed  
acquisition rights on to the Clevel-  
and Zoo. Dr. Goss successfully  
negotiated for the purchase of the  
Bongo on February 27th, and on  
April 2nd, after many weeks of  
extensive preparations, the animal  
was flown from Ghana to Rome,  
Italy, where Director of the Naples,  
Italy, Zoo, Mr. Franco Cuneo, re-  
ceived the Bongo and escorted it  
to the Naples Quarantine Station.  
At the Naples Quarantine Station  
the Bongo was well cared for  
while serving its 60 day U.S. Dept.  
of Agriculture required foreign  
quarantine period. On June 4th  
Mr. Cuneo sadly bid the friendly  
little Bongo farewell, and on June  
5th, Dr. Goss was on hand for the  
animal's arrival at Idlewild Air-  
port, New York. The Bongo then  
spent 30 days in domestic quaran-  
tine at the U.S. Dept. of Agricul-  
ture Quarantine Station in Clifton,  
New Jersey. Successful completion  
of this quarantine period at mid-  
night, July 4th permitted the Bongo  
to be released to the Cleveland  
Zoo, and at 11 p.m., Friday, July  
5th, the last leg of the Bongo's  
journey was begun. Mr. Walter  
Kuenzli, Zoologist of the Cleveland  
Zoo, accompanied the Bongo on its  
flight to Cleveland from Newark,  
New Jersey, Airport. Arrival at the  
Cleveland Airport was at 12:30 a.m.  
Saturday, July 6th.

 The arrival at the Zoo marks  
another historical "first." The Cleve-  
land Zoo now boasts the only  
pair of captive Bongos in the  
world. This is the first time a pair  
of Bongos has been exhibited in  
the United States. Karen was only  
the 7th Bongo ever to be exhibited  
in a zoo, and the new male is the  
9th.

 The newcomer was captured as  
an infant in mid-December, 1962,  
and has grown considerably since.  
On arrival in Cleveland its weight  
was recorded at 160 pounds.

 When mature, Bongos weigh up  
to 500 pounds, and average about  
4 feet in height at the shoulder.  
Color patterns of Bongos are quite  
unusual. Base color is a rich red-  
dish russet with vertical white  
stripes on both sides. Patches of  
white mark the head and legs.  
Stripes are rarely the same num-  
ber on both sides. Karen's striping  
pattern is 12 on the left side and  
13 on the right. The new male's  
pattern is 11 on the left side and  
12 on the right.

 Both sexes have horns, although  
those of the male are usually the  
longer. Horns grow with one com-  
plete spiral twist and the points  
of the horns usually meet or some-  
times even overlap. Karen's horns  
are nearly fully grown, and mea-  
sure 24 inches. The new male's  
horns are just now beginning to  
sprout and are only 2 inches in  
length.

 Cleveland Zoo's Bongos, although  
they will be able to see each other  
through a dividing fence outdoors,  
will not be put together until  
there is assurance that they will  
be compatible, and completely  
friendly toward each other. No  
Bongos have ever been bred in  
captivity, and should the Cleveland  
Zoo's pair prove productive, another  
"first" would be claimed. The  
new male, however, will not be of  
breeding age for approximately  
another year and one-half.
