Mraz hudo prizadel
dežele južne EvropeV Italiji je bilo zaradi zame-
tov in mraza 109 mrtvih, v
Jugoslaviji 45, v Grčiji 24.LONDON, Vel. Brit. — V za-
četku tedna je mraz v Veliki
Britaniji in Franciji malo popu-
stil, pa v sredo znova pritisnil,
med tem ko je južno Evropo dr-
žal v začetku tedna trdo v svo-
jem objemu. Snežni meteži so
zajeli Kreto v Grčiji, Sardinijo
in Sicilijo v Italiji.Stevilo mrtvih zaradi mraza
in snežnih zamerov se je dvig-
nilo na 109; od teh so v zadnjih
dneh trije zmrznili v nezakurje-
nih stanovanjih, neki nočni ču-
vaj pa v svojem avtomobilu. V
Jugoslaviji je število žrtev zad-
njega vala mraza poraslo v to-
rek na 45 oseb. Donava je še
vedno zamrzla, ceste in železni-
ci delno še vedno zmetene.Hud mraz je zajel tudi Mad-
žarsko, Vzhodno Nemčijo in
Poljsko. Na Poljskem se posla-
li okoli 10,000 ljudi čistiti želez-
niške proge in glavne ceste, ki
jih je zamezel debel sneg. V
Belgiji je začelo primanjkovati
piva, ker ga ni mogče dostav-
ljati iz pivovarn, ne da bi med
potjo zmrznili.Zanimivo je, da je mraz val
zajel tudi večji del Japonske.
Tam je zaradi njega izgubilo
življenje blizu 80 oseb.Neporočeni pari so med
študenti na Angleškem
že prava vsekdanjostLONDON, Vel. Brit. — Anke-
ta med študenti londonske uni-
verze je pokazala, da živi pri-
bližno eno tretjino vseh študen-
tovskih parov skupaj, ne da bi
bili poročeni in ne da bi jih to-
kaj vznemirjalo. Glavni raz-
log naj bi bil v tem, da dobita
študent in študentka vsak za se-
be večno vladno podporo za štu-
dij, kot bi jo prejemale kot po-
ročen par.Od 200 parov, ki so odgovorili
na vprašanje, je poročenih 40,
95 je zaročenih in komaj čakajo
na končanje študij, da se poro-
če, ostalih 65 parov pa živi sku-
pj brez vsake zakonite osnove.
Tudi ti se popolnoma "zavedajo"
svoje odgovornosti do dru-
žbe, svojega odnosa ne skrivajo,
pa se z njim tudi ne ponašajo,
jemylo ga kot nekaj vsakda-
njega in popolnoma sprejemlji-
vega.

bro dosegla že višino 126 cen-
tov za unčo. Federacija misli,

servativni obrambni minister Harkness, med tem ko pred-
sednik vlade Diefenbaker in zunanj minister H. Grenn no-
četa zavzeti jasnega stališča. V zadnjih dneh je postala
debata posebno ostra. Obrambni minister Harkness je po-
vedal, da se vrše med Kanado in Združenimi državami novi

**Preganjanje krščanstva v Sudanu
in drugod v Afriki in Aziji**

Sudan je precej obsežna država južno od Egipta pa vse do Abesinijskega morja. V prejšnjem stoletju je bila znana po zagrivenih pristaših islama, ki so vprizorili upor Mahdija proti evropskemu vplivu, ki je prodiral v deželo iz Egipta, kjer se so usidrali v onem času zaradi Sueškega prekopa Angleži. Angležem se je upor posrečilo steti tik pred koncem stoletja. Slovencem je Sudan znan posebno po tem, ker je skočil tam delovati sredi preteklega stoletja slovenski misijonar Ignacij Knoblehar, ki je tudi kot prvi blež prodrl tako daleč na jug in svojo pot znanstveno popisal.

Ko je Egipt postal po prvi svetovni vojni neodvisen, je prešel Sudan pod angleško-egipčanski protektorat, v okviru katerega pa so Angleži ohranili glavno besedo. Severni del dežele je naseljen pretežno z Arabci, Nubijci in mešanci, ki so skoraj vsi pripadniki islama, južni del države je naseljen po "sudanskih" črnih, ki so delno še pogani, delni muslimani, delno pa kristjani. V tem predelu je prišlo do uradnega zaviranja in prepričevanja dela krščanskih misijonarjev. Samo v zadnjih nekaj mesecih so pognale oblasti od tod skupno 36 duhovnikov, redovnikov in redovnic, ki so širili krščansko vero.

Večji del vseh oblasti v Sudanu je v rokah muslimanov s severnega dela dežele, ki so prožnejši in na višji kulturni ravni kot črni na jugu dežele. V verskem pogledu so skrajno fanatični in gledajo v krščanskih misijonarjih svoje najhujše sovražnike. Ni jim mar, da ti črni ne učijo samo krščanske vere, ampak jim pomagajo tudi k gospodarskemu in kulturnemu napredku, ker so "džavri", morajo na en ali drug način iz dežele.

Oblasti so izdala posebno odredbo, po kateri morajo imeti vsi misijonarji in misionske ustanove posebno dovoljenje za svoje delovanje v državi. To dovoljenje je treba obnoviti vsako leto. Oblasti ga izdajo ali pa tudi zavrnejo. To store, če morejo najti le najmanjši razlog za to, često store, da tudi brez vsakega posebnega vzroka, le iz gole verske nestrnosti.

V južnem delu Sudana je okoli 400,000 kristjanov, te bi državne oblasti na vsak način rade "spreobrnile" k islamu. Kot prvi korak k temu cilju je postopno izganjanje tuje duhovštine.

Dostikrat je izgledalo iz pisanja časopisa, da preganajo krščanstvo samo v komunističnih državah, dejansko temu ni tako. V islamskih deželah je to na splošno še vedno zelo sovražno sprejeti, boljše le dopuščano kot vera tujcev. Njenega širjenja med domačine ne trpe. Zato je misijonsko delo v islamskem svetu skoraj nemogoče in tudi zelo skromno.

Sovražno razpoloženje do krščanstva se je začelo v zadnjih letih kazati tudi med budisti na Ceylonu. Tam je prišlo do podržavljenja krščanskih šol, pa tudi do drugega oviranja misijonskega dela. Tudi v Indiji se kaže v raznih delih dežele sovražno razpoloženje do krščanskih misijonarjev, prav tako v nekaterih predelih črne Afrike.

Komunisti preganajo vsako vero, proti krščanstvu, zlasti proti katoliški cerkvi se ženejo posebno, ker vidijo v njem svojega najmočnejšega nasprotnika, islam se bori proti krščanstvu iz verske nestrnosti, črna Afrika in Azija pa začenjata pod vplivom prebujajočega se nacionizma gledati v krščanstvu in njegovih oznanjevalcih tudi nauk in širitelje tuje miselnosti.

Po trideset letih

V sredo je poteklo 30 let, od kar je imenoval predsednik Nemške republike Hindenburg vodnika nemških nacistov Adolfa Hitlerja za nemškega kanclerja. Hitler je prevzem oblasti je proslavil Berlin na najbolj slovesen način. Tisoči nacističnih udarnikov so korakali skozi mesto, množice so jih navdušeno pozdravljale. Za Nemčijo se je začela doba pretiranega nacionalizma; obsežno obroževanje je končalo brezposelnost, Hitler se je pripraval na osvojitev Evrope in sveta.

Poudariti je treba, da je Hitler prišel na oblast zkonitim potom; njegova stranka je izšla najmočnejša iz splošnih volitev, zato je bil Hitler imenovan za kanclerja.

Ko je Hitler enkrat prišel na oblast, je uvedel svoj red in ukinil onega, ki mu je pomagal do oblasti. Nemške množice se zaradi tega niso dosti vznemirjale, navduševale so se za obnovljeno nemško moč, bile vesele, da je bila brezposelnost končana in možnost dela ter zasluga velika.

Hitler je zasedel demilitarizirano Porenje, odločil plebiscit v Posarju v svojo korist, se povezal z Mussolinijem in nato priključil Avstrijo Reicu. Segel je po Češki in ko ni naletel na noben pravi odpornik, še po Poljski. Nato se

je sprožil plaz. Nemške armade so zasedle večji del zahodne in severne Evrope, prodrele preko Jugoslavije v Grčijo in se vgnezdile celo na Kreti. Prodrele so do samega roba Moskev in na jugu preko Ukrajine vse do Kavkaza.

Nato je nastopil obrat vojnega sreča. Rusi so potiskali nemške armade nazaj, Amerikanici in Angleži so jih porazili v Afriki in se izkrcali v Franciji. Komaj 12 let po nastopu Hitlerja so stali nasprotniki Nemčije zopet na njenih tleh in se naglo bližali njenemu središču. Hitler je napravil samomor v svojem skrivališču v Berlinu, Nemčija je bila razdeljena med zmagovalce.

Hitler ni potegnil v nesrečo samo Nemčijo, ampak ves svet. Skozi Berlin teče danes "zid", skozi sred Europe že lezna zavesa, ki loči svobodo od komunističnega nasilja.

Kitajska atomska bomba v enem letu ali dveh!

TOKIO, Jap. — Načelnik japonske narodne obrambe Konjiro Shiga je izjavil v japonskem parlamentu, da ima rdeča Kitajska stiri atomske reaktorce, ki dajejo na leto okoli 10 kg plutonija. Po njegovem imajo Kitajci že najmanj dve atomski bombe gotovi in ju bodo najpreje v enem ali dveh letih preskusili.

Severni Vietnam se je naslonil na Moskvo

Novotnyja, ki hvali Moskvo in Hruščeva, zato pa komaj z besedo omenja Peiping in Mao-Tse-tunga. Doslej je Vietnam sedel na plotu in se ni nikoli jasno izjavil ne za Moskvo ne za Peiping.

Kaj je vietnamke komuniste nagnili, da so se odločili za Moskvo, še ni jasno. Vsekakor bo ta izjava imela tudi politične posledice za gverilsko vojskovno v Južnem Vietnamu. Češki komunist Novotny je na političnem potovanju po vzhodni Aziji.

Kennedy predložil Kongresu farmarske zakone

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Kot vsako leto, je Kennedyjeva administracija tudi letos poslala na Kapitol posebno spomenico z zakonskimi predlogi, ki naj uredi nekaj perečih farmarskih problemov. Zakonski predlogi se nanašajo na zajamčene cene za krmno, pavolo in mlečne izdelke.



SPRING HITS CLEVELAND EARLY



Not since grandfather's day has this area had a winter like this. But in a dozen greenhouses in northern Ohio, something is being done to put an end to the drab, dreary, ice-bound season.

Hundreds of thousands of mid-summer flowers are being coaxed into full bloom far ahead of the season, to fill Cleveland's huge Public Hall with gardens and flowers in the twentieth annual Cleveland Home and Flower Show, which will look like this March 9 through March 17. Here

less than half of the floral spectacle in the Main Arena is shown with the dominant stage feature, the "Dancing Waters" fountains. Five other vast halls in Public Auditorium will contain home and garden equipment, appliances, and furnishings. The full-sized A.I.A. Show House and a dozen model rooms, created by the American Institute of Interior Designers, will highlight the Homeland Section of the exposition.

Cleveland Home and Flower Show

The Garden Club of Ohio's first State Flower Show will be an important part of the annual Cleveland Home and Flower Show at Cleveland Public Hall, March 9 through March 17.

Member Clubs throughout Ohio are invited to participate, according to Mrs. R. G. Schulke, of Brecksville, general chairman of the Garden Club of Ohio Show. Actually, she points out, there will be three Standard Flower Shows of three days duration, each with classes in Flower Arrangement, Table Settings, Horticulture and Collages.

This Show will occupy a sixty-five-foot exhibit area in the Main Exhibition Hall at the Cleveland Home and Flower Show.

Other new features at the Cleveland Home and Flower Show will include a collection of 30 or more aquariums containing hundreds of unusual fish. This exhibit is arranged by the Cleveland Aquarium Society and a model of the new Cleveland Aquarium will also be shown.

The Cleveland City Greenhouses will have gardens throughout the exhibit areas and the Holden Arboretum and the Garden Center of Greater Cleveland will also have exhibits.

A dozen home gardens in full season bloom, created by the members of the Cleveland Florists' Association will provide the gateway to Spring atmosphere in the big main area.

Throughout the other halls of Public Auditorium will be some 200 exhibits of home appliances, equipment, materials, power garden tools, seeds, bulbs, and all other things for the home and garden.

The Homel and section of the Show is to feature the full-sized, Chamber of Commerce sponsored, American Institute of Architects model home, built by members of the Home Builders Association of Greater Cleveland.

Championships In Three Divisions Of Racing

Extra-distance midseason championship title races will be featured on Friday night's (Feb. 1) midget auto, motorcycle and stock car racing bill at Cleveland Arena.

Midget auto and motorcycle main events will be extended from 20 to 35 laps and stock cars will circle their longest distance of 20 laps.

Just as the Payroll Savings Plan has appealed to many people because it is an automatic way of saving, it is expected that the new tax refund plan will be popular for much the same reason. The Treasury hopes so.

It would be well for all citizens who are expecting tax refunds this year to consider seriously taking them in Savings Bonds — to benefit themselves and their country. A check mark in the proper place on the new tax forms can put you in an active role in supporting the Nation, and feathering your own nest at the same time.

THE PRESIDENT'S BUDGET MESSAGE. The President's State of the Union Message was notable for its stress on the need for major tax reductions and tax reform and its absence of specific recommendations. The Budget Message which followed later in the week calls for the shocking expenditure of \$98.8 billion. It is the largest budget in history. Representative Clarence Cannon (D. Mo.), Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee, summed up the thoughts of many of us when he said: "I have never seen or heard a budget message like this one, and neither have you; nor has anyone else."

After two years in office, President Kennedy by his own estimate, will have run up the national debt by \$15.2 billion. The further deficit of \$11.9 billion anticipated by the latest budget message will make a total of \$27 billion for his first three years as President. How do we like that?

We were told in the "State of the Union" message that plans for a tax cut and increased defense spending would necessitate limiting "severely" fiscal 1964 expenditures in domestic fields. However, the 1964 budget proposes spending of \$4.4 billion above 1963 and over \$2 billion of this increase is for other than national defense. New domestic programs and expansion of present Federal bureaus will require 36,492 more civilian government employees. The President has already added 145,175 employees since he assumed office.

Those of us in Congress who long have been concerned over fiscal responsibility have great difficulty understanding how we can cut federal tax revenue and at the same time increase non-defense spending to such record proportions. The Administration's answer, of course, is deficit spending! But what does this policy lead to? Fixed interest costs on our Federal debt exceeded \$10 billion last year—second only to

defense as our largest single expenditure. With the anticipated deficit, the interest for next year will go over \$11 billion. Continued mounting federal debt can only result in another round of inflation and the discrediting of the American dollar.

BACKGROUNDS OF THE 88TH CONGRESS MEMBERS

More members of the 88th Congress show Civil Service and Politicians among the occupations in their background than any other line of work. Many mention more than one occupation. Next most numerous are Lawyers, closely followed by Business and Banking. There are three physicians in the House and one in the Senate. There are two ordained ministers in the House and one former labor union official.

The 88th Congress has thirteen women Members—eleven in the House and two in the Senate. Only one of the thirteen is new to the Congress—Representative Charlotte Reid of Illinois a Republican. You will recall that Mrs. Reid's husband was campaigning when he passed away suddenly and she had the courage to pick up and go on. We welcome her with enthusiasm.

Modern Government needs a continuing supply of competent manpower to provide the many services required by the American people. The Civil Service Merit System is the best system yet devised to assure the American people that the affairs of their Government will be conducted without interruption day in day out by competent employees.

Almost all types of jobs found in private industry are also found in Civil Service, and there are some jobs in Civil Service which are not found elsewhere. Over the past four years, the Cleveland Post Office Civil Service Board has conducted examinations for 55,031 competitors for various positions in the Federal Service. There was a time when most Government workers got their jobs through political influence. Then, when the opposing party won control of the Government, many employees were dismissed to create vacancies to be filled by the party in power. After every election, hordes of job-seekers swarmed into Washington and camped on the grounds of the capitol and White House. In fact, Abraham Lincoln once remarked while ill with smallpox in the White House, "Tell all of the office-seekers to come at once, for now I have something I can give to all of them." In a more serious vein, he also said, "I am afraid this thing is going to ruin the republican government."

Prior to the enactment of the merit system, Government machinery was frequently at a standstill due to the mass removal of government workers after the change of administration. In 1883, the year the Civil Service Act was passed, only 10% of the federal work force was in the competitive service. Positions are called competitive because applicants "compete" for them in Civil Service examinations.

The Civil Service Act put merit into appointments and prevented wholesale firings and restaffing
