## Vi ste sol in luč sveta

Ko je Jezus pri zadnji večerji molil velikoduhovniško molitev, je za svoje učence rekel, da »niso od tega sveta«, kot tudi On »ni od tega sveta«. Danes nam pravi: »Vi ste sol zemlje.« Kaj to pomeni? Ali kristjani morda nismo enaki drugim ljudem? Nekateri ljudje, tudi kristjani, preprosto ne zdržijo, da bi bili drugačni kot drugi. Drugačnost svet kaznuje, se pohujšuje, spreneveda. »Na svetu boste imeli stisko, vendar ne bojte se, jaz sem svet premagal,« nam je napovedal Jezus. Najbolj pa kristjane prizadene očitek, da nismo nič boljši od drugih, čeprav se delamo, da smo nekaj posebnega.

Ali imamo kristjani nekaj, kar nas spreminja in ločuje od drugih ljudi? Kot je Jezus Sin nebeškega Očeta, tako smo tudi mi otroci istega skupnega Očeta. Jezus ločuje svoje učence od tega sveta z ločnico, s katero je tudi sam ločen od njega. Pri krstu smo postali deležni njegove narave, njegovega življenja.

Za sol je značilno, da se ne more pokvariti. Lahko se porabi, lahko se stopi v vodi ali kakšni hrani, lahko se pomeša s kakšno drugo snovjo, toda pokvariti se ne more. Tako tudi kristjan ne more izbrisati svojega krstnega dostenjstva, svojega božjega življenja. Edino, kar se lahko zgodi, je, da soli zmanjka, da zaradi greha preneha nadnaravno življenje in delovanje posvečajoče milosti. Tedaj prenehamo biti sol, toda skriti se ne moremo. Ali smo drugim sol in luč ali pa jih zavajamo v zmoto in temo. Kristjan ne more zbrisati svojega krščanstva, lahko pa ga zataji. »Ne more se skriti mesto na gori.«

Tudi odpadli angel, Lucifer je bil »luč sveta« ali nosilec luči za svet dokler se ni spridil; postal je nasprotje nosilca luči, zato je bil zavrnjen.

Da bi bili sol zemlje in luč sveta, ni treba narediti nekaj izjemnega. Dovolj je, da smo to, kar smo. Da ostanemo v Gospodu. On nam daje sol za modrost življenja in gorivo za naše svetilke. Ljudje nas opazujejo, kako se obnašamo, kako govorimo, kako se odločamo. Nekateri nas gledajo z žalostjo in ugotavljam, da nismo nič boljši od drugih, ki niso verni.

Res je, da je v Cerkvi tudi marsikaj slabega in grešnega, ker smo kristjani slabi in grešni. Toda s tem ni nihče upravičen opravičevati svojega slabega

početja. V Cerkvi je tudi veliko lepega in dobrega. Tako tisti, ki si prizadevajo za popolnost in svetost, verujoče in neverujoče vabijo k življenju po evanđelju in posnemanju njihovega življenja. Jezus pravi: da se na svetilnik postavlja luč, da bi vsem svetila: drugi nam, mi drugim.

Jezus vabi vse ljudi, da bi bili luč in sol drugim. Jezus opogulja: »Ne boj se, mala čreda, kajti Bog vam je sklenil dati v posest narode.« Malo soli daje okus vsej hrani in mala čreda lahko daje pomen in smisel mnogim ljudem. Malo dobrih kristjanov bo privabilo veliko novih članov. Veliko povprečnih kristjanov pa se bo spojilo s tem svetom tako, da ne bo skoraj nobene razlike med kristjani in tistimi, ki to niso. Ko ni več razlike, je znamenje, da ni več ne luči ne soli.

Med tem svetom in kristjani je povezanost, obstaja pa tudi napetost. Kristjan ni in ne sme biti od tega sveta. Pismo Diogenetu, ki je bilo napisano v prvih začetkih krščanstva, pravi takole: »Kristjanov ne loči od drugih ljudi: ne dežela, ne govorica, ne običaji. Nikjer ne prebivajo v lastnih mestih, ne govorijo posebnega narečja in ne živijo posebnega življenja. Prilagajajo se krajevnim običajem glede obleke, hrane in drugega življenja. Živijo pa vzorno in čudovito, da vse preseneča. Ženijo se kakor vsi drugi, vendar otrok ne izpostavljajo. Mudijo se na zemlji, a njih domovina je v nebesih. Pokorni so zakonom in postavam, a s svojim življenjem prekašajo postave. Ljubijo vse, a vsi jih preganjajo. Ne poznajo jih, a jih vendar obsojajo. Ubogi so, a bogate mnoge. Vsega jim manjka in imajo vsega v izobilju. Jemljejo jim čast, a oni v nečasti žanjejo slavo. Sramotijo jih, a oni blagoslavljajo. Ponižujejo jih, oni pa izkazujejo čast. Delajo dobro, pa jih kaznujejo kot hudodelce. Celo smrtne kazni s veselijo, kot da vstajajo v novo življenje. Kristjani prebivajo v tem svetu, pa niso od tega sveta. Kristjani ljubijo svoje sovražnike. V tem svetu so kot duša v telesu.«

Good works, done in the name of Christ, are to be unashamedly put on display for all to see.


*“Your light must shine in the sight of men.”*



### **Illustration**

Lighthouses are incredible structures, and they come in many different shapes and sizes. The tallest in the world is claimed to be the Jeddah Light in Saudi Arabia, which stands at the entrance to Jeddah's harbour on the Red Sea. This lighthouse is a very modern design. Built in 1990, it is a far cry from the more traditional structures that we are familiar with. Constructed from concrete and steel, it has a wide triangular base, which leads into the main vertical section. This, in turn, leads to a large, bulbous head, where the lamp is to be found along with a viewing balcony. Most importantly, it emits three white flashes every twenty seconds.

Lighthouses are often built in or close to inhospitable places. There is something enigmatic about them. They are there as immovable objects in places of danger and they share one thing in common –



they unashamedly shine their light and save lives. Whether it's the Red Sea, the Atlantic Ocean, or the English Channel, lighthouses all have one job, which is to be an unfailing beacon and sign of hope to the traveller on the waves. They may all have their own architectural style and their special paint job, but at the end of the day they shine brightly and can be seen for miles, and that's all that matters.

### Gospel Teaching

There is clarity in Jesus' teaching about the need to be his witnesses; to be bearers of light. Jesus calls his followers to proudly stand up and be bold in sharing the new life that they find in him. To know Jesus is to be living in the light, and this light cannot be hidden. The analogies that Jesus uses are very clear. It's all about visibility brought about through loving service. Those good works, which followers of Christ would naturally want to engage in, will be a beacon for others.

Today's Gospel reading is preceded in Matthew by the Beatitudes, Jesus' revolutionary teaching about how we are called to see ourselves in the way that God sees us. Jesus shows us that those who, in the eyes of the world, live in the darkness are in fact those who are truly blessed. These are the ones who share in the sufferings of Christ. These are

the ones who have the light. This light is a light to be shared so that safe harbour may be found by all and thus fitting praise be given to God our loving Father.

### Application

Just as lighthouses are all very different in their appearance, so are we. We all have our unique gifts and talents; we all have our way of interacting with each other and the world. As Christians, though, what we share in common is our overarching story. The central message of the whole Gospel is that God is love, and that we find freedom in Christ, who suffered, died and was raised from the dead for us. Baptised into Christ, and with the Holy Spirit in us, we are all called to share God's love as we grow in holiness according to our vocation. This vocation – be it marriage, single life, the religious life, or priesthood – is our way in which we share the light of the Gospel. It is our way of being light.


One of the most attractive things about parishes where people are fully alive and filled with the light of Christ is that they know how to worship. The psalmist tells us that God dwells in the praises of God's people. Where there is great devotion and lively, heartfelt worship, light is emitted powerfully. A place of worship can become a lighthouse, spreading grace into the local community. A family regularly praying together can become a transmitter of light to the local neighbourhood. A faithful community of religious sisters or brothers can be a bright emitter of light across a wide area. Of course, this light is invisible, for it is the light of grace and it acts upon human hearts without people realising. The principle of the lighthouse applies here, though. Christians gathering to listen to, receive and respond to the light of the world do so as gifted individuals. When we share that light through our works of charity, we are doing so collectively because we are truly the body of Christ. We may all be different but we are enlightened from the same source and shine forth our witness to that same source – Jesus the one, true light.



## 11. FEBRUAR 2020, 28. SVETOVNI DAN BOLNIKOV

Za svetovni dan bolnikov, ki bo kot vsako leto 11. februarja, na god Lurške Matere Božje, je papež Frančišek napisal poslanico z naslovom »Pridite k meni vsi, ki ste utrujeni in obteženi, in jaz vam bom dal počitek«.

### Jezus ponuja svoje usmiljenje

Kot zapisa papež, ob 28. svetovnem dnevu bolnikov Jezus namenja to povabilo bolnim in zatiranim, revnim, ki znajo neposredno biti odvisni od Boga in ki, ranjeni s težo preizkušnje, potrebujejo ozdravitev. »Jezus Kristus tistemu, ki živi tesnobo svoje situacije krhkosti, bolečine in šibkosti, ne postavlja zakonov, ampak ponuja svoje usmiljenje, torej svojo osebno okrepitev. Jezus gleda ranjeno človeškost. Ima oči, ki vidijo, ki se zavedajo, kajti gledajo v globino, niso brezbržne, ampak se ustavijo in sprejmejo vsega človeka, vsakega človeka v njegovem zdravstvenem stanju, brez zavračanja kogar koli, pri tem pa vsakega vabijo, da vstopi v njegovo življenje in doživi nežnost.«

### Kdor doživi tolažbo, lahko daje tolažbo

Jezus goji takšna čustva, ker je on sam postal slaboten, ko je doživel človeško trpljenje in od Očeta prejel počitek. »Sam kdor to izkusi v prvi osebi, je lahko tolažba za drugega,« izpostavi papež. Obstajajo različne oblike velikega trpljenja, neozdravljive in kronične bolezni, bolezni, ki potrebujejo rehabilitacijo in paliativno oskrbo, psihične patologije, različne invalidnosti, otroške in starostne bolezni ... V teh okoliščinah se včasih opaža pomajkanje človečnosti in zato je nujen osebni pristop k bolniku, s tem da se k zdravljenju doda oskrba za celostno človeško ozdravitev. V bolezni oseba ne čuti le pojemanje lastne fizične integritete, ampak tudi odnosne, razumske, čustvene in duhovne razsežnosti. Zato poleg terapij potrebuje tudi podporo, skrb, pozornost, skratka, ljubezen. Poleg tega pa je ob bolniku tudi družina, ki trpi in tudi sama potrebuje tolažbo in bližino.

### Cerkev kot gostišče dobrega Samarijana

Papež se obrne na same bolnike: »Dragi bolni bratje in sestre, bolezen vas na poseben način postavlja med tiste, ki 'utrujeni in obteženi' pritegujejo Jezusov pogled in srce. Od tu prihaja luč za vaše temne trenutke, upanje za vašo obupanost. Vabi vas, da greste k Njemu: 'Pridite.' V njem bodo namreč nemir in vprašanja, ki se v tej noči telesa in duha dvigajo v vas, našle moč, da se jih prestane. Ja, Kristus nam ni dal receptov, ampak nas s svojim trpljenjem, smrtjo in vstajenjem osvobaja zla.«
