Doma in po svetu

PREGLED NAJAVAŽNEJŠIH DOGODKOV

Predsednik Reagan trdi, da je zasedba Grenade povsem uspela — Nov veleposlanik ZDA za Srednji vzhod bo Donald Rumsfeld

WASHINGTON, D.C. - Včeraj je predsednik Reagan izjavil, da je ameriška zasedba Grenade uspela in da ni več dosti odpora na tem majhnem otoku. Ameriški vojaki so že začeli otok zapustiti. Tiste vojake ZDA, ki so padli oz. bili ranjeni, smatram za junake v polnem pomenu besede, je dejal Reagan.

Zasedba Grenade ne bi smeli razumeti kot invazijo, je rekel predsednik, ki je pa sam uporabil besedo »izvazijo«, ko je obvestil javnost o zasedbi otoka 22. oktobra. Šlo je za »rešilno akcijo«. Novinar je Reagana vprašal, ali bi storil isto, ako bi nastale podobne razmere v kaki drugi deželi. Predsednik je odgovoril, da bi, čeprav ne pričakuje, da bo zopet kdaj prišlo do kaj takega.

Reagan je bil jezen, ko ga je drugi novinar vprašal, ali ni bila ameriška akcija na Grenadi ista kot je bila sovjetska zasedba Afganistana. Noben pameten človek ne bi mogel priti do takega zaključka, je dejal Reagan. Rekel je tudi, da je bil kar ravnoden, ko je slišal vest, da je 108 držav v Združenih narodih glasovalo zoper ameriški zasedbi Grenade, le 9 devet držav pa je zasedbo podprt.

Predsednik je začel svojo tiskovno konferenco z izjavo, v kateri je povedal, da je imenoval bivšega obrambnega tajnika in republikanskega kongresnika Donalda Rumsfelda za svojega novega veleposlanika za srednjevzhodne zadeve. Dosedaj je to dolžnost opravljal Donald McFarlane, ki je postal predsednikov svetovalec za nacionalno varnost.

Nova Grenadska vlada že prihodnji teden — Kubanci in Sovjeti izgnani z otoka

ST GEORGE'S, Grenada - Včeraj je od Anglije imenovani generalni guverner za Grenado Sir Paul Scoon dejal, da bo imenoval novo vlado na Grenadi že prihodnji teden. Vlada bo izvenstrankska in bo imela med drugimi nalogimi, da pripravi svobodne volitve. Scoon je bil v hišnem priporu na Grenadi vse od 1979. leta, ko je državni udar pod vodstvom Mauricea Bishopa uspel. Ameriški vojaki so Scoona rešili in je takoj začel sodelovati v prizadevanju za vrnitev k demokratični ureditvi na otoku.

Volitve bodo res svobodne, je dejal Scoon. Pravico do sodelovanja bodo imeli tudi pripadniki odstranjenega režima gen. Hudsona Austina, ako niso kaj hudega storili v času, ko so bili na oblasti. Gen. Austin je še vedno v ameriških rokah, prav tako njegov ožji sodelavec Bernard Coard. Scoon je pa povedal novinarjem, da bosta oba kmalu izročena novim grenadskim oblastem.

Na otoku ni več dosti odpora do ameriških vojakov. Novinarji, ki poročajo z Grenade, soglašajo, da je velika večina Grenadčanov vesela radi odstranitve prejšnjega režima. Mnogi Grenadčani tudi pomagajo vojakom ZDA pri odkrivanju zadnjih Kubancev na otoku in pripadnikov Austinovega režima.

Čeprav je angleška vlada kritizirala ameriško zasedbo Grenade, je ta kritika v zadnjem tednu postala milejša. Ker so vojaki ZDA odkrili veliko kubanskega in sovjetskega orožja na otoku ter našli dokumente, ki pričajo o kubanskih načrtih za Grenado, je v Angliji več razumevanja za ameriško akcijo.

Prav tako je Thatcherjeva vlada začela s pošiljanjem gospodarske pomoči Grenadi. Na otok bo poslala skupino gospodarskih in policijskih strokovnjakov, ki bodo pomagali oz. svetovali Sir Paul Scoonu.

Rev. Jesse Jackson postal demokratski predsedniški kandidat

WASHINGTON, D.C. - Včeraj je črnski voditelj Jesse Jackson napovedal svojo predsedniško kandidaturo v demokratski stranki. Jackson, ki je star 42 let in ni bil nikoli politični kandidat, je dejal v daljšem govoru, da bo ustanovil koalicijo, v kateri bodo imele največ besede in vpliva tiste skupine, ki jih drugi politiki, tako demokratski kot republikanski ignorirajo. Gre za črnce, špansko-govoreče, ženske, starejše, Indijance itd. Seveda bo iskal tudi podporo belcev, je dejal.

Politični analitiki v glavnem mestu soglašajo, da je Jesse Jackson sploh najboljši govornik med vsemi 8 demokratskimi kandidati, najbrž je pa tudi najradikalnejši v svojem programu. Tudi Jacksonovi najtesnejši sodelavci ne trdijo, da ima Jackson resnejšo možnost, da bi postal demokratski predsedniški kandidat zoper Ronald Reagana na volitvah, ki bodo novembra 1984. leta. Trdijo pa, da bo Jackson s svojo kandidaturo prisilil ostale demokrate, da bodo glasneje podpirali posamezne točke njegovega programa ter da bo moral dejanski demokratski kandidat zoper Reagana upoštrevati ta program in Jacksona samega.

Splošno mnenje analitikov je, da bo Jacksonova kandidacija najbolj škodovala Walteru Mondalu, ki je posebno veliko računal na glasove črncev. Ti črnci bodo v veliki večini podpirali Jacksona. Kar ni jasno analitikom, je, kako bodo ti črnci reagirali na samih predsedniških volitvah, ko Jackson ne bo demokratski kandidat. Ali bodo pripravljeni glasovati za Mondala, Glenna ali drugega belca, ali pa bodo ostali domov.

Proti-Arafatski elementi v PLO skušajo doseči popolno zmago

BEJRUT, Libanon - V zadnjih dneh potekajo hudi boji v okolici severnolibanonskega obalnega mesta Tripoli med enotami PLO, ki jih podpira Sirija, in tistimi, ki so še vedno zvesti Jasirju Arafatu. Ofenzivo so začeli proti-Arafatove enote, baje ob soudeležbi sirijskih vojakov. Uporne PLO enote obstreljujejo položaje Arafatovih vojakov, poročila, ki prihajajo iz Bejruta zatrjujejo, da je Arafat sam v Tripoliju. Po nepotrjenih vsteh, naj bi v dosedanjih bojih padlo najmanj 34 Arafatovih vojakov, ranjenih pa je bilo 119. Napadalci uporabljajo poleg topništva in minometov tudi tanke.

Najnovejši napad na Arafata je le nadaljevanje politike sirijskega voditelja Hafeza Assada, ki želi, da bi prišla PLO pod njegovo popolno kontrolo. Kot kaže, uspeva v tej politiki in so Arafatovi dnevi šteti.

Chrysler Corp. prisiljena zapreti mnoge obrata radi štrajka v eni sami tovarni

TWINSBURG, O. - Pretekli torek zjutraj so začeli štrajkati delavci Chrysler Corp. obrata, zaposleni v Twinsburgu. Jezni so, ker podjetje nočje upoštrevati njihovih zahtev glede delovnih razmer v tej tovarni. Gre za lokalna nesoglasja in delavci ne zahtevajo povisjanja plač. Ker so pa drugi Chryslerjevi obrati odvisni od delov — avtomobilskih vrat — ki jih proizvajajo v Twinsburgu, brez teh delov ne morejo obratovati.

Razgovor o Louisu Adamiču

Letni slavistični kongres v Kansas Cityju od 22. do 25. oktobra 1983 je imel na programu tudi razpravo ob okrogli mizi o Louisu Adamiču in njegovi vlogi v drugi svetovni vojni. Sestanek je v okviru Society for Slovene Studies (Društvo za slovenske študije) pripravil univ. profesor Jože Velikonja.

Pred nedavnim so državni arhivi odprli nove zbirke dokumentov FBI, OSS in njihovih predhodnikov, v katerih je Adamič pogosto zabeležen. S tem je omogočeno raziskovanje in pretresanje dogodkov in posegov, ki so se doslej naslanjali na osebne arhive in poročila. Razgovor za okroglo mizo je potekal ob intenzivnem sodelovanju strokovnjakov: prof. Henry Christian, vodja oddelka za angleščino na Rutgers univerzi v Newarku, znani in priznani raziskovalec in pisec o Adamiču; prof. Bogdan Novak, zgodovinar z univerze v Toledo, Ohio; dr. Matjaž Klemenčič, profesor zgodovine na univerzi v Mariboru. Urednik A.D. Rudolph M. Susel in pisatelj Ivan Dolenc, ki sta bila na programu, se sestanka nista mogla udeležiti.

Predsedujoči prof. Velikonja je najprej nakazal namen razgovora: po simpozijah v Minnesoti in v Ljubljani leta 1981 potreba po raziskovanju Adamičevega dela ni zbledela. Potrebno je resno razpravljanje, ki naj razčisti nejasnosti o Adamičevem življenju, o njegovem delu in posebno o njegovi vlogi in pomembnosti. Vojna doba je en tak časovni odlomek iz Adamičevega življenja. Za nas je posebno vabljen predmet Adamičovo zgodnje navdušenje za odporniško delo četnikov in Mihailovića, o katerem je zagotovil predsednika Roosevelta pri večerji 13. januarja 1942, da je »a good man«; njegova spomenica predsedniku 3. februarja 1942, v kateri ga je opozoril na obstoj še druge skupine (»another fighting force«); njegovo prizadeno pisanje o aktivnostih partizanov poleti 1942, do ostre obsodbe Mihailovića ob koncu istega leta. Vse ozadje, ki je privedlo do te usmeritve, še ni popolnoma jasno. Po vseh dosedaj doseglih dokumentih Adamič ni bil komunist in ni bil direktno vezan na Ameriško komunistično partijo. Z njimi je simpatiziral in jim bil v marsičem koristen.

Razgovor na sestanku je kljub različnim gledanjem treh raziskovalcev in predsedujočega potekal bolj v medsebojnem dopolnjevanju kot v polemičnih nasprotovanjih. Vsak sodelavec se je naslanjal na doseglije dokumente: Christian predvsem na Adamičeve arhive v Princetonu, ki jih on sam ureja in tolmači; Bogdan Novak na arhive v Chicagu, Minnesoti, Clevelandu in na zapuščino pokojnega Kazimirja Zakrajška; Matjaž Klemenčič pa poleg arhivov v Ameriki uporablja tudi arhive v Ljubljani, Zagrebu in Beogradu. Arhivi FBI in OSS so bili le delno pregledani.

Doslej je mogoče potrditi naslednje: Četudi je imel Adamič stike z vodilnimi člani Ameriške komunistične partije, ni bil komunist in ni dokazano, da bi delal po direktivah iz Moskve. Iz dokumentov je tudi jasno, da Adamičovo gledanje ni odmev Ameriške zunanje politike in da tudi ni sledil njihovim direktivam. Izlučiti je mogoče, da je Adamič kot naprednjak našel bolj domače ozračje med naprednjaki v Ameriki in so mu bili bliže tudi revolucionarji v domovini, ko je odkril, da so v vodstvu Osvobodilne fronte ljudje, s katerimi se je srečal v Sloveniji v letih 1932 in 1933. Razgovor je potrdil, da je Adamičeva težnja po socialnih in političnih preureditvah sveta bolj v soglasju s programi slovenskih in jugoslovenskih partizanov kot pa s programi londonske vlade, Mihailovića in konzervativnih predstavnikov med Slovenci v Ameriki.

Municipal Elections

General Elections will be held in Richmond Heights on Tuesday, Nov. 8 from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. Ward 1 voters will be voting at the Christian Assembly Church located at 25595 Chardon Rd. Voters in Ward 2, 3, and 4 will be voting at the Kiwanis Lodge located in the Richmond Heights Park.

State Issues 2 and 3

The passage of Issue 2 will alter the Ohio Constitution by repealing a 132-year-old provision requiring a constitutional majority vote in both the Ohio House and the Ohio Senate to pass "revenue raising bills," and substitutes a three-fifths vote requirement in its place. Passage of this issue will allow a minority to deadlock any revenue bill. A NO vote is strongly recommended.

The passage of Issue 3 will amend the Ohio Constitution by repealing "any changes in the tax laws of the state that were enacted after January 1,

1983". Passage of this issue will force the state government to eliminate tax credits and transfers for senior citizens, increase tuition at public institutions, and force local governments and schools to find alternate methods to finance their operations. In other words, tax levies at the local level. I strongly urge a NO vote on Issue 3.

The passage of Issue 1 will raise the drinking age for beer and wine from 19 to 21. I strongly urge the passage of Issue 1.

I urge Richmond Heights residents to re-elect Council President William Zaffiro for the term commencing Dec. 1, 1983. In his first term, William Zaffiro has shown the leadership and maturity needed on Council. His legal background and concern for his city will benefit our community.

In Ward 1 Marcia Starkey Morgan is seeking a return to Council. Marcia is a 10 year veteran on Council and was a Mayoral candidate in 1981. I have had the pleasure of work-

ing with her (she is presently Clerk of Council) and have solicited her advice on many occasions. I strongly urge Ward 1 residents return Marcia Starkey Morgan.

As for myself, I hope that my reports through the Ameriška Domovina have been both informative and enjoyable. Our city is at the cross-roads and needs progressive, independent thinkers. I respectfully ask for your support on Nov. 8th.
