KLAVNIŠKE DRUŽBE ZVIŠALE MEZDE ZA 8 PROC.

Klavniški magnati pravijo, da so zvišanje izposlovalne kompanijske unije. Okrog 100,000 delavcev prizade-
tih.

CHICAGO, 25. sept. — Včeraj so štiri velike klavniške družbe naznanile, da bodo s 1. oktobrom zvišale mezde svojih delavcev za okrog 8 odstotkov. Te družbe, ki imajo monopol nad razpečevanjem mesa v deželi, so Swift and Co., Wilson and Co., Cudahy Packing Co. in Armour and Co. ter so znane kot "Big Four". Pričakuje se, da bodo enako zvišanje odredile tudi manjše družbe in da bo istoga deležnih okrog 100,000 klavniških delavcev v deželi.

Navzlic zvišanju pa bodo mezde v klavniški industriji še vedno zelo nizke. Znašale bodo namreč od 47 centov do 50c na uro. Kompanije sicer pravijo, da bodo minimalne mezde s tem stopile na višjo stopnjo kot so bile leta 1929, ampak pozabljajo, da so povodati, da so delavci takrat bili stalno zaposleni, danes niso, važno pa je, koliko delavcev zasluži v celoti in ne koliko na uro.

V svojem naznanilu o zvišanju mezd kompanije seveda niso pozabile naglasiti, da se je to odredilo po posredovanju "kompanijskih unij". Očividno namen tega je, ustvariti med delavci vtis, da so jim "zunanje" samostojne unije nepotrebne, da sami od sebe upoštevajo delavske zahteve. Igra klavniških magnatov je jasna — baš sedaj, ko je agitacija za samostojne delavske unije na višku, so pripravljene vreči delavcem nekaj drobtin, da preprečijo rast pravih unij.

Dočim je "Ameriška Domovina" že ponovno pisala da je pisatelj Louis Adamič pozabljen, in da nihče več niti "ne govori niti ne piše" o njem, pa list "New York Times" z dne 21. septembra prinaša obširno poročilo o literarni čajanki, ki jo je priredil Adamič za stavkujoče književne delavce pri Macaulay Co. v New Yorku. Omenjeni list pravi, da je Adamič prvi ameriški pisatelj, ki je sprožil tako idejo. Na sestanku, sklicanem od njega, je bilo navzočih nad sto uposlenecv omenjene družbe, ki so na stavki, da si priborijo boljše življenske razmere. Adamič je izjavil na sestanku, da so založniške tvrdke kot celota sicer bolj dostojne s svojimi uposleni kot večina delodajalcev, da pa so žal tudi tu izjeme, ki zahtevajo popravka. "Založniki sami bi morali najbolj gledati, da ohranijo dobro ime, ki ga v splošnem uživa ta industrija," je izjavil Adamič, kot piše N. Y. Times.

Sinclair je menda o-milil svoj program

Odstranil je več radikalnih točk iz svojega 'Epic' programa, da dobi podporo demokratskih političarjev.

SAN FRANCISCO, Cal., — Tukajšnji politični opazovalci pravijo, da je Upton Sinclair drastično omilil svoj "Epic" program, da s tem pridobi podporo konservativnih elementov v demokratski stranki. Kot se govori, je Sinclair po razgovoru z George Creelom, ki je imel v primarni kampanji podporo Rooseveltove administracije, pristal na to, da se črta točke za starostno pokojnino, za državno lastovane tovarne in združne farme. NEW YORK, 25. sept. — Dokazi proti Brunu Hauptmannu, ki je osumljen, da je ugrabil Lindberghovega otroka, se kopičijo. Zdad so detektivi našli na neki deski v shrambi na njegovem domu naslov in telefonsko številko dr. Condon, ki je kot posredovalec za Lindbergha pred tremi leti in pol plačal \$50,000 odkupnine, v upanju, da dobi otroka živega nazaj.

Ko je Hauptmann skušal razložiti, za kaj je napisal dotični naslov, je prišel sam s seboj v protislovja. Dalje se je našlo na domu osumljenca tudi serijalne številke bankovcev, ki se jih je plačalo kot odkupnino.

Hauptmann se nahaja skozi zadnjih 68 ur neprestano na izpraševanju in detektivi mu ne dajo niti sekunde počitka. Pravijo, da je že čisto uničen ter pričakujejo, da se bo v kratkem podal ter priznal krivdo.

Lindbergh, ki je prišel iz Californije, da vidi osumljenca, bo najbrže jutri stopil pred Hauptmanna. Okrog okrajne sodnije v Bronxu, kjer je danes Lindbergh nastopil pred veliko poroto, je postavljenih 230 policajev da zavarujejo avijatika pred radovednejši in vsakovrstni tip, ki iščejo naslade v preiskavi senzacijskega zločina.

FAŠIZEM V ANGLIJI?

Proces proti bankirjem

Včeraj se je na zveznim sodišču v Clevelandu začela obravnava proti trem uradnikom ropadle Guardian Trust banke, ki so obtoženi 27 različnih prestopkov, ki se nanašajo na zlorabo bančnega denarja in ponarejanja poslovnih knjig. Na zatožni klopi sedijo J. Arthur House, bivši predsednik banke; Harry C. Robinson, eksekutivni podpredsednik, in William R. Green, podpredsednik. Proces vodi sodnik Samuel H. West. V poroti, katero se je izbiralo tri ure, sedi sedem žensk in pet moških.

Zopet vandalizem

Nov val pobijanjanja izložbenih oken in razbijanja trgovskih napisov je izbruhnil v Clevelandu tekom zadnjih dni. Po zakonu je to zločin, katerega imenujejo vandalizem, in resnici pa je le odmev gnilih ekonomskih razmer. Ker so delavci teh obrti najslabše plačani, so tudi najbolj ignorantni in najbolj nasilni.

Injunkcija proti delavcem

Okrajni sodnik Harris je izdal injunkcijo proti članom unije garažnih in "parking lot" uslužbencev, ki so pikitrali Terminal Garage na Huron rd.

Italijanski dijaki

Včeraj je dospela v Cleveland skupina 350 univerzitetnih dijakov, ki potujejo po Ameriki na stroške italijanske vlade.

HYDE PARK, N. Y., 25. sept.

Hugh S. Johnson je danes položil svojo dolgo pričakovano resignacijo kot administrator NRA katero je predsednik Roosevelt takoj sprejel. Resignacija stopi v veljavo 15. oktobra. S tem dnem bo Johnson pretrgal vse stike z Rooseveltovo administracijo, pod katero je služil zadnjih 15 mesecev. "Modri orel" in kampanja za organiziranje ameriške industrije na podlagi pravilnikov je bilo povečini Johnsonovo delo. Če bo Johnson v hodoče imel kako drugo pozicijo pri vladi, je dvomljivo.

Razmerje med Rooseveltom in Johnsonom je bilo že dalj časa hladno, da pa razboriti general ne bo več dolgo načelnik NRA, je postalo jasno pred par tedni. Takrat je imel Johnson v New Yorku govor, v katerem je brezobzirno napadel voditelje tekstilne stavke. Kot se je zvedelo, je ta govor Roosevelta zelo razdražil, kajti jasno je bilo, da taki govori niso dobra politična reklama za administracijo.

Navzlic temu pa sta se Roosevelt in Johnson na zunaj ločila kot najboljša prijatelja. Ločitev sta oba pokrila z uljudnimi frazami: Johnson je v svojem pismu, v katerem je sporočil resignacijo, navedel kot vzrok za odstop "nujne zasebne posle", ter zagotovil predsednika, da bo vsak čas na razpolago, če bi se ga kdaj v prihodnosti potrebovalo. Roosevelt je odgovoril s pismom, ki se začinja z nazivom "Dragi Hugh", nakar se zahvaljuje Johnsonu za "veliko delo", ki ga je izvršil v prvem štadiju NRA.

Jasno je, da poslovanje NRA, ki je bilo doslej v celoti podrejeno samo Johnsonu, bo v bodoče temeljito reorganizirano. Kako se bo NRA reorganiziralo, sicer ni znano, gotovo pa je, da v bodoče ne bo imel noben posameznik take oblasti kot jo je imel doslej gen. Johnson.

Sicer pa so mnogi tudi mnenja, da bo vlada v bodoče NRA igrala vedno manj važno vlogo, nekateri pa celo mislijo, da bo "Modri orel" izginil s pozorišča, in bo od vsega ogrožja, ki se ga je zgradilo pod NRA, vlada obdržala le določbe za odpravo otroškega dela, za minimalne mezde in pa za kolektivno pogajanje med delavci in delodajalci. Vse kaže, da bo vlada v bodoče prenehala z vsemi poskusi za regulacijo cen, kar pomeni, da konzumenti ostanejo brez vsake protekcije.

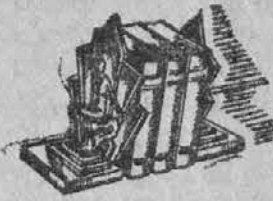

Our Campaign and Lapse Membership

Campaigns for new membership seem to be the chief weapons our Slovene organizations pit at each other in war against one another. One society cannot announce a campaign with inviting features without the others following the next opportune time. Each tries to outdo the other in striving to gain additional membership and thereby build a numerically more powerful organization. During all our campaign announcements, our explanations of attractive offers, our inducements for campaigners and our desire to supplant leadership from one another, has the most important work of fraternal organization been stressed, that of lapsed membership.

Organizations for many years have been deploring lapse of the rank without attempting to do anything concrete about the situation. True they have paid monthly assessments through funds created for such a purpose. They have used passivity with advantage, lodges have used up their funds to maintain members within ranks; but despite all these outstanding features of fraternal organizations they have failed to use methods that would inspire members to do everything in their power to continue as members without liberal support. English-conducted lodges have spent a large sum of money in trying to stimulate lodge activities as a means of preserving their membership, without any effort being spent to explain to the membership the wonderful insurance contracts they have.

One person in a hundred within our SSPZ realizes what superlative service the organization offers within the insurance policy and outside of the certificate which he possesses.

S. Howard Sieman, field manager of a sound fraternal organization, classifies three reasons for lapse of membership in our respective fraternal organizations, they are as follows: "First: Lack of planned advertising, which would have educated the public to the advantages of Fraternal Legal Reserve Life Insurance; Second: Lack of proper training and education of a field force; Third: the insidious, misrepresentation of commercial agents."

We have used some of our minimum allowance for advertising the SSPZ with greatest of success, in fact accomplished more with it than organizations that have spent two-fold our amount. We must go further with the same affectiveness. We cannot speak of a field force outside of our own membership. There is nothing organized in our method of conserving members and signing new applicants. We are in dire need of accepting a new plan of appointing field managers. We can then battle issues with commercial agents.
