LJUBLJANA, 26. septembra.—Strašna povodenj je v nedeljo in včeraj zadela slovenske kraje. Osemdeset mest, trgov in vasi je poplavljenih. Tudi Ljubljana je deloma pod vodo. Prizadeta je tudi okolica Celja in vsa hrvaška ravnina okoli Zagreba. Prebivalci v celjski okolici so izpraznili dvajset vasi.

Silno je prizadeta okolica Ribnice. Privreli so novi tokovi vode izpod zemlje in naglo poplavlili bivališča; ljudje niso imeli časa, da bi se rešili. V Strugi je utonilo najmanj 50 oseb.

BELGRAD, 26. septembra.—Prva poročila o silni katastrofi v Sloveniji in na Hrvaškem so površina, vendar je jasno toliko, da je veliko število ljudi izgubilo življenje in ikoda je ogromna. Vlada je poslala vojaštvo, ki pomaga pri rešitvah ekcijah. Povodenj je uničila vse pridelke v prizadetih krajih in voda je odnesla hiše, tovarne, mostove in druge stavbe. FIVE NEW ZEPPELINS IN NATIONAL AIR DERBY

FOUR SHOW ASTOUNDING SPEED TO TAKE PLACES AMONG LEADERS OF RACE

All Zeppelins Report Great Gains to Make Past Week Greatest in Campaign

NATIONAL AIR RACE BULLETIN

Joliet, Ill., Sept. 27—Showing all the blazing speed and brilliancy of a quartet of comets, four new zeppelins made their appearance this week in the K. S. K. J. National Air Race. Unheralded, they streaked across the high heavens to smash all existing records and throw this spirited 1,000-mile race of the skies into a thrilling free-for-all.

Hardly out of their hangars, this quartet—the KSKJ West Virginia, KSKJ California, KSKJ Connecticut and KSKJ Oregon—opened wide their powerful motors and meteorically soared by the lagging tail-enders of the race to take com-

West Virginia Second

Setting the pace for her new-comer sister ships, the KSKJ West Virginia jauntily showed her slim keel to the rest of the field as she zoomed 267 miles to pull up close on the heels of the KSKJ Wisconsin, which has held the lead since the opening gun. Bothered by motor trouble, the Wisconsin was unable to report any gain and her position remains at 345 miles, just 78 ahead of the onrushing West Virginia. Reports received here from the Wisconsin indicate the breakdown is only temporary and that the craft will soon be under way again.

This is the first time any of the air liners in the race have been within 200 miles of the pace setter.

Vieing with the West Virginia for the week's honors were the KSKJ Connecticut and the KSKJ California, who battled neck and neck throughout the entire week to wind up in a deadlock for third place. Both of the air monsters have traveled 180 miles.

Illinois Holding Pace

The KSKJ Oregon, the fourth of the upsetting levitans, cruised 125 miles to take up sixth position nine miles behind the KSKJ Illinois, which was once again thwarted in its valiant bid for second place. The Illinois, the largest of the zeppelins, advanced 37 miles to keep in the running with a total of 134 miles.

The KSKJ Kansas found the damage sustained three weeks ago more serious than expected and for the second consecutive week was unable to move forward. As a result the gallant little ship was forced to drop from the coveted runner-up post to seventh in the standings.

Following close behind is the KSKJ Indiana, which surprised race officials with a brilliant spurt of 93 miles to bring its total up to 108. The Indiana, a comparatively small craft, is highly powered and will bear watching in the race.

Pennsylvania Ninth

Maintaining her steady pace, the KSKJ Pennsylvania moved ahead 33 miles to push her silver nose just past the 100-mile marker. The Keystone flyer is the ninth ship to pass the century post.

The KSKJ Ohio, despite the fact it made its greatest advance for any week so far, was unable to weather the blistering competition and dropped from fifth to tenth place. Its total of 71 miles, however, represents a two-mile gain on the Pennsylvania, which now heads it by 30 miles.

Likewise picking up a little speed, the KSKJ Colorado doubled its previous total advance to be credited with 60 miles. Just ten miles behind is the KSKJ Michigan, the fifth new ship to enter the race during the week's flying.

The KSKJ Minnesota reported no advance and consequently dropped to the rear of the big air parade.
