



## Doma in po svetu

### PREGLED NAJVAŽNEJŠIH DOGODKOV

**Predsednik Reagan in papež Janez Pavel II. se srečala v Aljaski – Skupna prizadevanja za mir – Papež obiskuje Južno Korejo**

FAIRBANKS, Alaska; SEOUL, J. Ko. — Preteklo sredo sta se srečala na letališču v tem mestu predsednik Ronald Reagan, ki se je pravkar vrnil s 6-dnevnim obiskom v Kitajski, in papež Janez Pavel II., ki je bil na poti v Južno Korejo in druge azijske države. Srečanje je želel predvsem Reagan. Na letališču je bilo zbranih kakih 9.000 ljudi.

V nagovoru je Reagan povedal papežu, da se ZDA zanimajo za mir in tudi za boj zoper lakoto in bolezen po vsem svetu. Reagan je rekel, da je pripravljen poslati v Vatikan posebno delegacijo, ki se bi pogovarjala z vatikanskimi predstavniki o ameriških programih pomoči lačnim po svetu. Predstavniki Vatikana bi pa seznanjali Amerikance o programih Cerkve s tem v zvezi. Cilj teh pogovorov bi bil skupen nastop zoper lakoto in bolezen, je pojasnil Reaganov predstavnik za tisk Larry Speakes.

Reagan in papež sta tudi govorila o predsednikovem obisku v Kitajski. Menda je papež upal, da bo imel Reagan kaj povedati o položaju Cerkve na Kitajskem, vendar o tem poročila ne govorijo. Vatikan ima težave s kitajskim režimom glede delovanja Cerkve v Kitajski, ker želi režim, da bi bili katoliški duhovniki in tudi hierarhija odvisna predvsem od političnih oblasti. Beseda je tekla tudi o Poljski in Srednji Ameriki.

Po srečanju z Reaganom, je papež nadaljeval pot na Južno Korejo, kjer se bo mudil pet dni. V svojem prvem govoru po prihodu v Seoul je Janez Pavel II. izrazil željo, da bo kdaj prišlo do združitve obeh delov Koreje. Rekel je tudi, da upa, da bo prišlo do več politične demokracije v obeh delih ločene države. Študentje, ki obiskujejo univerzo Sungkjung, so demonstrirali proti vladi, policija pa je uporabila solzilni plin. Danes bo papež obiskal južno mesto Kwangju. V državi je okoli dva milijona katoličanov.

**To nedeljo predsedniške volitve v El Salvadorju – Možnost zmage desničarskega kandidata Roberta d'Aubuissona**

SAN SALVADOR, El Sal. — To nedeljo bodo v tej državi predsedniške volitve, na katerih tekmuje dva kandidata, ki sta bila dobila največ glasov na volitvah pred meseci, na katerih pa noben kandidat ni dobil absolutne večine. Kandidirata Jose Napoleon Duarte, ki je politični sredinec, in ki menda ima komaj prikrito podporo ameriške vlade, in pa desničar Roberto d'Aubuisson, o katerem so sicer nepotrjene govorice, da vodi desničarske morilske skupine, katere ubijajo osebe, osumljene levičarstva. D'Aubuisson trdi, da so take trditve izmišljotine prav levičarjev oz. komunistov.

Opazovalci el salvadorskih razmer govorijo o možni zmagi d'Aubuissona, kar smatrajo v State Departmentu, Beli hiši in tudi zveznem kongresu za pravo katastrofo. Razporeditev do El Salvadorja v kongresu je že itak odklonilna, prihod na oblast d'Aubuissona bi lahko imel za nadaljevanje ameriške vloge v tej državi daljnosežne posledice, pravijo poznavali razmer na kapitolskem hribu. Okrepljeni bi bili predvsem tisti kongresniki, ki nasprotujejo ameriški pomoči »diktatorski vladi« v El Salvadorju. V Beli hiši se tega dobro zavedajo, zato želijo, da bi zmaga! na volitvah Duarte. Zadnja beseda bo pa izrečena v El Salvadorju.

**Obrambni tajnik Caspar Weinberger pripravljen pristati na določeno omejitev izdatkov za obrambne namene ZDA**

WASHINGTON, D. C. — Včeraj je obrambni tajnik ZDA Caspar Weinberger poslal senatnemu odboru za vojaške zadeve izjavo, v kateri je povedal, da je pripravljen pristati na določeno omejitev že predlaganih izdatkov za obrambne namene ZDA in sicer kot prispevek k zmanjševanju ogromnega proračunskega primanjkljaja. Weinberger je rekel, da bi bilo mogoče črtati iz predlaganih izdatkov obrambnega tajništva za fiskalno leto 1985 14,4 milijarde dolarjev.

V zveznem kongresu so pa nezadovoljni z Weinbergerjevem predlogom. Dejstvo je, pravijo, da je rast izdatkov za vojaške namene zadnja leta poglavitni vzrok za zgodovinsko velike proračunske primanjkljaje. V od zvezne vlade predlaganem proračunu za leto 1985 na primer, bi bili izdatki za vojsko večji kar za 13% v realnih cenah v primerjavi z l. 1984. Tudi, ako bi zvezni kongres odobril Weinbergerjev načrt, bi bili izdatki večji za 7,8%. Kongresniki, med njimi tudi mnogi, ki podpirajo močno vojsko, želijo znatneje omejiti te izdatke, Weinberger in tudi predsednik Reagan pa trdita, da so predlagani izdatki nujno potrebni za zagotovitev varnosti ZDA.

**Presenetljivo obsežne demonstracije na Poljskem – V Gdansk Lech Walesa sam demonstriral – Policija strogo ukrepala**

VARŠAVA, Polj. — V dneh 1. in 2. maja je prišlo v mnogih poljskih mestih do demonstracij oporečnikov in tistih, ki še vedno podpirajo prepovedano delavsko gibanje Solidarnost. Najbolj so bile oblasti razburjene v obalnem mestu Gdansk, kjer se je demonstracije 1. maja udeležil sam Lech Walesa, ki je sicer pod stalnim policijskim nadzorstvom. Walesa in drugi pristaši Solidarnosti so se namreč pomešali z udeleženci od oblasti organiziranega pohoda. Ko so korakali mimo tribuno, na kateri so stali predstavniki oblasti, so pa začeli vzklikati gesla v podporo Solidarnosti. Oblastniki so osupnili, ko so jih zagledali.

Danes potuje v Moskvo na obisk gen. Wojciech Jaruzelski. Najbrž bo poročal o najnovejših dogodkih sovjetskim voditeljem.

**Sirija zadržuje tri Izraelce, ujeta v Libanonu – Izraelska vlada zahteva njih izročitev**

BEJRUT, Libanon — Pretekli tork so vojaki libanonske vojske ujeli tri Izraelce, potem jih izročili Siriji. Zakaj so bili Izraelci v severnem Libanonu še ni pojasnjeno, Sirijci pa trdijo, da so Izraelci vohuni in da so imeli s seboj opremo, ki jo uporabljajo vohuni. Sirijska izjava trdi, da bodo ujetniki smatrani za vojne ujetnike in »saboterje«.

Izraelska vlada zahteva vrnitev ujetih oseb in trdi, da je za zadevo odgovorna libanonska vlada. Čeprav so razmere v Libanonu mirnejše zadnji čas, ko so v teku priprave za ustanovitev enotne osrednje vlade, je še vedno veliko napetosti med Izraelom in Sirijo. Najnovejši incident bo to napetost samo poostril, pravijo opazovalci razmer, čeprav soglašajo, da do obsežnejšega vojaškega spopada med Izraelom in Sirijo najbrž ne bo prišlo. Kot kaže, je Sirija v močnejšem vojaškem položaju napram Izraelu kot v preteklosti. Sovjetska zveza je namreč poslala v Sirijo zelo sodobno orožje, v Siriji pa je več tisoč sovjetskih vojaških strokovjakov oz. svetovalcev.

## Izdana revolucija

Nedavno se je vrnil iz Nikaragve v Italijo 28-letni Salvatore Napoli, ki je v tej težko preizkušeni državi preživel skoraj deset let. Kar je tam doživel, ga je nagnilo, da je ustanovil z nekaj prijatelji »Odbor za uveljavljanje človeških pravic v Srednji Ameriki«. Njegove izjave ob tej priliki je objavil italijanski dnevnik *L'Avvenire*.

Leta 1972, kmalu po njegovem prihodu v Nikaragvo, je hud potres razdejal prestolnico Managua. Tedaj je bilo na tisoče mrtvih. V začetku se je seznanil s Somozovo diktaturo. Oblast v deželi je imelo kakih 40 družin, vsakične volitve so bile ponarejene. Toda, dodaja, svoboda izražanja je bila precejšnja in hrane ni manjkalo. Tudi šolska vzgoja je imela krščanski pečat.

Leta 1979 je tako imenovana sandinistična revolucija sredi poletja pregnala Somozo. Toda Sandino ni bil nikak komunist, boril se je le za pravice ljudstva. Današnja fronta narodne osvoboditve pa zlorablja Sandinovo ime. Namesto enega diktatorja, Somoze, jih je sedaj devet. Na oblast so prišli z lažjo in nasiljem. Ko se jim Joaquín Chamorro, katoliški časnikar z demokratično nastrojenostjo, med ljudstvom zelo priljubljen, ker se je s pogumom v svojem časopisu spoprijel s Somozovim režimom in bil tudi zaprt, ni hotel pridružiti, so ga ubili, za umor pa obtožili Somozov režim. Računali so, da enkrat odstranjen Chamorro, bi lahko dvignil narod zoper diktatorski režim. In so tudi uspeli.

Bil je nato priča, kako je začela prihajati pomoč s Kube in je sandinistični režim orožje pošiljal naprej levi gverili v El Salvadorju. Govoril je s premnogimi od ljudstva. Vsi so mu ponavljali: v Nikaragvi ni več svobode. Kdor ne misli kot onih »devet«, ga razglasijo za agenta ameriške obveščevalne službe CIA in zaprejo. Revščina je vedno večja. Nikaragva, svoj čas izvoznik riža, fižola, kave, sira, mesa in bombaža je danes v gospodarskem razsulu.

Kar se tiče pravih komunističnih gveril, je v neprestanem porastu. Laž je, da jo pogojujejo somozisti. Teh je samo 2 odstotka. Gverila deluje s severa in z juga. V zadnjem času sta se obe skupini povezali v enotno nastopanje.

Režim si skuša podvreči Cerkev. Zato se zavzema za tako imenovano ljudsko Cerkev, ki pa jo podpira le 3% prebivalstva. Obisk papeža je močno okreplil krščansko zavest vernikov. Imeli so občutek, da jim je prinesel svobodo. Že pred papeževim prihodom je bilo znano, da bodo sandinisti papeževu mašo izrabili za svojo propagando. Tako se je tudi zgodilo, toda množice, ki so jih oblasti držale proč od kraja prireditve, so z vzklikanjem izrazile svojo privrženost papežu. Škofje so zelo pogumni in ne molčijo. Tako so v kraju Juigalpa sandinisti s kamenjem napadli škofa Vega, ker je javno ožigosal zločine in krivice sedanjega režima.

Napoli zaključuje svoje poročilo: »Prepričan sem, da se bo ljudstvo kmalu dvignilo zoper nasilnike. Režim je v vedno večjih težavah, ne bo več dolgo trajal. Prav zato se je treba pripraviti na trenutek, ko se bo zrušil. Praznino, ki bo nastala, bo treba napolniti z novimi ljudmi. Upajmo, da bodo to pot to resnični demokrati in dosledni kristjani.«

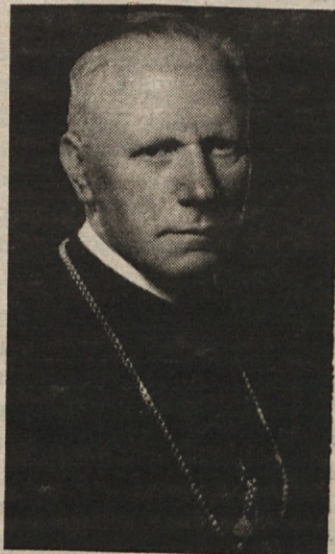

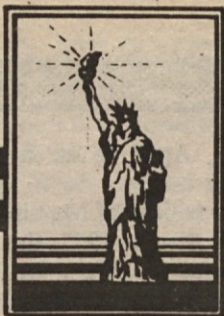

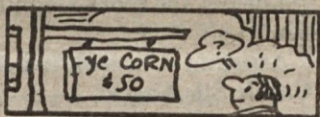

# Recipes

## BIG EVENT BEEF BAKE

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 1/4 cup chopped green pepper
- 2 tablespoons butter or margarine
- 1 can (10 3/4 ounces) condensed cream of mushroom soup
- 1 can (10 3/4 ounces) tomato soup
- 1 soup can water
- 1 clove garlic, mashed
- 8 ounces spaghetti
- 1 cup shredded sharp cheese

In large skillet cook beef, onion and green pepper in butter until meat is lightly browned and vegetables are tender; stir often to separate meat. Add soups, water and garlic; heat. Meanwhile, cook spaghetti as directed on package; drain. In 2 1/2-quart casserole combine spaghetti, meat mixture, and 1/2 cup cheese; top with remaining cheese. Bake at 350°F. about 30 minutes or until hot and bubbling. Makes 4 to 6 servings.

## SALLY LUNN

The original Sally Lunn cake was baked in Bath, England in the early 1800's and named after the woman who first sold them.

- 1/2 cup warm water (105-115-degrees)
- 1 package active dry yeast
- 1 cup warm milk
- 1/2 cup softened margarine
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 3 eggs, well beaten (room temperature)
- 5 1/2 to 6 cups all-purpose flour

Measure warm water into large warm bowl. Sprinkle in yeast, stir until dissolved. Add milk, margarine, sugar, salt, and eggs.

Stir in 3 cups flour. Beat until well-blended, about 1 minute. Stir in enough remaining flour to make a soft dough. Cover and let rise in warm place, free from drafts, until doubled in bulk, about 1 hour.

Stir down; spoon into well-greased and floured 10-inch tube pan or two well-greased 9 by 5 by 3-inch loaf pans. Cover and let rise in warm place, free from draft, until double in bulk, about 1 hour.

Bake a large loaf in preheated 400-degree oven for 30 minutes, or until done. Bake small loaves at 375-degrees about 30 minutes, or until done. Remove from pans and cool on wire racks.

## LOUISA'S APPLE SLUMP

Louisa May Alcott, the author of "Little Women" was so fond of this New England dessert that she named her house in Massachusetts, apple slump.

- 6 cups apples, pared and cored and sliced
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1/2 cup water
- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 cup light cream

Combine apple slices, sugar, cinnamon and water in a saucepan with tight fitting lid. Heat to the boiling point.

Sift together dry ingredients. Stir in enough cream to make a soft dough. Drop dough from a tablespoon onto apple mixture.

Cover tightly and cook over low heat for 30 minutes. Serve warm with a nutmeg sauce or rich cream. A dip of vanilla ice cream would be good, too.

## Nutmeg sauce

- 1 cup sugar
- 1 tablespoon flour
- 1 cup boiling water
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1 teaspoon nutmeg

Mix together sugar and flour. Stir in boiling water and cook, stirring constantly, until sauce bubbles and thickens slightly. Add butter and simmer gently for 5 minutes. Remove from heat and stir in nutmeg. Serve hot.

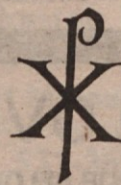
