Povračilo z enako mero?

Vse zakonodaje starega Vzhoda, Mojzesova, Hamurabijev zakonik in rimsko pravo so dovoljevale povračilo z enako mero. Ljudje so vračali milo za drago. V Jezusovem času se je uveljavilo poravnavanje sporov in razžalitev v denarju. Osnovno načelo, ki se mu je Jezus zoperstavil, pa je ostalo isto. Kaj Jezus uči drugačnega?

Kristus se obrača na ranjenega, razžaljenega človeka. Njegovo prizadevanje, hrepenenje po pravici ni nikoli popolnoma upravičeno. Na dnu srca klije seme maščevalnosti. Jezus svari pred željo, da sočloveku vrne vse storjene krivice. Navkljub pregovoru je maščevanje bolečina: kazen rojeva novo kazen, vse se ponavlja v sklenjenem krogu. Ali Jezus opozarja, da je tudi »pravično naložena« kazen krivična? Ali je naš način kaznovanja in vzgoje primeren ter uspešen. Jezus je imel v mislih božjo zamisel: svet naj bi postal skupen dom, v katerem bodo ljudje živeli povezani v solidarnosti in razumevanju. Ne zago-varja popustljivosti, strahopetne ustrežljivosti. Otroci luči morajo biti ljudje dobre volje, brez zahrbtnih namenov. Pozabiti moramo na svoje potrošniške izgovore. Jezus opozarja na razsodnost, ki bo izbojevala resnično zmago. Člo-vek, ki se mu je zgodila krivica, naj ne posnema hudobneža; naj ne sprejema »svetnih« norm. Mogoče se bo pri tem poboljšal tudi zatiralec, če že ne takoj, pa ob pogledu na trpečega. PRIDE AND HOPE

I am also proud of the support and activism of Slovenians in Hamilton and other countries around the world as they quickly rose up to support the Slovenian fight for independence and support it politically, financially and morally. During that dangerous and ultimately, exhilarating time there was a great spirit of unity among all Slovenians worldwide.

I hope that spirit can be renewed and sustained into the future by the younger generations.

I am proud of the Slovenians who came to the Hamilton area.

There are many notable accomplishments whose story must be told and re-told to the youth of the next generation so that they can appreciate them.

Ask them this: "As a person born here, can you imagine departing your country of birth and being placed in a far off foreign country with no knowledge of the local language, few resources or knowledge of local laws and customs and in less than one generation building thriving multi-million dollar facilities to support Slovenian spiritual, social and cultural needs?"

As an example, my father came to this country as a refugee with one suitcase with one change of clothes in it and \$20 in his wallet. By working hard, he built himself a successful life here and also contributed many hours to the various activities within the Slovenian community. His is not an unusual story among Slovenians coming to Canada in the 1950's.

Slovenians are by nature a hard working people. This is, in fact, a measurable statement – just before

their independence from Yugoslavia, Slovenians represented 8% of the population of the county but produced 20% of the gross domestic product – in other words each Slovenian produced 2.5 times more than the other citizens.

In 1961, the American President John Kennedy said during his inaugural address **"ask not what your country can do for you; ask what you can do for your country"**.

It is evident that many Slovenians in the Hamilton area have taken this approach to life – they have contributed uncountable volunteer hours in serving their community.

In one generation of immigration to Canada, Slovenians have built excellent facilities to assist in the preservation of a Slovenian cultural identity. Then they developed programs like the Slovenian school, choir, folklore group, credit unions etc., organized and staffed primarily by volunteers.

Recently, while I was preparing a display for a function at the parish hall, I was approached by a young girl about 12 years old and asked how much I was being paid to do this work. Frankly, I was shocked by the question. I hope this incident was an unusual one and that we are doing a better job of instilling a volunteer ethic in our young generation for the good of our community.

The next generation has been presented a great gift and advantage in that, the physical facilities are already complete and are ready to be utilized. Only time and participation in the existing programs and/or development of new programs is necessary.

I hope young parents and youth become more and more involved – take advantage of what is here and invent or re-invent what is needed. The way forward is not always easy and convenient – certainly many people have some distance to drive to take advantage of the facilities - but in the end, the effort is worthwhile and rewarding.

7TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Response: **The Lord is merciful and gracious!**

First Reading Leviticus 19:1-2, 17-18

We are to be holy as God is holy.

Second Reading 1 Corinthians 3:16-23

The Spirit of God lives among us for we are God's temple.

Gospel Matthew 5:38-48

We are to be perfect just as our heavenly Father is perfect.

"Be holy, for I, the Lord your God, am holy."

We are living through four years of remembering the hundredth anniversary of the events of the First World War. We rely mainly on black-and-white photos and films, which capture the dark and relentless nature of the conflict. The overwhelming image is that of the young men who went out boldly to fight in what turned out to be a style of warfare that had reached stalemate. Many of them did not return, and many of those who did return were marked physically and mentally for life.

Yet in the midst of this massacre of minds and bodies there were acts of heroism. Medals were given for acts of valour against the enemy, but the acts of heroism that stay longer in the mind are the acts of self-sacrifice that people made for the injured and those in need. Soldiers carried colleagues and even their enemies out of the living hell of no-man's-land, sometimes wounded themselves but determined to bring the wounded back to help and healing.



Among the acts of violence and desperation there was yet room for these higher ideals. Men flung themselves on explosives to save the lives of their comrades, held on to impossible positions to give others the chance to escape, literally gave up their lives that others might live. And behind the front, and back home, battalions of women nursed the wounded and attempted to bring them back to health and sanity from this world that had lost all reason.

Gospel Teaching

We sometimes think that the law of love belongs to the New Testament whereas the *lex talionis* or the law of retribution, "an eye for an eye", dominates the Old Testament. Yet today we see in the book of Leviticus the injunction not to exact vengeance but to love our neighbour as ourselves. The challenge addressed by Jesus takes this commandment a step further. He acknowledges that even the tax collectors and pagans are neighbourly to those who are good to them. The difficult question is, how do we react to those who are our enemies and those who treat us badly?

In the Sermon on the Mount, which has formed our Gospel readings over the last few Sundays, Jesus is explaining what the Beatitudes mean in practice. What does it mean to be meek? What does it mean to be merciful? You wonder whether lurking at the back of his mind is the awareness of what his commitment to us, who are sinners, is going to demand of him at the end of his life. Is the

passion already in his consciousness? It is certainly there in the awareness of the Gospel writers, who are writing as it were backwards, trying to explain how those great salvific events of death and resurrection came about. They came about because Jesus is capable of obeying his own injunction to love his enemies and pray for his persecutors. It is in this way he shows us how to be perfect, just as his heavenly Father is perfect.

Application

When faced with words such as "holiness" or "perfection", our first reaction may be to distance ourselves from them. Such terms belong to saints. They don't come into the orbit of our everyday world. It is true that we are not required to live at these heights every moment. Moral theologians used to make a distinction between behaviours that were required of us to be good rather than bad and behaviours that were counsels of perfection, those acts of self-sacrifice that probably belonged only to the few. Jesus does not make such distinctions. He asks us to consider that, if we are his true followers, we all have the potential to respond at this level. We can all follow in his footsteps.

It is not behaviour we can chart accurately in advance. The times when we are asked to give of ourselves so utterly are few and far between. But we prepare ourselves for such challenges by the way we live through the day-to-day moments of our lives. If we think of others rather than ourselves, if we are not overwhelmed when others fail to notice us or even treat us with respect, when we are sensitive to others' needs as well as our own, especially those who are not close to us or with whom we have little in common, through all those moments we are becoming the disciples of Christ, disciples who are learning to be perfect just as our heavenly Father is perfect.
