Kakšen jarem?

V Jezusovem povabilu odkrivamo blagoslov, zven zvonov, ki usmerja romarje proti cilju. Kdo vse je povabljen? Vsi, ki vztrajajo pri napornem delu. Resnično breme življenja niso le krivice, materialno izkorisčanje. Človeka vedno razjeda bivanjski strah in ga bremenijo z grehi obtežene vesti. Vendar Jezus blagoslavja vse! Ta trditev nas bega. Jezus jo lahko izreka, kajti ima večjo avtoriteto, kot pa je avtoriteta zakona; samo Jezusove besede so prepričljive in verodostojne.

Jezus odstranja breme predpisov in nesmiselnih ritualov. Pozna edino zakon ljubezni. Človek naj ljubi Boga, ki se razodeva v Jezusu, in od Njega bo prejel moč, da mu bo sledil. Namesto napuha nastopa ponijenost srca. Spoznavamo novo svobodo božjih otrok. Namesto obupa nad grehi se sedaj človeku z odpuščanjem odpira novo, večno življenje. Vera človeka osvobaja strahov in bremen v vsakdanjem življenju. Z odpiranjem Kristusu človek odkriva samega sebe. To novo odpiranje življenju ni pristajanje na brezdelnost, ni mrtvičenje telesa in duha. V njegovo srce se sedaj naseli mir. Nihče ne pozna Očeta kakor le Sin. In Sin nam podarja svoj mir.

Ljudje, ki so poslušali Jezusa, so bili v sponah predpisov. Jezus jim predлага, naj zamenjajo okove. Uporablja rabinsko prispolobo religije kot jarma postave. Kot tesar je sam izdeloval volovsko vprego. Sedaj vabi nas: Vzemite ... Ponuja nam blagoslovljeni jarem. Naša narava je ustvarjena za izkazovanje spoštovanja. Kdor je nezvest Bogu, mora prenašati jarem grenkobe in nemira. Polnost življenja dosežemo le v zvestobi.

Kako naj opišemo jarem? Gre za jarem vere. Čeprav nam je vera podarjena, čeprav nam grehe odpušča Bog, so pomembne naše besede: »To verujem in tako bom živel.« Človek se odloči, da bo ravnal tako, kot pričakuje Bog. Gre za jarem ljubezni, jarem osebne vdanosti Kristusu. Človek premaguje svoj ponos in samozaverovanost in ponižen vztraja pred Bogom.

»Učite se od mene - iz mojih besed, predvsem pa iz celotnega mojega življenja«, so Jezusove besede in Njegovo povabilo. Blagoslovljeno breme, ki je olajšalo vsa bremena.

Neka legenda opisuje, kako so se ptice, ki ob stvarjenju niso imele kril, uprle dodatnemu bremenu. Ko so jih vendarle sprejele, jih je breme poneslo v nebo. Kristusov jarem so krila za človekovo dušo. Jarem, ki ga je nosil tudi on sam. »Ne moja, ampak tvoja volja se zgodi.«

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14. nedelja med letom

V današnji evangeljski priliki je natančno opisano seme, ne pa sejalec, ki je mogoče sejal blizu kraja, kjer je bila zbrana množica. S semenom so predstavljene štiri osnovne skupine ljudi. Nekateri so brezbrizni, otopeli. Verjetno se ne znajdejo v okolju, ki jih je ranilo. Mogoče se sami sebi smilijo. Vse gre narobe, svet se je zarotil zoper nje: ne najdejo primernega kraja za bivališče. Samo lemež velike nesreče, propad nekaterih med njimi, bo predrl klubovanje zemlje - okolja. Mogoče je tukaj opravičilo za polomije in razočaranja.

Drugi so zelo površni, brez pravega duha. Čeprav so dobro seme, jim primanjkuje globine. Zadovoljni so že z majceno razpokico v skali in prgiščem zemlje v njej. Hitro se vnamejo in »poženejo kvišku«. Njihova vnema pa kmalu splahni. Kako naj taki ljudje odkrijejo globino? Sedaj sedijo in opazujejo; mogoče celo Gospoda na križu. Samo dolgotrajno božje trplje-nje jim lahko pri tem pomaga.

Spet drugi so v sebi razdeljeni. Lahko so sijajni kristjani: prejeli so veliko darov, odlikuje jih gorečnost. Ob tem hrepene po svetu. Padajo v greh, posvetnost jim duši resnično življenje - dokler jih resnična tragedija ne prečisti.

Nekaj semena pa je padlo na dobro zemljo in je dajalo sad; nektero stoternega, nekatero šetdeseternega in nekatero trideseternega. To niso

prazne besede. »Bog namreč ni tako krivičen, da bi pozabil na vaše delo in ljubezen, kakršno ste skazali njegovemu imenu« (Heb 6,10). Tu je odgovor na bridko vprašanje o smi-selnosti vsega. Vsaka dobra beseda, vsakršno dobro delo obrodi sad, postaja novo veselo oznanilo, ki ga Bog sprejema.

V tem je jedro celotne prilike. Evangelij se nam dozdeva tako neznaten in slaboten, kot je šibko seme, ki pade v tuji svet. Ali ima sploh kakšno prihodnost med posvetnostmi in mlačnimi ljudmi? Ima in zaradi skrivnostne življenjske energije ne bo propadlo. Sejalec mora sezati, četudi bo nekaj semena padlo na kamnito zemljo. Zmeraj so med nami ljudje, ki pričakujejo Gospoda. Zanje smo mi odgovorni!

Kdor ima ušesa, naj posluša! Seme je dobro in tudi sejalcu lahko zaupamo. Uspeh pa je odvisen predvsem od zemlje. Jezus je upo-rabil pregovor, ki mu je priostril pomen.

Slišimo, poslušamo - čemu? Prisluhnemo preroški resnici, to pa je tudi vse, kar smo storili. Norčujemo se iz prerokov, ker nam sporočajo neprijetno resnico. Zahtevamo balzam, odprti imamo obe ušesi - skozi enega gredo opomini noter, skozi drugega ven. Naša odgovornost pred Bogom pa je velika: »Dolžni smo prenašati slabosti šibkih, ne pa iskatи lastno ugodje« (Rim 15,1). Vsak izmed nas se zaveda, da ni prejel premoženja samo zase. »Kako more biti božja ljubezen v človeku, ki ima premoženje in vidi, da je brat v pomanjkanju, pa zapira svoje srce pred njim« (1 Jn 3,17)? Pozabljamo pa na dar, da slišimo in razumemo Jezusov nagovor. Prav zato nam pripoveduje priliko o semenu in zemlji: tisti, ki posluša, lahko uresniči evangelijske besede, lahko pa sporočeno tudi zavrže.

Kdor ima ušesa ... Gre za opomin, da smo vsi ljudje sposobni poslušati. Kdor pa ima tako občutljiva ušesa, kot npr. glasbenik, da sliši tudi vse podtone resnice; njegova odgovornost je toliko večja. »Od vsakega, ki mu je bilo veliko dano, se bo veliko zahtevalo, in komur je bilo veliko zaupano, se bo od njega toliko več terjalo« (Lk 12,48).

14TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Response: I will bless your name for ever, my King and my God.

First Reading Zechariah 9:9-10

The prophet shares a vision of the forthcoming joyful reign of a servant king and calls all to be jubilant in anticipation.

Second Reading Romans 8:9, 11-13

We are called to live a life according to the spirit of the living God, who resides in each one of us and makes us God's sons and daughters.

Gospel Matthew 11:25-30

Jesus knows the heart of the Father and reflects that tenderness to all, who, drawn low by the pressure of life, trust in him.

"You will find rest for your souls."

In the 2013 film *Tangerines*, nominated for an Academy Award in the category of best foreign language film, Ivo, an Estonian carpenter, is living in the war-torn territory of Abkhazia in Georgia during the conflict of 1992–1993. Following a firefight outside his house, Ivo takes in two men who have been badly injured. One is a Chechen mercenary on the Abkhazian side, the other is a Georgian volunteer. Sworn enemies, they both vow to kill each other when they are strong enough. Ivo, their rescuer, will have nothing of their fighting talk and, through his gift of hospitality and gentle care, he begins to humanise them. Slowly, each man begins to respect

the other, until finally they protect each other as they both come under attack from a new source.

The beauty of the film is the gentleness of Ivo, who knows the pain of loss, having seen his own son die in the conflict. Ivo penetrates the poison of hatred through his attention to his unexpected guests, always respecting their dignity. He is a true refuge in a time of pain and sorrow. He gives a good example of selfless love.

Gospel Teaching

Jesus reveals an interesting paradox in today's Gospel reading, which is that great learning, or a high IQ, is no guarantee of knowing the deepest truth. Jesus reveals to us the heart of the Father, and knowledge of this is something that comes to us as pure gift. We do not have to be at the highest echelons of academia to come to this awareness. Instead, the Father, in his great generosity, makes it known to whomsoever he wishes, in the power of the Holy Spirit, through Jesus. Those to whom the Father reveals his truth and who respond to it are rightly called "children" because they become members of God's family.

At the core of Jesus' ministry is a compassion that reflects the tender love at the heart of the Godhead. Jesus' invitation for all those who are struggling to come to him is an active one. Jesus holds out his hand, drawing us to himself, so that we may follow in his footsteps. Putting on Christ is not burdensome. However, following Jesus and growing in discipleship require that we know that we are yoked to him. Then, learning from Jesus, and revelling in his gentle and humble heart, we can start to appreciate how the vision of the kingdom in today's first reading is not only a real possibility, but something already in our midst and something worth working for.

Application

Coming to Christ and knowing his loving care is an amazing experience. We have perhaps all heard stories about people being down and out and then meeting Jesus in the midst of their desperation. We do not have to look far for such witnesses. There are many accounts of people who have encountered the tender mercy and kind compassion of God.

It is one thing to talk about how Jesus has been so generous with us, offering us shelter in the midst of our crises. It is another thing to become that which we have received. Are we prepared to become like Christ by seeking to be a safe haven ourselves?

In our baptism we are called to be Christ-like. So being people who can embrace and hold safe those who are struggling will hopefully be high on our list of priorities. This may appear difficult, even dangerous, but being a place of refuge for those who need comfort need not be as risky as it sounds. It does not necessarily call for us to open up our homes – though some may be called to do that. But it asks us to open our hearts. Even though our hearts may feel inadequate and conflicted, we can trust that Christ, dwelling deep within, can communicate his tenderness through us. All we have to do is to trust him and allow some of our natural gifts of hospitality to be built upon by grace.

For many of us who live busy lives, we meet people every day who need a listening ear, or a shoulder to cry on, or some gentle encouragement. Let us not be afraid to reflect the love of the Father by reaching out to them. The Holy Spirit will guide us and Jesus will touch their hearts. Then we will show we are truly his disciples as we embrace others in the way that he did.

15TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Response: The seed that fell on good soil produced a hundredfold.

First Reading Isaiah 55:10-11

God's word succeeds in what it is sent to do.

Second Reading Romans 8:18-23

We ourselves and the whole of creation retain the hope of freedom and glory.

Gospel Matthew 13:1-23

Christ, the Word of God, the seed of the sower, produces an astonishing crop.

"Imagine a sower going out to sow."

Catch people's attention with your first sentence" is the advice offered to public speakers. The same is true for preachers. If we send you to sleep at the beginning of a homily there is not much hope of getting your concentration at all. A teacher may be able to employ visual aids to grab the students' attention. Public speakers often use digital presentations. But

priests don't usually have these advantages. At seminary we are encouraged to begin homilies with a good story, though it isn't always easy to think of one. Occasionally some local or national event, with implications for the faith, may put an idea for a homily into our minds.

Perhaps something like this once happened when Jesus was preaching. His mother and relations appeared at the back of the crowd, anxious to have a word with him. Someone pushed through the throng to tell Jesus, who stretched out his hands towards his disciples, saying, "Here are my mother and my brothers. Anyone who does the will of my Father in heaven, he is my brother and sister and mother." That same day, a little later, Jesus told his famous parable of the sower, and it seems it may have been the sudden appearance of his mother that inspired him to preach it.

Gospel Teaching

In Jesus' day, farmers in Palestine suspended a large bag of seed from their necks and, walking up and down the field, threw the seeds out with both hands as far as they could. Inevitably some seed fell on the edge of the path, some landed on rocks, others among thorns. But other seed landed in rich soil where it produced a great crop. It is one of the few parables that Jesus explains in detail. The seed is the word of God. Some of the scattered seed inevitably bears no fruit when people don't understand it, or if they get overwhelmed by trials or persecution, or with "the worries of this world" and the "lure of riches". But the great point of the parable is that the word of God produces a bumper crop, maybe thirty or sixty per cent, some even one hundred per cent. It is powerful. Palestinian farmers thought they had done well if their seeds yielded seven per cent. Ten per cent was a great harvest, thirty per cent unheard of. Perhaps Jesus had his mother in mind when he

spoke of a hundredfold response. She above all others heard the word of God and kept it. "Let it be to me according to your word," she said, and never for a moment did she ever deviate from that fidelity and love.

Application

Where are we in all this? If we are tempted to think that we belong among the seed that fell on the edge of the path or on the rocks or among weeds, think again. Jesus did not relate this parable to discourage us, but rather the reverse, to emphasise that there is no limit to what God's grace can do in us, what God can make of us, and what goodness and fruit God can produce.

Of course we are realistically aware of our faults, for, as St Paul said, "all of us who possess the first-fruits of the Spirit... groan inwardly as we wait for our bodies to be set free". There is a struggling, a breaking away from the things that hold us back. We may fall, but we rise again, praying, "Lord, have mercy." The saints, like Our Lady, never look down on us with our sixty or thirty per cent. They do not regard us as failures. The fact is that we all vary. Some do become wonderful saints; we ask them to pray for us and we can learn from them as role models. There are other people, maybe not saints, whom we nonetheless admire for their goodness, love and kindness. But in all the struggles and temptations of our life Jesus tells us never to be discouraged. We may sometimes feel we are just hanging on to Jesus by our fingertips; in reality he is the one who is holding on to us, because he loves us. As the Lord declared to Isaiah, "the word that goes from my mouth does not return to me empty, without carrying out my will and succeeding in what it was sent to do". Mary said the same: "Nothing is impossible to God."
