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GOSPODOV SLUŽABNIK - LUČ IN JAGNJE BOŽJE

Misel današnjega evanglijja je nakazana še v prvem berilu, ki govorji o poslanstvu božjega služabnika: gre za poslanstvo, ki se razprostira do skrajnih meja zemlje. Drugo berilo nam delno zamejuje razsežnost tega poslanstva: Pavel govorji o tistih, ki kwersibodi kličejo Gospodovo ime. Evangelij nam predstavlja Janeza, ki je prihajajočega Jezusa zelo pomenljivo opredelil: »Glejte, Jagnje Božje, ki odjemlje greh sveta.« Jezus je bil na videz navaden človek, tesarjev sin iz Nazareta; vendar ga Janez, navdihnen po Svetem Duhu, prepozna in opredeli v tem svetu.

Kako ga je mogel prepozнатi? To nam razloži sam: imel je videnje. »Nisem ga poznal,« pavi Janez, »vendar tisti, ki me je poslal krščevat z vodo, mi je rekel: 'Človek, nad katerim boš videl, da se spušča in ostaja Duh, je tisti, ki krščuje v Svetem Duhu'.« Predhodnik je imel božje znamenje, da je prepoznal Jezusa. Ko je bil Jezus krščen, se je Sveti Duh predstavil v telesni obliki kot golob in je ostal nad njim.

Krst v Svetem Duhu namreč predstavlja dve stvari kot potrjuje Pavel, Duh pričuje o našem duhu, da smo božji sinovi. Po drugi strani pa je Duh tisti, ki prečiščuje, ki odvzema grehe. Ko se je vstali Jezus prikazal učencem, jim je rekel: »Prejmite Svetega Duha; komur grehe odpustite, so jim odpuščeni« (Jn 20,23).

Janez je videl in sedaj pričuje, da je Jezus Božje jagnje, ki odjemlje grehe sveta. Jagnje je daritvena žrtev. V dogodku, ki ga imenujemo Abrahamova daritev, je Izak vprašal očeta: »Tu je ogenj in drva, vendar kje je jagnje za daritev?« (1Mz 22,7). In Abraham, navdihnen po Svetem Duhu, mu je odgovoril: »Bog si bo preskrbel jagnje za žgalno daritev, moj sin« (1Mz 22,8). Na videz bi se lahko ta prerokba nanašala na ovno, ki ga je Abraham našel v bližini, potem ko mu je angel prepovedal žrtvovati Izaka; v resnici pa je ta oven le podoba, nikakor ni pravo jagnje, ki ga je Bog pripravil za pravo žrtvovanje, za pravo daritev, ki je sposobna brisati grehe.



Starozavezna darovanja ne morejo odvzemati grehov: »Nemogoče je namreč, da bi grehe odvzema-la kri volov in kozlov« (Heb 10,4). V tem primeru gre za živali, ki so jih žrtvovali popolnoma brez zavesti, in torej nimajo nikakršne globlje povezave ne z Bogom ne s človeško zavestjo. Jezus pa je bil, kot Božje jagnje žrtvovan z osebno daritvijo: daroval je sam sebe kot brezmadežno žrtev in tako je izrinil greh.

Torej Kristusovo poslanstvo, ki je Božje jagnje, ni omejeno zgolj za rešitev judovskega ljudstva, temveč se razširja na popravo grehov vsega sveta. Kajti ves svet je omadeževan z grehom in potrebuje odrešenja.

Bog govorji svojemu služabniku: »Premalo je, da kot moj služabnik vzpostaviš le Jakobove rodoве in privedeš nazaj Izraelove rešence.« In Bog še dodaja: »Zato sem te postavil za luč narodom, da boš moje odrešenje do konca zemlje.« Ta Izaijeva prerokba, tako kot besede Janeza Krstnika, se izvršuje z ozna-njevanjem apostolov. Te je Jezus povabil, naj poučijo vsa ljudstva.

Tako Pavel, ki se opredeljuje kot »apostol Jezusa Kristusa po Božji volji«, more govoriti Korinčanom, o »vseh tistih, ki na vseh krajih kličejo ime Kristusa, našega in njihovega Jezusa Kristusa.«

Korinčani, pogani, so bili s Pavlovim oznanjeva-njem poklicani k vstopu v Cerkev. Skupaj z mnogimi drugimi so vstopili, tako da lahko apostol govoriti o »teh, ki na vsakem kraju kličejo Gospodovo ime«. Pa-vel je imel preroško intuicijo, da je mogel že vnaprej prepoznati razsežnosti Cerkve.

To nas napolnjuje z velikim veseljem in s tolažbo. Vemo, da je ponižni Jezus tisti, ki odjemlje grehe sveta in ki vabi k sebi, da bi privadel k Bogu - seveda vsa ljudstva sveta. Vedno bolj se moramo zavedati te ve-soljne razsežnosti Jezusovega poslanstva. Imejmo široko srce. Ne skrbimo zgolj za naše lastne potrebe, niti za tiste duhovne, temveč bodimo odprti do vseh ljudi. Kristjani smo in pridruženi smo Kristusu, rešite-lju sveta, Kristusu, »ki je Božje jagnje, ki odjemlje gre-he sveta«.

Če se ukvarjamо zgolj s svojo malo skupino, ne moremo biti resnično združeni z Jezusovim srcem. Razširimo srca, da bomo lahko z Gospodom sodeležni pri odreševanju vsega sveta.

For St Paul, the only true nation is the nation of those who call on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Gospel *John 1:29-34*

John was born to reveal Jesus to Israel. We are to reveal him to the world.



When the musical Jesus Christ Superstar was revived for a theatrical performance in London, posters to advertise the play were put up in the West End, the major commercial and theatrical area of the city. They showed street scenes of crowds walking through the busy streets of London, but, in each picture, highlighted a particular face. The face was one of the stars of the production. Without the highlighting, you would not have noticed that one person among the throng of people.

What was it that John the Baptist saw in Jesus that told him that this was the one he was waiting for? It wasn't the dove which appeared above him at his baptism, since this would not look remarkable without that spe-cial insight that was given to John. However this insight worked, it was sufficient for the disciples who could see that John could see. It



is good for us to remember that there are no unimportant people in the crowds that surround us. Each one has a special gift from God, if we could see.

Gospel Teaching

When Christ came into the world, he gave us power to be responsible for that world. He, as the prophet Isaiah foretold, was to be the light of the nations, his salvation was to reach to the ends of the earth. Yet he shares this ministry with us. We can think of the humanity of Jesus, his soul and body, as a sort of instrument. This is not a denial of the incarnation, because God the Son uses that humanity to be himself, and he will never lay down that instrument. We too become instruments of God through the humanity of Jesus. We are the brothers and sisters of the one who is God and still human.

All human beings have to work through others. Great music, art and writings only exist if they are appreciated and received by other human beings. Christ wishes to be received into our hearts, so that his love and redemption can be worked for the world. This places an immense responsibility on us, but even though we are inadequate instruments, it is the skill of God in using us as instruments that we are to rely on, not our own strength. Look at Jesus, and let him enter.

Application

Stand in a city street, anywhere in the world, and there will be so many people passing by. Most of them we will not know, but occasionally there will be a face in the crowd we recognise. Perhaps someone we know, perhaps someone we merely know about. Those faces stand out. Yet every one of the faces of the people who flow by us in the great river of souls is known to God. We can't know very many people in this life, and even the ones we do know, we don't always know very well. We know their habits, can get to be good at knowing what they will say, how they will react to a particular event. Yet it is all superficial. We don't really know people because we don't really know ourselves. It is the one face in the crowd that helps us to connect to the many, to the countless lives that have been or will be lived in this earth.

John the Baptist lived a solitary life. He had his disciples, he spoke to the crowds of people, but he was apart. He waited for the coming of the Christ because only through him could he connect. Peter and the other apostles followed Jesus out of the crowd and they would come to know some unexpected individuals in their lives as they followed Jesus. They would speak to Roman governors, soldiers, leaders of foreign synagogues, and great thinkers, but it would always be one to one. We cannot see humanity as a whole and so we can only know a few in our lives. Yet in prayer and the sacraments, we can touch all the faces of humanity. The Eucharist is the sign of how Christ united himself to every human being on earth. He offers himself to the world, and he is present to all who pray, not just in his divinity but in his humanity. His human presence is extended to the many, and so in heaven will our humanity be extended.
