NAJVEČJA LJUBEZEN

»Jaz pa vam pravim: Ljubite svoje sovražnike in molite za tiste, ki vas preganajo . . .«

Med najbolj spornimi točkami Jezusovega govora na gori je gotovo zahteva, da ljubimo sovražnike. Poskušajmo jo bolje doumeti tako, da se najprej vprašamo: Kdo so naši sovražniki?

V prvi vrsti lahko rečemo, da je naš sovražnik vsakdo, v kolikor je drugačen: drugačnih misli, idej, okusov; drugačnih pogledov, navad in obnašanja. Težko se z njim ujamem; neprijeten mi je in težak. Sovražnik mi je tudi tisti, ki mi ni naklonjen. Če je le mogoče, mi oporeka; mi ruši moje iniciative in mi meče polena pod noge.

Nekdo mi je sovražen, ker sem mu odveč; ževel bi se me znebiti, me raniti ali celo uničiti. Sovražen mi je lahko človek, ki me duši s svojimi nenapovedanimi obiski ob najmanj zaželenem času in mi požira ure časa z očitnimi traparjami.

Sovražnik mi je dvoličnež, za katerega vem, da misli prav nasprotno od tistega, kar govorí; da je prekanjen goljuf, prodana duša in sploh človek nikakršnega zaupanja ...

Če v tako širokem smislu pojmujiemo sovražnike, ki naj bi jih ljubili, spoznamo, da se fronta našega srečanja z njimi razširi na vse naše vsakdanje življenje. Celo na vse ljudi. Saj nam celo najdražja in najbolj ljubljena oseba v trenutku lahko postane sovražnik.

Astrid Lindgren je ob podelitvi nagrade za mir v Frankfurtu leta 1978 povedala zanimivo družinsko zgodbo. Nanaša se na mlado mater še iz tistih časov, ko je veljalo pravilo: Šiba novo mašo poje. Čeprav je imela svojega otroka zelo rada in šibe sicer ni uporabljala, se je zgodilo nekega dne, da jo je mali krepko ušpičil in si prislužil leskovega mazila. Zato ga je poslala na vrt, naj sam prinese šibo. Mali je odšel na vrt in ga dolgo ni bilo nazaj. Ko pa se je vrnil, je držal v rokah kamen in dejal: »Šibe nisem našel; vrzi vame kamen!« Češ: tudi s kamnom mi lahko pri-



zadeneš bolečino! Ganjena mati je tedaj otroka objela in oba sta zajokala. Od tistega dne je ležal kamen na kuhinjski polici, da bi družino za vedno opominjal: nasilja nikdar!

Nasprotuočim in sovražnim izzivom se ljudje v prvotnem nagibu upiramo z nasiljem. In če zlo najde zaveznika v nas, je naša borba že vnaprej izgubljena.

Evangeljsko naročilo »ljubite sovražnike« nam odpira pot rahljanja sovražnih mehanizmov. Kristjan zaživi ustrezno svojemu bivanju tisti trenutek, ko poruši logiko: zob za zob; udarec za udarec; ljubezen za ljubezen; pozdrav za pozdrav ... Tisto kar človeka vlec v vedno globlji vrtinec prekletstva.

V moči Kristusove vere mora biti kristjan sposoben izstopiti iz krogotoka mehaničnega odgovora: sovražnika obvladaš ne tako, da se mu upreš, marveč, da ga presežeš: da mu ponudiš še drugo lice, da greš z nasilnežem še eno miljo dlje, da tatu prepustiš še pllač ... »Če namreč ljubite tiste, ki vas ljubijo, kakšno zasluženje imate?« Preprosto rečeno: v sovražnih odnosih mora imeti kristjan moči za prvi korak v drugo smer. Nič kolikokrat ostajamo blokirani v svojih odnosih, ko pričakujemo »prvi korak«.

Naši odnosi namreč niso nikdar dokončni. Tudi sprejeti jih ne smemo kot take. Ne smemo dopustiti, da se sovražnost naseli v nas; da nitke postanejo vrvice in da vrvice postanejo vrvi.

Nič ni dokončnega. In če se mi tudi zdi, da je vsako upanje zaman, da se ne da nič popraviti, imam kot kristjan vedno še eno možnost: pogled na križ. Kristus je prav s križem popustil svojim nasprotnikom; z njimi je šel dlje, do konca in prav na križu odprl neskončne možnosti sprave.

V zaključni sceni nekega filma je bilo rečeno: »Na razdalji 300 metrov je sovražnik tarča. Na razdalji treh metrov pa je - človek.« Kristjani povemo to misel po svoje: V bližini Kristusovega križa je naš sovražnik - naš brat.

Onstran vseh nasprotij in navzkrižij je področje »svetega«, na katerem je možno tudi v bolečini in potrežljivosti graditi pravo bratstvo. To pa samo, če verujem, da je ljubezen močnejša od sovraštva, če si v tej veri tudi vztrajno prizadevam živeti.

7TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Response: The Lord is merciful and gracious.

First Reading Leviticus 19:1-2, 17-18

The book of Leviticus can seem rather dry. It begins with the command to be as holy as God. This is an impossible command, but the point is to allow God to live that holiness within us by making space for God in our lives.

Second Reading 1 Corinthians 3:16-23

Paul writes to the Corinthians, a community made up of common people with no pretensions to greatness. He reminds them that their dignity comes from being temples of God.

Gospel Matthew 5:38-48


Jesus sets out the implications of living as his disciples. He reminds us that God gives the same grace to good and bad people alike. The choice is ours, on a daily basis, whether to respond to it or not.

You must therefore be perfect just as your heavenly Father is perfect.

In Nathaniel Hawthorne's tale *The Birth-Mark*, the brilliant scientist Aylmer falls in love with a beautiful young woman called Georgiana. She is beautiful but has a birthmark like a small hand on her cheek. It is attuned to her emotions, becoming almost invisible when she blushes, but standing out when she is pale. Other lovers have thought this a sign of beauty, telling her that a magical fairy must have touched her cheek, but Aylmer sees it as a blemish, an imperfection that challenges his scientific skills. He becomes unable to appreci-



ate his wife's beauty clearly as he becomes obsessed with what he sees as her imperfection. He urges her to let him remove the mark.

Georgiana realises that Aylmer is disturbed by her blemish. He cannot see beyond the blemish to the beauty that is within her. She is deeply hurt but, out of love for him, agrees to submit to whatever experiment he devises to render her beautiful again in his eyes. She drinks a chemical potion destined to remove the birthmark but finds that the mark is linked to her life. As the mark disappears, her life drains from her. Aylmer has achieved his idealistic dream of a perfect wife, but in the process he has destroyed what he failed to love and accept.

Gospel Teaching

The Gospel for today, from Matthew, may seem as harsh and burdensome as the urge to have the perfect image of oneself or another. How can sinful people like ourselves measure up to the exacting standard of perfection that Jesus seems to put before us? Is there any point in even trying to be perfect as our heavenly Father is perfect? How could we ever hope to reach such a state of perfection in this life and not be destroyed in the attempt?

Luke's Gospel echoes the same teaching but makes a crucial change in the wording. We are told by Jesus to be compassionate as our

heavenly Father is compassionate. That in itself is a tall enough order, but it avoids the tyranny of that word "perfection". Yet here Matthew faces us, without escape, with the challenge of Jesus. There must be a key to this, as Jesus does not place impossible burdens on our shoulders nor make demands that will lead to inevitable failure. The key lies in the promise of God's grace and in the very fact of the incarnation. God does not demand the impossible of us. Instead, we are offered a share in God's own life – a life that is lived in us by Jesus himself. His becoming human transforms our human nature from within, making it possible for us to be holy because Jesus himself is our holiness and our healing. When we make space for him in our lives and try our best to follow his teaching, his grace comes alive within us.

Application

Christian life is never about trying to achieve some impossible state of perfection. It is always about intimacy with God. This means allowing God to become a familiar part of our lives. Most of us are only too conscious of our own sins and imperfections, and even more conscious of those of others. Being harsh and judgemental with ourselves or with others is never the answer, and when we hear that note in our own voice or that of others, we know it is not from God.

God's compassion is infinite, as is God's grace, which comes to us new every morning. Every day is a day for a new start, and no one is more willing to help us than God. Whatever temptations and difficulties we face, whatever defects of character we may think we have, God looks on us and finds us very good. God has faith in us, loves us and has hopes for us. It is that faith, hope and love that give us the strength we need to face each day with its challenges, knowing that God's grace is perfection enough for each one of us from our birth to our dying day. Addicts in recovery often encourage themselves with sayings such as "one day at a time". If we can take up this attitude and spend a little time with God each day, reviewing the choices we have made and seeing where we have been present to or absent from God's loving presence in our lives, we will begin to see where the path to goodness lies for us, and will find the grace to respond.


