PAKT MED GENERALOM DE GAULLEM JEM IN ANGLEŠKO VLADO

Angleška vlada se obvezuje, po zmagovito končani vojni vzpostaviti neodvisnost in veličino Francije. — Načrt koordinacije angleških in francoskih armad.

LONDON, 9. avgusta. — Angleška vlada je podpisala z generalom de Gaulle-jem, poveljnikom francoskih čet izven Francije, ki ni priznal premirja med Francijo in Nemčijo, pogodbo, v kateri se francoski vojaki pod poveljstvom generala Charlesa de Gaullea obvezujejo, boriti se z Angleži do konca voje proti Nemcem, ne pa proti Franciji.

Obveza angleške vlade Pogodba je v prvi vrsti vojaškega značaja ter vsebuje osnovo za koordinacijo obeh armad, konec pogodbe pa vsebuje politično deklaracijo angleškega premierja Churchilla generalu de Gaulle-u:

"Ob tej prilici izjavljam v imenu angleške vlade," je zatrdil Churchill francoskemu generalu, "da se angleška vlada svedčeno obvezuje, po zmagoviti vojni vzpostaviti popolno restoracijo, neodvisnost in veličino Francije."

V pogodbi je določeno, da bodo francoske čete obdržale v polni meri svoj francoski karakter, gleško vlado.

Masni napad nemškega letalstva na Anglijo je pomenil "bankrotno strategijo"

Ta napad stane Nemce približno dva milijona dolarjev. — Škoda, ki jo je utrpela Anglija z izgubo šestnajstih letal, je nadomeščena.

LONDON, 10. avgusta. — Nemški masni letalski napad na angleški otok je stal Nemcem mnogo več kot pri Angleži, in sicer na denarju, morali in letalih. Nemški napad, ki so ga predeli nemški letalci v četrtek s 400 letali, je bil prava bankrot-strategija, in sicer iz sledečih vzrokov:

Nemci so izgubili pri tem napadu 60 letal.

Angleži so jih izgubili 16.

Na ladjah, ki so bile pri tem napadu uničene, in sicer po letalkih in motornih čolnih, je izgubila Anglija 5,039 ton. Anglija priznava, da je bilo sedem ladij v konvoju poškodovanih, toda so vse dosegle angleška pri-


Doma iz bolnišnice

Rumunija se je uklonila pritisku glede Dobrudže

Z zasegom Besarabije in Bukovine je prišla Nemčija ob ogromne zaloge žita.

BUKARESTA, 9. avgusta. — Pod silnim pritiskom Nemčije in Italije se je rumunska vlada uklonila ter pristala "v principu" na to, da se odpove velikemu delu Dobrudže v korist Bolgarije ter da zamenja z Bolgarijo 200.000 prebivalcev.

100.000 Rumuncev, ki žive danes pod Bolgarijo, bo premeščenih v rumunski Cadrilater okraj, odkoder bo odšlo enako število Bolgarov v okraju, ki pripadejo poslej Bolgariji.

BUKARESTA, 10. avgusta. — V Besarabiji in severni Bukovini, kateri provinci sta v dosegu nemških rok in kateri je zasegljala Sovjetska Rusija, je toliko žita, da bi lahko krijo potrebe vsega ostalega nemškega uvoza. Z zasegom teh dežel od strani Rusije je prišla Nemčija ob ogromne zaloge žita.

Grilla, ki je tudi član SNPJ, da ponižava dve organizaciji, ki sta njegovi organizaciji, na — tako nizko stopnjo konjskega in kravjega meštarstva!"

"SNPJ ne kupuje SSPZ, niti ne kupuje nikogar! Ako je zakoniti in odgovorni predstavniki obeh organizacij ne morejo zediniti za združitev na pogojih enakopravnosti, bratskih interesov članstva in načel, tedaj je bolje, da ostanemo vsak zase!"

Dolgo in na daleč je hodil Molek okrog vrele kaše, predno je prišel do pravega pointa — do tistega pointa, ki je na dnu vsemu nesramnemu manevriranju od strani birokracije na Lawndale Ave., da v resnici ne marajo združenja!

Oni so proti pravičnemu, enakopravnemu združenju, katerega zahteva ogromna večina našega članstva! Oni so proti združenju, za katerega je napravila načrt 10. redna konvencija SSPZ!

Zato so položili ultimatum s famozno točko prvo na mizo konvencije na dan, ko se je ista otvorila! Zato so priobčili neslanje čekanje br. Antona Zaitza v kolonah Prosvete o "intrigah"! Zato so dvignili huronski kril proti sklepom 10. redne konvencije! Zato so ignorirali in še vedno ignorirajo obstoj združevalnega odbora, katerega je izvolila in poverila konvencija, da izvede konvenčni sklep za združenje! Zato so v preteklosti in bodo tudi v prihodnosti nadalje ribarili v kahem in vsakogar, ki ima pogum ugovarjati njihovi vzvišeni modrosti, enostavno proglašili iz izdajico naroda in nasprotnika združenja!

Dolgo so ti faktorji manevrirali, stikali po kotih in opletali okrog sebe kot človek, ki se je s svojo lastno pametjo skregal, končno pa je le prišlo pravo razojetje: BOLJE JE, DA OSTANEMO VSAK ZASE!

Članek o "kapitulaciji" Napredkovega urednika — ki pa je bil vse kaj drugega! — je Molka tako prevzel, da se je zrušil in obupno zaklical: BOLJE JE, DA OSTANEMO VSAK ZASE!

Gospod Molek — brata ga ne moremo imenovati, kajti on ni član SSPZ — se je strašansko vznemiril, ker smo imeli drznotu opozoriti naše članstvo, da je imel glavni odbor SSPZ na vidiku tudi njegove materialne interese, vsled česar sedaj zlobno podstavlja uredniku Napredka smisel in besede, ki obstoje samo v razburkani domislji Molka in nikogar drugega! Ampak vsa zloba in podstavljanje je zaman, kajti nehote in morda nevedejo Molek priznal, kje njega in druge faktorje na Lawndale čevelj žuli — BOLJE JE, DA OSTANEMO VSAK ZASE!

Molek, nežna dušica, ki najbrže še verjame v Miklavža in da štorklje bebičke nosijo, se kar peni od srda, ker smo opozorili, da niso važni samo moralni, temveč prav tako gmotni interesi našega članstva. Da, g. Molek, član SSPZ, pa tudi pri SNPJ, ne plačujejo asesmentov zato, da jih bodo Molek, Grill, Kvartich, Cainkar, Rus ali Vider delali lepe pridige o bratstvu, temveč svoje trdo zasluzene dolarje odstevajo redno vsak mesec tudi zato, da bodo prejeli pomoč v slučaju bolezni, nesreče ali smrti! On lahko to imenuje "kravje ali konjsko meštarstvo," ampak za članstvo to ni ne kravje ne konjsko meštarstvo. To je poslovna stran našega bratskega prizadevanja — to je biznes, po amerikansko povedano — pa če Molek še tako zavija, potvarja po notoričnem sistemu njegove "pasje logike." Člani vsake podporne organizacije plačujujo "cash" za obljubljeno protekcijo, in zahtevajo po

vsej pravici, da dobijo "cash," kadar so v potrebi in stiski.

V današnji izdaji Napredka je priobčeno besedilo združitvenega sporazuma v obeh jezikih, v slovenskem in angleškem, skupno s pojasmilom br. M. G. Kuhela, blagajnika SSPZ in tajnika združitvenega odbora, ki ga je izvolila 10. redna konvencija naše Zvezde.

Sedaj, ko to pišemo, je ta sporazum v rokah odbora SNPJ, in ima torej g. Molek sijajno priliko, da se seznaní z njegovo vsebino. Upamo, da je ne bo zamudil, kajti v njegove super-možgane bo potem prodrl odkritje, da je poslovna ali bizniška stran podpornih organizacij ZELO VAŽNA, in da jih oblasti države Illinois ne smatrajo za kako kravje ali konjsko kupčijo! Če se bo g. Molek potrudil, bo celo pronašel, da v tej pogodbi, katera ima pečat odobritve zavarovalinskega departmента države Illinois, ni ne duha ne sluga o famozni točki prvi, katero je zahtevala gospoda na Lawndale Ave. kot pogoj združenja. In pronašel bo dalje, da je bilo stališče 10. konvencije SSPZ, ki se je uprla PRIKLOPITVI, absolutno PRAVILNO z LEGALNEGA STALIŠČA. Tega ne trdi kak Kvartich, Rus ali Grill, ki jih je Molkova zverižena logika razboblala za "nasprotnike združenja." Ne, brate Molek, še daleč ne! Tako pravi in trdi državni zavarovalinski department illinoiski!

Pa še ena skrajno zanimiva in važna točka se nahaja v tem sporazumu, na kateri Molek lahko eksercira svoje super-možgane. To je točka 11 (d), ki je silno važna za protekcijo materialnih interesov, oziroma zavarovalnine Zvezinega članstva v zadevi združenja. In to je biznes — "kravja kupčija" po Molkovi skisani logiki — in izposloval je to ogromno pridobitev tisti združitveni odbor, čigar izvolitev na 10. redni konvenciji sta Molek in Zaitz proglašila za "fiasco in polom združenja!"

Ako pozabimo na hinavščino, katera se zrcali iz teh besed, je to jasen in pribit dokaz, da je možak spoznal, kako kolosalno ga je polomil, ko je odprl zatvornico infarnih napadov na SSPZ, njeni konvenciji in delo združevalnega odbora. Manever se je izkaljal za boomerang — udarilo je nazaj; igra je razkrinkana. Junaški vitez v svetlem oklepnu na belem vrancu je izginil kot kafra, na njegovem mestu pa stoji skesan in izgrevan kruhoborec, ki stoka in joče: "Daj, brate Grill, brani konvenčne sklepe! Ne bodi nemumen in drži se svojega korita kot se jaz svojega. Mar neves, da je BOLJE, DA OSTANEMO VSAK ZASE!"

To je bistvo in smisel dolgovzelnega čenčanja, ki je zagledalo luč sveta v Prosveti z dne 31. julija. Ampak Molek se hudo moti, če misli, da je to-le kaka igra za "kratek čas in zabavo." Kašo, katero sta skuhala Molek in Zaitz, bosta sama pojedla. Grill ne more pomagati, če postaja tako peklensko vroča!

VOJAJSKA MOČ ITALIE

Italijanska oborožena sila obsegata pehoto, vojno mornarico, letalstvo in fašistično milico.

Mirnodobsko vojaško stanje Italije znaša v normalnih časih okoli 600,000 mož, v vojni pa 8 milijonov vojakov. Od letalstva je dodeljeno pet divizij po 350 letal, v glavnem izvidniških in lovskih letal.

Poleg tega razpolaga Italija še z dvema milijonom kolonialnih vojske.

SLOVENE FRATERNALISM

American Slovenes are good organizers, particularly in the field of Fraternalism. In the course of forty odd years they have built four national fraternal societies and as many societies whose membership is limited to a particular city or state. The largest fraternal body of the first type is Slovene National Benefit Society (SNPJ) with headquarters in Chicago. Of the latter type the largest and most successful one is Slovenian Mutual Benefit Society (SDZ) of Cleveland.

In one way these societies are all alike—all pay various kinds of benefits: mortuary, sick, operation etc., in another, every one of them possesses definite characteristics—political, religious, or both. Even those that claim to be neutral in these matters, which, in the technical sense, they are, are classified by public opinion.

That is one of the reasons why attempts made from time to time to bring about a consolidation of our fraternal societies are so difficult.

Who is to blame? Nobody in particular, or all of us put together. The basic reason of course is this—scratch and old-time Slovene you find an individual who is still more or less influenced in his present-day opinions by the heritage brought from across the ocean. Some of that heritage is good, some of it is bad, but whatever it be—here it is, and only time will smoothen things out.

What the young American Slovene should keep in mind is that his mother or dad, no matter what particular group they may happen to be identified with, did a darn good job of organizing. If the young folks will do as well when the pioneers are gone and consolidate what they have built, they will have achieved something.

The Slovene Woman And the Counter-Reformation

Note: The following article is translated from the Slovene of Tatjana Rozmanova by Anthony J. Klančar.

Like a great deluge, Lutheranism inundated the Slovenian provinces; the nobility and the bourgeoisie almost to man took the side of Trubar and his archdeacons, but the peasantry was also to a great extent favorably inclined toward the new religion. In Upper Styria, among the Hungarian Slovenes, in Carniola, in Primorsko (the Slovenian Litorale), as well as in Carniola; particularly the cities, towns, castles, and big villages were Lutheran. It goes without saying that all the intelligent men and women and all the more educated people in Slovenia were Lutherans. In 1575 Trubar emphasized "that all the aristocracy, the knights and nobles, as well as the greater part of the more intelligent bourgeoisie of Ljubljana, with their wives, sons and daughters, are one in the true (Lutheran) faith." Similarly Bishop Tavčar of Ljubljana said in Rome in 1589 "that almost all the bourgeoisie, particularly the more wealthy, are avowed Lutherans."

In the history of the Slovene Lands the year 1580 marks a great, violent change. The rulers of the house of Hapsburg remained loyal to Catholicism, and consequently issued an endless number of decrees as to how Lutheranism in the state, and among the Slovenes too, should be suppressed.

The beginning of this unconditional fight against Protestantism among the Slovenes is associated with the names of the bishops of Ljubljana Janez Tavčar (1580-1597) and Tomaž Hren (1597-1623).

All the Protestant archdeacons were either imprisoned or exiled, Protestant chapels were torn down, Protestant Slovens books were collected and burned, the estates of the rebellious lords and bourgeoisie were confiscated and anyone who did not take the oath to recant the new faith was exiled from the state.

In 1581 Bishop Bizanci, the papal envoy, imposed some-

thing like 25,000 gold crowns as a fine on the demoralized Catholic clergy of Carniola. "This money he offered to the archduke Charles on condition that his officials find a suitable punishment for the clergy." (Dr. Ivan Prijatelj, l.c.)

And the government with its machinery, together with the Ljubljana and other bishops, did the job well. They dismissed officials, mayors and town councils and replaced them with Catholic officials and priests. They imposed enormous fines. Nobles were ordered to return to the Catholic Church or move out and have their estates sold. About 800 of the nobility, whole families, did really settle partly in Germany, partly in Bohemia or Hungary, some even in Nordic countries. With the immigration of the Protestant nobility the religious wars ended. By 1629 there was no more opposition to the demands of the government. (Dr. Josip Gruden's "Zgodovina," Part, 1915.)

"It may be said of the Counter-Reformation," writes Dr. Prijatelj, "that it hindered the development of Slovene culture for two centuries. Not only because it destroyed the flowering literature of the Protestants, but more so because it again excluded the Slovenian nation from a cultural life, pushed it into the passive existence of village life and again cultivated Latin and German literature."

"Bishop Hren maintained that the new religion came among the Slovenes through the laity. But history shows that the ideas for reformation first found favorable ground among the clergy—that is, only among the better educated clergy, for the unfortunate, illiterate servants of the church could not get to the ideas of the learned tracts of Luther and Melanchthon. These were only known to men educated in the humanities and preachers enthusiastic in their calling."

In this period, too, Slovene and also foreign, for the most part domesticated women, suffered terribly. Kristina Spaur Turjaška, Sabina Lamberska, Pečovič, Aichelburgs, Apfalters, Mordaxes, Moscons, Rauas, Schwabs, Tschernevals, etc. persevered in their faith with their sons and daughters and sought freedom of conscience in foreign lands.
