## PORAZUM MED BOLGARIJO IN RUMUNIJJO

**Pogajanja glede vrnitve  
Dobruže zaključena**

## BOLGARIJA ZAHTEVA ODŠKODNINO

Sofija, Bolgarija, 6. avg. — Bolgarija in Rumunija sta se po letih kontroverze glede sporov o zemlja uklonili Hitlerjevi in naznanili, da bosta podvojili sporazum o vrnitvi Dobruže Bolgariji prihodnjo soboto. Rumunija je dobila Dobružo od Bolgarije l. 1913, ko je bila slednja poražena v drugi balkanski vojni.

Po navodilih, katere je dal Hitler balkanskim diplomatom, ki so se sestali zadnji teden v Salzburgu, da morajo poravnati vsebinski spor na miren način v kratkem času, so bila preljubljeni pogajanja sinoči zaključena. Predstavniki Rumunije in Bolgarije se bodo ponovno zbrali prihodnji četrtek v Craiovu, v mestu v južozapadnem delu Rumunije.

Balkanski večaki pravijo, da je Bolgarija nagajana, ker se je naslonila na ostanke Rim-Berlinskega paktu. Njo je pričela v zadnjem času posnemati tudi Rumunija. Nemška podpora Bolgariji je bila omenjena v listu Slovo. Ta je poročal, da sta bolgarski premier Bogdan Filov in zunanji minister Ivan Popov zagotovila Hitlerju, da Bolgarija ostane zavezana ostanke Rim-Berlinskega paktu.

Sovjetska Rusija je pred nekaj tedni zasledila Besarabijo in severni del Bukovine, provinci, kateri je dobila Rumunija po zaključeni prvi svetovne vojne. Druška zahteva od Rumunije vrnitev Transilvanije in izgleda, da bo Rumunija morala pristati na zahtevo.

Početni krogi napovedujejo, da bo Bolgarija dobila nazaj vse svoje bivše teritorije. Bolgarske vojske iz leta 1913 bodo vzpostavljene. Bolgarija bo predložila Rumuniji tudi račun \$234.000.000 kot odškodnino v zvezi z rumunsko okupacijo Dobruže. Rumunija pa bo nasprotno zahtevala isto vsoto za kritje stroškov javnih del, ki jih je ugrajila v času okupacije.

## Senator Lucas okrcal Lindbergha

Washington, D. C., 6. avg. — Senator Scott W. Lucas, demokrat iz Illinoisa, je v svojem govoru po radiu opazil letalca Charlesa A. Lindbergha, ki je zadnji nedeljo na "mirovnem" shodu v Chicagu priporočal, naj Amerika sodeluje s Hitlerjem. "Ko je sovrastvo starega sveta vzplamtelo v vojni, smo slišali Lindberghov svet, naj Amerika ponudi Evropski mirni načrt, da konča vojno," je rekel Lucas. "V istem govoru pa je Lindbergh posvaril Ameriko, naj se ne vmešava v afere tujih držav, kar je paradoksalno. On menda misli, da mirovna ponudba zavezanim državam ni vmešavanje v notranje zadeve teh držav." Lucas je dalje rekel, da je čudno to, ker je Lindbergh pokazal, da se strinja z nemškimi diktatorjem.

## Raziskovalec Cook umrl v bolnišnici

New Rochelle, N. Y., 6. avg. — Dr. Frederic A. Cook, ki je v septembru l. 1909 naznanil, da je odkril severni tečaj, je večerjal umrl v tukajšnji bolnišnici v starosti 75 let. Njegovo naznanilo je izvalo ostro kontroverzno, ker je pet dni pozneje admiral Robert E. Peary izjavil, da je on prvi dosegel vrh zemlje. Cook je bil obsojen v zapor zaradi zlorabljanja pošte v sleparske namene l. 1923, sedem let pozneje pa je bil pomilošen.

## Viharna debata o mobilizaciji

**Senatni odsek  
odobril načrt**

Washington, D. C., 6. avg. — Senator Burton K. Wheeler, demokrat iz Montane, je napadel alarmiste, vojno propagando in vojno historijo v teku vroče debate o Burke-Wadsworthovem zakonskem načrtu obveznega vojaškega vežbanja in registracije okrog 12.000.000 mošt v starosti 21 do 31 let. Načrt je prišel na razpravo potem, ko ga je odobril senatni odsek z dvajsetimi protitrem glasovom.

Vojni tajnik Stimson je podprl načrt, ki je v soglasju z Rooseveltovim programom narodne obrambe. Vse kaže, da bo izzval opozicijo med senatorji, čeprav ga je senatni militariistični odsek odobril z veliko večino. Senator Wheeler je v svojem govoru poučarjal, da se je ljudstvo že naveličalo kličanja o vojni nevarnosti, ki je tesno povezano s prihajajočimi volitvami.

Debata o Rooseveltovem načrtu mobilizacije narodne garde in masni konskripciji se bo nadaljevala. Senator Key Pittman, načelnik senatnega odseka za zunanje zadeve, je pohvalil generala Pershinga, ki je v svojem apelu po radiu urgiral, naj Amerika proda 50 rušilcev Veliki Britaniji.

## Finci pomagajo Američanom

**Ameriški parnik  
dospel v severno luko**

Helsinki, Finska, 6. avg. — Finske avtoritete hočejo pomagati ameriškim državljanom pri transportaciji v Petčam, luko ob Arktiku, kamor je večerj dospel parnik American Legion, da jih odpelje v New York. Ta bo odpul iz te luke 13. avgusta, toda zdaj še ni gotovo, če bo okrog 150 ameriških državljanov, ki se nahajajo v Latviji, Estoniji in Litvi, dospelo tja ob pravem času.

Ameriški diplomatje v teh državah se trudijo, da pregovore sovjetske vlade v prekleto odredbe, ki prepovedujejo potovanje ameriških državljanov preko njihovega ozemlja v Petčam. Američanom so svetovale potovanje preko Berlina in Stockholma, kar je veliko daljša in dražja pot preko Finskega zaliva na Finsko.

Finske oblasti so izjavile, da so pripravljene preskrbeti Američanom vlake in avtobuse za prevoz v Petčam, da se bodo lahko ukrcali na parnik, da jih odpelje domov.

## Kanada internirala montrealskega župana

Montreal, Que., Kanada, 6. avg. — H. R. Cagnon, načelnik kanadske policije, je naznanil, da je bil Camillien Houde, župan tega mesta, interniran na obtožbo kršenja vojnih regulacij. R. B. Hanson, vodja opozicije v kanadskem parlamentu, je zadnji soboto izjavil, da se Houde odprtu upira oblastem in poziva ljudstvo na odpor proti zakonu splošne registracije.

## Registracija nedržavljanov v Chicagu

Chicago, 6. avg. — Poštar Ernest J. Krutgen je naznanil, da se bo registracija 180.000 nedržavljanov, ki bivajo v Chicagu, vršila v poštini uradih. Registracijske listine bodo dosepele v nekaj dneh in potem se bo pričela registracija v smislu zakona, ki je bil nedavno sprejet v kongresu.

## NAPETOST MED JAPONSKO IN ANGLIJO NARAŠČA

**Tokijski list zahteva  
prelom odnošajev**

Tokio, 6. avg. — Tukajšnji list Hichi je objavil uvodnik z zahtevo, naj vlada odločno nastopi proti Veliki Britaniji zaradi aretacij več prominentnih Japoncev na angleških teritorijih. List urgira tudi prelom diplomatskih odnošajev in odpoklic Roberta L. Craigieja, angleškega poslanca v Tokiju.

Drugi japonski listi svetujejo vladi, naj odločno nastopi proti Veliki Britaniji.

Japonska politika glede holandske Vzhodne Indije bo kmalu zavzela definitivno obliko. Iz poročil v časopisu je razvidno, da bo Japonska podzela odločne korake glede dostavljanja olja, kavčuka in drugega materiala iz Vzhodne Indije.

General Kuniani Koiso je že sestavljal načrt, ki ga bo predložil članom kabineta. On je dejal, da holandska Vzhodna Indija producira 8.000.000 olja letno in več starega železa kot ga Japonska potrebuje.

Vodilni japonski krogi se jeze na Ameriko, ker je odredila embargo za izvoz letalskega goriva in sliščo se govoric o prihajajoči vojni med Japoncem in Ameriko. Noaki Hošino, načelnik državnih svetov v Mandžuriji, je v razgovoru s reporterji izjavil, da s prihranjenimi otokovi v Južnem morju bloku Vzhodne Azije bi ta blok postal najmočnejši na svetu.

London, 6. avg. — Vlada bo danes podala izjavo o odnošajih z Japoncem in aretaciji nadaljnjih Japoncev v Singapuru in Rangoonu, Burma. "Vest o aretacijah nas vznemirja, ker smo upali na izboljšanje odnošajev med obema državama," je rekel predstavnik vlade.

Mamoru Sigemitsu, japonski poslanik, je obiskal zunanjega ministra Halifaxa. Po razgovoru objavljeno poročilo se je glasilo, da je zahteval izpustitev Japoncev, ki so bili aretirani zadnji teden v Londonu in angleških teritorijih, iz ječe.

Londonški listi namigujejo, da nemški vpliv na japonsko politiko na Daljnem vzhodu je deloma odgovoren za porast napetosti.

## Streicher, sovražnik židov, umrl

**Poročilo angleške  
časopisne agenture**

London, 6. avg. — Poročilo časopisne agenture Reuter, objavljeno sinoči, pravi, da je Julius Streicher, guverner Frankonije in velik sovražnik židov, umrl. Vest je dospela iz zanesljivih virov "nekje na nemški meji."

Streicher je bil star 55 let. Na 8. novembra preteklega leta se je nahajal s Hitlerjem v pivnici v Monakovu, v kateri je eksplozivna bomba nekaj minut potem, ko je Hitler odšel. On se je udeležil tudi izjavljene nacističske puče v Monakovu l. 1923 in bil je aretiran z eno s Hitlerjem.

Streicher je imel velik vpliv pri Hitlerju. On je propagiral izločitev židov iz nemških industrij, trgovine in poklicev ter podiranje sinagog. One v Monakovu in Nurembergu so bile kmalu razdejane. Streicher je ustanovil tudi list Der Stürmer, v katerem je silovito napadal žide in primerjal Hitlerja s Kristu.

## Roosevelt še vedno v popularni večini

**Gallup Poll mu  
daje 51% glasov**

Princeton, N. J., 6. avg. — Najnovejši reprezentativno-glasovanje Instituta za javno mnenje v Ameriki (Gallup Poll) je pokazalo, da ima predsednik Roosevelt še vedno popularno večino, to je na splošno. Ta večina je pa zelo borna, znaša komaj dva odstotka glasov in kaže, da je Amerika domala enako razdeljena med republikance in demokrate. Na splošno stoji glasovi: Roosevelt 51%, Willkie 49%.

Toda deležni glasovi po državah dajejo drugačno sliko. Če bi se volitve vršile danes, bi Willkie dobil majhno večino — od pol odstotka do dveh odstotkov — glasov v 24 državah na vzhodu, srednjem zapadu in zapadu in ta večina bi mu prinesla 304 elektoralnih glasov, do čim bi Roosevelt imel 227 elektoralnih glasov. Za zmago je treba 266 elektoralnih glasov.

## Italija prepovedala prodajanje električnih pečev

Rim, 6. avg. — Senca mrzle zime se je pojavila nad Italijo večerj z objavo dekreta, ki prepoveduje prodajanje in instaliranje električnih pečev in grelocev v hišah. Dekret je ubil upanje mnogih, ki so mislili, da se bodo lahko greli ob električnih pečev, ker je v Italiji pomanjkanje premoga.

## FRANCIJA MORA SPREJETI FAŠISTIČNA NAČELA

**List Le Temps piše o novem  
gospodarskem redu****REVOLUCIONARNA  
ZNAČILNOST  
BORBE**

Vichy, Francija, 6. avg. — Linija in načela, na katerih podlagi bosta Hitler in Mussolini narekovala mirovne pogodbe, so označena v uvodniku, ki ga je objavil list Le Temps Ta pravi, da Nemčija in Italija vidita značilnosti velike borbe med ljudstvi in revolucionarno vojno.

"S tega gledišča," piše list, "je vprašanje preureditve mej, uključenega v mirovni pogodbi, postopranskega pomena in rezultat nove borbe. Ekonomske in moralne americe osiäka Rim-Berlin bodo prevladovale v vsej Evropi v mednarodnem in narodnem smislu. Eden najvažnejših problemov vedanje vojne bo vzpostavitev režimov avtoritativnega in totalitarskega značaja. To pomeni, da bodo naredi na evropskem kontinentu govorili samo eden politični jezik, kar je potrebno za doseg splošnega sporazuma. Rim in Berlin sta uverjena, da ta načela se dominirajo kontinent od Portugalske do Finske. Na podlagi teh bo prišel tudi sporazum s garancijo miru in zagotovitvo stopnjevalne razorožitve. Na tej bazi bo omogočena ustanovitve novega gospodarskega reda v Evropi."

Jean Ybarnegaraj, načelnik mladinske administracije v Petalnovi vladi, je večerj naznanil, da bodo delavci v novi Franciji dobivali plačo v sorazmerju s številom članov svojih družin, ne pa po zasluženju. "Francoske ženske," je dejal, "se bodo morale vrniti v tradicionalno življenje, omejeno na dom in vzgajanje otrok, da postanejo močni in zdravi ljudje."

On je dalje rekel, da bodo imeli očetje prenod pri zaposlitvi v privatnih industrijah in pri javnih delih, kar naj bi ustavilo padanje števil rojstev. Padanje rojstev je deloma odgovorno za polom francoske militaristične mašine. Francija bo imela še koristi od poraza. Temu bo po mnemju Ybarnegaraja sledila največja zmaga ljudstva, ki jo bo izvojevalo samo. "Matere bodo igralo veliko vlogo v tem tajnem in veličastnem triumfu," je dejal.

## Newyorška unija izključila komuniste

**Imena bodo izročena  
federalnim oblastem**

New York, 6. avg. — Krajevna unija Building Service Employees, ki ima 4000 članov in je njen glavni stan v Bronxu, je sinoči izključila 26 članov, ki je eksekutivni odbor na obravnavi ugotovil, da so komunisti. Izključitev je naznanil Alexander Schwartz, odgovnetnik unije. Thomas Lewis, predsednik unije, je dejal, da bodo izključeni komunisti avtomatično izgubili delo. Njihove pozicije bodo dobili drugi člani unije. Lewis je dalje rekel, da bodo imena izključenih komunistov izročena federalnemu detektivskemu biroju v Washingtonu in uradu Ameriške delavske federacije.

Predsednik te unije je bil pred nekaj meseci George Scallise, bivši kaznjensec, ki bo prišel pred sodišče prihodnji teden. On je obtožen, da je ukradel iz blagajne unije čez \$60.000.

## ADF proti obvezni vojaški službi

**Izjava predsednika  
Greena**

Washington, D. C., 6. avg. — Ameriška delavska federacija je izjavila, da nasprotuje obvezni vojaški službi in vežbanju. Na tem stališču bo vztrajala, dokler se ne bo pokazalo znamenje, da je tak korak potreben za obrambo, zaščito in ohranitev Amerike.

William Green, predsednik ADF, je izjavil, da je njegova organizacija za prostovoljno novčevanje. Program naj bi se izvajal z namenom, da se ameriška oborožena sila poveča na 1.500.000 mošt. Taka armada bi zadostovala za obrambo Amerike.

Chicago, 6. avg. — Člani katoliških delavskih organizacij po vsej državi so proti programu obveznega vojaškega vežbanja in konskripcije. Tako piše list Catholic Worker, glasilo katoliških delavskih grup. Ta dalje pravi, da bo Amerika postala totalitarska država, kakor hitro bo imela milijon mošt pod orožjem.

## Enotna borba proti peti koloni

**Roosevelt priporoča  
kooperacijo**

Washington, D. C., 6. avg. — Predsednik Roosevelt je priporočil sodelovanja med krajevnimi, državnimi in federalnimi avtoritetami pri izvajanju naredb in zakonov za pobiranje subverzivnih aktivnosti in drugih akcij elementov pete kolone. "Politični razlogi ne pridejo v poštev pri reševanju tega problema," je dejal predsednik v razgovoru s poročevalci, katere je sprejel na svojem domu v Hyde Parku.

Rooseveltova deklaracija je bila prečitana na konferenci guvernerjev, državnih pravdnikov in drugih uradnikov ter reprezentantov 42 držav, ki so prišli v Washington, da razpravljajo z uradniki federalnega justičnega departamenta o izvajanju zakonov, ki se nanašajo na narodno obrambo. Na konferenci so govorili federalni justični tajnik Robert H. Jackson, J. Edgar Hoover, načelnik federalnega detektivskega biroja in drugi. Zborovanje bo zaključeno danes.

## Poljaki sklenili pakt z Angleži

London, 6. avg. — Militaristični sporazum med Veliko Britanijo in poljsko vlado v izgnanstvu, ki izraža odločnost glede nadaljevanja vojne proti Nemčiji do konca, je bil večerj podpisan v Londonu. V imenu Anglije sta pakt podpisala premier Churchill in zunanji minister Halifax, v imenu poljske vlade pa Vladislav Sikorski, premier in minister za militaristične zadeve. Pakt določa borbo poljskih vojakov na strani angleške armade. Anglija pa prevzame stroške vzdrževanja poljskih čet.

## Predsednik prve jeklarske unije umrl

Pittsburgh, Pa., 6. avg. — Michael F. Tighe, bivši predsednik prve jeklarske unije Amalgamated Association of Iron, Steel & Tin Workers, je večerj umrl po dolgi bolezni. Ob smrti je bil star 81 let. Predsednik te unije, ki je izstopila iz Ameriške delavske federacije pred štiri leti in se pridružila CIO, je bil sedemnajst let. Tighe je bil goreč zagovornik miru in v vrstah organizirane delavskega.

## ITALIJANI NAPAJAJO ANGLEŠKE BAZE V AFRIKI

**Bombe povzročile veliko škodo****NEMCI IZGUBILI 307  
LETAL**

RIM, 6. avg. — Vrhovno poveljstvo poroča, da so italijanske čete prekorale mejo Libije pri Cireneci, invadirale Egipt in pogrnale Angleže v beg. Dva tanka sta bila zasečena, dva druga pa uničena, dostavljena poročilo. Dregava vest omenja letalsko bitko nad Malto, angleškim otokom v Sredozemskem morju, v kateri so Italijani sestrelili dva angleška bombnika.

Rim, 6. avg. — Italija je začela sistematično letalsko ofenzivo, da razbije važne britanske baze, ki obkrožajo italijanske poseidine v Afriki, po poročilu, ki ga je objavila uradna časopisna agencija Stefani. Italijanski letalci so v zadnjih dneh uprisorili več navalov na angleško-egiptski Sudan, Kenjo in Aden in bombardirali važna angleška aredišča in koncentracije.

Vrhovno poveljstvo naznanja, da so Angleži izgubili 14 bombnikov v bitkah s Italijani v zadnjih dneh. Samo v enem epopodu so Italijani uničili deset letal. Italijani so napadli s bombami tudi Halyjo in Summitt, važni železniški križišči, in pristanišče Zello, britska Somalija. Bombe so povzročile veliko škodo.

Kairo, Egipt, 6. avg. — Tri italijanska letala so bila sestreljena v bitki z Angleži, ki se je vršila v graku nad vzhodnim delom Libije, italijanske kolonije, se glasi poročilo poveljstva angleške letalske sile.

London, 6. avg. — Nemški letalci so večerj ponovno bombardirali mesta na severovzhodnem angleškem obrežju. Proti njim so se takoj dvignila angleška letala in jih odpodila.

Exchange Telegraph poroča, da je bila danska potniška ladja potopljena kmalu potem, ko je odrinila iz Copenhagena. Zajemla je ob mino. Mnenje prevladuje, da je potnik rešila nemška bojna ladja, ki se je nahajala v bližini.

Mornarični minister je naznanil, da je angleška ladja Marsona zadela ob mino in se potopila. Druge podrobnosti niso znane.

Sinoči objavljeno uradno poročilo se glasi, da so Nemci izgubili 307 bojnih letal v spopadih z Angleži v zadnjih štirik tednih. Angleške izgube v tem času so znašale samo 172 letal. Poročilo naglaša, da je angleška letalska sila močnejša kot je bila kdaj prej. Produkcija letal se je povečala, ker vse tovarne obratujejo s polno paro.

## Jugoslovani v uradu registracije tujcev

Washington, D. C., 6. avg. — (J. K.) Donald R. Perry iz Philadelphije, Pa., je bil 2. t. m. imenovan za prvega pomožnega direktorja registracije nedržavljanov. Perry je Jugoslovian oziroma Srb; njegovo pravo ime je Dragoslav R. Perišić in roditelj je v Ivancju v Šumadiji. Star je okrog 35 let in je izučen računan. V uradu za registracijo bo imel v oskrbi oddelek za statistiko registriranih inozemcev.

To je že drugi Jugoslovian, ki je bil zadnje tedne imenovan na važno mesto v federalni službi. Prvi je bil Louis Adamič, ki je dobil mesto svetovaleca v obrambni komisiji.

Those from the Cleveland and Detroit areas should use Route 14 to Salem, Ohio. In Salem get on Route 45 until reaching Lisbon, Ohio, where you change to Route 30 to reach East Liverpool. Take 30 out of East Liverpool for about twelve miles until Route 198 is reached. Go on 168 until reaching Route 18 at Frankfort Springs. Follow 18 into Hickory where signs will direct you to Strabane.

Accommodations Upon arriving in Strabane, visitors desiring lodging are urged to inquire either at the SNPJ Hall or at the National SNPJ Day headquarters on Chartiers Street. It is important that this is done immediately upon your arrival for it will be best for you and us. Thus all of our visitors can be quickly settled and start spending an enjoyable week-end.

Still better, if lodges can approximately estimate the number of members who will attend; write to John Podboy Jr., Strabane, Pa. Hotel accommodations can be arranged for them and will save us a lot of work. Such accommodations can be secured in fine hotels situated only ten minutes drive from Strabane.

In order to give those people who have never been to Strabane, a picture of our community, we decided to write this article.

Strabane itself is not a corporate village, being a part of North Strabane Township and a suburb of Canonsburg, a town of 15,000 population, which is 22 miles southwest of Pittsburgh. Canonsburg and its suburbs of Strabane and Houston have many places of historical interest.

On the Canonsburg High School campus is an old log cabin, which was known as Jefferson Academy and was the first college west of the Allegheny Mts. George Washington made many visits to this district as a young surveyor. Opposite the High School is the site where the "Black Horse Tavern" stood. This tavern was a famous stopping place for travelers going from Fort Pitt (Pittsburgh) down the Ohio Valley by land.

Located in this district are the Standard Tin Plate Mill, two potteries, brickworks, vanadium works and numerous soft coal mines. It was the old Standard Chemical Works, now a vanadium plant, that Madame Curie, the founder of radium, visited to see how radium was extracted from pitchblende. This chemical plant was at that time the world's largest producer of radium.

Near Canonsburg, the Pennsylvania State Training School is situated. This place is a site of beauty for it has a really large campus and also many beautiful buildings. This school is a reformatory for boys and girls of Pennsylvania.

Our town of Strabane is strictly

is feverishly preparing for national defense. For this purpose it is building huge armaments of airplanes, tanks and warships. Spending billions of dollars for armaments. America is forced to prepare the question is whether it is preparing fast enough.

armaments alone cannot defend the country against an invader. A correspondingly large army is necessary to man the war machine. It is inconceivable how quickly Congress responded with armament appropriations and how extremely slow it is to the conscription law for the training of men to enable them to man the machine. Consistency?

There are many sincere advocates of peace who think that by unpreparedness America can escape war. They have learned nothing from the fate of the invaded neutral and unprepared nations in Europe. As long as we live in a world of international gangsters we have but one alternative: prepare!

Dictators have a way of spreading their poisonous propaganda among such people who are for peace at any price, who believe that our two great armies are ample defense—not taking account of the modern inventions which enable an invader to "blitz" through any seemingly impenetrable defenses.

Sunday afternoon, in Chicago's Soldier Field on the lake front, the Citizens' Keep America Out of War Committee held what was intended to be a peace rally of at least 100,000 people. In reality only about twice as many attended as did the first annual SNPJ Day affair in Cleveland 25—only about 18,000! The German-American National Alliance, or GAN, and members of "Father" Coughlin's Social Justice League (pro-fascist) were among the groups who rallied to the call.

Of course, Col. Charles Lindbergh, erstwhile national flying hero, was the principal speaker at the rally. According to reports, Lindy suggested in his speech that America should find a way to deal peacefully—by negotiation—with Hitler after England is defeated.

Lindbergh speaking as an individual or as he representing some intangible interests? Of course, everyone in this country is entitled to expound their own views as long as we still enjoy our rights and liberties, but it is interesting to know whom and the Chicago Tribune, the ultra-carbonic "word's greatest paper" present.

On the weather front, Chicago continues to sizzle in a record heat with all the breathing spells. The only consolation is the thought that a month or so now we'll be looking for warmth, and probably grumbling then, too.

SHARON-FARRELL, PA.—Because of the shut-down of the local tin mill, many former employees now have a chance to think of what is the best plan for our future. The question is, What plan would be most suitable for our people here in Sharon and Farrell, and how could this be solved.

The answer, as some think, is the Townsend plan. Some of its provisions are: the citizens 60 years of age or over, would be eligible to get a pension of no less than \$50 a month; anyone 60 years of age or over must retire; there are approximately four million elderly citizens employed and under this plan would be forced to retire and make jobs for four million younger workers.

According to this plan, about 10 million older citizens would receive a retirement pension each month and would have to spend the money, thus creating a better market for business. The money would come from a 2% income tax on the total amount earned by a person or business making over \$5,000; all those earning less would be exempt.

These are some of the features of the plan. Do you think this plan would solve our present unemployment problem?

Perhaps it would be more correct to say that TOO LITTLE IS DONE, or action is taken TOO LATE for positive and constructive results.

First I wish to refer to last year's campaign celebrating the 35th Anniversary of our Society. That campaign, I believe, began in April, and it was not until fall, when more than one-half the campaign period was over, that our executives found it convenient to send out to lodges good campaign pamphlets that were of genuine aid to campaigners in soliciting new members. Is there sufficient reason why these could not have been in the hands of lodges before the campaign began?

At the February meeting of the Supreme Board, one member in high authority, whose ability, loyalty, and devotion is acknowledged by most of our members, bemoaned the inability of our members to match wits with private insurance salesman. True! But what was done at that meeting to train our members to become better agitators? Prosveta is conspicuous with its lack of suggestive material and the lack of genuine campaign material is indicative of a complete shut-down of printing presses. Another member of high authority finds it convenient or expedient to write in the Slovane section, but his contributions to the English section amount to mere announcements. Our members are hungry for good campaign material, and the responsibility for it rests with the heads of our Society.

The Third Term

From now until the elections, political propaganda will concern itself with the third-term question.

To much of the voting public the controversy will be presented as something that is entirely new to American history—as something so unprecedented that it is not to be thought of.

Actually, however, there have been two previous attempts of presidents attempting to secure a third term. These have been Ulysses S. Grant and Theodore Roosevelt. The first of these had the idea in mind at two different times. Neither one, however, tried to obtain the third term consecutively. Both of them did so after having been dissatisfied with their immediate successor.

Grant, elected on the National Union Ticket (because of his quarrel with Johnson) in 1868 was reelected in 1872. Towards the end of his second term Roscoe Conkling, influential in his party, was ambitious to place Grant for nomination once more. He was, however, checked by a vote of the Democratic house of representatives who were joined by the Anti-Grant forces among the Republicans already in 1875.

Hayes received the Republican nomination, therefore, in 1876, and was also elected, after a bitter dispute between the Democrats over the fact that Tilden was rightfully elected.

The Republicans, feeling that their strength was ebbing away in 1880 persuaded Grant to be candidate once more. Anti-third term leagues sprang up and even a national Anti-third term convention was held.

Because of this growing disension, Grant failed to secure the 378 out of the 787 votes necessary to nominate him, and the "dark horse" James A. Garfield was nominated.

Theodore Roosevelt, governor of New York, was vice-president under McKinley's second term which began in 1900. Upon McKinley's assassination on Sept. 6, 1901, Roosevelt became president. He was renominated at the Republican convention in 1904 by acclamation and also reelected.

When Roosevelt's second term ended in 1908, he threw his full support to William Howard Taft. Roosevelt did this, expecting that Taft would follow up the progressive policies he had instituted, and after the election departed for a hunting trip to Africa.

But Taft was a disappointment to Theodore Roosevelt and his followers, and as the election of 1912 neared, Roosevelt was prevailed upon to allow his name to be placed in nomination to prevent Taft's renomination. This Roosevelt consented to in the early months of 1912.

But the Republican Convention in Chicago, on June 18, 1912, was controlled by the Taft forces, and upon charges of steamrolling renominated Taft.

Thereupon, the Roosevelt supporters decided to carry the contest directly to the public. They held a mass meeting and formed a new party, the Progressive Party. At their convention on August 5, they placed the name of Theodore Roosevelt up for election.

In the meantime, the Democrats had nominated Woodrow Wilson (on the forty-sixth ballot) and the three candidates: Wilson, Taft, and Roosevelt were in the running. It was this split-up in the Republican forces that resulted in Wilson's election.

The third-term idea, therefore, is no new thing. Neither Grant nor Theodore Roosevelt, however, succeeded in securing the third-term nomination on their own party ticket. The fact that both of them had been out of office for one term before attempting it may have been a factor in this.

Nevertheless, this of historical fact-finding is sufficient to prove that the anti-third term issue is simply so much ballyhoo.
