Kratke tedenske beležke

A SLOVAŠKEM so bile te razne kulturne prireditve, ki so jih udeležili tudi člani, ki so imeli na njih svoje ure. Predsednik vlade župnik je govoril o poslanstvu in o omike ter se je pri tem tudi politike. Pfeffer, ki je kot sodnik uvedel prvo preiskavo v zadevi umora nadvojvode Franca Ferdinanda in njegove žene, je izjavil, da je bila nadvojvodova žena tudi zastrupljena, da bo tem bolj gotovo mrtva. Dejal je, da bi se jo moglo rešiti, če bi se ji posvetilo nekoliko več skrbi in če ji ne bi dali injekcije, ki je vsebovala — po njegovem mnenju — strup. Ko je tedaj izrazil svojo sumnjo, ter zahteval raztelesenje njegovega trupla, je bila njegova zahteva gladko odbita. Stari jurist pravi, da je bil atentat kakor "made to order" za Avstrijo, ki je hotela za vsako ceno vojno s Srbijo.

ROOSEVELTOVA ADMINISTRACIJA si prizadeva za zakonom o embargu preprečiti vojno v Evropi, dasi oni, ki zagovarjajo izolacijo, tega ne vidijo ali nočejo videti.

Senat ima še vedno čas, da popravi napako, ki je bila narejena v zbornici poslancev ter zakoniti tak nevtralnostni zakon, ki bo pomenil v resnici zaščito ameriškega miru. In to je tisto, kar predsednik želi in zahteva.

Fašistični gospodarji Nemčije in Italije so vzeli za zadoščenje na znanje, da je ameriška zbornica poslancev odglasovala za prepoved izvoza orožja. LONDON, 7. julija. — "Manchester Evening News" je natisnil danes poročilo svojega poročevalca v Washingtonu, ki pravi, da je bil poslan državnemu departamentu v Washingtonu nemški mirovni načrt, katerega naj bi podpisale Zedinjene države, Anglija, Francija, Nemčija in Italija. Načrt je poslala v Washington italijanska vlada. Načrt sestaja v glavnem iz sledečih šestih točk:

Podpis 25-letnega pakta za nenapadanje med Nemčijo, Anglijo, Francijo, Italijo in Zedinjenimi državami.

Nemčija naj izvede v centralni Evropi "anšlus," ki naj se raztegne vse do meje Rusije.

Uvedba enega samega denarnega sistema po vsej Evropi, ki naj bi baziral na angleškem funtu.

Vprašanje kolonij oziroma zahteva po njih se odloži za 25 let.

Gdansk mora biti vključen v "ogrodje nemškega rajha," toda poljski Koridor ostane poljsko ozemlje.

Redukcija rednih armad vseh držav tako, da ne bo imela nobena država pod orožjem več kot 300.000 mož močne armade.

KDO NAJ PODPIRA WPA STAVKARJE?

Pred županom Burtonom je vprašanje direktnega relifa za stavkarje, ki so pustili delo pri WPA projektih.

Burtonova mestna administracija ima zdaj odločevati o važnem vprašanju, ali naj se da zdad direktni relif onim WPA delavcem, ki so šli na štrajk, ali kaj naj se stori.

Prvi dan štrajka WPA delavcev, ki so zastavkali v protest proti podaljšanju delovnih ur na 130 na mesec, in sicer za isto plačo, katero so prejeli doslej, je šlo na stavko od 3.500 do 12.000 delavcev.

WPA uradniki poročajo, da so našli 2.123 izvežbanih in navadnih delavcev, ki so prostovoljno pustili delo pri raznih W. P. A. projektih. Zaradi tega pa je bilo prisiljenih nadaljnjih 1.412 delavcev oditi domov, ker niso mogli opravljati svojih del brez pomoči strokovno izvežbanih delavcev.

Delo pri 16 projektih ustavljeno
Delo pri šestnajstih projektih se je popolnoma ustavilo, delo pri nadaljnjih desetih projektih pa je domala obtičalo. Največji projekt, kjer se je prenehalo z delom, je projekt v Woodland Hills parku.

Pet in sedemdeset odstotkov onih, ki so včeraj pustili delo, je navadnih delavcev, ki so priključeni večinoma CIO organizaciji in Workers Allianci.

CIO in Workers Alliance, ki sta izjavili, da je šlo 12.000 W. P. A. delavcev na štrajk, sta dejali, da bodo ti delavci pričeli danes zopet z delom, ker stavka je bila enodnevna, v protest proti novim odredbam kongresa z ozirom na WPA.

WPA uradniki pa pravijo, da se je po vsej državi Ohio odzvala pozivu na stavko komaj okoli 12.000 delavcev.

ZBOR JUGOSLOVANSKE MLADINE

Osumljenec se piše Frank Dolezal ter je stanovanj na 2491 East 22nd St., ko je bil v sredo aretiran.

Šerif je dejal, da je jetnik priznal, da je umoril Mrs. Polillo z mesarskim nožem v svojem stanovanju na 1908 Central Ave.

Kako jo je umoril
"Ona je sunila proti meni z nožem, nakar sem ji izvil nož iz rok, jo udaril po glavi, da je padla, nakar sem ji odrezal glavo," je dejal.

Truplo Mrs. Polillo, ki je bila stara 42 let, so našli dne 26. januarja 1936 razkosano na nekem praznem zemljišču v bližini hiše št. 3315 E. 20 St.

Nadaljne žrtve
Šerif je izjavil, da bodo zdaj pričeli preiskovati tudi zadevo umorov 28-letnega Edwarda Andrassyja in 42-letne Rose Wallace.

Wallacejevo truplo in truplo še nekega neidentificiranega moža so našli ogledljeno in z odrezanimi spolovili dne 23. septembra 1935 v Kingsbury Runu. To sta bili prvi dve žrtvi izmed dvanajstih, ki so bile pozneje najdene.

Žrtvi je odrezal glavo in truplo razkosal
Glede Mrs. Polillo je izjavil: "Ko sem jo zbil na tla, sem ji odrezal glavo, nato pa njeno truplo razkosal. Dele njenega trupla sem zložil v košaro, in vzelo mi je troje ali četvero potov, da sem jih odnesel iz hiše. Njeno glavo sem vrgel v jezero ob vnožju E. 49. ceste. Ko sem vrgel glavo v vodo, je veter vlek od brega ven proti jezeru. Stal sem na bregu in gledal, kako je voda odnašala glavo zmerom dalje od brega. Bal sem se, da se veter izpremeni in da bi voda splavila glavo nazaj k bregu, zato sem šel tri ali štirikrat pogledat, če je ni morda valovje splavilo nazaj k bregu.

Zločinceva strahopetnost

Ko sta detektiv Brown in šerif O'Donnell odpeljala morilca na kraj zločina, morilec ni hotel sedeti na sedežu avtomobila, temveč je legel na tla z obrazom navzdol. Ukazu ni bilo priloženo nobeno pojasnilo, toda v nekem članku nacistične revije "Nordland" je rečeno, da so študije bogoslovja ali teologije "brez vsake vrednosti in zato nepotrebne."

CLEVELANDER TO OPEN SCHOOL IN PITTSBURGH

John Rebol, who is instructor at the Cleveland College of Embalming, is going to leave for Pittsburgh this fall to take up a career at The Pittsburgh School of Embalming in which he has a third interest. He will be the head of the Department of Embalming and Restorative art. He will also take over the duties of giving students the final review of all previous instructions, when they finally are to make the test for a license to practice.

The school has met the requirements of the Pennsylvania and West Virginia Board of Undertakers and Embalmers.
