Velik porast smrtnih nesreč na naših cestah

V prvih dveh mesecih letosnjega leta je število smrtnih nesreč porastlo za 16%.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Lani je število smrtnih nesreč na naših cestah preseglo 50.000, prvič potem, ko je bila brzina vožnje omejena na 55 milij na uro v januarju 1974. Podrobna študija prometnih nesreč je pokazala, da je njihovo število porastlo med letom 1975 in 1978 za 12.6%, od 44,525 na 50,145.

Ljudje na splošno vedno manj pazijo na brzino 55 milij na uro. To lahko opazi vsak dan na naših cestah, zlasti še na velecestah. Velika večina drvi po njih z brzino nekje med 60 in 70. Prav posebno malo se za omejitev brzine na 55 milij ozirajo v zahodnem delu dežele, kjer so v nekaterih državah hoteli to brzino tudi že uradno povisiti na 65 milij.

Narodna uprava za varnost prometa na velecestah je objavila pretekli teden, da je bilo v prvih dveh mesecih letosnjega leta na naših cestah 6.267 mrtvih, 855 več kot v istem času lani.

Povečale so se zlasti nesreče treh vrst vozil, motociklov, težkih tovornjakov in malih tovornjakov. Odprava prepovedi obvezne rabe čelad pri vožnji z motocikli naj bi bila glavni vzrok povečave števila smrtnosti na teh vozilih.

Potres v Jugoslaviji je končal 94 življenj

BEOGRAD, SFRJ. — Uradno poročilo, ki so ga objavile oblasti preteklo sredo, pravi, da je potres ob južni obali Jadranja, ki je prizadel predvsem področje od Ercengovijsa na jug vse do Ulčinja in albanske meje, končal 94 človeških življenj. Prvotno so govorili o "vsaj 200 mrtvih", nato so to število zmanjšali na polovico.

Prvo uradno poročilo par dni po potresu je navedlo 101 mrtvega, sedaj, ko so položaj pregledali in preiskali podrtva poslopja, so dognali, da so bili nekateri ponesrečenci štetni ponovno. Prva poročila so pa itak bila samo ocena na temelju vtisov u ničenja.

Poleg 94 mrtvih je bilo nad 1000 oseb ranjenih, od tega 159 težko.

Skodo so ocenili na skupno 500 milijonov dolarjev, strehò je izgubilo kakih 80,000 ljudi. Vse so spravili pod šotor, tudi šolski pouk se vrši pod šotori.

Obvezni nadzor nad plačami in cenami?

WASHINGTON, D.C. — V poslovnem svetu prevladuje prepričanje, da bo kljub ponovnemu zanikanjem zvezne vlade prej ali slegle le prišlo do obveznega nadzora nad plačami, cenami in dobici, če inflacijski pritisk skoraj ne bo popustil.

Nobenega znižanja zveznih davkov do 1982

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Senat je v sredo s 56:36 glasovom zavrnil predlog W. Rotha, republikana iz Delaware, ki je predvideval znižanje zveznih davkov prihodnje leto za 10, leta 1980 pa celo za 35 bilijonov dolarjev. Istočasno naj bi bili v še večji meri zmanjšeni tudi zvezni izdatki in zvezni proračun uavnovešen.

Na predlog svojega proračunskega odbora je Senat načelno sklenil odložiti uravnovešenje zveznega proračuna do leta 1981, znižanje davkov pa do leta 1982. Zvezni proračun za prihodnje finančno leto, ki se bo začelo 1. oktobra 1979, bo imel predvidoma 28.8 bilijonov dolarjev primanjkljaja.

Izreden nalinj končal trimesečno sušo v južni Floridi

MIAMI, Fla. — V zadnjih treh mesecih je imela južna Florida komaj en palec dežja, to je povzročilo obsežno sušo. Preteklo sredo je prišel izreden nalinj, ki je ponekod v komaj 12 urah pustil 16 palcev dežja, več kot kdajkoli prej. Obsežna področja so bila poplavljena, ceste spremenjene v prave reke.

Svetovna konferenca o morjih spet ni uspela

NEW YORK, N.Y. — Konference Združenih narodov o ureditvi vprašanj prometa, cistoče in zlasti tudi izkorisčanja rudnega bogastva na dnu oceanov bo te dni končala svoje osmo zasedanje tekom zadnjih petih let, ne da bi se sporazumela o izkorisčanju rudnega bogastva na dnu oceanov.

Bomba v Salisburyju

Eksplozija močne bombe v trgovskem središču glavnega mesta Rodezije znamenje nasprotovanja Mu-zorewi.

SALISBURY, Rod. — V sredo je eksplodirala v trgovskem predelu glavnega mesta močna bomba, ki je raztrgala nekaj črno tako močno, da ni niti bilo mogoče dognati, če je on položil ali prinesel bombo. Sodijo, da bi naj bomba bila znak nasprotovanja Abelu Muzorewi, vodniku Afriškega narodnega sveta, ki je pri volitvah pretekli teden dobil 67% vseh oddanih glasov in 51 od 100 poslanec v novem parlamentu.

Abel Muzorewa, metodistični škof, star 54 let, ki je študiral v ZDA, je dejal, da bo njegova prva naloga, ko bo prihodnji meseč prevzel predsedstvo vlade Rodezije, končanje gverilske vojne.

Vodnika Patriotične fronte Robert Mugabe, ki vodi gverilski boj v Rodeziji z oporišč v sosednjem Mozambiku, in Joshua Nkomo, ki vodi gverilski boj z oporišč v Zambiji, sta odklonila priznanje volitev in nove vlade črne večine pod predsedstvom Muzorewe. Izjavila sta, da bosta boj nadaljevala "do končne zmage".

Nova vlada črne večine bo skušala doseči priznanje Velike Britanije, ZDA in drugih zahodnih, pa tudi drugih držav. V Londonu je vodnica konservativne stranke, ki ji napovedujejo zmago pri volitvah 3. maja, napovedala spremembu stališča do Rodezije, če bo zmagala, v Washingtonu izjavljajo, da je treba novi položaj temeljito premisli, predno bo prišlo do kake odločitve.

Kubanski najemniki

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Iz krogov obveščevalnih služb prihajajo vesti, da 20.000 kubanskih vojakov in 8.000 tehničnih strokovnjakov ni v afriški Angoli iz gole socialistične solidarnosti, ampak da so to plačani najemniki.

Angola plačuje Kubance, ki pomagajo vzdruževati njeno socialistično vlado na oblasti, v dolnjih, markah in drugih trdih zahodnih valutah, ki jih dobiva za svoje olje iz Kabinde.

Sredi aprila prodanih manj novih avtomobilov

DETROIT, Mich. — V drugi tretjini aprila je bilo prodanih skoraj 17% manj novih avtomobilov domače izdelave kot v istem času lani. V razdobju 11.-20. aprila je bilo prodanih skupno 247,373 novih avtov.

General Motors je prodala 9.8% manj novih avtov, Ford 23% manj, Chrysler blizu 38% manj in American Motors okoli 25% manj.

Črna napoved

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Načelnik upravnega odbora Federal Reserve William Miller je, da bi opozoril na resnost sedanje ravni inflacije, dejal, da bo sedanjih \$1 vreden samon in nikeli (5 centov), ko bodo sedanji študentje visokih šol stari 65 let, če ne bo uspeло inflacije omejiti.

V času predsednikov Eisenhowerja in Kennedyja so cene povprečno rastle le 2% letno, sedaj rastejo na letni ravni 9.8%.

PREDSEĐNIK CARTER ZAGOTAVLJA USPEŠEN NADZOR ZDA NAD SALT II

Ko je v Kongresu in v javnosti močan dvom nad sposobnostjo ZDA učinkovito nadzirati izvajanje določil SALT II od strani Sovjetske zveze, izjavlja predsednik Carter, da ne bo niti enega dne, ko bo SALT II uveljavljen, da ZDA ne bo mogle uspešno nadzirati izvajanje njegovih določil od strani Sovjetske zveze.

NEW YORK, N.Y. — Predsednik ZDA Jimmy Carter je zadnjič izrazil močan dvom v sposobnost ZDA za uspešno nadziranje izvajanja SALT II. To isto je storil tudi sam direktor Osrednje obveščevalne službe adm. S. Turner. Ta je dejal, da ZDA ne bodo imele takih sposobnosti do leta 1983. Obrambni tajnik Harold Brown je to zanikal in izjavil, da bodo ZDA v teku enega leta sposobne prav tako učinkovito nadzirati Sovjetsko zvezo, kot so jo mogle, dokler so imele svoja opazovališča v Iranu.

Dvomni odstranjen

Zagotovilo obrambnega tajnika in tudi zagotovilo samega predsednika ZDA ni odstranilo dvoma v dejansko sposobnost ZDA za nadzor, ki se mu Sovjetska zveza ne bi mogla izogniti.

Predsednik Carter je dejal, da ne bo izgubljeni niti en sam dan v sposobnosti ZDA uspešno nadzirati Sovjetsko zvezo in njeni izvajanje SALT II. Spoznamo moramo biti sposobni preverjati od dne podpisa in to bomo, je izjavil predsednik ZDA.

Stvari so prebistvene, da bi se smeli zanesti celo na nagnjenje Sovjetske zveze, da postopa v svojo najboljšo korist, je dejal Carter in nato obrazložil okoliščine, ki jamčijo, da bo nadzor ZDA učinkovit.

Zadnje vesti

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Včeraj je bilo objavljeno, da so življenjski stroški v marcu porasti za 1% in rasti v prvih treh mesecih leta 1979 povprečno na letni ravni 13%. Od lanskega marca so porasti za 10.2%.

Upokojenci Social Security bodo dobili z julijem pokojnine povisane za 9.9%, je objavil zvezni tajnik za zdravstvo, solstvo in socialno skrbstvo Califano.

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Pogajanja za novo kolektivno pogodbo v gumarski industriji so bila prekinjena. Glavna ovira sporazumu je vstrajanje zvezne vlade, da naj se drži nova kolektivna pogodba v pogledu povisila plač njenega vodila.

Odkar sta ti dve opazovališči ukinjeni, skušajo ZDA nadzirati Sovjetsko zvezo z oporišč in opazovališč v Turčiji, iz letal, z morja in z umetnih satelitov, ki sta bila oropana, ko sta se vracala peš v svoje stanovanje v NAPOLI, It. — Podatki William Callaghan, poveljnik Seste flote ZDA, in njegova žena sta bila oropana, ko sta se vracala peš v svoje stanovanje v NAPOLI. Ženi so roparji v zvezni vetrinici in druge dragulje.

Spomin na sodelavce za Baragovo zadevo

Ob smrti Fr. Gabriela Rusa.

LEMONT, Ill. — V Lemontu imamo Baragov park, sredi katerega stoji Baragov spomenik. Blagoslovil ga je pokojni marquettiški škof Thomas Noa dne 3. septembra 1950. Od tedaj obhajamo v Lemontu prvo nedeljo v septembri Baragovo nedeljo. Ker bo letos v nedeljo, 2. septembra, Baragov dan v Clevelandu, smo prestavili Baragovo nedeljo na 26. avgusta.

Letošnji Baragov dan v Clevelandu je zame povezan s spomini na pok. Fathra Gabriela Rusa SM, ki je umrl 25. marca letos v Daytonu, O. Pred dobroim letom sem začel prejemati od njega številna pisma, iz katerih sem spoznal njegovo globoko vernost in preprostost ter gorečnost v delu za Baragovo zadevo. Po težki operaciji je z zdravniškim dovoljenjem obiskal Baragovo in svojo rojstno domovino Slovenijo. Father Rus je bil doma z Bleda. Napravil sem ga za nekatere fotografiske posnetke iz krajev Baragovega delovanja v domovini in za fotografijo prenovljenega oltarja Marije Pomagaj na Brezjah. Mojo prošnjo je velikodušno uslušal. Zadnjo jesen je še enkrat potoval v Baragovo deželo. Delno je opisal to svoje potovanje za katoliški časopis, a članek ni bil objavljen. Poslal mi ga je brez pripombe; obljubil sem mu, da ga bom prestavil v slovenščino in ob priliki objavil. Z zanimanjem je sledil pripravam za Baragov dan 1979 in želel pri tem tudi sodelovati. V ta namen je naredil obširen načrt, ki bi ga lahko izvedli samo s pospeševalci Baragove zadeve, ki bi se vživeli v Baragovo duhovnost. Prepričan je bil, da bi lahko učinkovito predstavili Barago za zgled sodobni mladini, kar bi pospeševalo duhovniške in redovniške poklice. Njegov načrt je bil nepraktičen, ker bi zahvalil intenzivno delo iz meseca v mesec letosnjega leta. Ako bi bil izveden, bi Baragov dan 1979 prinesel obilne duhovne sadove. Izrazil je bojanen, da bo pri Baragovem dnevu poudarek na zunanjost v škodo duhovnega ali verskega dela. Ni mu bilo dočakati veselega sporočila, da bo tudi sobota (1. sept. 1979) posvečena molitvi in pobožnosti. Misli iz njegovega načrta za Baragov dan 1979 so praktične in nam bodo lahko v spodbudo ob raznih prilikah.

Ne morem pozabiti na pokojnega msgr. Johna Zaplotnika, ki je svoje zmožnosti posvetil raziskovanju zgodovine Baragovega življenja in dela ter drugih slovenskih misijonarjev-pionirjev katoliške Cerkve v ZDA. Mislim, da je bilo leta 1954, ko sem kot kaplan pri Sv. Stefanu (Chicago) prišel v začetku septembra v Lemont. Tam sem srečal msgr. Zaplotnika in Mrs. Josepha Gregoricha, ki sta se pripravljala na potovanje v Baragovo deželo. Povabila sta me, naj se jima pridružim. Z veseljem sem sprejel njuno vabilo in naslednje jutro smo se že vozili po cesti 41 proti Marquetteu. Na potovanju smo se ustavili v vseh krajih, ki spominjajo na Baragovo misionsko delovanje: od Munising preko Marquettea, Negaunee, po Keweenanskem polotoku vse do Copper Harbor; obiskali smo grob msgr. Rezka v Houghtonu in grob misijonarja Andolška v Eagle Harbor, bili smo tudi v Bayfieldu in La Pointu. Najdalje smo se zadržali v Negaunee, kjer je bil pri fari sv. Pavla župnik pokojni

msgr. Joseph L. Zryd. Spomnjam se, da nas je s svojim avtomobilom peljal v svojo poletno kočo ob Lake Superior. Tedaj sem zvedel, da je bil msgr. Zryd v avtomobilski nesreči, ko se je nekoga hladnega dne vračal iz koče. Cesta je bila prazna, potresen je ležal pod avtomobilom. Tedaj se je zaobljubil, da bo delal za Baragovo beatifikacijo, ako ga kdo reši izpod avtomobila. Prošnja je bila uslušana in msgr. Zryd je postal znan med Slovenci kot pospeševalec Baragove zadeve.

Pozneje sem še srečaval msgr. Zaplotnika. Z njim sem se tudi dopisoval kot urednik AM in AMK. V našem koledarju je objavljalo svoje zgodovinske spise o slovenskih misijonarjih. Pokojni Father Gabriel Rus SM mi je dajal spodbudo v delu za Baragovo zadevo. Prav v tem delu je bil sam želen aktiven v mesecih in tednih pred svojo smrtno. Zato cutim, da je dolžnost, da ne poročamo samo, da je umrl; z njegovim zgledom moramo nuditi tudi spodbudo za druge, zakaj Baragova zveza potrebuje zvestih sodelavcev. Pokojnega Fathra Gabriela se bomo spominjali v molitvi in skušali nadaljevati delo, ki je bilo njemu tako pri srcu.







Florida, the Land of Sunshine

Fort Lauderdale, Fla. — We are down again to spend the winter in southern Florida, the land of sunshine and warmth. At our retired age it is much more pleasant than it is up North where we had to spend all our growing and working days.

Down there it is quite different than up North where we will return when the time comes to plant and work in the garden.

Florida is a big state and very different from the others. It is a peninsula with a panhandle in the northwestern part that has the shape of a handgun. From the Northwest corner to the East and then South, the road measures full 750 miles, while from North to South the distance is 400 miles, the same as it is from East to West. The country is flat and the soil sandy.

At Christmas time the days at Fort Lauderdale are one hour and fifteen minutes longer than in Chicago or Cleveland.

The short winters are cool at night, but it warms up during the day as the sun rises and temperatures are reasonably steady.

From New Smyrna to Palm Beach there is an occasional frost, but further South it happens very rarely. In 1936 the first snow flurries were recorded in Ft. Lauderdale.

After you drive a couple of hours from Georgia into Florida, the orange and grapefruit groves are all around and there seems to be no end to them.

Here and there are lazy, rolling hills or knolls with some ponds in between. The fruit trees are all planted in rows, and as they need a lot of water, those on higher levels have sprinklers over

 them for better marketable fruit. Oranges and grapefruit need some 300 sunny days, so it takes from 10 to 12 months to ripen, with the result that in late winter you see both fruit and sweet smelling blossoms on the trees at the same time. Since there are many varieties, some ripen in November and others late in June; some of the trees are over forty years old. Such fruits as cherries, grapes, apples and other northern types do not grow here, but other tropical fruits do, such as bananas, but these are not good enough to be marketed.

Grass and trees are always green and bushes are covered with blossoms. The leaves are thick, often large and in time, change color, dry a bit and fall off, and that happens at any time of the year.

Here there is a big variety of palms from potted plants to big trees. Palm leaves grow from the center outward until they dry up and fall off. When the trunk is cut, it shows no rings and so you cannot tell the age of the tree.

In the interior there are a lot of ranches where cattle grazes in the open the year around, but you will see no hayfields or barns.

Of course there are also big vegetable fields for there are many crops per year; just now it is tomatoes, beans and cabbage time.

The houses and homes are usually built on one level, a

foot or two above the ground; and you will find no basements as not far underground water is found, so most houses and all buildings are erected on concrete piles. The homes are mostly built with cement, some brick and metal, but no wood or very little of it. Electricity is used for cooking, heating and air-conditioning but some still prefer the bottled liquid gas.

In the cities you will find many high-rise buildings, some reaching up to 25 stories; the apartments are mostly of the condominium type, that is each apartment is individually owned. There are also a lot of other apartments, efficiencies consisting of room and small kitchen, motels that can be rented for a day, week, month or season. If anybody is interested in buying property, be cautious and get advice from one who specializes in the type of building or home you are purchasing.

Besides the building and construction trades and the all-embracing tourist business, there is no large industry here, but one finds a big choice of restaurants from McDonald's to Le Cordon Bleu, retail stores, supermarkets and shopping centers. The prices are fairly reasonable but winter clothing outlets are not to be found.

Florida is well known for lots of sunshine, and in the summer it is hot, especially in the interior. The state is appealing and attractive but not for everyone. The majority of the people here come from the northern states.

A lot of Golden Agers are here for the winter, and then in the summer go up north to be with their family and long time friends. Then comes a time to settle in one place and the majority decides to stay here.

Slovenians are scattered throughout the state; most of them are on the Atlantic coast as in New Smyrna-Samsula where they have a long-time established Slovenian Hall.

In Fort Lauderdale a social is held in a very nice place, on the first Sunday of the month. All Slovenians are welcome. For information, please call Tony Kebe or his wife Mrs. Christine Kebe at 564-8756. It must also be mentioned that a good number of folks live on the West coast of the state, near the Gulf of Mexico.


