Zavezniški bombniki in topovi pa so uničili nadaljnih 39 tankov ter tekoma 24 ur prisilili čete maršala Rommela dykat k umiku.

Ameriški in angleški bombniki imajo absolutno kontrolo v zraku ter operirajo tako uspešno, da niso zavezniški izgubili iz za pondeljka, ko se je pričela sedanjo bitka, še niti enega letala.

V zadnji bitki je bilo 15 ameriških tankov, katerih posadke so štele 92 mož in šest časnikov. Med ameriškim moštrom ni bilo nobenih smrtnih izgub,

LONDON, 4. septembra.

Vse izgleda, da nameravajo nemški nacijski izpodnosti zadnje stebre, ki so še podpirali neodvisnost Madžarske ter da namestavajo urediti deželo, ki je bila ena prvih njihovih satelitov, popoloma po svojem načinu. Za madžarskega regenta in naslednika admirala Nikolaja Horhjevega so izbrali avstrijskega nadvojvoda Albrehta, ki je mož po njihovem okusu.

S tem je tudi pojasnjena zagonetna smrt Horhjevega sina, ki je postal "žrtve letalske nesreče" na ruski fronti, kakor tudi nesrečna smrt Julija Karolyja, Horhjevega zeta, ki se je tudi te dni "v letalski nesreči" ubil. Horhjev sin bi bil nasledil kot regent svojega očeta, admirala Horhjya, kot drugi pa je prihajal v poštev grof Karoly.

### NEMCI IZGUBLJAJO NA DAN POVPREČNO PO 45 LETAL

MOSKVA, sobota, 5. septembra — Ruski komunike naznačajo, da je ojačen ruski odpor na Stalingradu so bile nemške napadalne kolone ustanovljene. "Naše čete nadaljujejo z decimiranjem sovražnega mosta v njegove opreme," pravi ruski komunike.

V enem samem odsek na južnozapadni strani Stalingrada, so Rusi uničili šest nemških tankov ter pobili 600 Nemcev, ki so napadli zagozdo, ki so jo Nemci zabilo v ruske čete.

V smeri proti severozapadu so izgubili Nemci nadaljnih 13 tankov izmed štiridesetih, s katerimi so napadli.

Velike letalske izgube Nemcev

MOSKVA, 4. septembra. — Rdeča zvezda, organ sovjetske armade, poroča, da so nemške izgube v letalih na ruski fronti tako velike, da daleč presegajo nemško producijo letal. Med 15. majem in 15. avgustom so izgubili Nemci nad 4.000 letal, to je povprečno po 45 na dan. Nacijnska produkcija ne more vzdrževati korakov s takšnimi izgubami.



The World's Richest Man  
Found It Didn't Pay

Ashurbanipal of Assyria, the richest man who ever lived, was worth a trillion and a half dollars—75 times as much gold as is held in the United States Treasury. Yet it availed him nothing! Neither he nor his son had the sense to use this wealth for the good of their people or for their protection.

And so the great Ashurbanipal, the richest man in the world, was consumed in his own wealth—he immolated himself and became part of this great conglomerated melted mass of money—and so ended the Empire of the Assyrians. And it never rose again.

I was in Nineveh a few years ago. Only a few mounds marked the spot that was the glory of Ashurbanipal.

Why?  
Because Ashurbanipal, who had practically all the money in the world, didn't do anything with it! And he and his country were lost.

Even his conquerors—the Medes and the Persians—made this same mistake—they came, saw, conquered, and confiscated this great golden molten mass of money that was once the king's and the wealth of the great Empire of Assyria—what did they do with it?

Nothing!  
They melted it into money again—and remelted it—and in generations since it has been remelted a thousand times—until, Believe It or Not, it is a mathematical fact that every golden coin used in the world today contains in some minute particle of Ashurbanipal himself, the King who had all the money in the world but didn't know what to do with it!

What are we going to do with our money today? Enemies threaten us the same as they threatened Ashurbanipal in 626 B. C. The United States today, like the Assyria of Ashurbanipal, is the richest nation in the world. What will it avail us?

Nothing?  
Surely nothing more than it did Ashurbanipal unless we do something with it. And there is only one thing to do—and that is to Buy Bonds and War Stamps and make our money directly available to our country—help our country—otherwise it will become a melted molten mass and we the people will be destroyed as Ashurbanipal was destroyed 2600 years ago.

### Course For Civilian Defense Leaders

Cleveland, O. — A dozen Army officers and enlisted men from the War Department Civilian Protection School at Purdue University, will come to Cleveland to conduct, in the Little Theatre of Public Auditorium, a two-day extension course for Civilian Defense leaders of this area, Thursday and Friday, August 20 and 21.

This concentrated course consists of lectures and demonstrations by qualified experts, and will be climaxed by a great outdoor demonstration on incendiary bombs the night of Friday, August 21, at Brookside Park. Some seven hundred men and women are expected to attend the classes in the Little Theatre each of the two days, from nine o'clock in the morning to five o'clock in the afternoon, and a control center demonstration, Thursday evening from seven o'clock to ten o'clock.

Civilian Defense commanders from communities throughout northern Ohio are being invited to attend the stream-lined extension school, and all mayors and Civilian Defense officials in the Cuyahoga County Council, the training instructors, the controllers of the thirty report and control centers and their staffs, zone wardens, members of the fire department, directors of factory police and fire brigades, air raid wardens, auxiliary firemen, auxiliary police, emergency medical personnel, and others who wish to register for the free instruction course, are invited to do so by William A. Stinchcomb, Director of the County Council.

Such subjects as: Aircraft warning service, handling incendiary bombs, collective protection, protective clothing, decontamination, blackouts, police, fire, emergency medical, public works, utilities, communications, and control centers, from the War Department School faculty.

Those who wish to attend the extension course in the Little Theatre are urged to signify their intentions by writing to the Cuyahoga County Council for Civilian Defense, 279 Public Auditorium.
