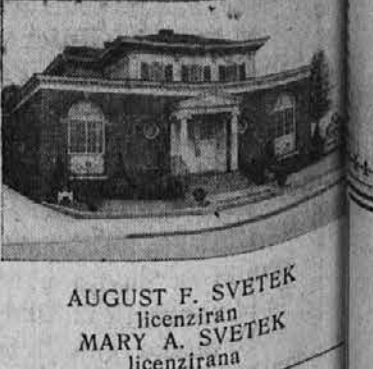

Still the most outstanding problem facing the present City Council is the Cleveland Railway transportation system—and the question "How to facilitate mass transportation in this town as quickly and cheaply as is possible?"

Last Monday night Council adopted legislation sponsored by 32nd Ward Councilman Anton Vehovec to provide a deluxe bus service line running from E. 185th St. to E. 140th St., picking up passengers in the northeast portion of Cleveland, and then running express through Bratenahl Village on Lake Shore Blvd. to E. 9th St., south to Superior Ave. then west on Superior to and around the old Federal Bldg. on the Public Square. This service is to cost the people of the Collinwood area 15 cents plus 1 cent for any transfer or one car ticket and 5 cents cash.

Many persons from that section attended the meeting and were in favor of the contemplated rate and Mr. Vehovec felt justified in supporting the legislation as a representative of those people on the grounds that for the past six or seven years the service there has been terrible—taking the people between one hour and a quarter to one hour and a half to get to the downtown area and with the installation of "deluxe" service this time would probably be cut in half.

However, several factors were brought out at the meeting which prompted me to vote against the legislation in spite of the fact that I knew the people in this part of Cleveland were entitled to better service than they have been getting.

In the first place a copy of a letter was produced, signed by the Mayor or Bratenahl Village, stating that their local Council would grant the company permission to use the portion of Lake Shore Blvd located in Bratenahl Village for their bus line. The letter continued, "... furthermore may I say that I believe that Bratenahl will welcome this additional service, as a real service to its citizens—after the decision as to the line has been reached, we can arrange the proper stopping points," signed, Mayor Garfield.

This letter clearly indicates that Bratenahl expects to pick up passengers and discharge them in their corporate limits—thereby not giving the Collinwood people so called "Express" or "deluxe" service that they will be paying for.

If the Cleveland Railway Company does not comply with the Village's request to make these stops, they will in all probability be refused this permit. Furthermore, no proof was offered that the residents of Bratenahl would have to pay a 15 cent fare, for all we know, they may demand to that charge.

Secondly, Mayor Blythin pointed out that if this 15 cent charge was approved it would establish a precedent for this rate for a ride beginning and ending in the city of Cleveland—a matter contrary to the Taylor Franchise which sets a top rate of fare at 10 cents a ride. The charges for this kind of service would be higher than "in any other city in North America" he said.

10 Cent Fare on Carnegie Now It was also brought out by Councilmen Emil Crown and Edward Pucel that for years the Railway Co. neglected to provide adequate service to this community and in fact disapproved similar legislation several years ago because the city would not grant a twenty-five cent fare, and now, suddenly desires to give this service.

Their action now makes it appear that the company fears the city may go into competition with the company by putting in supplementary lines and using Lake Shore Blvd. as one of the main routes, connecting the northeastern section with downtown Cleveland.

In the light of these facts I felt it my duty to vote against the proposal which was passed by a 22 to 10 vote. An amendment to make the rate 10 cents was introduced by Councilman Pucel but this proposal was defeated by council.

The 10th Ward councilman stressed the point that a similar express service is being operated now from the Heights on Carnegie Ave. for 10 cents by the Cleveland Railway Co. and contended that it was unfair to impose a 15 cent fare on the residents of Collinwood.

TWIN CITIES ATTRACTING CATHOLICS TO NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS

Expect 450,000 Worshipers To Meet From All Parts of American Life Including 150 Prelates and Dignitaries

ST. PAUL, June 13.—Completion of arrangements for the world's most important religious celebration in 1941, the ninth National Eucharistic Congress, June 23 to 26, in the Twin Cities, were announced by the Very Rev. James M. Reardon, Minneapolis, general chairman.

Heading an impressive list of Catholic notables who will participate in events during the four-day assembly is the Papal Legate, His Eminence Dennis Cardinal Dougherty, Archbishop of Philadelphia, appointed by His Holiness, Pope Pius XII, and the Most Rev. Amleto Giovanni Cicognani, Archbishop of Laodicea, Apostolic Delegate to the United States.

Fifteen archbishops and two abbots from the attending 150 prelates will officiate at religious functions and address general and sectional meetings. Archbishop John Gregory Murray of the archdiocese of St. Paul, is official host to the Congress which is expected to attract 450,000 Catholics from all parts of North and South America.

The Minnesota state fairgrounds, midway between Minneapolis and St. Paul, will be the National Eucharistic Center. Temporary seats for 125,000 persons are being erected for official opening of the Congress, midnight Mass for men and daytime pontifical Masses.
