Senat hoče strožji zakon za lobiste tujih držav

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Senadni odbor za zunanjo politiko je izglasoval nov zakon, ki bo običajno prizadel vse tiste lobiste, ki proti odškodnini zastopajo interese tujih držav. Novi zakon skuša preprečiti vse tiste zlorabe, ki jih uganjajo lobisti, kadar zastopajo tuje države. Kako velike so zlorabe, je pokazala lanska preiskava, ki je odkrila, kakšni vplivi in denarji so bili na delu za kvote, ki naj jih posamezne države dobijo za uvoz njihovega sladkorja v našo deželo. Zlorabe niso seveda bile nič manjše tudi v drugih manj razpitih slučajih.

Oče novega zakona je predsednik odbora in znan nasprotnik lobistov senator Fulbright. Spravil je v zakon določbe, ki obvezujejo lobiste, da igrajo v odkritimi kartami, da morajo o blastem dati točne in podrobne podatke o svojem poslovanju, da morajo zmeraj povedati, koga zastopajo in kakšno odškodnino so dobili za svoje delo. Lobisti tudi ne smejo podpirati ne političnih strank, ne kandidatov prav v nobeni o-

bliki in po nobeni poti. Fulbright upa, da bo zakon šel še letos skozi kongresno zasedanje.

Uvoz jekla narašča

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Načelnik Republic Steel Corp. Thomas F. Patton iz Clevelanda je odbor Herterja, ki zbira gradivo za konferenco, ki se bo sešla letošnjo spomlad v Zenevi v Švici, da uredi carine v trgovini med Združenimi državami in Skupnim trgov. opozoril na rastoči uvoz jekla v Združene države iz Evrope in Japonske.

Patton je dejal, da stoji naša dežela pred izbiro: Ali naj pritiska na evropske države in Japonsko, da znižajo uvozne carine na raven ameriških, ali pa da dvigne svoje lastne uvozne carine na raven evropskih držav in Japonske. Evropska in japonska jeklarska industrija je moderna in avtomatizirana v taki meri, da ameriška z njo komaj tekmuje. Dokler ne bo ta izpopolnjena in modernizirana, potrebuje neko zaščito zvezne vlade.

Uvoz jekla v Združene države naj bi se v zadnjih letih dvignil od 2.5 na okoli 9 milijonov ton. Ameriške jeklarne so sposobne izdelati vse potrebno jeklo vseh vrst doma, toda to je dražje od uvoženega, zato ga nekatere industrije raje kupujejo v tujini. S tem so seveda ob delo in zaslužek delavci v Združenih državah.

Patton je dejal, da je zmogljivost jeklarske industrije v svobodnem svetu že sedaj prevelika, da pa bo še večja, ker skušajo zaostale države graditi svoje lastne jeklarne.

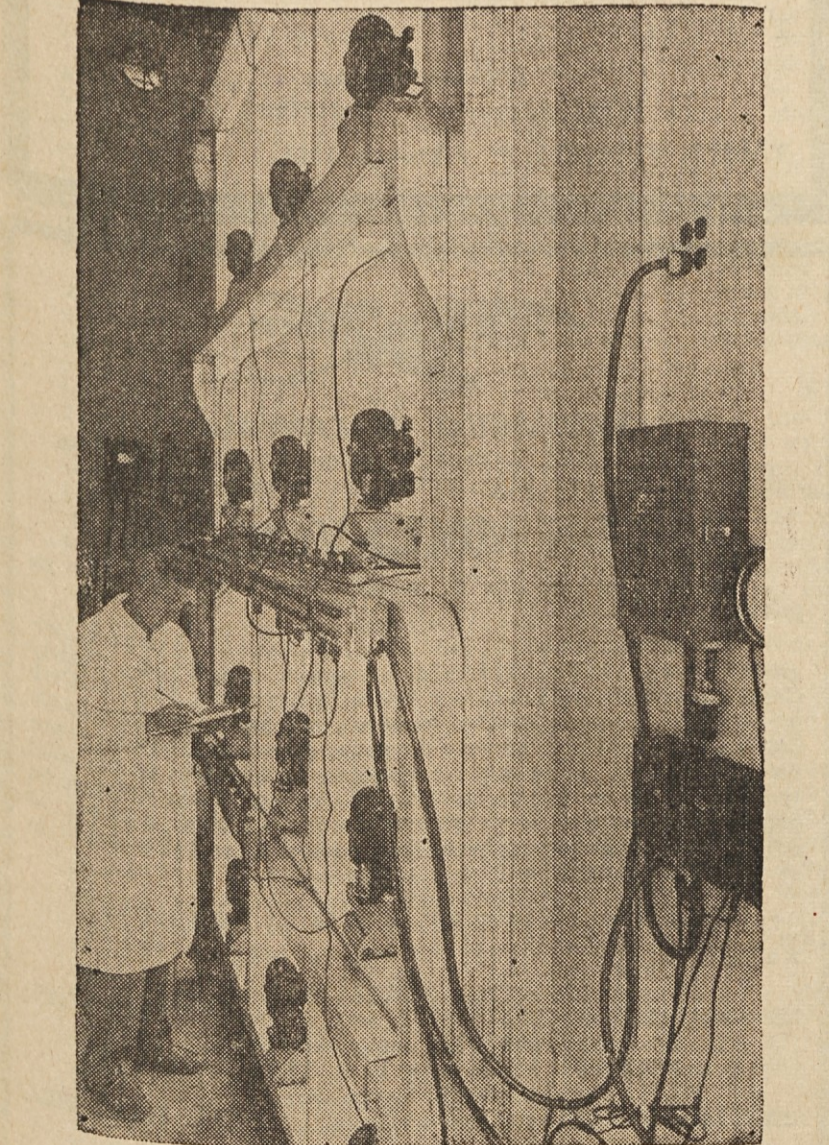

A Generous Tribute to our Slain President

Thousands of dollars in unsolicited memorial offerings have flowed into the United Nations and affiliated organizations since President Kennedy's death.

As the nation prepared to bury its slain President in Arlington National Cemetery, the Kennedy family suggested that instead of sending funeral flowers, mourners donate the money to benevolent causes.

Since then the U.N. comptroller has received dozens of contributions, one as large as \$1000, and the American Mission to the U.N. has accumulated more than \$1500. These sums will be used to build a Kennedy memorial wing for the new U.N. International School building in New York.

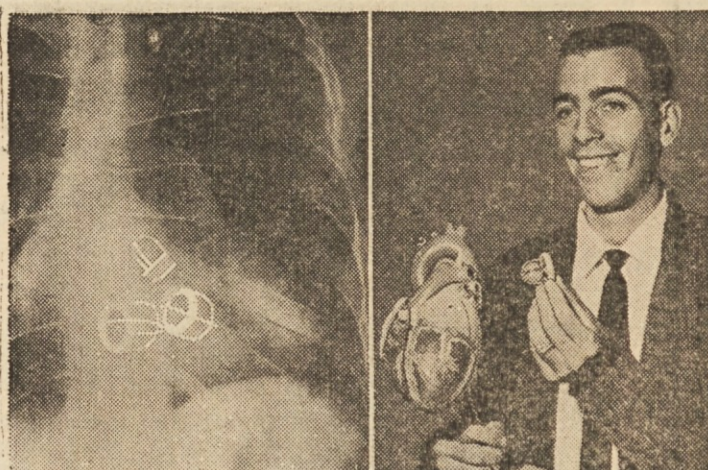
Other donors have sent more than \$2000 to the U.N. Children's Fund (UNICEF) and over \$100 to the U.N. Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) for their worldwide programs.

CARE, the U.N.-affiliated relief organization, reports a total of more than \$13,000. With her \$1 gift, a Bradley Beach, N.J. teen-ager wrote: "A few days ago I started saving money to buy myself a transistor radio. I would like you to use this money in your CARE projects. I have lost a true friend on the death of the President."
