

## VELIKA ZMAGA ZANIMIVE VESTI IZ ŽIVLJENJA NAŠIH LJUDI PO ŠIRNI AMERIKI

Levičarske stranke so dobiti več kot polovico vseh mandatov v parlamentu. Poražena vlada je proglašila "stanje alarma." Politični jetniki revoltirali.

MADRID, 18. feb. — V nedeljo so se vrstile v Španiji parlamentarne volitve, pri katerih so radikalne delavske stranke pod vodstvom Francisa Largo Caballera izvojevale sijajno zmago. Kot razvidno iz še ne-popolnih poročil, bodo radikali imeli v novem parlamentu najmanj 238 mandatov izmed 470. Ljudska (klerikalna) stranka je dobila 90 sedežev, vlada 35 sedežev, druge stranke pa ostale. Caballero je izjavil, da je zmaga levičarskih strank pri korak napravil socialistični republik pod diktaturo proletariata.

Vlada je uvedla strogo cenzuro ter širom dežele proglašila "stanje alarma," v mestih Valencia, Zaragoza in Alicante pa je bil proglašen preki sod. Sinoči je po nekaerih mestih prislo do ostrih političnih izbruhov. V Madridu in Barceloni so vse povsod zaplapalale rdeče zastave.

V Valenciji je v ječi revoltalo 734 jetnikov (očividno političnih), ki so začgali jetnišnico ter streljali na stražnike in vojaštvo. Jetniki so jetniškim stražnikom iztrgali orožje in municio in bitka se je nadaljevala pozno v noč.

### Stara garda za Landona

Državni odbor republikanske stranke v Ohio je včeraj apeliral na gov. Landona iz Kansasa, da stopi v predsedniške primarne volitve v Ohio, ker hoče na vsak način poraziti senatorja Boraha. Isti krogi tudi na vso moč pritisajo na čikaškega časnikega magnata Knoxa, da bi ne prijavil kandidature v Ohio, v zameno kar se mu obljublja pomoč za slučaj, da bi Landon ne dobil nominacije.

McKitternick, ki je 2. marca 1935 z avtomobilom zavozil v cestno-železniško čakališče ter ubil dve osebi, tretjo pa nevarno ranil. To je bila že tretja obnavava proti McKitternicku. Prosekacija je trdila, da je bil obtoženec za časa nesreče prijan. Kazen za ubojstvo je zapored pet do dvajset let.

Poklicnik je zdravnik dr. Pintarja, ki mu je nudil prvo pomoč, nakar je bil prepeljan v bolnišnico v Ljubljano.

Ako bi bil zmagal desničarski blok, bi bile monarhistične sile s tem doobile novega poguma in obstoj republike bi bil resno ogrožen. Taka zmaga bi najbrže prisilila predsednika Zamoro k resignaciji.

"El Socialista," vodilni socialistični organ, je 18. decembra začel iznova izhajati, in iznova so začele izhajati številne druge radikalne in delavske publikacije.

Na drugi strani pa obstaja notranje neprilike v socialistični stranki. Largo Caballero, poznan kot "španski Lenin," je odstopil kot predsednik stranke. Narodni izvrševalni odbor stranke ga je

Sledil je Boland, ki je tudi katoličan, ter udaril po Coughlinu radi njegove politične aktivnosti. "Pri svojih nedeljskih pridigah drži eno roko na svetem pismu, z drugo pa šteje dobiček od svoje špekulacije s srebrom," je dejel Boland.

Za radio pridigarja se je potegnil edino kongresman Sweeney iz Clevelanda, čigar govor pa je izval živige na galeriji. "Kaj je narobe s Coughlinom?" je vprašal Sweeney. "Zato, ker se drzno napasti mene ali vas? To je njegova pravica. Mi utegneši biti užaljeni, ker nas zmerja in ker nas grozi izgnati iz kongresa. Ampak v tej zbornici je veliko služabnikov velenjihčnih interesov. Cas prihaja!" je zaklical Sweeney, žigajoč najprej proti demokratom, potem pa se proti republikancem. "Vi uteste v svojem srcu, da se gre edino za pošteno delo za narod."

STOJADINOVIC JE DOBIL ZAUPNICO

BEOGRAD, 17. feb. — Kabinet ministrskega predsednika Stojadinovića je bil nanovo utrjen, ko je prejel zaupnico 153 glasov proti 110. Pred glasovanjem so poslanci, ki so ga načrtnili za časa Aleksandrovega in Živkovičevega diktatorstva, večinoma zapustili zbornico. Kot izgleda, opozicija ne more vreči Stojadinovića in da bo do 1. aprila dosegel, da bo skupščina sprejela njegov proračun.

## More On Paralysis

We have seen paralysis as arising in the brain proper. We have also stated that certain infections may cause a paralysis. Some infections have a special predilection for the spinal cord only and cause no damage to the brain. Infantile paralysis, properly termed anterior poliomyelitis, is such an infection and often leaves permanent damage to the nerve pathways, particularly at the junction points in the spinal cord. In the early stage of the disease there is no evidence that the nervous system is invaded by the infection and in such cases the patient may recover without ever having developed a paralysis although true infantile paralysis was present. A little later in the disease the nervous system is invaded and paralysis results, but with proper care the paralysis improves. The explanation is found in the fact that as the acute inflammation subsides some of the nerves turn out not to have been permanently damaged.

When a toxin from an infection affects a nerve, as it does occasionally in typhoid fever, diphtheria, influenza and other acute infectious diseases it is termed an infectious neuritis.

Injuries to the head often result in paralysis. The injury may be the result of a gunshot wound in which the bullet has penetrated the brain tissue. It may result from a fracture of the skull when the bones or bony fragments may press on the motor nerve centers. With any fracture and occasionally without fracture, a hemorrhage results from the tearing or rupturing of a blood vessel, and the hemorrhage itself causes an injury to the nerve pathways with paralysis resulting. In any injury, however, unless the motor control or motor pathways themselves are injured, the paralysis does not develop.


Injuries to the spine may produce paralysis, either by cutting the pathways in the spinal cord or by pressure on them. In either case the paralysis affects the whole body below the injury. With paralysis from this cause, a person loses sensation below the injured points because the pathways carrying the senses of touch and temperature and pain are likewise interrupted. This is what happens in those cases we read about at times in which a person diving in shallow water hits his head and comes to the surface with a broken neck. He not only is paralyzed below the neck, but also has lost all sensation below this point.

Stretching, pinching or cutting a motor nerve in the arm or leg may result in the paralysis of the muscles supplied by that nerve. The pinching or cutting of a nerve may be the result of fractures, cuts, etc. The stretching of the nerves in the arms that sometimes occurs when a child is being born tears these nerves at their roots, thus being the explanation of a certain type of paralysis present from birth.


