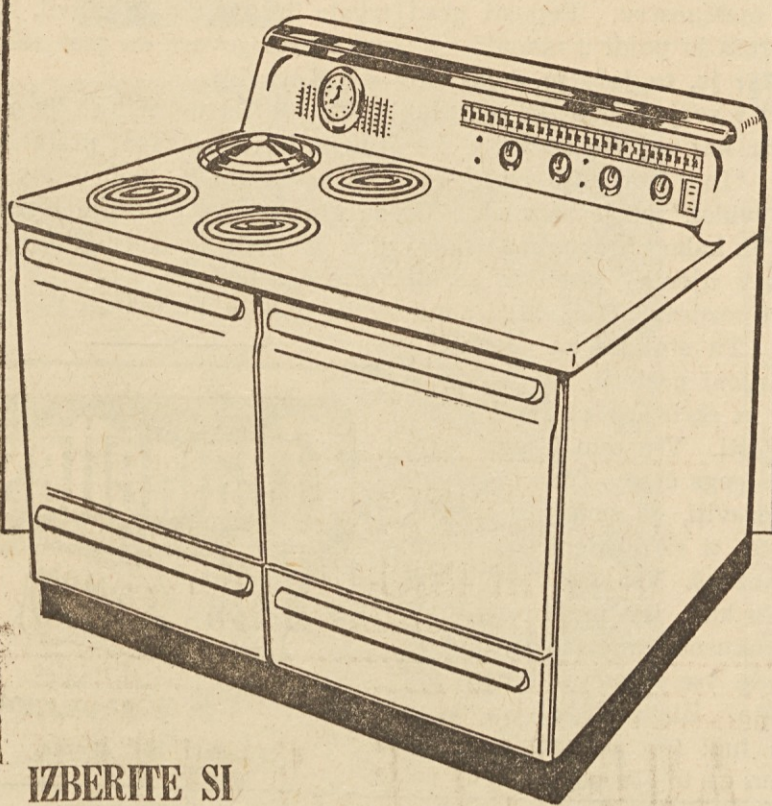

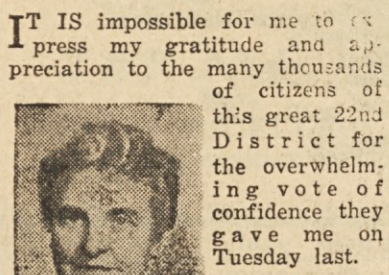

This and That in Washington

IT IS impossible for me to express my gratitude and appreciation to the many thousands of citizens of this great 22nd District for the overwhelming vote of confidence they gave me on Tuesday last.

It is a very real challenge, Friends, and I shall take my seat in the 82nd Congress on January 3rd with deep appreciation, fresh courage and an even greater determination to give myself to your service, to the preservation of the Freedom that is the heritage of all Americans, and to the principles of our Representative Republic, which more than any other formula of government yet devised by man, protects the individual and gives opportunity to all.

To the hundreds and thousands who worked actively in my behalf, I want to express my deep gratitude. My appreciation cannot be put into adequate words. I take advantage of this medium of contact with you to say a "thank you" which comes from the bottom of my heart.

I pledge to each man and woman of this great District continuance of the selfless service I set myself to give when I was first elected to the Congress in 1940. You know me well, you know these are not idle words.

Although the total popular vote, in contrast with the number eligible to vote, as given in the Plain

Dealer of November 3rd was exceedingly disappointing in view of the importance of the decisions that had to be made, it is gratifying that those who went to the polls did so with a very definite understanding of what was at stake. Here in Ohio the numbers far exceeded expectations. The protest against the status quo was very clear. Let us hope that there may be a continuing interest in the vital matters that will have to be considered during the last weeks of the 81st Congress, and the two years of the 82nd. They will affect the long future.

While we have been giving ourselves to our free election, tremendous things have happened in the world. The Korean situation, as I write, seems to have come to a moment of possible resolution. Let us hope that whatever action is taken by the United Nations, it may be one without appeasement but with united strength. Reports that come over my desk seem to indicate that France is moving towards agreements that will be bulwarks of strength to free Europe. Indignation over the ruthless aggression in Tibet of the Chinese Communist regime is world wide, as is the anxiety as to its implications and results.

The world is indeed in turmoil. We, who are in a position requiring great wisdom, understanding and courage, must not speak nor act impulsively, nor must we move without weighing all considerations on the scales of Peace, for Peace is the ultimate goal, the longing of every human heart. It is for us to protect the road the world must travel to reach that goal. It is for us to seek courage, understanding, awareness and wisdom daily before the throne of Almighty God.

To Review Mlakar Book at Collinwood Library

Collinwood Branch Library, 856 E. 152nd St. is happy to announce an event which should be of interest to everyone. On Thursday evening Nov. 30 at 8 p.m. at the library, Miss Marjorie Ramisch, Librarian of Broadway Branch, will review the book entitled HE, THE FATHER by Frank Mlakar. Here is an opportunity for the residents of Cleveland to hear a review of an outstanding novel, dealing with sin and repentance, beginning and ending in a Slovenian village, with the mid-western U. S. (which is Cleveland) as the scene of the main action. As many of you perhaps already know, the author, Mr. Mlakar, lived in the Collinwood area and is a graduate of Collinwood High School.

In a letter to Mrs. Irene Adair, Librarian of the Collinwood Branch, Mr. Mlakar expressed his wish to attend the review. Unable to do so, he has sent his heartiest greetings and sincere thanks for any interest his friends may have in him and the book. He says, "There is nothing so gratifying to a writer as the nod of approval from the home-town folks. Some of them who probably knew me very well in the old days, may have difficulty in picturing me as a writer, but perhaps Miss Ramisch will have a few nice things to say about the book and that ought to convince them, don't you think?"

The critics have a few things to say about Mr. Mlakar's book. "A first novel of distinct promise and haunting impact," says J. G. Hitrec of the SATURDAY REVIEW OF LITERATURE. "Mr. Mlakar, American born in 1913 but a Slovene by ancestry," writes J. H. Jackson of the San Francisco Chronicle, "has

NEPH Essay Contest Set for H.S. Juniors, Seniors
Rules for a 1951 "NEPH" Essay Contest have been sent to 70 high schools in Cuyahoga County by the Mayor's Committee for the Employment of the Handicapped, Chairman Frederick T. McGuire, Jr., announced. The contest is being sponsored locally by the Mayor's Committee and nationally, by the President's Committee on National Employment of the Physically Handicapped Week.

Topic for the essays is "Equal Opportunity in Employment for the Physically Handicapped," and the contest is open to all high school Juniors and Seniors.
Parchment awards signed by the President of the United States will be given the four best essays in each state. State first prize winners will be eligible for national prizes of \$1,000, \$300, \$200 and \$100.
Entrants may contact their local Ohio State Employment Center, local libraries, local offices of the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation of the State Department of Education, and offices of the Veterans Administration for background information.
Deadline for essays entrants is Dec. 15th.
