KEEP TAXES DOWN!

Auditor's Report

As I have pointed out before, all Real Estate taxpayers in Cuyahoga County will receive a 10% reduction in the tax bill they receive in June.

Most of this reduction will be wiped out in your December bill because of a Board of Tax Appeal's ruling that will increase property valuations in Cuyahoga County to 35% of market value.

I am, therefore, asking for support from all taxpayers for Substitute Senate Bill 455 which will guarantee that you will receive your full 10% reduction in December.

Substitute Senate Bill 455 delays the implementation of the Board of Tax Appeals 35% rule until the next county-wide reappraisal. It also provides that when the 35% rule goes into effect and property values increase, tax rates will be proportionately reduced.

Substitute Senate Bill 455 will be debated on the floor of the Senate when the General Assembly reconvenes in May. So that you do not have a Real Estate tax increase in December, I urge you to contact your state senator indicating your support of Senate Bill 455.

A national Conference on Ethnicity will be held at Cleveland State University May 11, 12, 13. Prominent scholars will present their views of the concept of ethnicity in the American context as well as their opinions on the coexistence of the numerous nationality groups in America. Of particular relevance are their findings on the role of ethnic consciousness plays in the life of the individual person and the influence such consciousness will have on the development of American society.

Thirty ethnic groups are preparing a festival and folk arts

exhibit representing the rich cultural heritage of the various nationalities that contribute so much to Cleveland's life. The festival itself will take place in the Allen Theater, 1407 Euclid Ave., on Saturday, May 13, at 7:30 p.m. Individual exhibits will be on display in downtown stores from April 26 to May 8 and then at CSU from May 11 to 13.

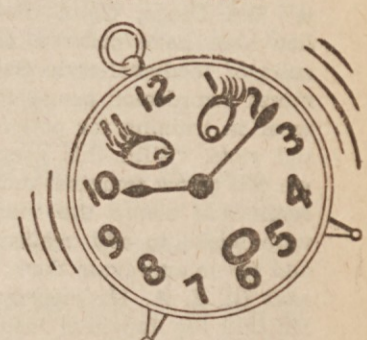
