Kak bo naš odgovor?

Mussolinijev agent namnil, da bo Italija izstopila iz Lige narodov

IZREDNA SEJA BRITSKEGA KABINETA

Pariz, 20. avg.—Angleško-italijanski spor zaradi Abesinije se napolil po polomu angleško-francosko-italijanske konference v Parizu. Z britske strani je včeraj prila odpela grožnja, da bo skoraj abesinske vojevne s skupinami in modernimi puškami, z italijansko-namigom, da bo Italija izstopila iz Lige narodov.

Baron Pompeo Alasio, Mussolinijev predstavnik, je prvič, od kar je izbruhnila angleško-abesinska kriza, poudaril možnost izstopila iz Lige narodov.

Alois je celo dejal, da navzvenost predstavnikov Italije na sredu sveta Lige narodov, ki se očitoma 4. septembra v Ženevi, zadajo dogodkov, ki se bodo razvili v prihodnjih dveh tednih. Jezova izjava se tu smatra za izredno mnenja, da je Mussolini spregovoril končno besedo in da Italija kmalu napovedala izstopila iz Lige narodov.

Angleški krogi, ki so bili nenačuditi, da se bo slednja lahko uradila Italijanom, je prvi odgovor Anglie Mussoliniju, ki je zaredil angleško-francoski mirovni načrt in s tem povzročil polom konference.

Dasi je koncentracija italijanske vojaštva v Eritreji zmanjšala možnost, da bi Abesinija očitoma svojo neodvisnost, je že včeraj spremval, da bo afriška država igrala gldečilno vlogo, ako bo pravočasno dobila dovolj orodja in muničije, zlasti če bo celo Selassie izjavil strategijo, ki bila po mnenju evropskih miliitarističnih ekspertov najbolj učinkovita v kampanji proti Italiji. Italijanski armadi naj bi delovali vkorakanje v Abesinijo, dokler naj bi njegovi vojevni skupini guerilsko vojno proti sovražniku. V tem slučaju, pravijo stranknjaki, je možnost, da dobro izvijejo vojno.

Baron Alois je včeraj očitoma skoraj, da so Italijani vznemirjeni zaradi britske kampanje, kar je mobiliziranje javne mnenje proti Italiji pred očitom se sveta Lige narodov. Možnost je, da bodo člani Lige na tej seji odobrite ekonomike in druge sankcije proti Italiji. Alois je včeraj prvič, od kar so tudi prilegli razgovori o italijansko-abesinski krizi, posebno časopisne poročevalce. Tukaj je pojasnil, da sploh ne spore med Italijo in Anglijo. Britaka grožnja, da bo Angleška oborožila Abesinijo, je spravljena v zatoči tudi Lavala, francoskega premierja. On bi rad potonal spor in preprečil vsakega vrnitev v Ženevi. Ki bi lahko vrnitev Italije v nemški tabor. Očitoma Francija in Anglia, pa se želijo javnega mnenja doma kažejo tudi pritiska s strani mafija, ki zahtevajo, da Lige narodov odobri ekonomiske sankcije proti Italiji. Te sankcije bi tudi zavtorile Sueški prekopa italijanskim bojnjadom.

Ružička je izrekel upanje, da se velika revolucija obeta iz te pridobitve. Umetno ustvarjeni hormoni te vrste bodo hodovali služili bodočemu zdravniku za popravljanje spolnih abnormalnosti in drugih fizičnih ter mentalnih defektov pri ljudih.

E. S. L. Conference Important Notice

It is with particular pleasure that we are able to announce the successful consummation of a historic act adopted by the Supreme board of the Slovene National Benefit Society at its semi-annual session, held on Aug. 8-9-10, 1935, authorizing a special conference of all English speaking lodges of the Society which will take place on Nov. 2, 1935, in conjunction with the commemoration of the tenth anniversary of the founding of the English speaking lodge movement within the SNPJ, sponsored by the Pioneers, Lodge 559, of Chicago.

This important decision provides that each and every English speaking lodge shall be entitled to one representative at the conference, regardless of distance or number of members, and that the Society shall pay for railroad transportation and one per diem (\$7.50) to every delegate attending the conference.

The conference will be held in the SNPJ auditorium, actual time and details of the program of the conference to be announced later and at the proper time. The Board also decided that a preliminary conference shall be held in Cleveland at the celebration of the 10th anniversary of the E. S. L. by the Cleveland Federation on Aug. 31—Sept. 1 and 2, over Labor day. At this gathering definite plans will be laid for the Chicago conference to be held in November.

Now, brothers and sisters, let us realize the full meaning of these significant decisions, and let us respond to the call cheerfully with the true SNPJ spirit!

Let us realize that this special privilege granted to the English speaking lodges by the Supreme board actually means a new epoch for the younger generation and a great and vigorous forward stride in our fraternal endeavors!

Let us also realize the fact that the Slovene National Benefit Society was the first fraternal organization recognizing the need and importance of the role the youth will play in our fraternal world if given a real opportunity; that the SNPJ was the first to sanction the idea of organizing English speaking lodges; and that the SNPJ is the first in granting its young members the privilege of holding a genuine conference or convention of their own, of all English speaking lodges.

Let us realize, further, that the Slovene National Benefit Society is the most progressive workers' fraternal organization in everything that is really progressive and worthwhile, and that within its ranks we find our best chances to assert ourselves fraternally and socially.

Therefore, let us show our gratitude and appreciation to our pioneers and veteran members and the Society by responding unitedly as a great fraternal body and help make this unique occasion a great historical event for the entire English speaking lodge movement and for the Slovene National Benefit Society.

Let us show that within us exists the indomitable spirit and hope that during the tenth anniversary jubilee campaign the English speaking lodges will show sufficient progress to warrant our progressive claims and justify our demands for a bigger and stronger English speaking lodge movement of the Slovene National Benefit Society. Let us strive to increase our folds so that our lodges will embrace every hamlet and village, every town and city where our people live, and bring under the benevolent protection of our Society every eligible adult and juvenile individual.

An excellent idea! Of course, the big crooks who shield kidnappers, bank robbers and others of that ilk should be confined to "hoosegow".

But how about the members of the bar who are in league with the criminals of the upper world—bankers, utility magnates and others who persistently flout the law but are kept out of the penitentiary by smart lawyers?

Mr. Cummings has been in office more than two years. He has delivered more speeches denouncing crime and criminals than any other attorney general, but the big law-breakers are still doing business at the old stand.

New Deal Contradictions

Behind every move at Washington dealing with the depression is the idea of not disturbing the holy institution of capitalistic property. Human beings outside the range of view are dealt with as animals to be kept until the owners can use them in industry.

The latest move is the WPA program reducing wages in the building trades one-half and extending the hours of labor. This is intended to shift workers from relief rolls to payrolls of the government. Only a little over a hundred thousand have thus far been shifted from idle relief to employment relief. In Middle West some states have cut off relief to force those receiving it to work in harvest fields.

Of the WPA program another situation developing. There are those who are jobless but who have some resources not yet exhausted. Not until they become bankrupt will they be eligible for idle relief, but they also can no longer work as these jobs go to those receiving relief. The job preference of the idle thus coming to be called the "aristocracy of the idle." Later the jobless man whose sources are finally exhausted will have the glorious privilege of being a member of the "aristocracy."

Meantime, the WPA program will exert fearful downward pressure on wages throughout the country, thus reducing purchasing power and increasing the number of the idle. These contradictions and absurdities are direct outcome of policies that seek the preservation of production for the profit gains of the capitalist class. Misery without end is the price of all this unless the masses have the intelligence to end the capitalist system out of which this torture and uncertainty issue.

The Answer to Machine Production

The ingenuity of man has made it only possible, but necessary—for private plantation owners to cast aside an entire section, involving millions, of the working class. We refer to the Rust cotton-picking machine.

The mechanical cotton picker will do a job better and quicker than human hands possibly could. The share-cropper and the farm laborer will therefore be added to the relief rolls.

It matters not that machines don't wear out and will therefore not become customs for their product. It is useless to point to the plight of the workers who will be ruthlessly scrapped. The plantation owner simply must use the machine or be beaten out in the race by competitors who do use it.

So what . . . ?

What is the answer to machinery under a system of competitive production for private profit? Do we want to smash the intricate tools of production and return to the hand labor era? Impossible! Do we want to permit displaced millions to starve to death? Unthinkable; who, then, would wear the cotton?

There is but one answer. It is the ownership of the means of production and distribution and the operation of industry for the use instead of for profit. When society sees that answer machinery will become the servant, instead of the competitor of people. Plenty and leisure will take the place of poverty and unemployment.

Think it over. Have you any other suggestion?
