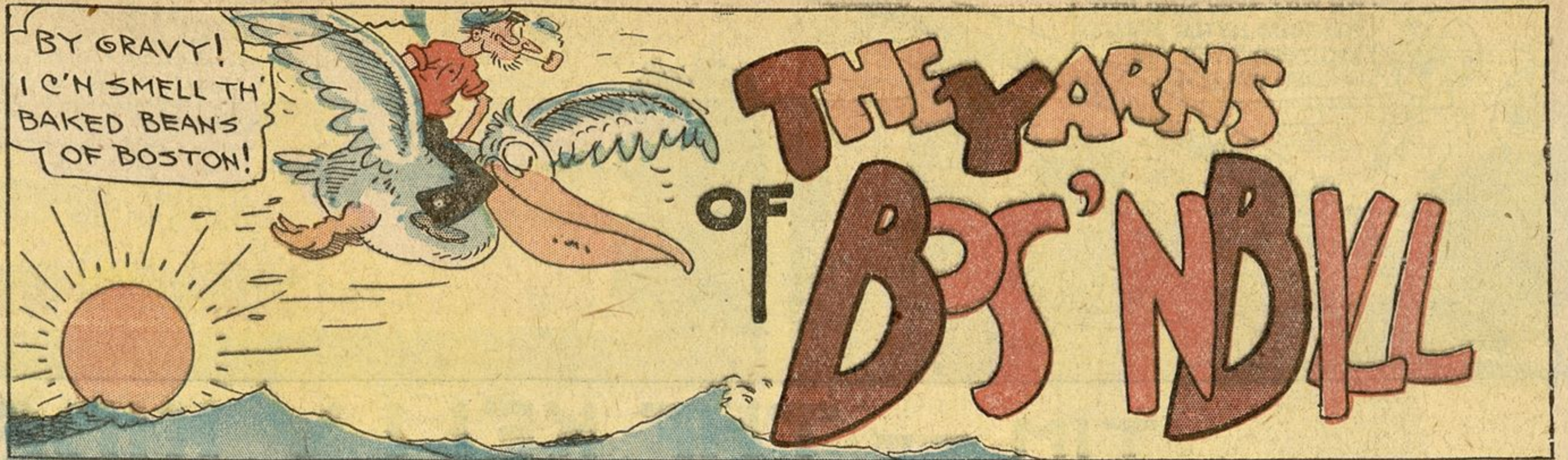
When I got back to th' beach I saw Woogie and his missus feedin' a pelican. That's when I got a hunch for a stunt that might get me away from th' island.
