Slovenian Coordination Committee - Niagara (SCCN) - The Mission

Twenty-five years ago, Slovenian spiritual, cultural and social organizations were already well established and thriving in this area of Southern Ontario. While St. Gregory the Great Slovenian Parish was the spiritual, cultural and social heart of the community, Slovenian clubs in the area such as: Lipa Park, Club Bled Planica 13, Slovenski Park, Club Sava and Triglav were proudly independent while hosting their numerous events during the year. Visits paid to these events by parish priests established the initial bond of fellowship among these Slovenian clubs. Due to the large number of celebrations being held each year, it became apparent that the coordination of events at each location would be beneficial. Leaders from each of the groups attempted to form such a plan and as a result of their discussions, the Slovenian Coordination Committee –Niagara was founded in December 1989 based on the principles of goodwill and cooperation among member organizations. As a testimony of their commitment to these principles, the executive decided to stage one event each year- to be known as Slovenski Dan (Slovenian Day).

The first Slovenian Day was held here, at St. Gregory the Great parish hall on June 17th, 1990. From that date forward, Slovenian Day was held each year on the fourth Sunday in June at one of the member organization sites in turn: the celebration travelled from St. Gregory's to Slovenski Park, Lipa Park, Club Bled Planica 13, Triglav and Sava. It was soon realized that with this event, the Slovenian community was on a successful path for the future. Each year, the host group presented a cultural and social program that represented its own community and was rewarded for its effort by the attendance of fellow Slovenians from other member organizations. Following the Declaration of Independence by Slovenia on June 25, 1991, Slovenian Day also became a day to commemorate Slovenia's independence. Since then, Slovenian Day has been a three dimensional celebration: a manifestation of good will, a recognition of Slovenia's Independence Day as well as an early Canada Day celebration.

Members of the Slovenian Coordination Committee- Niagara work hard to ensure that all events are well organized. This talented and industrious group meets twice each year: at the fall meeting they coordinate the schedule of all events to be held by member groups for the coming year and in the spring they coordinate the tasks required to ensure a successful Slovenian Day in June.

Looking toward the future, it is obvious that the Slovenian community will need to continue this system of reciprocal support. As the original community members age, it is encouraging to note that their descendants continue to appreciate and participate in this success story. Today, at St. Gregory's, we are entering the fifth cycle of Slovenian Day celebrations and are still going strong. As a result, we can proudly say, "Long Live the Slovenian Coordination Committee-Niagara."


