

INDOEUROPEAN ⁺e IN LUWIAN

In the article are presented reflections of IE short ⁺e in the cuneiform Luwian. Based on the material from DLL and HW it was established that IE ⁺e in the neutral positions reflects as -a- while in the non-neutral positions (before or behind Proto-Luw. ⁺i and behind ⁺u) reflects, at least in graphics, as i.

There are many hazy facts in the historical phonetics of the IE-Anat. languages. In the present article I am trying to clear up a developing course of IE ⁺e in the cuneiform Luwian. I present examples with rather acceptable etymologies which contains Proto-Anat. ⁺e from Laroche's Dictionnaire de la langue louvite (DLL) and Friedrich's Hethitisches Wörterbuch (HW). DLL has been until now the most systematical collection of Luw.¹ words. Proto-Anat. ⁺e is generally identic with IE ⁺e, with exception of borrowed words which came in the language(s) after IE parting.

First, I have to present reflections of IE ⁺e, ⁺e and ⁺o, ⁺a in the IE-Anat. languages in the neutral positions:

Second, I want to point at the inexact cuneiform writing, which had been destined for Akkad. language and has not been adapted to IE-Anat. languages successfully enough. So, we don't know the exact phonetic value of the cuneiform signs  /yi/ and  /pi/ in Luw. that are the topics of the present ar-

ticle. In all probability we have to read the vowel of these two signs, at least in cases where it doesn't reflect IE ⁺i and ⁺e (or i-diphthongs) as a bit palatal semivowel which, unfortunately, in writing has coincided with the real i from mentioned sources. Below in the text I always deal with the orthographic but never with the phonetic values of discussed signs.

I also have to remind on Hitt. assibilation of dentals, which is caused by Proto-Anat. ⁺ṣ, ē (i.e. IE ⁺ṣ, ⁺i and ⁺e) but never ⁺ṣ.

At last, in the Luw. orthography the Proto-Anat. ⁺e is distinguished from ⁺a/a by the fact that IE ⁺l, ⁺r, ⁺m, ⁺bh, ⁺dh and ⁺gh are doubled behind accented IE ⁺é; IE ⁺s is doubled also behind unaccented IE ⁺ě, while all these consonants are written singly behind Proto-Anat. ⁺a/a (Čop 1970: 85 ff.).

Examples of Proto-Anat. ⁺e in the neutral positions:

1) Luw. aya- "faire", HLuw. aia-, Lyc. a- = Hitt. iaa- "machen, tun" (DLL 23, HW 80). The Hitt. and Luw. verb may be from ⁺iaia-, IE reduplicated Pres. ⁺iaia- from the root ⁺iē- "werfen, machen, tun" (Tischler 1978: 339). So, there is no e in this Anat. verb.

2) Luw. akuwa- "boire", Pal. ahu- "trinken" (?) = Hitt. eku- "trinken" (DLL 24, HW 40), Toch. AB yok- "to drink", IE ⁺ak^ua- : ⁺ek^u- "Wasser, Fluss" (Pokorny 1959: 23, Čop 1971/2: 35 f.). The Anat. verb is the result of IE ablaut ⁺e : ⁺a (> a). Luw. a-kuwa- might be also a generalized weak stem which is found in Hitt. Pres. 3. Pl. akuṣanzi.

3) Luw. annari- (according to Rosenkranz 1952: 21) "eine wünschenswerte Eigenschaft", cf. Luw. annar-ummi- "fort" = Hitt. innar-a-ṣant- "rüstig (?)", Luw. ^DAnnarumienzi = Hitt. ^DInnara-ṣantes (DLL 27, HW 83) < Proto-Anat. ⁺én-nar-a- "strenght, vigorous" < IE ⁺én-n^or-o- = Slav. ⁺(j)ędrǫ with inserted -d- between the old ⁺n- and ⁺r-, cf. Skr. jēdar "vigorous, fresh", ⁺jędrǫ in OCS jędro, Russ. jadró, Pol. jadro, Skr. jédro "nucleus" that

is not related to OI andá- "egg, testicle" (so Miklošič 1886: 104) or Gr. ἄδρός "voll, dicht, ausgewachsen, reif" (so Trautmann 1923: 107 and others) that is built from the Adv. ἄδην from IE *sə-d- (cf. Arm. at-ok "voll, ausgewachsen", further Lat. satis, Goth. saps "satt") by the suffix -ró- (Frisk 1973 I: 20 ff.). IE *en-n^ə-r- is a compound from IE *en "in" and the root *ner- (by Pokorny 1959: 765 *aner-, *aner-) "(magische)Lebenskraft" = Finn.-Lapp *nōre- in Finn. nuori, Lapp nuorrâ "young" (the IE-Ural. equation discovered by Čop 1975/2: 94). Gr. ἄνιρ "man" results IE *n-nér-s, OI sūnara "strong, youthful" < IE *su(ə)nnéro- and Gr. εὖ-ήνωρ "idem" results IE *séu-^ənnor-s. So, there is no need to suppose an initial laryngeal in this root.

Otherwise Tischler 1978: 361 presumes originally *^ə₂nor- that would reflect in Hitt. and OI as in- (cf. OI Indra- "the name of the god"). By such assumption it is impossible to explain Luw. ann- that in confrontation with the Hitt. inn- represents only IE *enn-.

4) Luw. aš- "être", HLuw. as-, Pal. aš-, Lyc. es (?) "idem" = Hitt. eš- "sein, vorhanden sein" (DLL 33, HW 42) from IE *es- "sein" (Pokorny 1959: 343).

5) Luw. ašha(r)nu- "ensangler", Hitt. ešharnu- "blutig machen" (DLL 34, HW 44) are identical denominative-causative verbs, made from IE *esH-r- (Hitt. ešhar) "Blut" by the suffix *-n(e)u- (Pokorny 1959: 343).

6) Luw. ad- "manger", HLuw. ad-/ar- = Hitt. ed- "essen, fressen" (DLL 34, HW 44) from IE *ed- "essen" (Pokorny 1959: 287 f.). Luw. ad- may be also a weak stem like Hitt. Pres. 3. Pl. adanzi.

7) Luw. atari- "nourir" = Hitt. etrija- "ernähren" (DLL 34, HW 44), cf. Hitt. etri- "Gericht, Speisen, Mahlzeit", further see N° 6.

8) Luw. adduwal(i)- "mal, mauvais", HLuw. adu(wa)ta, cf. Hitt.

idalu- "schlecht, böse" (DLL 35, HW 93, Meriggi 1962:44), Toch. B yolo "böse", OI ādhra- "poor", IE *edh- "bad, evil" (Čop 1970: 91, 1975/1: 204 f.).

9) Luw. kutaššara/i- "muraille", HLuw. kutasari = Hitt. BAD-eššar "Mauer, Befestigung, Burg" (DLL 58, HW 226), cf. etymologically the same suffix beyond the N° 30.

10) Luw. mallit- "miel", Pal. malit = Hitt. melit (written mi-lit) from IE *melit, cf. Gr. μέλι, Gen. μέλιτος, Goth. miliþ, Alb. mjaltë (Čop 1970: 85).

11) Luw. mammana- "dire", Hitt. mema-, memija- "sprechen" (DLL 67, HW 140) is reduplicated Perf. IE *me-mon-, *me-mn- from the root *men- "denken, geistig erregt sein" (Pokorny: 1959: 726, Čop 1961: 58 ff., 1970: 85).

12) Luw. mannahuni-, manna(hu)wani- = Hitt. maninku(ṽant)- "kurz" (DLL 68, HW 136), hypothetical IE *men-enk-; the first member of compound is IE word for "hand" (weak stem) (by Pokorny 1959: 740 *mer-, Gen. *me-n-és "Hand") the second one is the suffix of direction that is found also in OI ūd-añc- "turned upwards", Lat. prop-inqu-us "near". The second Luw. suffix is compared with that one in Hitt. arahz-en-a- "umwohnend ..." (cf. Hitt. arahza "ringsum, ausserhalb" (Čop 1970: 88 f., HW 28).

13) Luw. mawa- "4", HLuw. ma- = Hitt. meu- "4", Proto-Anat. *meu- "4" (DLL 70, Friedrich 1960: 71).

14) Luw. parran "devant, avant", HLuw. paran = Hitt. piran "vorn, voran" (DLL 78, HW 170) from IE *péro-m (Acc. Sg. to *pero-s "ferner"), cf. OI param "hinaus über, jenseits, nach" (Pokorny 1959: 811, Čop 1970: 86).

15) Luw. šappa- "écorcer" = Hitt. (arḫa) šippa(i)- "abschälen" (DLL 85, HW 193). But in the Hitt. exists also šap- "abscha-ben (?)", säubern (?), (gefälte Baumstämme) von der Rinde be-

freien (?)", Pret. Sg. 3. šap-pa-at-ta (HW 183, 193); both verbs from IE ⁺sep- "sich mit etwas abgeben, in Ehren halten" (Pokorny 1959: 909). So, Proto-Anat. ⁺e in this Luw. word can not be proved.

16) Luw. šašša(i)- "coucher, reposer" = Hitt. šeš- "ruhen, schlafen" (DLL 87, HW 191), IE ⁺ses- "to sleep", cf. OI sasti, Av. hahmī "he sleeps, I sleep" (Mayrhofer 1976: 449).

17) Luw. tappaš(a) "ciel", HLuw. tapas(a) (DLL 87, HW 191), = Lith. debesis "cloud", probably from IE ⁺nébhes- "Nebel, Dunst ..." (Pokorny 1959: 315).

18) Luw. uwata- "amener" = Hitt. uuate- "herbringen" (DLL 104, HW 239) is a thematic Pres. IE ⁺u-yōdh-e- from the root ⁺yedh- "führen" (Pokorny 1959: 1115 f.). Luw. thematic vowel in the neutral position is -a-, Hitt. -e-, cf. also thematic iterative suffix Luw. -šš-a-, Hitt. -šk-e- (Friedrich 1960: 74 f.). Cf. N° 24 and 28.

Luw. wašš- "vêtir" is probably comparable with the Hitt. weak stem uāš(š)- (ueš(š)-, uāššija-, ueššija-) "bekleiden, bedecken" (HW 248), p.ex. Pres. 3. Pl. uāššanzi = Luw. wasanti; IE ⁺ues- "kleiden", Goth. wasjan (Pokorny 1959: 1172 f., DLL 108).

Luw. wašha- "maître (?)" derives from IE ⁺uos-Ho- (by Pokorny 1959: 1174 ⁺uesu- "gut") related to Luw. wašu- "bon" (Čop 1971 /1: 9 f.) (that is not identic with Hitt. aššu- "gut", so DLL 110) < IE ⁺uos-u- = OIr. fō "gut, Güte" (Pokorny, l.c. without Luw. examples). Cf. the relations between Hitt. ešha- (written išha-) "Herr" from IE ⁺es-H-o- = lat. erus (Pedersen 1938: § 107), OI asu-ra- "mighty, master" < ⁺es-u- at IE ⁺étse- "souffle, âme" (Čop 1981: 93 f.) and aššu- "gut" from IE ⁺os-u- or ⁺s-u- to the root ⁺es- "gut, tüchtig" (Pokorny 1959: 342, Friedrich 1923: 370).

Examples of Proto-Anat. ⁺e in the non-neutral Positions:

Laroche (DLL 134) calls attention to the opposition Luw. i- a-

gainst Hitt. ke/i- and cites two examples:

19) Luw. immara/i- "campagne": Hitt. kim(ma)ra- "Feld, Flur" (HW 109). Both words may have arisen from IE ⁺ghrem-əro-, cf. Germ. ⁺grun-þu- "Grund" (Čop 1956: 43) or IE ⁺ghim-ro- without a single parallel (Čop 1971/1: 3).

20) Luw. iššari- "main" : Hitt. keššera- "Hand" (HW 108) < IE ⁺ghés(o)r- "Hand" (Pokorny 1959: 447).

In both cases weakend IE ⁺gh (gh) > ⁺y before the palatal vowel assimilates following ⁺e to i. Regressive assimilation is found in:

21) IE ⁺dhéghom- → ⁺dheǵóm+i- > Luw. tiyami- "Erde", cf. Hluw. takam- "earth" < IE ⁺dhéghom- (Čop 1971/1: 6 f., 19 f.).

22) Luw. ⁺mai- "crowd", Adj. mayašši- "de la foule" (DLL 65) dissimilated from ⁺miyi- < IE ⁺megh-i- "multa, magna" (see Pokorny 1959: 708); the vowel -i- is saved in Lyc. mi-ñt-i "meeting, assamby" < ⁺mi-ant-i- < IE ⁺meghā-nt- = OI mahānt- (Čop 1965: 123, 1971/1: 1-24). Example for such a dissimilation is cited also under the N° 1. The phenomenon IE ⁺gh > Luw. ø detailed by Čop 1971/1: 1-24.

The second non-neutral position that prevents changing ⁺e to a is behind Proto-Anat. ⁺u (and ⁺p (?)). Examples:

23) Luw. iššar-wili- "droite" (DLL 53) against Hitt. yal-kiššara- "kundig erfahren" (HW 234)², IE ⁺uel- "wallen, wählen", OHG wela, wola "well" (Čop 1980), otherwise Hrozný 1917: 40 compares Lat. valeō.

24) Luw. widai-, (A) wiwida(i)- "(her)bringen (?)" = Hitt. uēda- "herbringen" (DLL 111, HW 256), IE ⁺uēdh- "führen, heimführen" (Pokorny 1959: 115 f.).

25) Pal. uite- "bauen"³, Lyd. ui↑- = Hitt. uete- "bauen" (Caruba 1970: 76, Ševoroškin 1967: 23, HW 254), IE ⁺uēdh- "knüpfen,

binden" (Pokorny 1959: 116 f.) or ue-dhē- (-dhe₁- (?)) "nieder-
setzen" (Kronasser 1966: 554).

26) Luw. wid- "eau" = Hitt. stem in Gen. Sg. uet-en-aš (DLL 111, HW 249). Luw. wid- may be explained as a lengthened grade, too, cf. Hitt. Nom.-Acc. Pl. uidār (?), OCS vědro (Pokorny 1959:80). In Pal. Loc.-Dat. uattana (Carruba 1970: 79) we can see the same vowel as in the Hitt. Nom. Sg. uatar.

27) Luw. wiyana- "vin", Hitt. uiiana- "Wein" (DLL 111, HW 225) < ⁺uäina-, taken over from Semith. ⁺wainu (Assir. īnu). The phenomenon can be explained as regressive assimilation (see N° 21, 22 and 1).

28) Thematic vowel IE ⁺-e- is in neutral position in Luw. realised as -a- (see N° 18). On the other hand, Luw. tarawi- "abatre, terasser" can be explained as thematic deadverbative ⁺tarau-e- related to Hitt. tarū "bäuchlings (?)", taraya "idem" (DLL 92, HW 213, 217; etymology Luw. tarawi-: Hitt. tarū founded by Čop 1980).

29) Luw. (Hupešna) SAL alhuitra- "a kind of priestess" = Hitt. SAL alhuešra- "Funktionär im Kultus" (DLL 176, HW 19, Čop 1965: 100). Etymology unknown.

30) Luw. huidwali- "vivant", huitwal-aḫit- "vie", stem huidu- "vivre", cf. Hitt. huišu-ai- "leben", huiš-, hueš- "idem" (DLL 47, HW 71 f., Čop 1965: 108 f.). Proto-anat. ⁺hues- "to live" may be simply IE ⁺Hues-, cf. OI vásati "he dwells", Goth. wisan "to be, to remain" (Pokorny 1959: 1170; about other alternatives see Čop, loc. cit.).

Luw. šahuidar(a)- "régulier, normal" and Hitt. šakuḫaššar(a)- "richtig, vollständig" (DLL 84, HW 178) have arisen from Proto-Anat. ⁺sak^uasar(a)- (cf. Hitt. šakuḫa "eyes"). The Luw. word is influenced by the primary adjective šahui- that is saved p. ex. in šahui-dali- (Čop 1965: 99, 112). The -i- in šahu-i- is identical with that one in Luw. parra-i-, Lat. tenu-i-s etc. So, there

is no -e- in this case.

Uncertain examples are Luw. (UZU)happiša- "membre" that may result hap-ešar = Hitt. UZUhappeššar "Glied, Körperteil (DLL 41, HW 54, Tischler 1977: 165), cf. the same suffix in Luw.malḫašša- (DLL 65) and under the N°9; and Luw. pintanza (Acc.Pl.) "die Ruder (?)" (HW 169) that may represent IE Acc. Pl. +(s)pendhons, +(s)pēndhons (?), cf. vrddhi formation in Hitt. Nom.-Acc. Pl. uidār to Nom. +(s)pendho-, +(s)pondho- "Holzeimer", cf. Gr. ὀνάση (<spndhā) "Bez. mehrerer flacher und länglicher Gegenstände; z.B. Schwert(klinge), Ruderblatt, Spatel ..."; Pokorny 1959: 989 without the Luw. and Gr. parallels to which kindly called my attention Prof. Bojan Čop). Otherwise Frisk 1973 II 775 connects the Gr. word with Germ. spādan, -ōn "Spaten".

Conclusions

IE +e reflects in Luw.: 1) In neutral positions a according to the phonetical-orthographical rule (Čop 1970: 85 ff.), see N°2-18; 2) In the proximity of Proto-Luw. +i is assimilated to i, see N° 19-22; 3) behind IE +u reflects aš i (also in Pal. (?)), see N° 23-30. In the last case the +e following consonant in Luw. is not doubled although IE +e is accented.

Finally, I have to remark that the third conclusion is exclusively phonetical-orthographical rule and has nothing to do with the productiveness of -i- stem in Luw. that is a matter of word formation. The rule should be proved or disproved by more materials that are not accesible to me.

He also compares Luw.hirut- "serment" with Hitt.harušaš-i- "secret" where vowel relations in the first syllable are not clear.

³Carruba loc. cit. cites as a possible meaning also "bringen" but at least from the context arūnam-pi tī úiteši āntanam tī úiteši (KUB XXXV 165 Vs. 23) where the agent is ^DKatahzipuri only the meaning "bauen, erschaffen" is evident.

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Povzetek

REFLEKSI INDOEVROPSKEGA ⁺ě V LUVIJŠČINI

Iz materiala, ki ga nudita Larochev DLL in Friedrichov HW je razvidno, da v nemotnih pozicijah indoevropskemu ⁺ě ustreza luv. a. Če stoji praluv. refleks indoevropskega ⁺ě v sosedstvu praluv. y (kakršnegakoli izvora), ga ta palatalni konsonant asimilira v historični i. To velja tudi pri izposojenkah. Tudi v poziciji za ide. ⁺u stoji vsaj v ortografiji na mestu ide. ⁺ě luv. (in pal. (?)) i, ki pa ne povzroči ortografske geminacije sledečega sonanta ali medie aspirate niti v primerih, ko je bil ⁺ě poudarjen.
