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»Ali hočete oditi tudi vi?«

V sinagogi v Kafarnaumu je Jezus pravkar sklenil svoj govor o kruhu življenja. Med učenci in poslušalci pa se širi vprašanje: »Trda je ta beseda. Kdo jo more razumeti?« Ves odlomek je zaznamovan z napetostjo, ki se je ustvarila po Jezusovem govoru. Kristus sam izrecno spregovoril o »pohujšanju«, pomanjkanju vere in celo o izdajstvu; mnogi učenci so tedaj »odstopili« in ga zapustili. Še več, tudi apostole Jezus vpraša, ali mu hočejo obrniti hrbet »in oditi tudi oni« ter tako postati odpadniki.



V središču današnjih beril je temeljno vprašanje zgodovine vsakega človeka, njegova odločitev za resnico in ljubezen, ki sta za kristjana osredotočeni na Kristusa. Ta odločitev pogosto ni preprosta, ker je odločitev za živega in zahtevnega Boga v razmerju do mrtvih in udobnih idolov. V tem smislu je značilno tudi starozavezno berilo, s katerim odpira današnje bogoslužje božje besede.

Izraela, ki je prišel v osrčje obljubljene dežele, v Sihem, kjer je bil sedež narodnega svetišča, povezanega s patriarhi, je Jozue, njegov voditelj pri vstopu v Sveti deželo, vprašal: »Danes si izberite, komu hočete služiti.« Idolom ali Bogu, ki vas je rešil egiptovske suženjstva? Zanimiva je ugotovitev, da je v svetopisemskem besedilu kar štirinajstkrat (to je število, ki označuje polnost in popolnost) odmeva glagol služiti (*servire, servus*). Ta izraz v svetopisemskem jeziku nima pomena »servilnosti«, marveč označuje svobodno in veselo sprejemanje božjega načrta. Služabnik je ime za najpomembnejše biblične osebe, kot so Abraham in Mojzes, Jozue in David, od prerokov do mesijanske podobe »Gospodovega služabnika«, ki ga opeva Izaija. V Novi zavezi se Marija imenuje »Gospodova dekla«,

in tudi Jezus je »služabnik« (servus) (Apd 3,13; 4,27). »Služiti Gospodu pomeni sprejemati njegov božji predlog življenja, pomeni bati se ga v pri-znavanju njegove veličine in slave, ljubiti ga z vsem srcem, dušo in močmi (5 Mz 6,5), pomeni verovati vanj.

Jezusovo vprašanje: »Ali hočete oditi tudi vi?« je namenjeno tudi nam. To vprašanje je kot meč, ki razdvaja zgodovino na dve polovici. Na eni strani so tisti, ki »se umikajo nazaj« zaradi sporočila, ki presega človeške moči. Z druge strani pa nam Petrove besede odpirajo drugo obnebje, obnebje tistih, ki izpovedujejo pristno vero v Kristusa, tistega, »ki ima besede večnega življenja, Božjega svetnika«.

V Matejevem evangeliju je že ob nekem drugem dogodku Peter izrekel podobno in jasno priznanje vere v Kristusa, ki je vprašal apostole: »Kaj pa vi pravite, kdo sem?« Petrov odgovor - »Ti si Kristus, Sin živega Boga« - je bil povod za izredno oblubo, ki je spremenila življenje preprostega ribiča: »Ti si Peter, Skala, in na to skalo bom postavil svojo Cerkev« (Mt 16,18). Celotno krščansko občestvo, ki ga je izzvalo to temeljno vprašanje, je tudi danes vnovič izzzvano, da se prebudi iz zaspanosti svojih misli in površnosti ter se poda na zavestno in zavezujajočo odločitev: »Mi verujemo in vemo, da si ti Kristus ...«

Tedaj in danes je lahko sprejeti Kristusa kot »pomnožitelja« kruha, tudi sprejemanje vere v njenem napredovanju je nekaj spontanega tedaj in danes. Na to navdušenje je Jezus v govoru v Kafarnaumu izlil mrzlo prho in pozornost usmeril k zahtevni in zavezujajoči skrivnosti, ki jo je oznanjal. To je »galilejska kriza«, kakor jo imenujejo učenjaki, ki ni zgolj bled zgodovinski spomin Kristusovega zemeljskega življenja, marveč je nenehno dogajanje, v središču katerega smo vsi in vsak dan, ko je pred nami »življenje in sreča, smrt in zlo, blagoslov in prekletstvo; izvoli torej življenje, ljubi Gospoda svojega Boga, bodi pokoren njegovi besedi in bodi vedno z njim...«

Gospel John 6:60-69


Jesus, like Joshua, calls for his disciples to remain faithful after some had gone away.

“We too will serve the Lord, for he is our God.”

Judas Iscariot is an enigmatic character. Why did he betray Jesus? Was it just the money? Did he stop believing in Jesus? Or was it disillusionment? The famous passion play which is staged every ten years at the German village of Oberammergau takes this latter view. Judas did believe: he believed Jesus was going to inaugurate the new glorious kingdom of God expected by the Jews. But he thought Jesus was being slow to act. Judas grows weary of following Jesus. He takes himself off and starts thinking, "Why should I continue to follow him?... I am tired of believing and waiting... I wish to share his reign. It fails to materialise, and what is forthcoming – dread and suffering. Who feels like sharing those with him? Not I! Not I!" But after Jesus is condemned to death Judas falls into despair. He throws back the thirty silver pieces and says to himself, "How kind he has been toward me! How gently he comforted me when dark dejection oppressed my soul! How he warned me, when I was already harbouring this



shameless betrayal. And I, this is how I have rewarded him... Not a disciple any longer."

Gospel Teaching

One of the most poignant events in the Old Testament is when old Joshua assembled God's people at Shechem, just before he died. He wanted to hear them make a decision, an irrevocable decision, either to serve or to desert God: to make their decision and then to stand by it for life. And to his joy he heard them echo his own vow, "We have no intention of deserting the Lord... We too will serve the Lord, for he is our God."

One of the most poignant events in the New Testament is towards the end of the sermon Jesus preached about the bread of life, when he declared that, "Anyone who eats this bread will live for ever; and the bread that I shall give is my flesh, for the life of the world." Some of his followers said, "This is intolerable language. How could anyone accept it?" And many of them left him. Then came that most heart-breaking moment when Jesus turned to the twelve apostles: "What about you, do you want to go away too?" Like Joshua he calls for a decision. And Peter spoke for them all, "Lord, who shall we go to? You have the message of eternal life, and we believe; we know that you are the Holy One of God."

Many Catholics today find some Catholic teaching difficult. St Paul, in the second reading, instructs wives to obey their husbands. That will strike some

as "intolerable language", and indeed in Catholic marriage vows brides have never promised to obey their husbands. But before we get too annoyed with St Paul, let us notice his next words: "Husbands should love their wives just as Christ loved the Church and sacrificed himself for her." Jesus never made unreasonable demands on the Church, nor must husbands make unreasonable demands on their wives. Rather must a

husband sacrifice himself for love of her. And they form one body. This was breakthrough teaching on the status of women and marriage.

Application

We may question other teachings of the Bible or the Church, but a closer study of them can sometimes alter our perceptions. In the end, if we question its teachings, or the Church is beset by scandals and we are let down by our priests, then, like those early followers of Jesus, we may even come close to leaving him. So what is it that holds us in the Church? Perhaps, for some, it is the response of Peter, "Lord, who shall we go to? You have the message of eternal life, and we believe; we know that you are the Holy One of God." We may sense the truth of these words; and when it comes down to it, what keeps many people close to Jesus is love for him. We may love him because of the Church; and sometimes, perhaps, it may seem we love him despite the Church.

Judas, of course, was the exception among the apostles. And there are many real saints doing God's work today. There are those whose lives have been transformed after being converted to Christ and who, coming into the company of Christ's faithful people, have discovered this to be true: "You have the message of eternal life, and we believe; we know that you are the Holy One of God."
