OPEN HOUSE OF CANADIAN SLOVENIAN HISTORICAL SOCIETY AT DOM LIPA

On Saturday, April 23rd, 2016, the Canadian Slovenian Historical Society held a very successful, well-attended Open House at Dom Lipa in Etobicoke. Student family research projects from both the Toronto and Hamilton Slovenian Heritage Language Schools were the main focus of the display. Individual and group projects written in Slovenian and English recounted stories of how family members began a new life in Canada, the challenges they faced and the successes they achieved. These memories sparked much discussion and reminiscing among the approximately 150 visitors who attended the exhibition.

Marjan Ulčar, the society president, spoke briefly about the work of the society and introduced Dr. Marjan Cencen, the current Slovenian Ambassador to Canada. Dr. Cencen congratulated the students on their hard work and interest in their Slovenian heritage.

Each school received a donation cheque in the amount of \$500 in recognition of a commitment to the preservation of the Slovenian language and culture. Jerry Ponikvar presented the cheque and individual certificates to Sandy Ferletič and students from the Hamilton school while Dr. Janez Vintar made presentations to Marta Jamnik-Sousa and the students from Toronto.

Following the presentations, visitors were able to view the projects, tour the archival offices and enjoy refreshments.

All society board members contributed in some way to the success of the day, but special thanks go to Miriam Čekuta and her team of Jerry Ponikvar, Mary Desanti and Dr. Janez Vintar for being the driving force behind the project.

GOOD MORNING FRIENDS...

As you know we have been making short announcements to keep our parishioners updated on the happenings here within our parish community. Today, I would like to bring to you information about a number of things your parish council is working on.

First, I would like to thank everyone who participated in our Spring Banquet. It was a wonderful! It was so nice to see so many of you come out to spend time with your fellow parishioners. Supporting parish events is an important and integral part of building a sense of community.

As you all know, Fr. Bogdan from Slovenia is the author of a book which details the history of our Parish here at St. Gregory the Great. This book is bilingual written in Slovenian and includes the English translation. The book is now ready for print and publishing details are now in the works. We have decided to order 300 copies of this hard cover book. Those who have signed the paper showing interest in this book will have a reserved copy and the rest will be sold on a first come first serve basis. Unfortunately, we are still awaiting shipping costs, therefore we are unable to announce a price for this book at this time... but I assure you it is coming and it will be reasonable!

The buildings on our property are in need of some improvements... the Flat roof is nearing the end of it's lifetime and will need to be replaced. We are looking to finalize costing for this repair and are currently looking at an estimate cost of \$95,000 for the flat roof upgrade.

The fencing along the Delawana side of our property is also in need of being repainted. In order to do a proper job, this will include sandblasting of the current fencing and powder coating it. We expect this to be a two year process and estimate this cost to be between 10 and 14,000 – making it 5 to 7,000 per year over the next two years.

The sidewalks along the front of our church and rectory are not level and are troublesome as they can cause our parishioners to trip over the uneven slabs. This is the last thing we want happening and we need to ensure safety, therefore we are looking at having these concrete sections raised to create an even and safe platform for people to walk on. We are currently in the process of having this re-leveling costed out and will get that information to you once we have the numbers.

Although we know that our parking lot is also in dire need of being repaved and improved on, we will be focusing on these other projects first and then move on to the asphalt upgrading.

I know, you're all probably wondering how on earth we are going to pay for all these improvements! Well, we are certainly working on ways of raising these funds as painlessly as possible. We are currently looking at possible grants to help alleviate these costs. Hopefully we will find some financial aid. The parish council has also decided to organize and run a "Casino or Stag" style fundraiser. We are currently looking at a couple possible dates in October and a couple possible dates in November. Once we find the date that works best, we will begin organizing this social, fundraising event and we will welcome all the volunteers and ideas we can get. It is important to remember that we all need to work together to make all these things happen and we hope all parishioners will show their support!

Keeping our property looking nice is an ongoing task and having a mall across the road makes this a constant challenge. So, we ask everyone for help pitching ... if we can all find a little time pick up the debris that gets blown onto our property this task will be an easy one and we will have success keeping our property looking clean and beautiful.

Finally, we cannot forget about Summer being just around the corner. As you all know, Fr. Drago will be going to Slovenia June 29th and returning August 1st. Although we will miss him, we hope he will have well

deserved time with his family in friends! While he is away, a good parish friend, Fr. Bajzek will be with us to fill in for Fr. Drago. Now, with activities and schedules always being planned over the summer months, this year, we have decided to try to have **only one mass on Sundays beginning Sunday, July 3rd and continuing through to Sunday August 28th**. This one service will take place every Sunday including and between those dates at 10am. So remember, throughout the summer we will have only one mass on Sundays and it will be held at 10 a.m.

We hope everyone finds these little updates useful. We will continue to do our best keeping everyone updated with our parish news. On behalf of your Parish Council... we wish everyone a wonderful Sunday!

WORKING AGAINST SUICIDE

The Government of Canada has introduced Bill C-14, *An Act to amend the Criminal Code and to make related amendments to other Acts (medical assistance in dying)*.

This proposed legislation, which responds to the decision of the Supreme Court of Canada in early 2015, will make euthanasia and assisted suicide legal and more accessible in our entire country.

The Supreme Court decision and current legislative efforts are in stark contradiction to the endeavours of individuals, families and communities to counteract the dangers and sufferings of suicide.

6TH SUNDAY OF EASTER

The apostle John shares his great vision of heaven, where Christ will reign for ever and we shall see God face to face.

Gospel John 14:23-29

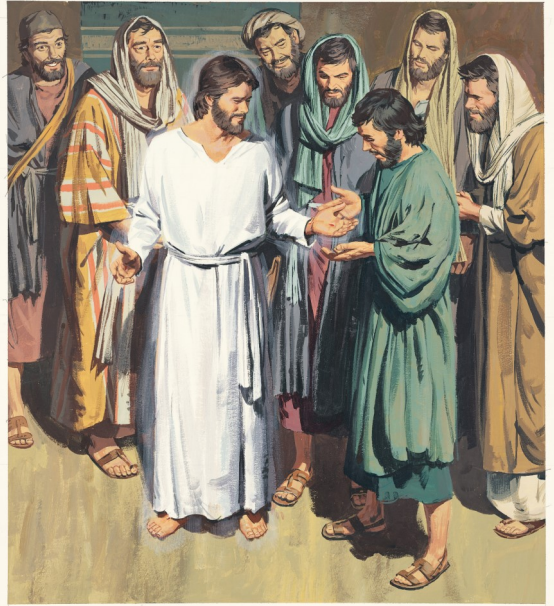
Jesus teaches his apostles that they will become temples of the Holy Trinity, and the Holy Spirit will be the guiding light of the Church.

“If anyone loves me he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him and make our home with him.”

There are two things that all people need to negotiate their way through the world: an interior sense of purpose and the need to belong to a wider group. These two basic elements help form our identity and both drive and support us throughout our life. In the ancient world, belonging to a clan or tribe was what gave people their sense of identity. Very often some code of honour, or mode of behaving according to their status, gave them their interior motivation. In the play *Ajax* by the ancient Greek dramatist Sophocles, we see what happens when someone is deprived of these two elements.

First of all Ajax, the great Greek warrior, is deprived of the armour of the dead Achilles, which he thinks is his due, by the rest of the army. This insults



his honour. In order to be revenged he sets forth at night to slay the Greek leaders. The goddess Athena stops him by sending a madness on him. He then mistakes the army's cattle for his fellow Greeks and slaughters them and drives others off to torture them in his tent. When the rest of the army finds out, he becomes a laughing stock. He is isolated from his former comrades, his honour has now completely gone, and he sees no way out except suicide. Ajax does not have the Christian virtue of hope, nor do his comrades have much notion of forgiveness. So with his interior code bankrupt, and having lost the support of his group, his life dissolves around him.

Gospel Teaching

Sophocles paints a deliberately bleak view of the imagined Greek warrior society that Ajax belongs to. Without genuine divine help (not the capricious gods of Olympus), human beings can easily end up being estranged from themselves and from each other. If all that drives us is, say, consumerism, and we are only valued by our peers for what we

have, then when these things disappear, so, in a sense, do we.

In today's Gospel, Jesus assures us that we are more than any earthly group can make us, and we are interiorly led by more than any human code or sense of honour. Through the giving of the Spirit, we become dwelling places of the Holy Spirit, and if the Holy Spirit, then the whole of the Blessed Trinity.

This teaching of Christ on the indwelling of the Holy Spirit is absolutely central to the New Testament. It is taken up by the apostles: as St Paul wrote to the Corinthians, "Didn't you realise that you were God's temple and that the Spirit of God was living among you?" And again St Paul says that God's love has been poured into our hearts by the Spirit. This living of the Holy Spirit within us gives us direction, makes us beautiful in God's eyes and makes us part of the wider body of the Church. It is also vital to remember that the indwelling of the Spirit does not make us puppets, or short-circuit our free will. Rather, it creates our freedom, helps us to act in a more human way, a graced human way, than we would otherwise.

Application

Like any adventure in living together, allowing the Holy Spirit to dwell within us requires certain things. First of all, spending time with God in prayer. It is the Holy Spirit that prompts us to pray in the first place, and if we respond we can become like wells of living prayer. It is, of course, basic to understanding prayer that, on one level, we don't know how to do it. As Paul wrote to the Romans, "The Spirit too comes to help us in our weakness. For when we cannot choose words, the Spirit himself expresses our plea in a way that could never be put into words." Not only do we raise our minds to God, but our hearts become aware of God's presence within us and in the Church.

Secondly, living together with friends requires communication. We need both to speak and to listen. The time we spend in prayer helps us reveal our joys and sorrows, our hopes for this world and our desire for eternity. We might think of St Teresa of Avila's definition of prayer, "Contemplative prayer, in my opinion, is nothing else than a close sharing between friends; it means taking time frequently to be alone with him who we know loves us."

THE NEXT PILGRIMAGE SUNDAY AT THE CATHEDRAL

The next Pilgrimage Sunday at the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King will take place on Sunday, **May 15th**. The Cathedral will open to pilgrims at 2:00 p.m. The Door of Mercy can be accessed through the doors adjacent to the Cathedral Rectory. At **2:30 p.m. prayer in the style of Taizé** – Scripture and meditative chants will be offered. You are welcome to join us for the **4:00 p.m. Mass** – Monsignor Earl Talbot will preside and preach.

A **plenary indulgence** may be gained by the faithful who enter through the Door of Mercy. In order to gain the indulgence pilgrims enter the door, make a profession of faith and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father. They should also receive Holy Communion and celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation within 20 days of the pilgrimage.
