JEZUS POŠILJA APOSTOLE V SVET



Bogoslužje nam danes ponuja evangelij poslanstva, v katerem Jezus čuti usmiljenje do množice, izbere apostole in jih pošlje. Grška beseda, ki jo prevajamo kot »usmiljenje«, v resnici pomeni »drobovje, notranjost«. Gre torej za notranje usmiljenje. Jezus ima cloveško srce, ki je polno božje ljubezni.

Množice se mu smilijo, »izmučene in razkropljene kakor ovce, ki nimajo pastirja«. Njegovo usmiljenje je za vse, Jezus nima ozkih čustev, ampak zelo široka; globoko občuti potrebo množic po pastirjih, ki bi jih vodili in jim omogočili vedro in rodovitno življenje.

Jezus svoje sočutje pokaže s povabilom, naj prosimo Boga, gospodarja žetve, naj pošlje delavce na svojo žetev: »Žetev je obilna, delavce pa malo. Prosите torej Gospoda žetve, naj pošlje delavce na svojo žetev!« Zato Jezus sam prevzame pobudo: izbere dvanajst učencev, ki se pozneje imenujejo »dvanajsteri apostoli«. Beseda »apostol« pomeni »poslani«. Apostoli so izbrani, da bi bili poslani k množicam, da bi prenašali sporočilo evangelija in tako odgovorili na duhovne potrebe ljudi.

Vendar Jezus v prvem trenutku poslanstvo apostolov omeji na izgubljene ovce Izraelove hiše: »Ne hodite na pot k paganom in ne vstopajte v nobeno samarijsko mesto! Pojdite rajši k izgubljenim ovcam Izraelove hiše.« To nas preseneča. Navajeni smo na ukaz, ki ga je Jezus dal na koncu Matejevega evangelija: »Pojdite torej in naredite vse narode za moje učence« (Mt 28,19); zato se sprašujemo: zakaj tukaj poslanstvo omejuje na Izraelovo hišo? Vemo, da je Jezus vedno pokoren Očetu in hoče spoštovati meje svojega poslanstva, ki jih je določil Oče. Pomemben poudarek: vsak mora spoštovati meje. Mi nismo božja previdnost, ne moremo poskrbeti za vse potrebe bližnjega, ampak moramo spoštovati meje svoje poklicanosti, da bi jo lahko uresničili do konca. Če teh meja ne bomo spoštovali, ne bomo opravili ko-

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ristnega dela; neurejeno bomo begali na vse strani, končni uspeh pa nas bo razočaral.

Jezus sam je v odgovoru Kanaanki, ki ga je prosila, naj ozdravi njeno hčer, pojasnil, da je bil poslan samo k izgubljenim ovcam Izraelove hiše. V tem se razodeva božji načrt: izbral je eno ljudstvo, mu obljudil odrešenje, in sedaj pošilja Mesija prav k ljudstvu, kateremu je dal obljubo. Prvo berilo osvetljuje prav ta vidik božjega načrta. Po Mojzesu pravi Bog Izraelcem, ki so prišli pod goro Sinaj: »Zdaj pa, če boste res poslušali moj glas in izpolnjevali mojo zavezo, mi boste posebna lastnina izmed vseh ljudstev, kajti moja je vsa zembla. Vi mi boste kraljestvo duhovnikov in svet narod.« Bog je izbral majhno ljudstvo in mu obljudil poseben odnos s seboj, in tej obljubi je ostal zvest.

Njegov načrt je v resnici v prid vsega človeštva, kar lahko razumemo že iz besed izrečenih Abrahamu: »V tebi bodo blagoslovljeni vsi rodovi zemelje« (1 Mz 12,3). Božji načrt je univerzalen; vendar se mora univerzalnost uresničiti polagoma, zato tudi Jezus v svojem javnem življenju spoštuje ta božji načrt.

Drugo berilo nam da razumeti, da križ razodeva božjo ljubezen do grešnikov: »Bog pa izkazuje svojo ljubezen do nas s tem, da je Kristus umrl za nas, ko smo bili še grešniki.« V Jezusovem trpljenju Judje predstavlajo grešnike, zasedejo mesto najhujših grešnikov, ker v imenu vseh po krivici obsodijo Božjega Sina. Za Jezusovo smrt smo vsi odgovorni, ker smo vsi grešniki; vendar nas v tem predstavlja izvoljeno ljudstvo. Po Jezusovi smrti in vstajenju je odrešenje ponujeno vsem ljudem; edini pogoj, da ga dosežemo, je vera vanj, ki je umrl za naše opravičenje in vstal. Pavel pravi: »Veliko bolj bomo torej po njem rešeni jeze zdaj, ko smo opravičeni z njegovo krvjo.«

Po Jezusovem vstajenju se jasno pokaže razširitev božjega načrta do skrajnih meja zemelje. Mi nismo sposobni, da bi to v polnosti razumeli, moremo in moramo pa sprejeti sporočilo vere, ki nam ga oznanja. Iz tega sledi, da je vsak izmed nas poslan k drugim ljudem, da bi razširjal odrešenje. Poslanstvo ni izključna pravica nekaterih apostolov, ampak ga morajo uresničevati preprosti kristjani. Vsi smo odgovorni za druge; vsi moramo prispeti k temu poslanstvu, seveda na različne načine. Predvsem z molitvijo. Jezus nam pravi: »Prosite Gospoda žetve, naj pošlje delavce na svojo žetev.« Potem lahko pri tem poslanstvu sodelujemo z gmotno pomočjo.

Prispevamo pa lahko tudi neposredno, s krščanskim pričevanjem v svojem okolju. - (Prim.: Oznanjevalec 3, 2008)

11TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Response: We are his people: the sheep of his pasture.

Crowds are a strange human phenomenon. Many of us have probably experienced both the euphoria of being in a crowd and also the sense of fear when the mood of the crowd changes and becomes hostile. In his book *Crowds and Power* Elias Canetti, who had experienced the activities of mobs in Nazi Germany, analysed the way crowds behave. There has to be a common object or aim that focuses their attention.

As emotions are raised, people let go of their inhibitions and allow themselves to be carried away by the passion of the moment. Common sense, detachment, any usual politeness or propriety disappears. At such a point, if the crowd is thwarted in its aims, it can quickly become violent. In the storm of emotion, an enemy can be identified and attacked, and with the sudden outpouring of violence against this scapegoat the crowd's anger can



grow to even greater intensity before fragmenting into its bewildered parts. Anyone who can manipulate this force in crowds is in a very powerful position indeed, as history constantly reminds us. We can still see it in our world today, especially when crowds are stirred up by politicians. It is the art of detaching people from their sense of individual responsibility in such a way that they are taken over by a force greater than themselves. We may also be attracted to crowds if our own sense of self-esteem is low, for the strength and confidence of the crowd give us a false sense of our own importance.

Gospel Teaching

Jesus spends a lot of his time with crowds. In the end it will be a crowd that causes his downfall, egged on by manipulative leaders. Perhaps it was the same crowd that cheered him loudly on his way but a few days earlier. This is how crowds behave, even in this case to the point of declaring that they would willingly take his blood upon their heads and upon the heads of their children. Carried away by the passion of the moment, they are capable of anything.

But for all this Jesus never condemns the crowds. Rather he sees their underlying misery and despair. They are like sheep without a shepherd, lacking di-

rection and security. It is in response to the dejection of the crowds that Jesus gathers his disciples together for their first mission. He wants to offer true leadership, a leadership that will cast out evil spirits and cure all kinds of disease and sickness. He wants to take away their brokenness and lack of love. He has shown he can do this himself. Now he shares his power with disciples, sending them first of all to the people of Israel, for it is right that such healing is offered first to those the Lord has chosen as his own. Later the mission will be to the peoples of the nations as well, the Gentiles, for all are called to be healed and reconciled and to become members of God's people.

Application

Crowds have not changed. They are still very much with us, still capable of carrying us away with their enthusiasm, still capable of irrational acts of violence. Our calling as disciples is to follow in the steps of Jesus, not taking on the mob in their moments of anger but discerning the individuals' need for healing and reconciliation. Such a response takes great courage and much patience. First of all we need to have a good sense of ourselves and our relationship with Christ. That will help create an independence of mind that will prevent us being sucked into the crowd's mood, a mood that may express itself in elation or anger but so often covers an underlying dejection and lack of self-esteem.

If the individuals who form the crowd need care, even more so do their victims, often the scapegoats who wander unknowingly to their fate. These too will need our attention and concern. There is something in the crowd that exposes our vulnerability and our darker side at the same time. It is this element Jesus discerns and sets out to heal. Our reaction, faced by the same phenomenon, may firstly be the very sensible one to keep out of the way. But each crowd is made up of individuals, and at some point they return to themselves. At that point we are invited to be of help, even if, like Jesus himself, we have suffered at their hands.




