Italija napada Francijo in sovjetsko Rusijo

Rim, 9. septembra. Diktator Musolini je včeraj prvič povedal svetu, da stoji ramo ob ramu in Nemčijo, kar se tiče čehoslovaške krize. Nadalje je izjavil, da je fašistska Italija absolutno pripravljena "za vsak slučaj," toda dosedaj še ni bilo odrejene posebne odredbe za vojno. Položaj se ni še tako daleč razvil, da bi bilo potreben hiteti z vojnimi pripravami, pravi glasilo laškega zunanjega ministra. Obenem je Mussolini ostro kritiziral Francijo in sovjetsko Rusijo, ker baje podprtjeti čehoslovaško vlado, da kljubuje zahtevam sudetskih Nemcev. Laška vlada se strinja z zahtevami sudetskih Nemcev. Očividno je bilo laško stališče glede Čehoslovaške že odmerjeno maja meseca, ko je Hitler obiskal Mussolinija v Rimu.

Rochester, Minn., 9. septembra. Predsednik Roosevelt je odpotoval v petek zjutraj v Rochester, Minn., kjer bodo njegovega sina Jamesa operirali na želodcu. Njegova mati se že nahaja ob njegovi bolniški postelji. Glasom izjave zdravnikov se z zdravili in more ozdraviti sina Rooseveltovega, pač pa je na vsak način potrebna večja operacija. Predsednik Roosevelt ostane v Rochesterju pri sinu, dokler ne bo operacija izvršena. Izredno telefonsko zvezo so vpeljali za predsednika med bolnišnico v Rochesterju in med Belo hišo v Washingtonu.

Japonska prerokuje padec Hankova 10. oktobra

Japonska poročila nadalje trdijo, da je bilo ubitih 25 kitajskih generalov, ko so japonski zrakoplovi napadli neko hišo, v kateri se je vršila kitajska vojaška konferenca.

Zvezna vlada nima ničesar proti županu Hague

Washington, 9. septembra. Juštčni oddelek zvezne vlade je ustavil preiskavo napram županu Franku Hague iz Jersey City, N. J., ki je bil otožen, da je državljanom kratal njih ustavne pravice glede svobodnega govora in svobodne govorice. Zvezna delavska komisija je dognala potom prič in dokazov, da so bili omenjeni delavci odpuščeni od dela edino izvzroka, ker sto pristopili v C. I. O. organizacijo. Obenem je bila Fordova družba obosegana, da mora delavcem plačati vso zaostalo plačo, ki bi jo delavci dobili, ako ne bi bili odpuščeni od dela. Ford je izjavil, da se bo proti tej razsodbi pritožil.

The Purifier

"You Knights have often helped the priest vest for Mass. After vesting, the priest arranges the chalice. Before him on the vestment case is the chalice and over the top of it he drapes a folded linen cloth called the purifier. This purifier cloth is from 12 to 18 inches long and nine or ten inches wide. It is folded in three layers so that when placed over the chalice its width is about three inches. Now what is the purpose of the purifier? Just what its name implies. It is used for cleaning or purifying the interior of the cup before wine is poured into the chalice; it is used for cleaning the paten after the Pater Noster before the Sacred Host is placed on it; and it is used for drying the priest's lips and purifying the chalice after the priest's communion."

Since there seems to be a slight lull in the goings on of Ilirija at this time, and it is rather early to mention anything about our Church concert which is to be held on the second Sunday in December, we shall discuss something that has been on our minds for some time. Whether the singers who have to pay attention to notes, words, and to the director during services are able to express the feeling of devotion as well as others do who pray.

Perhaps not, however, if the choirists sing with the right intention, that is, to promote the honor of God, the inattentiveness that may occur is excused and those taking part are rewarded as liberally as others who pray with fullness of heart. After all, singing is by no means a mere prayer of the mouth, even if the singer at the moment does not remember the meaning of what he is saying. For example a child who recites a verse before some celebrant or for some occasion does not usually understand the meaning, but instead, learns the words as they follow each other, this, nevertheless, does not take away from the meaning of the verse as a person listens to it. So, as you go up into the choir make your good intention—that you shall do your bit for the honor and glory of God.

Few things wound the Sacred Heart as much as ingratitude. Last Sunday's gospel told of His question of pained surprise, when having cured the ten lepers, but one returned to give Him thanks—"Were there not ten made clean, and where are the nine?" Many of us are like the thankless lepers. We pray when we are in trouble. We storm Heaven for this and for that and then too often, take God's greatest gifts as a matter of course. Why are we not equally fervent in returning thanks? If we treated our earthly friends as we treat God, scarcely one would remain to us!

Jesus Christ came down from Heaven, became incarnate, lived His laborious life on earth, and suffered all the torments of His Passion for each of us, as if we alone existed: He lives day and night in the Blessed Sacrament for us. Each one of us may question thus:
