Jugoslavija po Titu**I.**

V zadnjih letih se veliko razpravlja v svetu in v Jugoslaviji o tem, kaka usoda čaka to državo, ko Josipa Broza Tita ne bo več pri njenem krmilu. Od leta 1945 do zdaj je preživel vrsto preskušen, bila ponovno v nevarnosti razpada, pa se vedno nekako rešila iz stisk.

Ob koncu druge svetovne vojne ni imela težav obnoviti svoje stare meje, ni pa ji uspelo razširiti svoje oblasti nad Albanijo, oziroma to vključiti v jugoslovansko federacijo. Albanci Srbov ne marajo in so ob prvi priložnosti pretrgali neljube zveze s Titom. Pridružili so se Stalinu, ko se je obrnil proti Titu, ko pa se je Moskva pomirila s Titom, so šli iskat oporo proti njemu v Peking h Kitajcem.

Upanje Slovencev, da bo druga svetovna vojna, ko sta bila oba glavna sovražnika slovenskega naroda in njegove zemlje, Nemec in Italijan, na strani sovražnikov, prinesla osvoboditev vsega slovenskega strnjenega naravnega ozemlja in njegovo združitev v Sloveniji kot eni od zveznih držav Jugoslavije je padlo v vodo, v dolgih stoletjih najugodnejši trenutek za doseglo tega cilja je zapravila Komunistična partija Jugoslavije, ko se je na vrat na nos vrgla v naročje Stalinu in se spustila v odprt spor z zahodnimi zaveznički.

Komunisti so zapravili Sloveniji ne le slovenski del Koroške, ampak tudi Gorico in Trst! Danes so Slovenci doma in izven meja Slovenije edini v tem, da bo nekoč slovenski narod pozabil na strahotne žrtve, ki mu jih je povzročila komunistična revolucija, ne bo pa Komunistični partiji pozabil, da mu je zapravila edinstveno priložnost za osvoboditev in združitev v svobodni državi.

Jugoslovanski komunisti so bili nekaj časa zagrizenješi od Stalina in njegovih, še ko jih je ta pognal iz Kominforme, so skušali na vse načine in z raznimi nasilji dokazovati svojo komunistično pravovernost — izjavljali so, da so boljši in pravovernejši komunisti od Stalina. Postopno so spoznali nesmisel in brezplodnost tega napora in začeli popuščati, ko so spoznali, da je to edina pot, da si pridobijo podporo svobodnega sveta in se tako ohranijo na oblasti.

Bili so uspešni. Svobodni svet, ki je bil zapleten v mrzlo vojno s Sovjetsko zvezo, je hotel uporabiti Tita za razbijanje komunistične edinstvenosti. Delno mu je to uspelo, ko je klica nacionalizma začela poganjati in se krepli v vseh satelitskih državah, najmočneje na Poljskem in Madžarskem, v manjši meri v Romuniji.

Po vseh satelitskih državah je prišlo do nastopov proti "titovcem", pristašem komunističnega "revizionizma". Precej jih je končalo na vislicah, nekaj pred puškami, drugi pa so preseđeli dolga leta v ječah. Končno je Moskva spoznala, da to njenim smotrom na dolgo roko ne more biti koristno. Pomirila se je s Titom in mu priznala pravico do "neodvisne poti v komunizem", pa dobila od njega tudi obljubo, da te svoje poti ne bo preveč vneto ponujal drugim, zlasti ne satelitskim državam.

Od tedaj so odnosi med Beogradom in Moskvo nihali, bili so dobri, pa zopet nekaj zategnjeni, pa zopet dobri. Praška pomlad je ustvarila novo napetost, ki pa sta jo Tito in Brežnjev odstranila z obnovo starega dogovora in obljubo novega sodelovanja. Brežnjev je pri tem misil že na čas, ko Tita ne bo več, oziroma na položaj, ki bo nastal, ko bo Tito odšel.

Svobodni svet se je navadil gledati na Jugoslavijo kot na neodvisno komunistično državo, ki naj bi bila nekak prehod med pravovernim komunizmom in svobodnim svetom. Posebej so pri tem opozarjali na jugoslovansko tržno gospodarstvo, na nekaj več svobode v Jugoslaviji in na njeni odprte meje. Titova povezava z Moskvo lansko jesen v času oktobra vojne na Srednjem vzhodu, ko so Sovjeti preko Jugoslavije pošiljali orožje in vse drugo na Srednji vzhod ter poslali v Jugoslavijo poleg tehničnih strokovnjakov tudi nekaj svojih čet, je vzbudila močan sum v pravilnost dotedanega presojanja Titove neodvisnosti in neuverjenosti.

Ko je ameriški državni tajnik Kissinger odklonil razgovor z jugoslovanskim zunanjim ministrom na zasedanju Združenih narodov pod vtisom novega spoznanja, so bili v Beogradu hudo slabe volje. Ta se je od tedaj nekaj skadiła in odnosi med Beogradom in Washingtonom so postali spet bolj "normalni".

Dober del vzroka je v tem, da tudi v Washingtonu misijo na čas, ko bo Tito odhaljal in odšel. Jugoslavija je na strateško važnem delu sveta, preko nje vodijo pota Sovjetske zvezne in njenega bloka držav do Sredozemskega morja, preko Jugoslavije vodi pot iz Srednje Evrope po kopnem na Srednji vzhod in v Prednjo Azijo. Svobodni svet ne bi videl rad, da bi Jugoslavija postala znova v celoti del

sovjetskega bloka, ker bi s tem Sovjetsko brodovje dobilo oporišča v pristaniščih Jadranskega morja, sovjetska moč bi dobila močan porast v jugovzhodni Evropi in v Sredozemskem morju.

In vendar? Bo Zahod kaj ukrenil, če bi zmede ob Tičevem odhodu uporabila Sovjeti za obnovo svoje polne oblasti nad Jugoslavijo, ki jo je leta 1948 izgubila?

The Emergency Resolution memorializes the Governor of the State of Ohio, the Honorable John J. Gilligan, Representatives Stokes and Minshall, Vanik and Stanton to use their best efforts to repeal daylight savings time.

Here is the Resolution:

WHEREAS, the imposition of daylight savings time as a measure

sure to conserve energy has not proved effective or practicable in achieving a meaningful conservation of energy; and

WHEREAS, daylight savings time causes school youngsters to travel to schools in darkness thereby subjecting them to danger and risk; and

WHEREAS, many State officials throughout the nation have seriously questioned the wisdom of imposing daylight savings time as an energy conservation measure; and


WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency mea-

sure providing for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety; now, therefore

Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Cleveland:

...It shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




